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INTRODUCTION

The district of 24-Parganas forms the south-western part of the Presidency division of West Bengal and lies between $88^{\circ}2'$ and $89^{\circ}6'$ east longitude. It is bounded on the north by the district of Nadia, on the south by the Bay of Bengal and on the West by the river Hooghly, which proceeding from north to south separates it from the district of Hooghly, Howrah and Midnapore. The area of the district is 4136 sq. kms. The density of population is 759.7 per sq. km. according to 1981 Census.

The district of 24-Parganas has six sub-divisions viz. Bongaon, Barasat, Barrackpore, Alipore Sadar, Diamond Harbour & Basirhat with their Head quarters at the town bearing their respective names. The district head quarter is at Alipore, a suburb of Calcutta. The Bongaon sub-division covers the Police Stations of Bagdah, Bongaon and Gaighata, the Barasat sub-division consists of the police stations of Habra, Deganga, Rajarhat, Barasat and Amdanga, the Barrackpore sub-division covers the police stations of Bijpur, Naihati, Jagatdal, Noapara, Barrackpore, Titagarh, Khardah, Belgharia, Baranagar, Dum-Dum, Nimta, Airport, Laketown and Saltlake, the sadar sub-division consists of the police stations of Gardenreich, Matiabruz, Maheshtala, Budge Budge, Bishnupur, Behala, Regent Park, Jadavpur, Kasba, Tiljala, Bhangar, Somarpur, Baruipur, Canning, Basanti, Joynagar and Kultali, the Diamond Harbour sub-division consists off the police stations of Magrahat, Falta, Diamond Harbour, Kulpi, Mandir-bazar, Mathurapur, Patharpratima, Kalkdwip, Sagar and

Nam Khata, the Basirhat sub-division covers the police stations of Warupnagar, Baduria, Basirhat, Haroa, Minal-khan, Hasiabad, Sandeshkhali, Hingalganj and Gosaba.

There are 102 towns in the district of which 31 are Municipal towns, 42 Non-municipal towns, 28 Urban out-growths and cantonments as per Census 1981.

In the district, out of 387 mouzas 83 were un-inhabited in 1971.

During the cold weather from November to January the cloud and rainfall is almost found absent in the district. The mean temperature falls steadily between November and middle of January but humidity continues to be high. In February, temperature begins to rise and in May, monsoon is occasionally experienced when Cyclonic storms form near the head of the Bay. With the commencement of the south-west monsoon which generally occurs in the latter half of June humidity increases to 90 percent of saturation, while heavy cloud in the sky ands rainfall are of daily occurrences. The avarage annual rainfall is 1673 millimetres and the maximum rainfall is experienced in between July and September.

The principal rivers of the district are the Hooghly, the Bidyadhari, the Piali and the Jamuna. The population of the district was according to 1981 census was 10739439 of whom 5642438 were males and 5097001 females. The Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes population constituted 25.04 and 1.75 percent respectively of the

total population in 1981. Out of the total population 44.6.2 percent were literates according to 1981 census. The percentage of literacy among males and females were 5.55.8 and 35.5 respectively in the same year.

Majority of the people of 24-Parganas depend on agriculture as their principal means of livelihood. The principal crops in the district are paddy, jute, wheat, pulses and mustard.

The most important industry in the district is the Textile industry.

Following places may be mentioned as the places of interest in the district.

Ganga Sagar—The great bathing festival of the district is known as Ganga Sagar which is held at southern end of Sagar Island on the day of Makara Sankranti in January. It attracts an immense number of pilgrims, who believe that by bathing at this sacred spot, they wash away their sins.

Palabari Joynagar—The Shrine of Radhaballabh at Joy-nagar is visited by a large number of pilgrims during the Dol festival in the month of Phalgun. Close to the temple is a Kadamba tree which during the festival is said to yield one flower in honour of God Krishna.

This is looked upon as supernatural phenomenon as the rainy months of July and August are the season in which the tree flowers.

Basra

- **Gazisaheb's Mela**, a religious gathering is held in later part of May or in the early part of June at Basra close to the station of that name on the Canning branch of the Eastern Railway.

Dakshin Barasat

- It is a village in Joynagar police station of Sadar Sub-division, situated on the bank of Adiganga, an old channel of the Ganges. The village contains a temple of Kali and Shrine dedicated to the God Adyamahesh. Three "Melas" are held here.

(1) The first on the last day of Chaitra in the bazar near Kali's temple. (2) The second on the first day of Baishakh in the Adyamahesh bazar and (3) the last in April in honour of sannyasi named Achalananda Thirtha Swami, who was the Guru or spiritual preceptors of Raja Surendra Narayan Dev Bahadur of the Sovabazar family of Calcutta.

- Fraserganj — It is an island in the extreme south of the Diamond Harbour Sub-division. It is bounded on the north and west by the Pattibunia Khalal on east by the Sattarmukhi river and Pakuriaber Khal and on the south by the Bay of Bengal. The place is now an attractive tourist centre of the state.
- Kanthalpara — Kanthalpara, a Village in the Barrackpore Sub-division situated about 2 k. m. from the Naihati Railway station is said to be a noted place of Sanskrit learning and was the birth place of the great Bengali novelist Sahitya Samrat Bankim Chandra Chattopadhyay.
