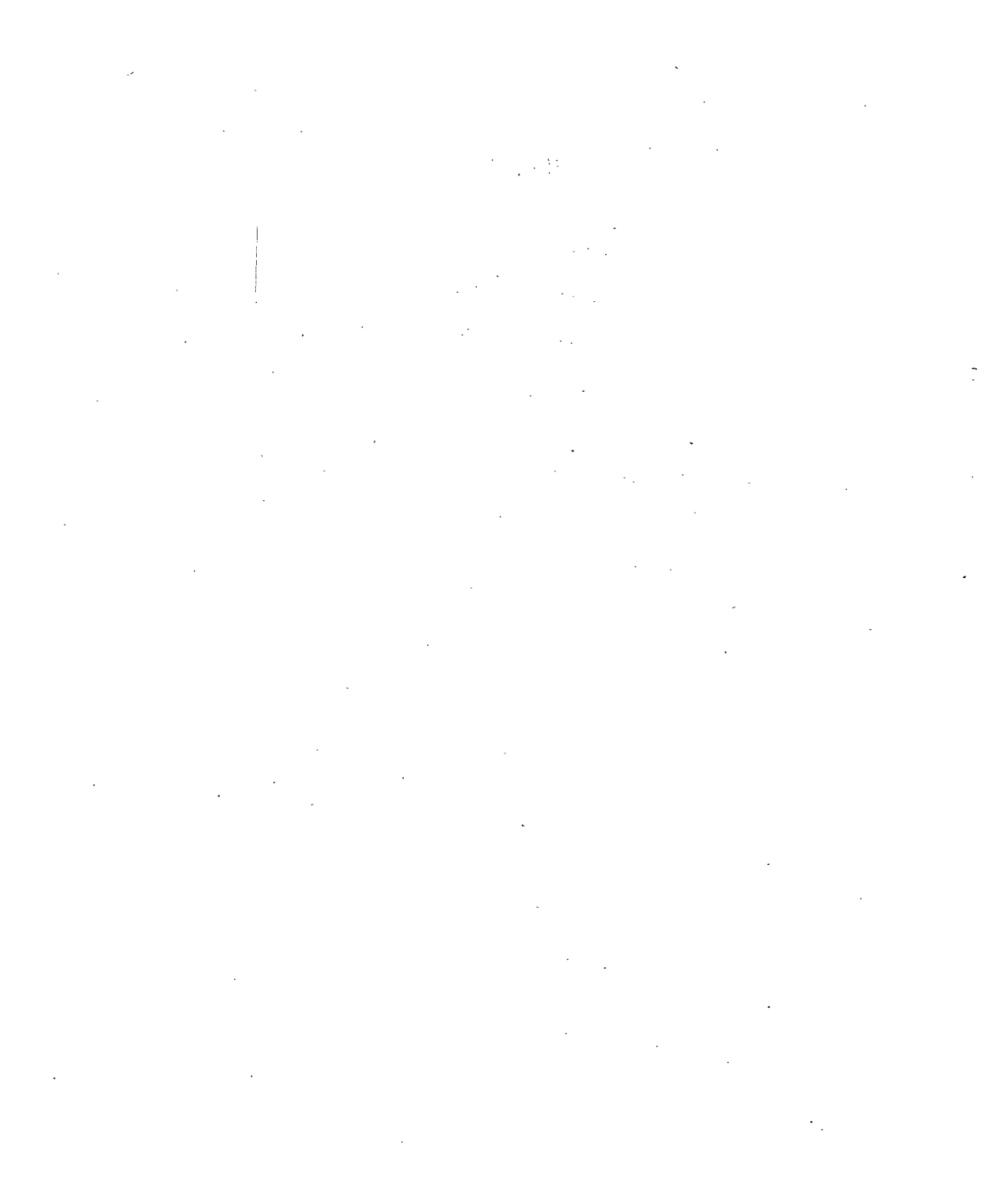
PREFACE
