IV. PHYSICAL FEATURES

A brief note on the physical features of Sikkim

Sikkim is a small hilly State in the Eastern Himalayas with formidable physical features. It is bounded by vast stretches of Tibetan Plateaus in the North, the Chumbi Valley of Tibet and the Kingdom of Bhutan in the East, the Kingdom of Nepal in the West and Darjeeling District of West Bengal in the South.

The State of Sikkim has a total area of only 7096 sq km. and is stretched over 112 kms from North to South and 64 kms from East to West. It lies in the North – Eastern Himalayas between 27° 00'46" to 28° 07'48" North Latitude and 88° 00'58" to 88° 55'25" East Longitude.

The State receives an Annual Rainfall of 2000mm to 4000mm. Tista & Rangit, which originates respectively, from Cholamu Lake and Rathong Glacier, are the two major rivers of the State.

Available phosphorous:	4.0-175 p.p.m. with mean value 46.87 p.p.m.
Available Potash:	45 to 490 p.p.m. with mean value 184.71 p.p.m.
Lime Requirement:	Most between 2.0 tonnes per acre but varies from 0 to 16 tonnes per acre.

10. IMPORTANT MEDICINAL PLANTS FOUND IN SIKKIM

Sl.No.	PARTICULARS
1.	NARDOSTACHYS GRANDIFLORA: Locally known as JATAMASI is about 40 cm in height and thrives above 12000 ft. It's finds a wide spectrum of uses as a tonic, antispasmodic, diuretic, laxative. Its roots are used to prevent epileptic fits. The roots are also used as incense, especially for religious offerings.
2.	Aconites (Bikhma): Commonly known as Monkshood and Bikhma locally is found at altitudes between 7000 ft. and 13000 ft. Growing to a height of about 3 ft, they are very poisonous. Their roots are however effective against rheumatism and fever but care has to be taken to administer the correct dosage.
3.	Artemisia Vulgaris (Titeypaty): Commonly known as Indian Wormwood and titeypati locally and grows up to altitude of 6000 ft. Attaining a height of about 4 ft, their leaves are used as an antiseptic.
4.	Piper Longum (Pipla): Commonly known as long pepper and locally as Pipla grows on the foothills of Himalayas up to an altitude of 3000 ft. It is a creeping herb. It's fruits are used as a tonic and a medicine for disease like asthma. The roots are used as an antidotes to snake bites.
5.	Picrorhiza Kurrooa (Kutki): Known as Kutki locally grows at altitudes ranging between 10,000 ft. and 16000 ft. It grows to a height of about half feet and it's roots are used as a purgative and have also been found effective against Malaria.
