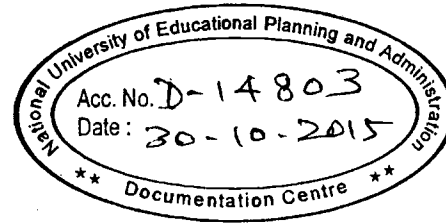



I would like to thank Statistical Cell of this Directorate for their efforts in bringing out this handy publication.

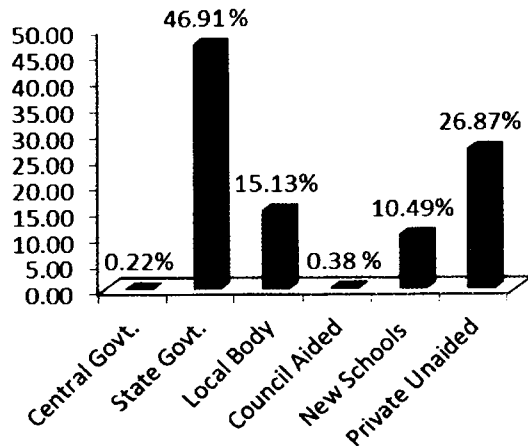

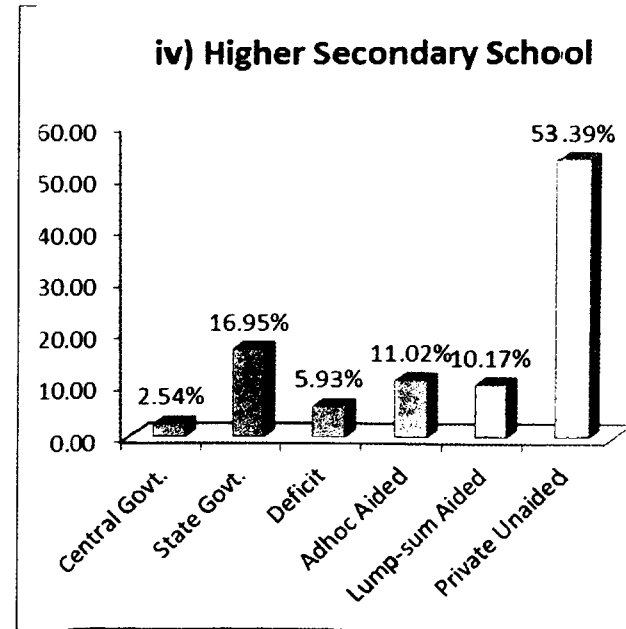

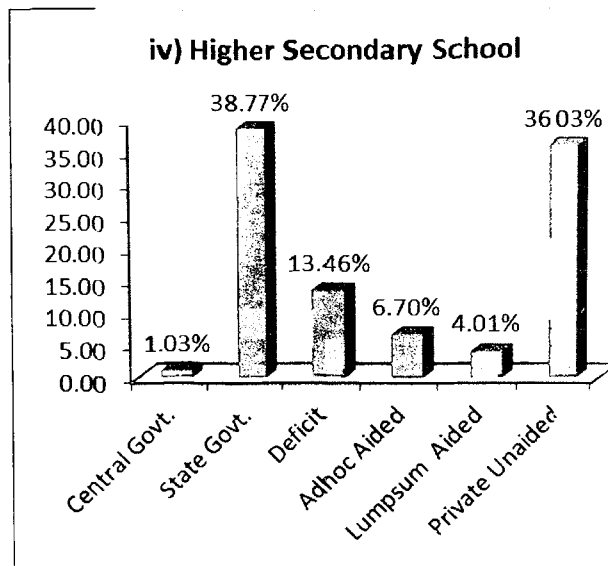
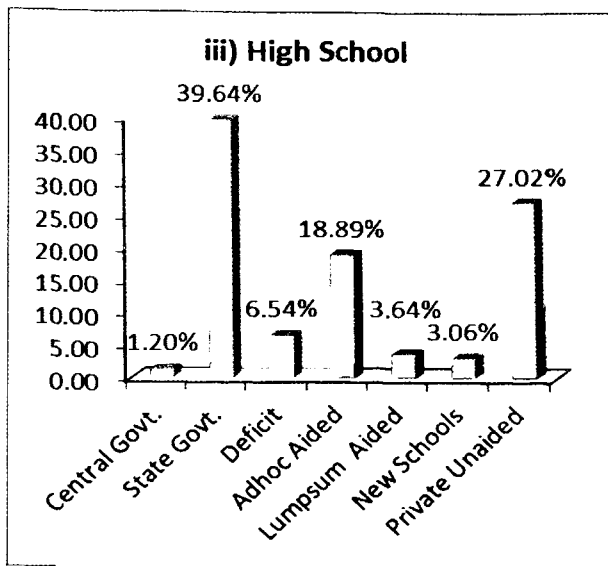
Number of Schools by Management (continue)



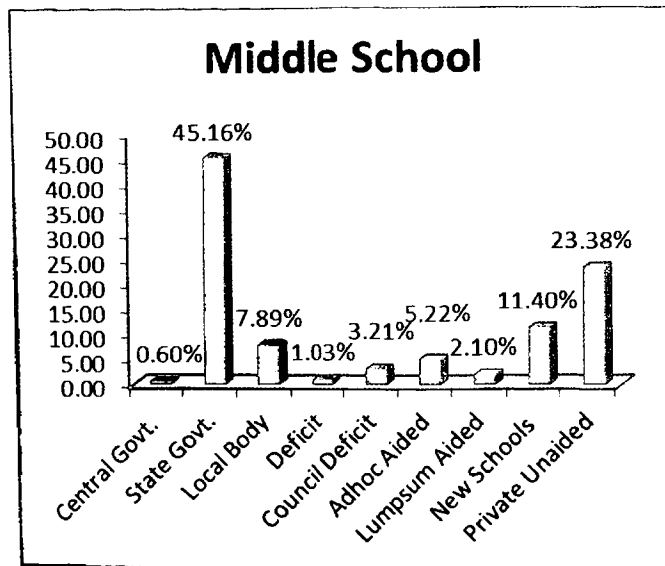
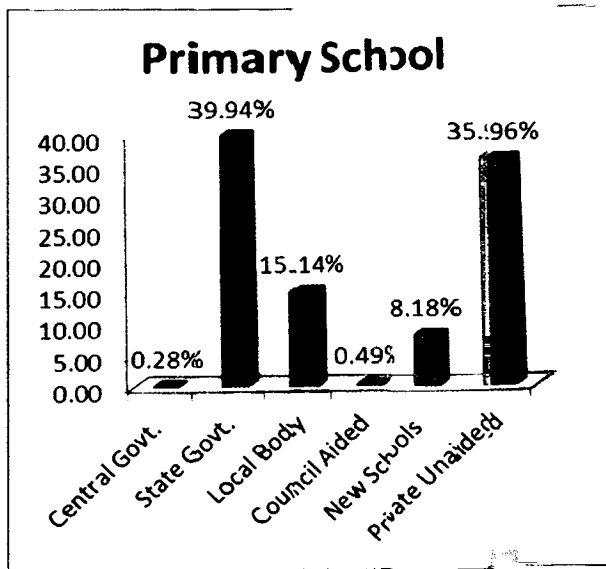
Enrolment of Students by Management

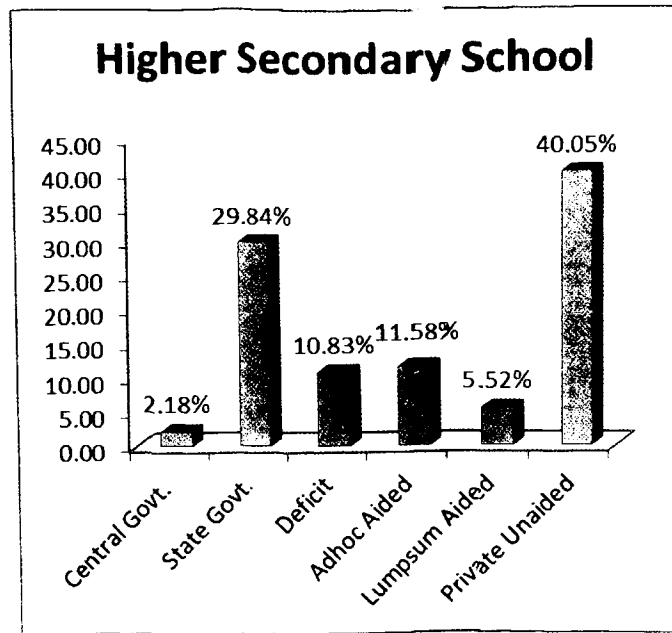
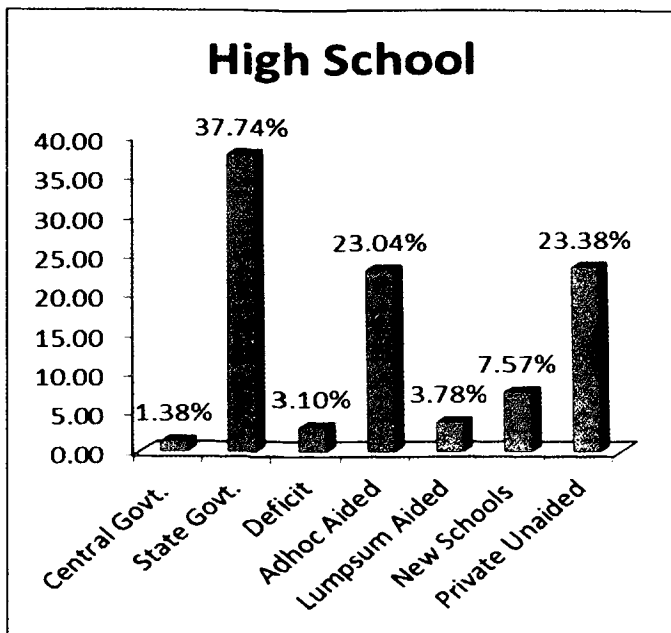

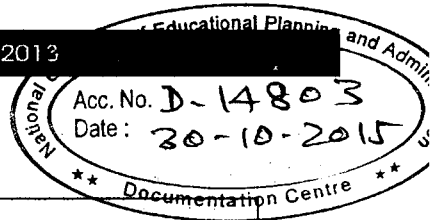
