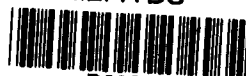

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## PREFACE

Distance Education in the form of correspondence courses was started in India in the early sixties to be followed by home studies and the open education system but no attempt was made to survey these facilities and to assess their contribution to the cause of education. An attempt for the first time has been made in this volume to present detailed information about the actual position of the various courses under distance education mode. We were somewhat handicapped by the fact that many institutions did not respond to our questionnaire as we would have liked them to but I am happy that a modest beginning has been made and our efforts to improve this publication shall continue in this direction.

I am grateful to all the universities who have supplied us information and that too within the shortest possible time and hope that the remaining institutions shall also supply it for our next publication. I am thankful to the dedicated staff under Dr. R.S. Thakur, Joint Director (Planning) who have worked tirelessly in bringing out this publication.

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## DISTANCE EDUCATION IN INDIA

1. During the preceding half-a-century, higher education in India has witnessed a remarkable transformation from a system meant for an elite group having colonial roots to a system of mass education attempting to meet the demands of vibrant democratic polity. Since independence, there has been large-scale expansion of higher education. The number of Universities increased from 20 in 1947 to 228 during 1996-97 i.e. registering around eleven-fold increase during the last five decades. New Institutions "Deemed Universities" have been established under Section 3 of UGC Act. There were around 900 Colleges in 1950-51 which have now increased to more than 8 thousand colleges thereby registering nine-fold increase in the Colleges. The number of scholars has increased from 0.42 million in 1950-51 to more than five million during 1996-97 registering more than eleven times increase in enrolment during this period.

2. There was a time when a student at the undergraduate level must either be admitted on a full time basis or go without education altogether. This would have created tremendous demand for full time regular seats in colleges but because the resources to accommodate the ever-increasing demand were not available, this might have lead to the deterioration of standards of education. This unwanted situation, to some extent, has been averted by the start of evening colleges, Correspondence Courses/Home Studies and recently by the system of Open Education in the country. A multiple entry system has come into being not only at school level but at higher education level also which has been a very important milestone in the lives of our people. Delhi University was the premier institution to start correspondence courses in the year 1962 on a pilot project basis. Slowly many Universities followed suite. During 1996-97, there were 7 Open Universities and as many as 51 other Universities running Correspondence Courses and/or Open Education programmes. Year-wise/State-wise break-up of these 58 Universities is given below:-

3. In India, the University of Delhi initiated Distance Education in 1962 in

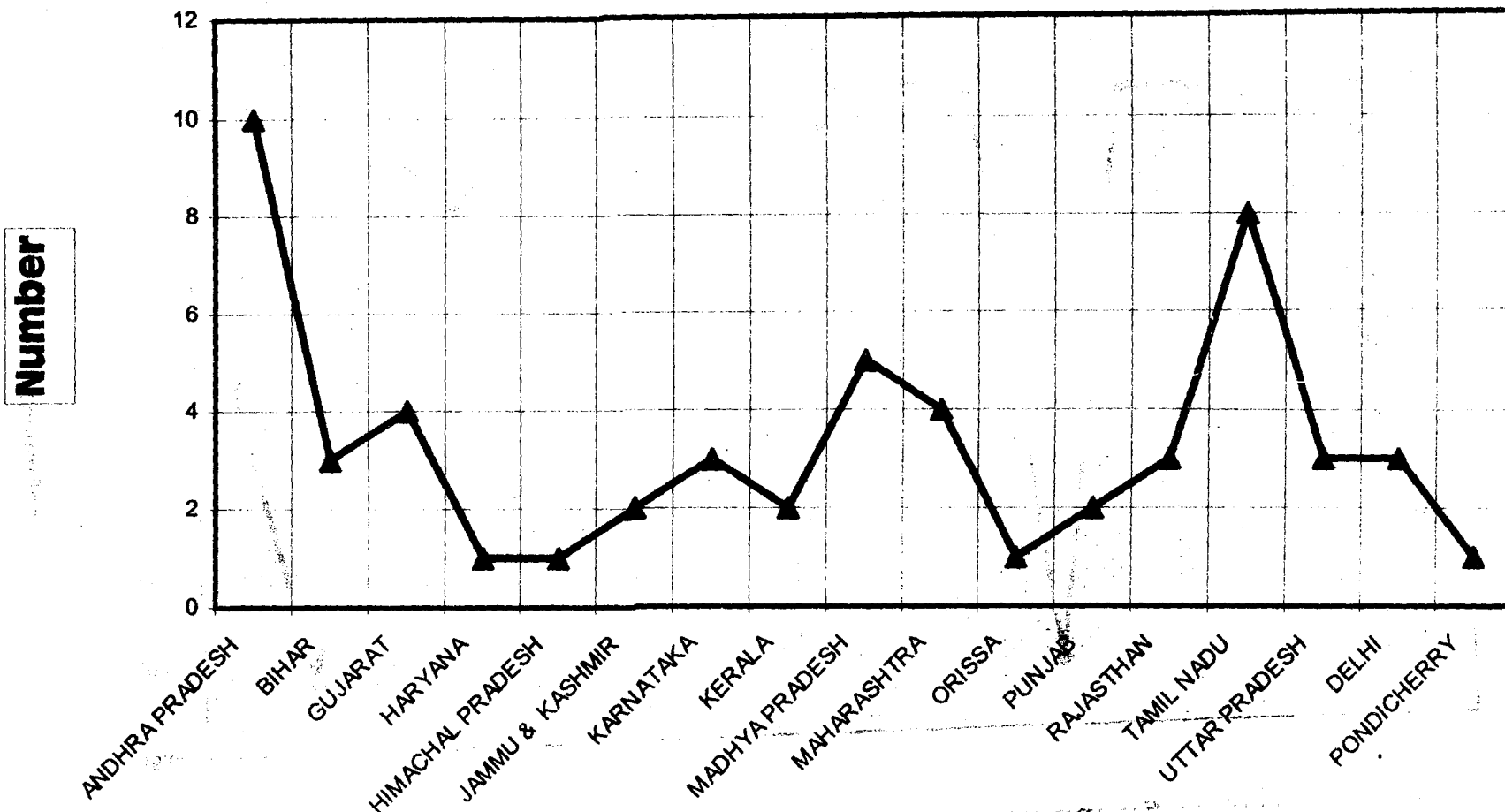
the form of correspondence courses. The first Open University was established in Andhra Pradesh in 1974, and the Indira Gandhi National Open University was established in 1985. The distance education system has grown substantially since then and during the year 1996-97 there were 7 Open Universities and 51 Correspondence Courses Directorates/Institutes attached to different Universities. Correspondence courses initially provided largely correspondence programmes with occasional contact programmes. However, with the establishment of Open Universities, the methodologies of instructions and evaluation have undergone sea changes. The open universities are following rigorous instructional designs in the development of instructional materials and in imparting of instructions. The universities provide regular counseling services through networks of study centers and make substantial use of electronic media. The Indira Gandhi National Open University has devised a large media networking and teleconferencing system to electronically link all distance-teaching institutions in the country. Open education network is poised to facilitate voice, image and data transmission through two ways audio and video-conferencing. There is optimism that Open Universities can also offer effective programmes in management and technology. Out of total enrolment of 11.14 lakhs, 8.53 lakhs i.e. more than 3/4<sup>th</sup> are studying in Humanities Group while the remaining less than 1/4<sup>th</sup> are studying in professional vocational, technical education and management courses. The Open Universities have taken note of the fact that the model of lifelong learning for all is slowly replacing the earlier model of higher education requiring selective learning. State-wise distribution of Universities and their enrolment is as follows:

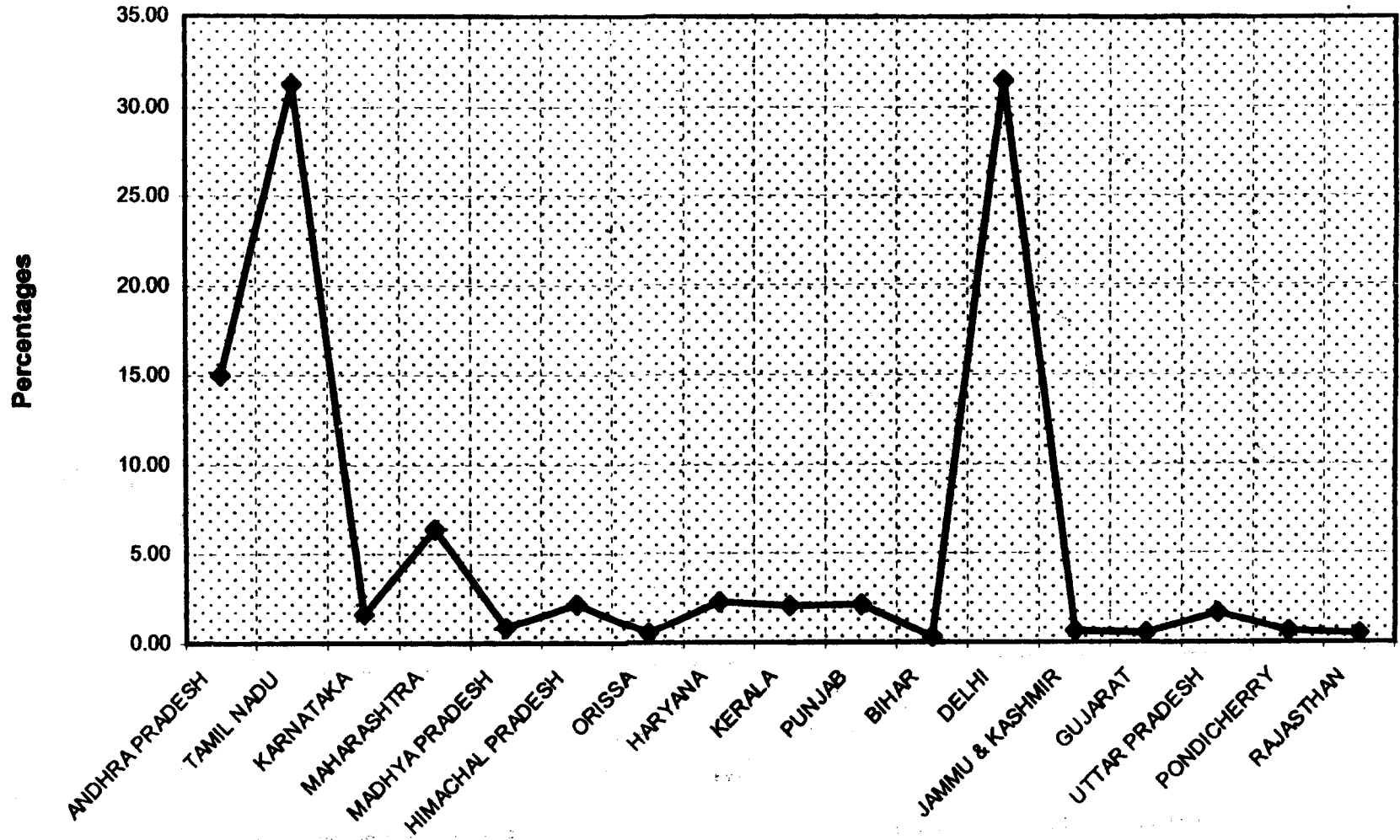

4. During the year 1996-97, AIU had recognised Distance Education programme in as many as 51 Universities/Institutes of National Importance and 7 Open Universities.

5. Out of 58 Universities running Distance Education Programmes, only one university namely APS Rewa, MP has not replied despite our best efforts.

8. Jadavpur University, Calcutta have stated that they offer "Comprehensive Examination for Medical Laboratory Technology by mail" for those working in Laboratories as medical Laboratory Technologists having 10+2 as academic qualification and 5 years working experience in a research laboratory. The University do not conduct any Certificate/Diploma/Degree Course but organises a programme meant for updating the knowledge of the working people.

9. Jain Vishwa Bharti Institute, Ladnun, Rajasthan, have been recognised for various courses. But no admissions were given during the session 1996-97 and this institute has therefore, given a Nil Report.

10. Nagarjuna University, Guntur has been recognised for B.A., B.Com. courses through correspondence as also under Open Education System and there are 13 teachers under the Department of Distance Education but while submitting the enrolment figures for the year 1996-97, they have submitted Nil Information by marking N.A in the forms meant for supplying the enrolment.

11. Punjab Agricultural University, Ludhiana, Department of Extension Education has been recognized for organizing one years' duration course in (i) Integrated Course in Agriculture and (ii) Home Management and Family life for the farmers/farm-women of Punjab State. However keeping in view the requirement of the farmers/farm-women, these courses and their contents have been reformulated and diversified. According to the University, the main objectives of these courses are not to grant academic degrees, diplomas or certificates but to impart instructions in Agriculture and Home Life to make the farmers useful to their farms and homes.

12. Shivaji University, Department of Adult and Continuing Education and Extension work has been recognized for conducting Diploma in adult Education and in Population Education. The University, has 9 teachers but while submitting the

information about enrolment, the University has given a Nil Report.

13. Tamil Nadu Agricultural University, Directorate of Extension Education, Coimbatore, organizes three months programme for farmers who are literate in Tamil. The end use of these programmes is to gain knowledge and to make farmers – better farmers and not for up-gradation in academic levels through Degree/Diploma/Certificate.

14. Tilak Maharashtra Vidyapeeth (Open Education Center) Pune, has been recognized for B.A.(Social Sciences) and have 20 teachers in the Open Education Center at Pune but while supplying information about enrolment, they have given Nil enrolment for 1996-97.

15. Gurukul Kangri Vishwavidyalya started B.Sc. through distance education during 1995-96 but due to certain circumstances, the Gurukul Kangri Vishwavidyalya could not continue this course and hence there is no graduate/undergraduate courses under distance education programme.

16. I.I.T. Madras: External Registration programme provide opportunities to employed individuals in scientific institutions and Industries to pursue MS and Ph.D Courses through research. However, while supplying enrolment figures, the IIT-Madras vide their letter dated 2.5.1997 has stated that no course is offered through Correspondence in this Institution.

17. Mahatma Gandhi Gramodaya Vishwavidyalya, Chitrakoot has been recognised for the following courses under distance learning and continuing education:

1. Pre-Primary Teacher Training/Primary Teacher Training
2. B.Ed./B.Lib Science/BJMC
3. M.Ed./M.Lib.Sc. MJMC
4. Diplomas, Journalism and Rural Communication and Public Relations and Advertising.

While submitting enrolment figures, the MGG Vishwavidyalya, Chitrakoot has stated that they are not running any courses through distance education for the year 1996-97.

18. The Indian Institute of Science under External Registration Programme provide opportunities to sponsored employed individual in R&D environment in Scientific Institutions and industries to pursue M.Sc. Engg. and Ph.D Science and Engg. Faculties but while submitting the information about enrolment, the Institute has stated that they do not conduct correspondence courses.

19. Amongst the seven Open Universities, IGNOU is the largest University in terms of enrolment. However, amongst all Universities, Annamalai University is the largest one having largest number of students enrolled for various courses and also the largest number of courses being offered by this University. In terms of number of courses, there are as many as 43 courses being offered to various scholars in Annamalai University as against 31 courses being offered by IGNOU to the different scholars during the year 1996-97. There is a combination of general education,

professional and technical education under distance education system and prospective scholars can take advantage of these courses at their convenience and according to their aptitudes.

20. In addition to the Universities mentioned above, the following organizations are also imparting education at school level through distance education mode:

- (a) NOS, New Delhi
- (b) Patrachar Vidyalya, Timarpur, Delhi.

21. 99% of the total enrolment in general school education come from these two organizations namely, (a) National Open School, New Delhi and (b) Patrachar Vidyalya, Timarpur. National Open School has accredited problem solving centers all over the country to facilitate school education through a system of open education. In terms of enrolment, NOS has the largest enrolment when compared between these two organizations.

22. The Rajasthan Board of School Education, Ajmer is also stated to have started school education courses under Distance Education but when they were asked for supplying the enrolment, they have not responded so far.

23. Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University, Hyderabad is having a school of continuing and distance education where correspondence courses are available for B.Tech (Civil, Electrical, Mechanical, Electronics, Electronics & Communication) as four years degree course. During the year 1996-97 there were 660 students on the rolls of this University for these programmes.

24. Apart from Ist/2<sup>nd</sup> Degrees in Humanities, courses under distance education system are available in diverse fields like: Agriculture, Management, computer, Engineering and Technology, Law, Vocational/job oriented courses etc. The details of these courses have been given in this volume.
