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The National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) is an autonomous organisation, established by University Grants Commission (UGC), with its headquarters in Bangalore.

NAAC functions through its General Council (GC), and the Executive Committee (EC). The Chairperson of UGC shall be President of the GC. The Chairperson of EC shall be an eminent academician in the area of relevance to the NAAC; he / she will be nominated by the President of GC.

Both GC and EC have members selected in two categories:

1. Ex officio members are representatives from the organisations such as MHRD, UGC, AIU. Some members are also selected from the following organisations on reciprocal basis, they are – AICTE, DEC, NCTE, AIU, etc.
2. Nominated members are selected from Vice Chancellors, Principals, Teachers, Experts from Industry and other sectors nominated by the president of the GC/UGC/MHRD. The nominated members shall have a term of three years

The academic and administrative head of NAAC is the Director, with the status of Central University Vice Chancellor, who is also the member Secretary of both the GC and EC. NAAC has a core academic and administrative staff and consultants to help it achieve its objectives.

The NAAC is grateful to the Government of Karnataka for providing rent-free accommodation for housing the Office of the NAAC at Bangalore till August 2006. The NAAC is also grateful to the Government of Karnataka and Bangalore University for providing 5 acres land in Jnanabharathi Campus, Bangalore University, Bangalore.

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Introduction

1.1 Prelude

In the higher education system in India, there is tremendous quantitative expansion in the number of higher education institutions. The profile of education providers vary in types, programs, curricular offerings, mode of delivery and funding pattern. In fact, higher education throughout the world is in a flux. Under such conditions, variations in standard and quality are natural outcomes. Arising out of the need for establishing standards in education in the context of the proliferation of colleges all over the country, the Program of Action(PoA) 1992 of the National Policy on Education(NPE) in 1986 emphasized the need for a mechanism to be setup, which will encourage self-assessment in institutions and also Assessment and Accreditation by an external agency. In this context of consolidating the gains of our educational system and to ensure quality education, the setting up of the National Assessment and Accreditation Council(NAAC) was a historic step. The NAAC is an autonomous institution of the University Grants Commission(UGC) with its prime agenda to assess and accredit institutions of higher education in the country has been established in the year 1994 and is headquartered at Bangalore.

In the reaccreditation stage, the instrument has been fine-tuned by operationalizing the key aspects by identifying the core indicators and focusing on getting the valid responses to the focused questions under each core indicators. NAAC has been continuously engaged in training the assessors for carrying assessment and accreditation. There were significant efforts from NAAC in sensitizing the institutions regarding the processes and sharing the best practices of the high-ranking institutions in the various conferences, seminars and workshops supported by NAAC.

As on 31st March 2007, NAAC has accredited 140 Universities and 3492 Colleges in India. The impact that the NAAC has made on Higher Education Institutions(HEIs) is evident from the number of quality assurance seminars and workshops that have been conducted in the year 2006-2007 in order to achieve its objectives. Hitherto, the NAAC has conducted awareness programs in all most all States and this has triggered many regional level and district level activities. NAAC has declared the calendar year 2006 as a “Year of Student Participation in Quality Assurance” and many seminars, conferences and workshops have been sponsored by NAAC for this activity. Calendar year 2007 as a “Year of Promoting Internal Quality Assurance

Systems". As a result of this as on 31st March 2007 1808 accredited colleges and 77 accredited universities has established Internal Quality Assurance Cells(IQACs).

The process of assessment and accreditation has created a tremendous momentum among the academia on issues pertaining to quality and this has largely been due to the successful partnership between NAAC and the State governments. As per the guidelines and suggestions of NAAC 28 States, so far 25 States have established Quality Assurance Cells (QACs) at the State Level, except Jharkhand, Sikkim and Tripura. In case of National Capital Territory and 6 union Territories i.e., NCT of Delhi, Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Chandigarh, Dadra and Nagar Haveli, Daman and Diu, Lakshadweep, and Pondicherry, the colleges are minimal, hence the Directorate/ Commissionerate of Higher Education of the respective UTs take care.

NAAC is the member of the International Quality Assurance Agencies in Higher Education(INQAAHE) and a founder-member of Asia-Pacific Quality Network(APQN).

1.2 NAAC: Objectives

The objectives of NAAC is to assess and accredit institutions of higher learning, universities and colleges or one or more of their units, i.e., departments, schools, institutions, programmes, etc.

The main objectives of assessment and accreditation are to:

- a) grade institutions of higher education and their programmes;
- b) stimulate the academic environment and quality of teaching and research in these institutions;
- c) help institutions realise their academic objectives;
- d) promote necessary changes, innovations and reforms in all aspects of the institutions working for the above purpose;
- e) encourage innovations, self evaluation and accountability in higher education.

In order to meet its mandate NAAC will:

- a) Review periodically and revise and update as and when considered necessary in the light of experience gained the techniques and modalities of assessment;
- b) Communicate the results of assessment and grading to the concerned institution in a form and manner appropriate for corrective action, rectification and self improvement;
- c) Help and encourage the institutions in developing their own procedures, techniques and modalities for self evaluation;
- d) Initiate research studies, in planning and evaluation of educational institutions, programmes etc.;

- e) Ensure an optimised use of resources and the achievement of the identified goals of institutions of higher learning;
- f) NAAC may collaborate with institutions, Indian and foreign, engaged in work of a similar nature and may also undertake on request assessment and accreditation of institutions of higher education, abroad.

1.3 Structure of NAAC

NAAC's working is governed by the General Council (GC) and the Executive Committee (EC) on which University Grants Commission (UGC), All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), Association of Indian Universities (AIU), Universities, Colleges and other professional institutions are represented. Senior academics and educational administrators are nominated as members on these two bodies.

Academic Activities

3.1 Introduction

NAAC is in constant collaboration with the State Governments by establishing Quality Assurance Cell(QAC) and State Level Quality Assurance Coordination Committee(SLQACC) in each State. So far 25 States have established QAC and NAAC is supporting this endeavor. This Cell primarily focuses on the preparation of the Colleges to undergo the processes of assessment and accreditation. Many quality improvement, programmes have been organized jointly by NAAC and QAC of States for Colleges.

The core objective of the NAAC as stated in the vision and mission is Quality Assurance in Higher Education. Assessment and Accreditation is the tool in reaching this objective. NAAC academic activities may be viewed at two levels one is the Awareness programmes on Assessment and Accreditation and the other is the Post Accreditation Programmes. The awareness / promotional programmes mainly explains the policy, direction and guidelines of MHRD, UGC and NAAC for Assessment and Accreditation.

The post accreditation activities on quality sustenance and quality enhancement are by means of Student Participation in Quality Assurance(SPQA), sharing of Best Practices for Quality Enhancement(BPQE) and to establish a functional Internal Quality Assurance Cell(IQAC) in each accredited College and University.

A programme or an activity may be a seminar, conference, workshop, symposia at the local, state, regional or national level. These activities are organized by NAAC in collaboration with the QACs, UGC-Academic Staff Colleges, Universities, or Colleges. Either a NAAC staff or NAAC representative is present as a resource person in most of the programmes across the country.

A brief of the academic activities across the country during the period 2006-2007 is given below in the chronological order region-wise.

3.2 Northern Region

Shanti Devi Arya Mahila College, Dinanagar organized a two-day seminar on the theme 'Quality Assurance in Higher Education' on 21-22 September 2006. The NAAC sponsored seminar evinced good participation from various sections of the stakeholders of higher education in the State. The workshop which was inaugurated by Dr. Surinder Singh, Former Vice-Chancellor Mahatma Gandhi Kashi Vidyapeeth, Varnasi, Uttar Pradesh had six sub-themes on 1) Teacher, Students and Alumni; 2) Industry Interaction; 3) College Management; 4) Community; 5) Healthy Practices; and 6) Finance. Dr. H. S. Soch, former Vice-Chancellor, Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar, Punjab delivered the keynote address. A host of academicians from across the state participated in the seminar.



Allahabad, Uttar Pradesh

A National Seminar on the theme 'Developing Quality Culture in Higher Education: Innovations and Initiatives', was organized by Jagat Taran Girl's Degree College, Allahabad on 18-19 November 2006. The NAAC sponsored seminar evinced participation from West Bengal, Orissa, Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan, Delhi, Haryana and Uttaranchal. Prof. B.K. Passi, former Vice Chairman, NCTE, Delhi was one of the resource persons. Prof. M. Mukhopadhyaya, Senior Consultant, NIEPA, Delhi delivered the keynote address.



Prof. R. G. Harshe, Vice Chancellor, Allahabad University, delivered the presidential address. A total of 101 papers were presented during these sessions. A host of academicians, resource persons, scholars including Prof B. N. Asthana, former Vice-Chancellor, Kanpur University, Prof Ram Shakal Pandey, Head, Department of Education, Allahabad University, Prof A. B. Samadar, Director, MNNIT, Allahabad and Justice Prem Shankar Gupt keenly participated in the seminar.

Srinagar, Jammu and Kashmir

A three-day regional seminar on 'Re-accreditation of Institutions of Higher Learning: Role of Stakeholders' was organized by Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of the University of

Kashmir, Srinagar, from 22-24, March 2007. The seminar was attended by academicians both from within and outside the State of Jammu and Kashmir. Besides all the members of teaching and administrative staff of the University of Kashmir, Principals of constituent and affiliated colleges along with the teachers concerned with the quality assurance of respective colleges.

Major themes deliberated upon during the three-day seminar included: Declining academic standards of institutions of higher learning: Causes and consequences, Relevance of the accreditation and assessment of the institutions of higher learning Role of stakeholders in assessment and accreditation Policy interventions for quality education. A panel discussion was organized wherein Vice-Chancellor, Dean-Academics, Director-IQAC, and Registrar, University of Kashmir responded to the questions of the participants.

3.3 North-Eastern Region

Jorhat, Assam

To consider using this grant for assisting continuous quality sustenance programmes in accredited HEIs in North Eastern Region, the NAAC has held discussion meetings with experts and officials concerned. The NAAC is providing Rs.50,000/- each to accredited college and Rs.1,00,000/- each to accredited University as one-time grant. Amount has been released with detailed guidelines to 224 colleges and 8 universities. As a result of this special grant and intervention of NAAC, all accredited HEIs will have IQAC, a dedicated computer system and institutional website.

The one time grant should be used primarily for creation and sustenance of Internal Quality Assurance Cells(IQAC) in all accredited HEIs in the North East by the end of X plan i.e. by March 2007.

3.4 Eastern Region

A two-day NAAC sponsored National Conference on the theme 'Quest for Quality: Dr. A. V. Baliga College of Arts and Science, Kumta organized Classroom Matters', on March 5-6, 2007. More than 350 delegates attended the conference. Prof. S. N. Hegde, former Vice Chancellor of University of Mysore, inaugurated; and Prof. M. I. Savadatti, former Vice Chancellor, Mangalore University delivered the key-note address. Prof. Kodandaramiah, Director of Collegiate Education; Prof. Sunny Tharappan of CLHRD, Mangalore; Dr. S. V. Kamat, Principal of the Balige college facilitated the proceedings.

Mangalore, Karnataka

To contemplate on the challenges and opportunities in enhancing the quality of teaching and to reflect on various aspects of teaching skills, a two-day NAAC sponsored conference was organized at Dr. Nitte Shankara Adyanthaya Memorial First Grade College, Nitte, Karnataka on 8-9 March 2007. Speaking at the inaugural session, Prof B.S. Sherigara, Vice Chancellor, Kuvempu University underlined the importance of harnessing intellectual and physical infrastructure for the well being of an educational institution. Mr. N. Vinaya Hegde, President, NITTE Education Trust presided over the session. The conference evinced participation from 113 delegates from 41 colleges.



3.7 NAAC Library and Information Centre

Academics and researchers extensively use the NAAC library as in-house reference for literature needs of higher education and related subjects. NAAC has a well-stocked library and information center with a collection of documents covering all spheres of higher education like Quality in Education, University Education, Academic planning and management, Information and Communication Technology in education, students participation and support systems, faculty development, curriculum and teaching techniques, assessment and accreditation, management and Total Quality Management, women's studies, research methods, LIS and others.

The library also has a wide-array of general and educational reference books like encyclopedias, biographies, directories, AIU publications, institutional publications of Government and International organizations. The Library subscribes to around 100 quality international journals both in print and online. It also gives access to CD Rom Databases to its users. In addition the library gives access to in-house reference of Self Study Reports submitted by over 3000 Higher Educational Institutions for accreditation and NAAC publications to the academics and researchers. Photocopying and printouts of library resources is available on request at a nominal cost.

3.8 International Academic Activities

Severes, France

The World Bank had organized a Joint Client-Staff Learning Seminar on Quality Assurance in Tertiary Education in Severes, France, on 18-20 June 2006. Prof. V. S. Prasad, Director, NAAC, was invited as a Guest Speaker at this conference. In the first panel discussion, Prof Prasad shared the Indian Experience of quality assurance in India. In the second panel, he spoke on the Asia Pacific Quality Network (APQN) experience as a Vice-President. The panel discussions allowed the participants to better understand how regional networks are emerging and the challenges faced.

Singapore

Dr. Latha Pillai, Adviser, NAAC, presented a paper on 'Grading and Ranking Higher Education Institutions: Necessity or Evil' in the 2nd Asia Pacific Professional Leaders in Education Conference hosted by QS Education Trust and Nanyang Technological University from 12-14 July 2006 at Singapore.

Bangalore, India

NAAC organized a two-day International Conference on 'Student Participation in Quality Enhancement' at Bangalore on 16-17 September 2006 to mark its 12th Foundation day. The Asia-Pacific Quality Network has supported the conference. The conference was inaugurated by Dr. M. Anandakrishnan, Vice-Chancellor, Anna University, India. Prof. V. S. Prasad, Director, NAAC outlined the scope and objectives of NAAC's initiative on student



participation. UGC Commission Members, Eminent educationists, Vice-Chancellors and Principals attended the conference to address the academia. The conference was attended by about 150 delegates including ten APQN delegates and more than 120 Indian delegates which included 30 students. In response to NAAC's appeal, 20 posters were presented by the students, from which four were selected for prizes. A team comprising Dr. Jagannath Patil, Deputy Adviser, Mr. B S Ponmudiraj, Assistant Adviser, Mr. Wahidul Hassan, Communication & Publication Officer, Mr. V Lakshman, Facilitation and Liaison Officer, took efforts for the smooth conduct of the programme.

Australia

Dr. M. S. Shyamasundar and Dr. K. Rama, Deputy Advisers, NAAC, visited Australia to experience and share various aspects related to Quality Assurance in the educational systems during 18–25 November 2006. The programme is part of Memorandum of Co-operation signed between NAAC & AUQA (Australia Universities Quality Agency) supported and facilitated by the APQN under the staff movement programme. NAAC officers visited Australian Qualification Framework Advisory Board (AQFAB), Office of Training and Tertiary Education, Higher Education and Regulation Division under Department of Education and Training and had detailed discussions on their quality assurance mechanisms / systems. They also visited Swinburne University of Technology, Kambrya College, Deakin University in Melbourne and Center for Learning and Innovation (OTEN) in Sydney and many other organizations dealing with educational systems in Australia.

Lahore, Pakistan

Prof. V. S. Prasad, Director, NAAC was invited as a guest speaker at the International Conference on 'Assessing Quality in Higher Education' held at Punjab University, Lahore, Pakistan from 11-13 December 2006. The Conference was sponsored by APQN. Prof. Prasad spoke on the topic 'Quality Assurance Policy for Higher Education: Developing Country Perspective'.

Mr. B. S. Madhukar, Deputy Adviser, NAAC participated at the International Conference on 'Assessing Quality in Higher Education' Lahore, Pakistan from 11-13 December, 2006. Mr. Madhukar presented a paper titled 'Methods of Grading Performance in Educational Institutions' at the conference.

Tokyo, Japan

Dr. Latha Pillai, Adviser, NAAC, participated in the JABEE Symposium on "Global Trend and Perspectives on the Quality Assurance of Engineering Education" and Workshop on 'Cross-border Cooperation of Accreditation Agencies in Asia' held from 14–16 December 2006 at National Graduate Institute for Policy Studies, Tokyo, Japan. She presented a paper on 'Accreditation Systems in India'. During her visit, she interacted with officials of National Institution for Academic Degrees and University Evaluation (NIAD) and Japan University Accreditation Association (JUAA), Tokyo.

NAAC- COL (Common Wealth of Learning)

Over the years NAAC in collaboration with COL has developed materials on Quality Assurance including methodologies for self-assessment of teacher education institutions. Recognizing the work done by NAAC, the COL an inter-governmental organisation of Commonwealth

Countries, which has initiated many measures for promotion of quality teacher education in Commonwealth Countries, proposed to NAAC to develop a “Quality Assurance Tool Kit for Teacher Education Institutions” which is basically a consolidation of the material developed in the various workshops and conferences organized in collaboration with COL. A workshop was organized for this from 18-20



December 2006 in Bangalore and was attended by participants from 10 major Commonwealth Countries including India. Dr. K. Rama, Deputy Adviser and Dr. Sujatha P. Shanbagh, Assistant Adviser, NAAC coordinated the activity.

NAAC- COL (Common Wealth of Learning)

NAAC and COL have been engaged in organizing workshops, conferences, expert meetings and material development on quality assurance. To give ‘Quality Indicators for Teacher Education’ to be used by the institution for self assessment a trial on field and make necessary amendments, if required. NAAC organised an orientation workshop from 21-22 December 2006 at Bangalore for thirteen Principals/Senior teacher educators from all over India. Prof. V. S. Prasad, Director, NAAC in his inaugural speech briefed on common interest of NAAC and COL and stressed on the importance of Quality Indicators and validation. Dr. Mohan Menon gave a brief introduction of COL and its objectives and the background of this programme. Dr. T.K.S. Lakshmi, Former Professor & Dean, Faculty of Education, Banasthali Vidyapeeth, Rajasthan; Dr. K. Rama, Deputy Adviser, NAAC and Dr. Sujata P. Shanbhag, Assistant Adviser, NAAC oriented the participants in field trial of the indicators. Dr. K. Rama, Deputy Adviser, NAAC was the co-ordinator of the programme.

Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia

Dr. Jagannath Patil, Deputy Adviser, NAAC was invited to Asia-Pacific Quality Network (APQN) Conference and AGM held at Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia on 4-7 February 2007. As a Board Member of APQN, he conducted workshop on “Student Participation in Quality Assurance” in the conference. Dr. Jagannath Patil also chaired a parallel session in the conference and participated in AGM and Board meetings.

Saudi Arabia

The National Commission for Academic Accreditation & Assessment (NCAAA) in Saudi Arabia in conjunction with AL Yamamah College had organized a three-day International Conference during 4-6 March 2007 on Quality Assurance in Higher Education. The conference was held at AL Yamamah College Campus in Riyadh, Saudi Arabia. Dr. M. S. Shyamsundar Deputy Adviser, NAAC had been invited to participate in this International Conference.

Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam

Mr. Ganesh Hegde, Assistant Adviser, NAAC attended a training workshop on the theme 'Internal Quality Assurance: Key factors for ensuring and enhancing quality in higher educational institutions' from 12-13 March, 2007 at Vietnam National University, Ho Chi Minh City. The training workshop was sponsored by Asia Pacific Quality Network and organized by Centre for Educational Testing and Quality Assessment, VNU.

Australia

Dr. Jagannath Patil, Deputy Adviser, NAAC has received Endeavour India Executive Award and Mr. B.S. Madhukar, Deputy Adviser has received Endeavour Executive Award set up by the Government of Australia for the Year 2007. The Endeavour India Executive Awards form part of the Endeavour Programme, established in 2003 to support high achieving individuals from around the world to undertake international study, research or professional development. The Hon Julie Bishop MP, Australian Minister for Education, Science and Training has sent the congratulatory message for receiving this prestigious award.

Future Plans

Planning is a prelude to rational action and this is true for individuals, institutions as well as Nations. Based on the experience of last 12 to 13 years of its operations, and keeping in view the future expectations of stakeholders, the NAAC has developed and initiated its Roadmap for the XI Plan, from the 1st of April 2007. This Perspective Plan is the result of diverse and varied experience of NAAC through the years.

Broadly the NAAC would focus on the following activities during the XI Plan:

1. Development of a New Assessment and Accreditation Methodology.
2. Assessment to cover all higher education institutions of the country, in a phased manner.
3. Promotion of internal quality assurance systems in HEIs.
4. Dissemination of best practices amongst HEIs.
5. Development of a pool of trained quality assurance professionals
6. Promotion of 'in house' Research on Quality Assurance and
7. Capacity building of NAAC



1. Development of a New Assessment and Accreditation Methodology

Based on extensive discussions with all the stakeholders of higher education, the NAAC has developed and implemented a new assessment and accreditation methodology with effect from 1st April 2007. The main objectives of this new methodology are:

- To ensure continuous/need-based improvements in the instruments of A/A
- To overcome some of the limitations of the methodology in practice hitherto
- To enhance the credibility and reliability of the assessment process and outcome

- To enable NAAC to conduct assessment of large number of institutions effectively and in a short time.

The important features of this new methodology are:

- A two-step approach is introduced for the assessment and accreditation of Affiliated and Constituent colleges which are seeking A/A for the first time: Step 1: is the determination of the Institutional Eligibility for Quality Assessment (IEQA) and Step 2: is the Assessment and Accreditation of institutions which have earned their IEQA status.
- Fine-tuning of Criteria, Key Aspects and development of Assessment Indicators as guidelines/probes for assessment.
- Provision for Key Aspect-wise differential weightages for effective measurement of Key Aspect-wise and Criterionwise quality profile of the institution.
- Changing the grading pattern from the earlier nine-point scale to the new three letter grades viz. "A", "B", and "C" for accredited institutions and "D" for those which are not accredited.
- Modification in the institutional overall scoring from the earlier percentage to the Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) system on a four-point scale
- Development of a specific format for Peer Team Report, to elicit focused and evaluative judgments on the institutional quality.

2. Assessment of large number of institutions

As on 31st March 2007, NAAC has assessed 140 university-level institutions and 3,492 colleges. NAAC has earned the distinction of having covered the highest number of institutions by any Quality Assurance Agency in the World. It is increasingly realized by the stakeholders that NAAC assessment contributes greatly to quality improvement. In spite of this, large number of institutions of the country are yet to be assessed and accredited. It is expected that by the two-step approach of assessment of Affiliated/Constituent colleges, and with the support of National Agencies and State higher education Departments, all the higher education institutions of the country can be assessed during the XI Plan period. To address the onerous task of assessment of large number of HEIs, NAAC is Networking with other Quality Assurance Agencies, besides making strong attempts at capacity building of NAAC and validation of assessment by select agencies.

3. Promotion of internal quality assurance systems

The NAAC envisages to usher in continuous quality in HEIs through a combination of internal and external quality assurance practices. NAAC strongly believes that ultimately, efficient Internal systems of quality assurance alone can sustain the quality of any institution. The NAAC

has developed detailed guidelines and action points for the functioning of Institutional Internal Quality Assurance Cells. As on date, over 50 percent of accredited institutions have established IQACs. It is envisaged that during the XI Plan, every HEI (accredited or otherwise) will be motivated by NAAC, to initiate systems for internal quality assurance systems.

4. Dissemination of Best Practices

The NAAC has been bringing out series of publications on Best Practices, with the hope that institutions can learn and benefit from each others' success stories and experiences. In the context of India's institutional diversity, institutions may have to emulate the best practices of other institutions, contextualize them to their individual situation and add value to their existing practices.

5. Development of trained quality assurance professionals

The Peer Teams play an important role in the assessment of institutional quality. It is a judgemental activity which requires sharp skills of evaluation and greater objectivity in measurement. Professional skill-based selection of assessors, is essential to ensure credibility to the NAAC operations. Therefore, NAAC proposes to focus on developing a pool of trained quality assurance professionals, to ensure greater stakeholder confidence and acceptability of the NAAC's Accreditation outcome.

6. NAAC Research Activities

Focused research on quality assurance contributes to the better understanding of complex and diverse realities of higher education. Under its Quality Assurance Resource Centre, NAAC has established a Research Unit to undertake focused research on quality assurance and related areas of study. This unit along with another important unit - the Publications Unit would focus on Quality Assurance as a research, development and promotional activity of NAAC.

7. Capacity Building of NAAC

To undertake newer tasks as above, it is also necessary to reengineer the organisational structure of NAAC. It is hoped that NAAC would be strengthened with more autonomy, more professional staff and state-of-the art use of ICT, to take up the new responsibilities.

5

Administrative Activities

1 Annual Stock verification

Annual stock verification of non-consumables, consumables, library and publications stock was carried out for the period ending 31st March 2007.

2 Finance and Accounts

The statement of accounts for the year 2006-2007 compiled and audited by statutory auditors. (details in chapter 6)

3 NAAC Campus Development

The Administrative and Library block of the building is almost complete. NAAC office has since shifted to the new building on 08th August 2006. It is further expected that the entire civil works at the new campus to be completed by 30 September 2007. The total expenditure incurred as on 31/03/2007 amounted to Rs.9.12 Crores. This is excluding the interiors, furniture's and other small project related works.

4. ICT at NAAC

NAAC has developed the new Management Information System software for the greater functionality and portability for Assessment and Accreditation purposes. The MIS is both compatible for INTRANET and INTERNET platforms. Online submission of Letter of Intention (LOI) is the key process from which the track ID is automatically generated and the institution can get the information related to the Assessment and Accreditation process with this TRACK ID at any given point of time. The TRACK ID will be unique for each institutions, so there will be no overlap and repetition.

The software backend is supported by the access database and front end with java based modules, so that the security part is not compromised at any level of migration. The new MIS software is designed in such a way that, the information once gathered will go upto the final accreditation stage. The software is designed based on the RDBMS concept. Apart from Assessment and Accreditation process, the MIS is integrated to other departmental data. Some of the modules that are embedded with this software are:

- Employee Management System
- Contract Employees Management System
- Connectivity to NAAC website through INTRANET
- Inventory Management System for Stationary
- Internal Circulars – Message board
- Access to LOI / IEQA submitted online.
- Manuals download etc.,

5. NAAC Website

NAAC website www.naacindia.org is highly appreciated by academic circles, institutions of national and international repute and research agencies across the globe for its professional quality content. It is regularly updated and monitored. There are dedicated team of professionals to look into the website matters. The uptime for this period is 100 percent. Some of the highlights of NAAC website are:-

- The website has all accredited institutions information according to state wise listing for easy retrieval and access.
- The website has got all the publications in download section which can be downloaded instantaneously.
- The events section has all the upcoming seminars and programmes conducted by NAAC from time to time.
- The circular division works as message board for the outer world.
- There is link of other institution to know more about Quality, Assessment and Accreditation of other agencies
- The News letter section has latest news letter and archive section contains previous news letters which can be easily downloadable.

Overall NAAC website is one stop shop to know about NAAC and its activities.

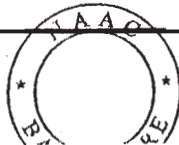

SCHEDULE : 12 STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTING POLICIES AND NOTES ATTACHED TO AND FORMING PART OF ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31ST MARCH, 2007.

A. Accounting Policies :

1. The Accounts are prepared under the historical cost basis of accounting, on a going concern and on accrual basis.
2. The financial statements have been prepared in conformity with the generally accepted accounting principles.
3. All significant accounting policies adopted in the preparation and presentation of this financial statements are mentioned hereunder :
 - a. All Fixed Assets (including assets acquired out of UGC Grants) are stated at cost, which comprises of purchase price and attributable cost of bringing the assets to its working condition for its intended use. No depreciation is provided in respect of such assets.
 - b. Assessment Fees, Appeal Fees for reassessment & re – accreditation and Interest on Fixed Deposits is recognized as it accrues. Other income such as sale of manuals etc are recognized as and when received.
 - c. Revenue Grants received from UGC are recognized as income to the extent of the corresponding net expenditure of the period for which they are received.
 - d. Interest on deposits with banks is treated as grants received from UGC.
 - e. Liability in respect of leave encashment & Gratuity to employees is accounted at the time of payment.




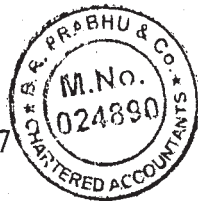
B. NOTES TO ACCOUNTS :


1. NAAC is an autonomous body established under UGC Act with the objective of providing a forum that will encourage excellence in institutions of higher education, by providing a mechanism for the self-assessment in such institutions and assessment and accreditation by NAAC. For this purpose, UGC releases Grants to NAAC to meet the above objects in accordance with approved budgets relating to both Revenue and Capital.
2. All fixed assets including Fixed Assets that are pertaining to NAAC – Quality Assurance Cells that are acquired out of UGC Grants are stated at cost and depreciation is not provided for in the accounts. The effect on the Income & Expenditure account is not readily ascertainable, to that extent.
3. Liability for payment of leave encashment & Gratuity to employees is not made in the books of accounts.
4. NAAC maintains separate bank accounts & Books of Accounts in respect of employees & employer contribution of Provident Funds pending registration of the Provident Fund, Balances have been merged with NAAC's Accounts.
5. Comparative figures have been recasted wherever necessary to confirm to this years classification.

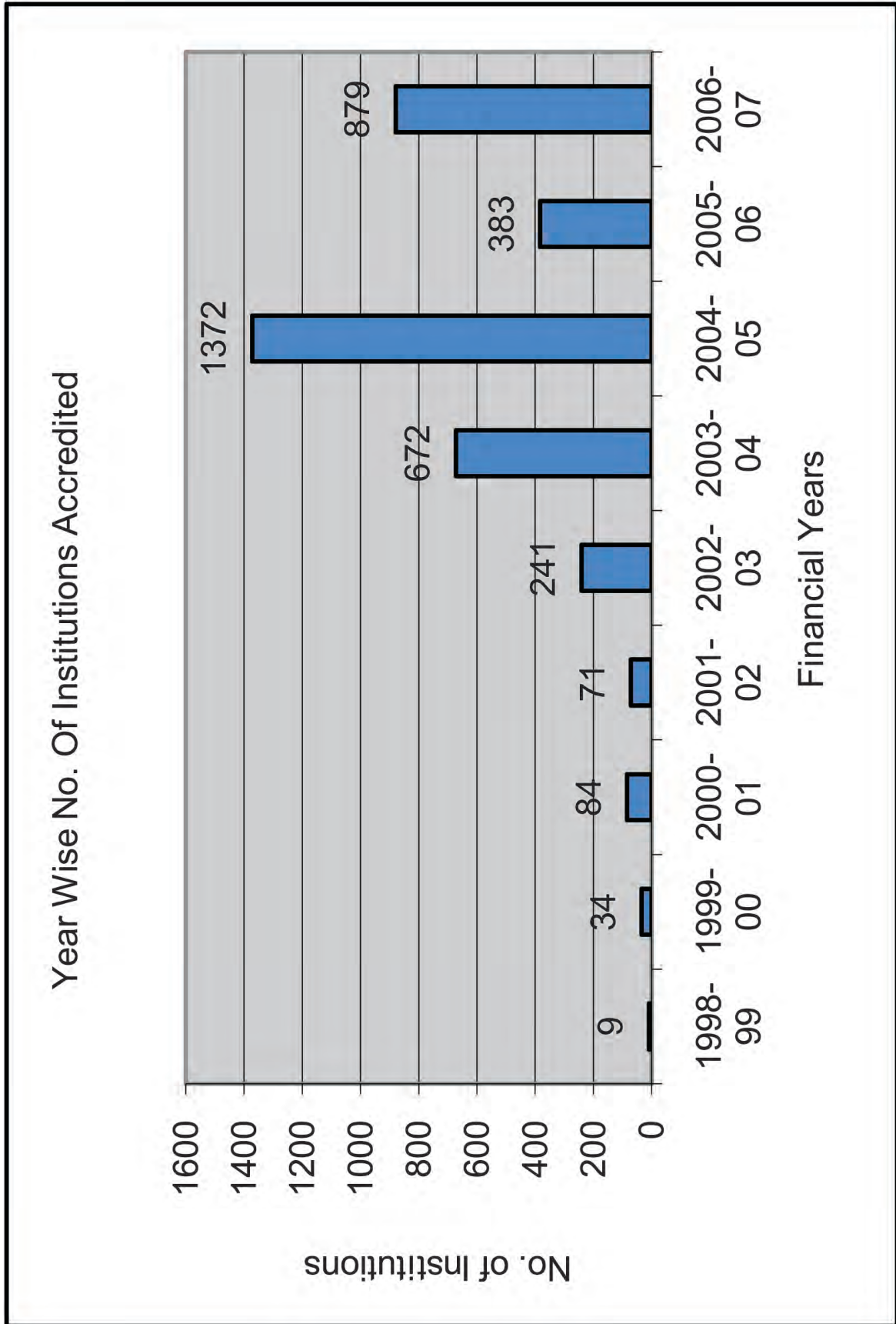
