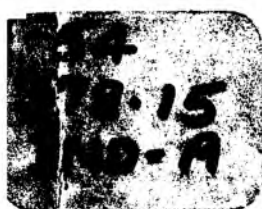

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## PREFACE

Every year generally during the period preceding, the presentation of the Annual Budget, Planning Commission holds discussions with the representatives of State Governments. These discussions are initially held sectorally. Education Division of the Planning Commission has been compiling, during the last few years, analysis of the annual Plans of State Governments relating to the Education, Art & Culture and Youth Affairs and Sports. Valuable data relating to financial outlays and physical targets in respect of various schemes, including MNP comprising Elementary Education and Adult Education are collected. Every year these data are analysed and circulated for internal use.

2. The compilation for the Annual Plan 1990-91 was circulated widely among all concerned, namely, Education Secretaries of State Governments, officers of Union Deptt. of Education, NCERT, NIEPA, etc. The circulation of the analysis evoked wide interest and there was demand for additional copies from some quarters.

3. The analysis of Annual Plan 1991-92 is similarly being circulated widely as in the previous year. As per the latest decision, this would be the year preceding inception of the rescheduled 8th Plan (1992-97) and data relating there-to should, therefore, be of interest in the context of formulation of the rescheduled 8th Plan. It is reiterated that the data are analysed as presented to the Planning Commission at the time of the Annual Plan discussion and little attempt to recheck or reconcile the data has been made. It is hoped all the same, that the compilation would be of use to the educational planners and administrators.

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A BRIEF REVIEW:

Seventh Five Year Plan

Against the approved outlay of Rs. 6382.65 crores for education in the Seventh Plan, Planning Commission allocated Rs. 8950.37 crores. However, the actual expenditure during the Seventh Plan period has been Rs. 8540.28 crores. This registers an increase of 33.8% over the originally approved plan Outlay of Rs. 6382.65 crores. The detailed sub-headwise and statewise expenditure for the Seventh Plan is given in the annexures-I, IX.

Eighth Five Year Plan

Planning Commission received Eighth Five Year Plan proposals alongwith the Annual Plan 1991-92 from all State Governments, Union Administrations and Ministry. The Working Groups constituted by the Planning Commission for the Eighth Plan examined the proposals and recommended outlays for the Education sector in terms of sub-sectors. Since Eighth Plan was postponed, financial outlays have not been approved. In view of this, outlays proposed by the State Governments, Union Territories Administration and Ministry of HRD are compiled alongwith the outlay recommended by the Working Groups.

An amount of Rs. 20870.27 crores was proposed for Eighth Plan including Rs. 300 crores for Border Area Development Programme (BADP) under Central Sector. Against the proposal of Rs. 12201.62 crores in State sector, the Working Group recommended an outlay of Rs. 10976.93 crores. The detailed break-up of the proposed and recommended outlay of Eighth Plan is given in the annexure-I.

Annual Plan 1991-92

Planning Commission approved an outlay of Rs. 2958.22 crores including Rs. 55.00 crores of BADP for the Annual Plan 1991-92 showing an increase of Rs. 384.68 crores (14.9% increase) over the Annual Plan approved outlay of Rs. 2573.554 crores including Rs. 55.00 crores for BADP for Annual Plan 1990-91.

An amount of Rs. 1215 crores (40% of the approved outlay for Education) has been earmarked for the priority sectors of education viz. Elementary Education and Adult Education.

The subhead-wise approved outlay for 1991-92 may be seen in the annexure-II.

Externally Aided Projects:

There are some externally aided projects under Elementary Education, Secondary education and Technical Education viz., Shiksha Karmi Project in Rajasthan, Bihar Education Project, Mahila Samkhya, U.P. Project, South Orissa Project, National Population Project, Technical Education at Polytechnics and Teacher Training Institute etc.

During Seventh Plan period, an expenditure of Rs. 16.12 crores has been incurred on Shiksha Karmi Project, Mahila Samakhya and population Education Project, under Central Sector. For these schemes, an amount of Rs. 27.36 crores has been approved for Annual Plan 1991-92, as against the approved outlay of Rs. 18.50 crores during annual plan 1990-91. Schemewise and yearwise details may be seen in the annexure-V.

Similarly under State Sector, World Bank Aided Project of Polytechnics is being run in some selected States. In the first phase an amount of Rs. 128.17 crores has been recommended by the Working Group for Annual Plan 1991-92 as against the outlay of Rs. 77.20 crores during annual Plan 1990-91 for Bihar, Gujarat, Karnataka, Kerala, M.P., Orissa, Rajasthan and U.P.

In the second Phase, the Working Group recommended an outlay of Rs. 100.19 crores for annual Plan 1991-92 for the states of Andhra Pradesh, Assam, Haryana, M.P., Maharashtra, Punjab, Tamil Nadu, West Bengal and U.T. of Delhi.

Statewise details are given in the annexure-VI.

### III. Border Area Development Programme (BADP):

A development Programme is being run in border states viz., Gujarat, J&K, Punjab and Rajasthan. The expenditure of Rs. 120.50 crores has been worked out for the Seventh Plan period and an outlay of Rs. 49.50 crores has been allocated for the annual Plan 1990-91. Yearwise expenditure and name of districts are given in annexure-VII.

### IV. Minimum Needs Programme (MNP)

Both Elementary Education and Adult Education are priority sectors known as MNP.

It has been noted that the amount of Rs. 3015.52 crores (Central Rs. 796.53 crores and State Rs. 2218.99 crores) actually allocated to Elementary Education during Seventh Plan could not be utilised fully and an expenditure of Rs. 2828.04 crores has been reported Rs. 637.12 crores under Central Sector as against the allocated amount of Rs. 796.53 crores; and Rs. 2190.92 crores under state sector as against the outlay of Rs. 2218.99 crores.

For Adult Education, an expenditure of Rs. 469.56 crores has been worked out as against the actually allocated outlay of Rs. 449.04 crores and originally approved outlay of Rs. 360.00 crores for the Seventh Plan (1985-90).

For the Annual Plan, 1991-92, Planning Commission approved an outlay of Rs. 1215.48 crores for MNP (Rs. 1036.73 crores for Elementary Education and Rs. 178.75 crores for Adult Education) which is 41.9% of total approved outlay

for education as against the approved outlay of Rs. 994.27 crores (Rs. 843.15 crores for Elementary Education and Rs. 151.12 crores for adult Education) during the last year 1990-91. Centrewise and Statewise breakup is given in the annexures-II & XI respectively.

#### Centrally Sponsored Schemes (CSS)

An expenditure of Rs. 1157.93 lakhs has been incurred on CSS, such as Operation Blackboard (OB), Non-Formal Educations NFE, Teacher Education, Vocationalisation, Science Education, Integrated Education, Rural Functional Literacy Project (RFLP) and language development during the Seventh Five Year Plan (1985-90).

The expenditure in the last year of Seventh Five Year Plan, i.e. 1989-90 was Rs. 360.07 lakhs. Planning Commission approved an outlay of Rs. 416.74 lakhs for the Annual Plan 1991-92 as against the approved outlay of Rs. 427 lakhs for the Annual Plan 1990-91.

Schemewise and yearwise details can be seen in annexure-IV.

#### Physical Targets & Achievements

(Seventh Five Year Plan and 1989-90)

The additional enrolment target for the 7th Five Year Plan was 255.18 lakhs for classes I-VIII (age group 6-14), 105.94 lakhs in classes I-V and 149.24 lakhs in classes VI-VIII. The achievement reported by the State Government and U.T.s for the Classes I-VIII was in order of 227.71 lakhs during the Seventh Plan period indicating a shortfall of 27.47 lakhs in additional coverage. There has been an overall 89.3% achievement of the target fixed for the Seventh Plan period. The State Governments of Andhra Pradesh, Assam, Goa, Karnataka, Kerala, M.P., Manipur, Orissa, Rajasthan, U.P. and West Bengal could not achieve the main target.

Some of the States such as Gujarat, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, J&K, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Maharashtra, Nagaland, Punjab, Sikkim and Tamil Nadu have achieved the target fixed for this period.

II. While analysing the achievement for classes I-V and VI-VIII separately, it may be observed that there is 32.0% over-achievement in the classes I-V (age group 6-11 years, but there is 41.7% underachievement in Classes VI-VIII (age group 11-14 years).

The additional achievement in enrolment of 140.76 lakhs children in the age group 6-11 years has been reported by the State Govt. as against the target of 103.94 lakhs children. There are backward states like Andhra Pradesh, Bihar, J & K, Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh and West Bengal, showing the over-achievement as against the target fixed for the Seventh Plan. However, there are backward states like Assam, Orissa, which showed shortfall in the achievements.

III. The target of additional enrolment for girls in the classes I-V has not been achieved in Andhra Pradesh, Arunachal Pradesh, Himachal Pradesh, Karnataka, Manipur, Orissa, Rajasthan, Tripura and West Bengal.

IV. The additional achievement of 87.00 lakhs as against the target of 149.24 lakhs in the classes VI-VIII (age group 11-14 is on the lower side. The states showing shortfall are-Andhra Pradesh, Assam, Bihar Goa, Gujarat, Haryana, Kerala, M.P., Maharashtra, Manipur, Orissa, Punjab, Rajasthan, Tamil Nadu, U.P. and West Bengal.

#### Annual Plan (1990-91)

The States/U.T.s have not reported achievement for 1990-91 As such the achievement is anticipated at the level of target i.e. 57.73 lakhs children in classes I-VIII for annual Plan 1990-91.

Annual Plan (1991-92)

A target of 75.34 lakhs additional children (45.20 lakhs in classes I-V and 30.15 lakhs in Classes VI-VIII) has been fixed for the annual plan 1991-92 as against the previous year's (1990-91 likely achievement of 57.73 lakhs children, 32.55 lakhs children enrolled in Classes I-V and 25.18 lakhs children in Classes VI-VIII).

Adult Education:

It was expected that about 300 lakhs adult illiterates would be covered during the 7th Plan period.

During the Annual Plan 1989-90, 105.35 lakhs illiterates were covered as against the target of 129.52 lakhs illiterates. For the Annual Plan 1991-92, a target of 136.92 lakhs adults have been fixed as against the previous year's (1990-91) target of 130.32 lakhs adult illiterates.

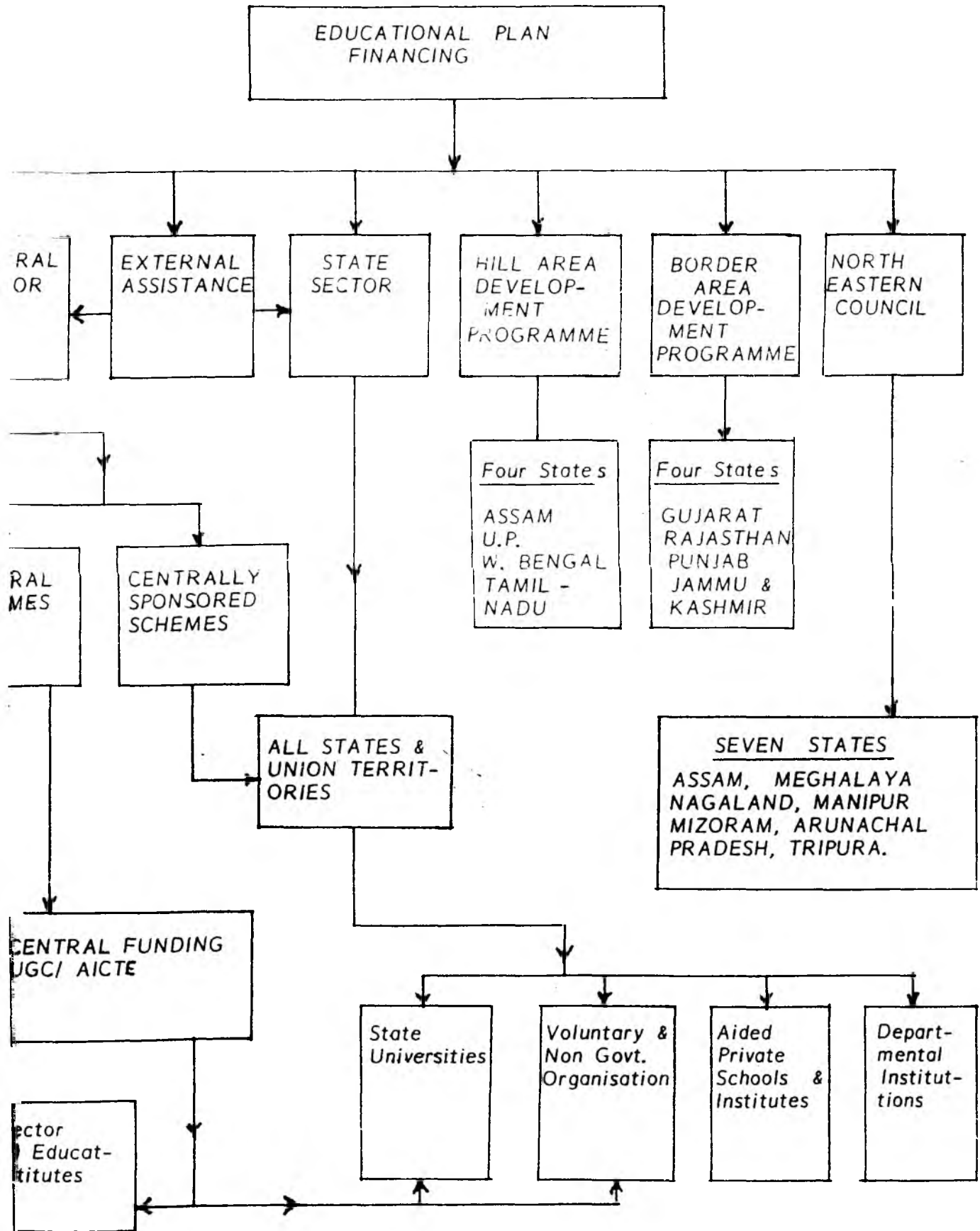
LIMITATIONS :

Sub-headwise actual expenditure on General Education for one year/1989-90 has not been provided by many States/UTs in the Plan document 1991-92. This information has been estimated within the limit of overall expenditure on General Education while maintaining the trends of expenditure during preceding three years.

Similarly anticipated enrolments in classes I- VIII and participants of Adult Education (age 15-35) for the year 1990-91 are not reported by many States/UTs. The same is estimated keeping in view the level of target for the year and actual achievement of preceding two years.
