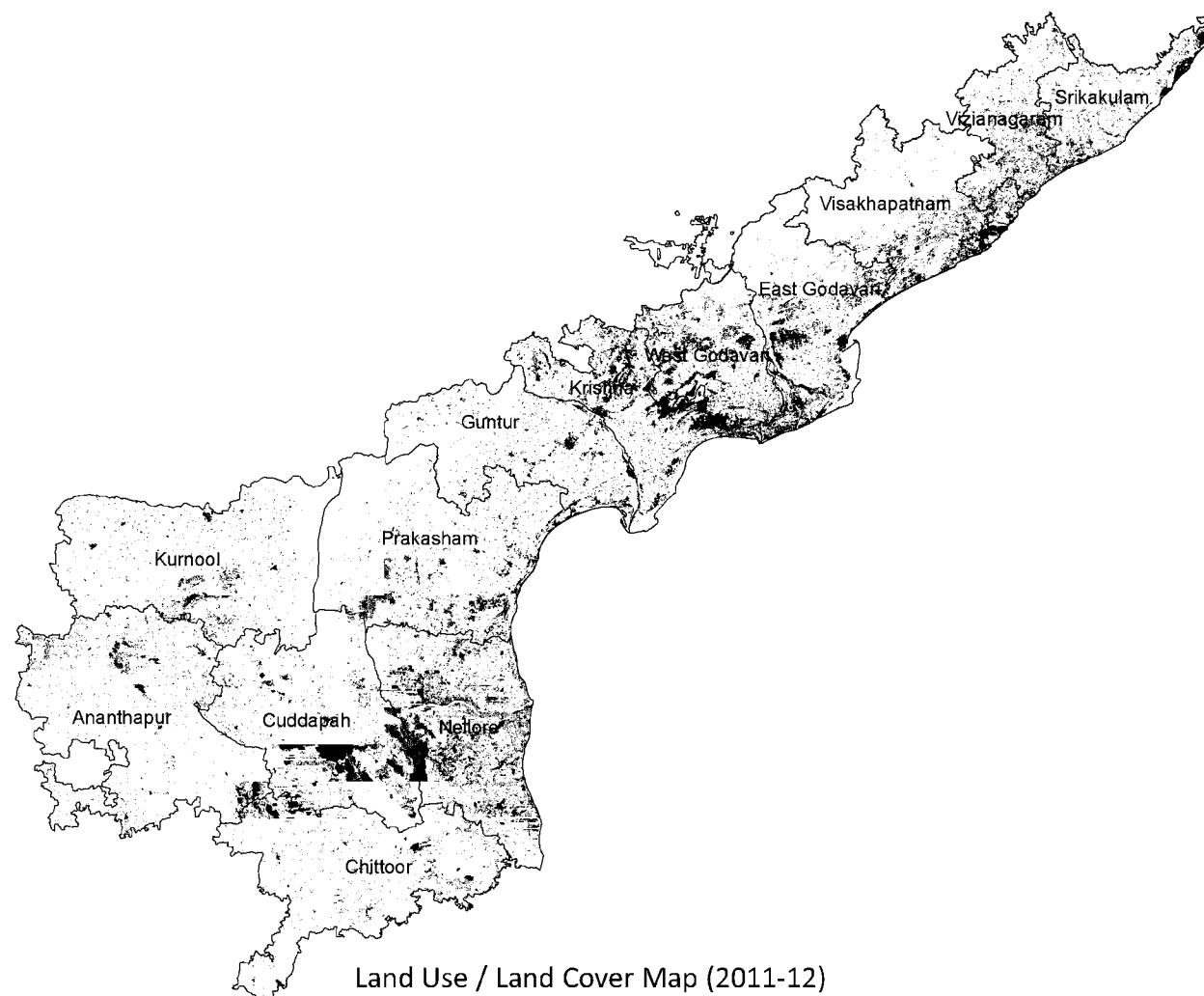

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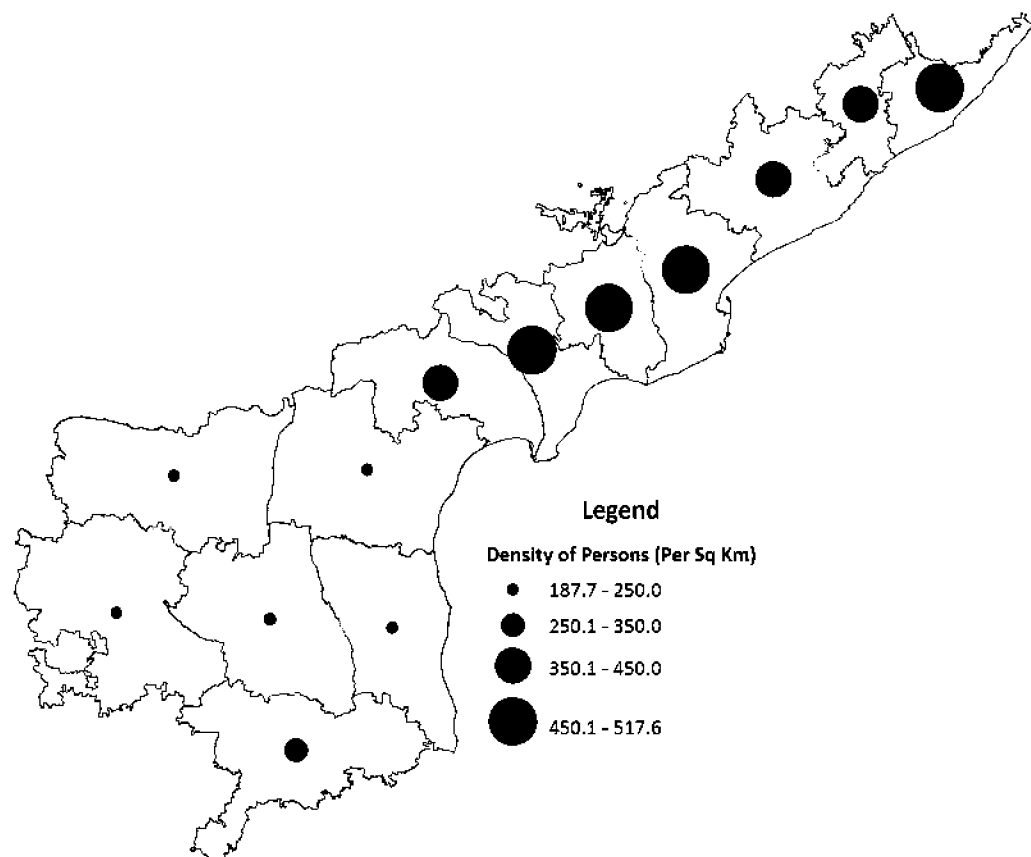

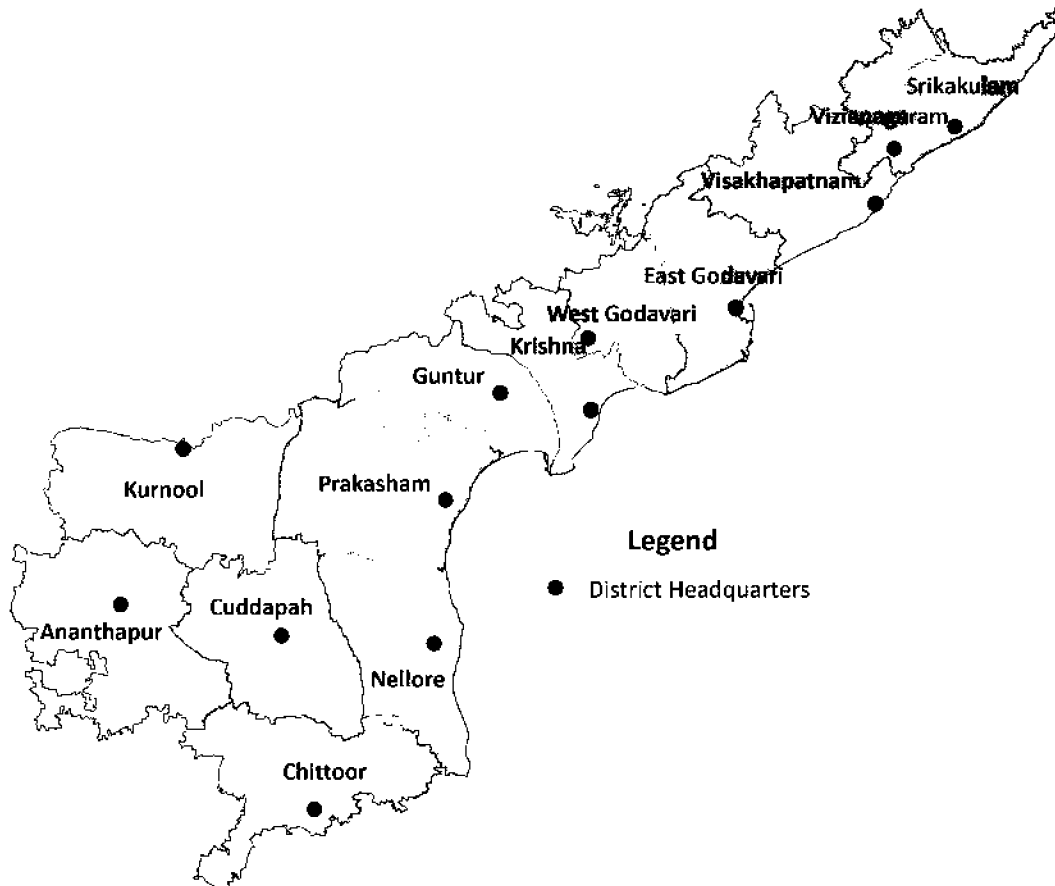
- Andhra Pradesh is located in the Southern peninsula of India and has a coast line of 974 km.

- The most commonly spoken language of the state is Telugu. Hindi, English and Tamil are the other languages used.

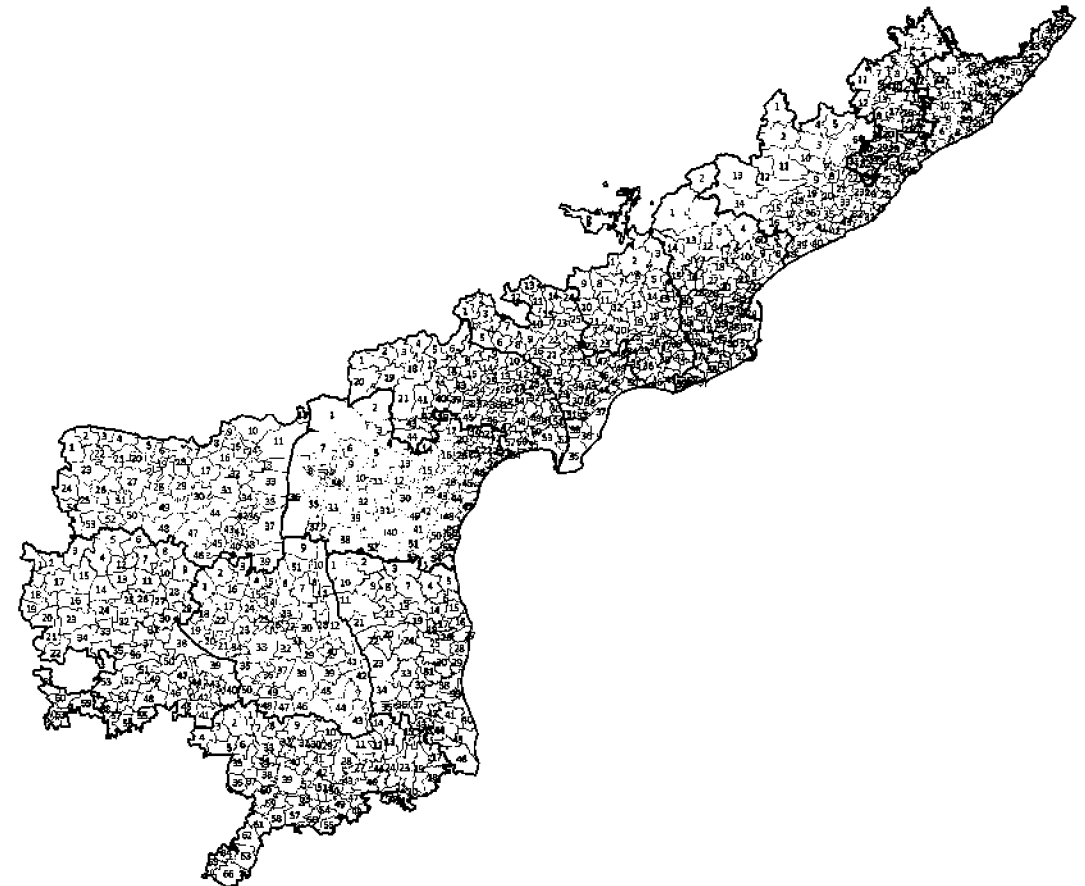

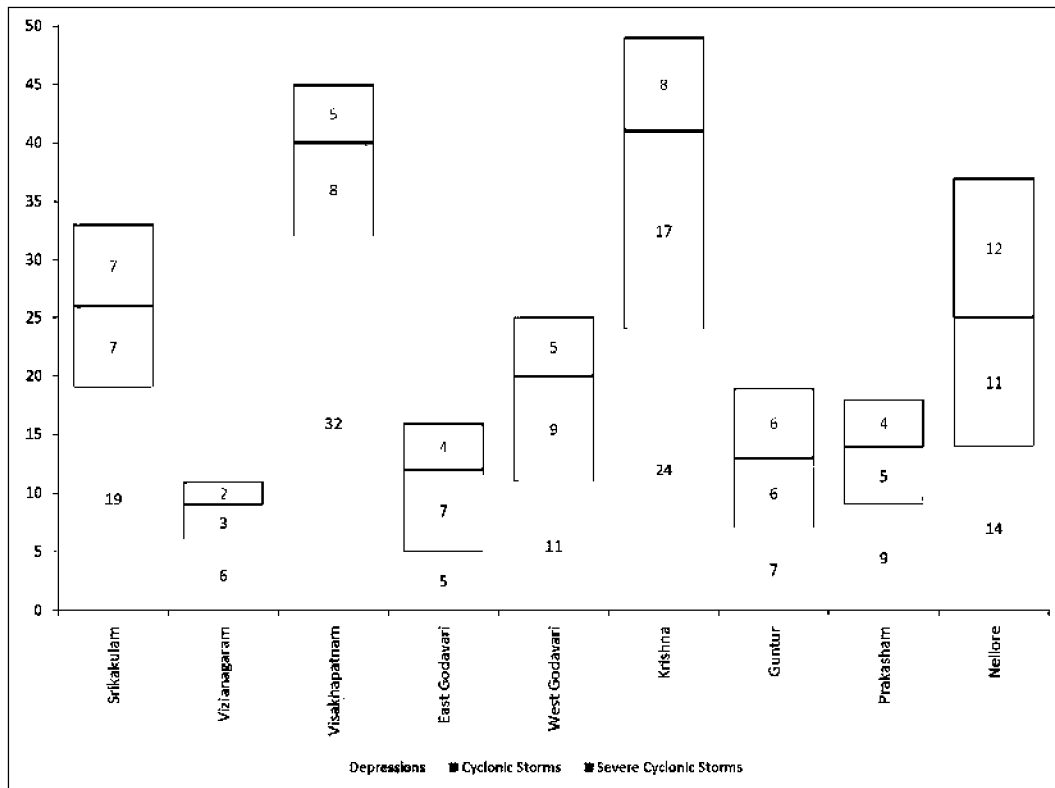


Damaging Wind Speeds at the Time of Cyclone Landfall

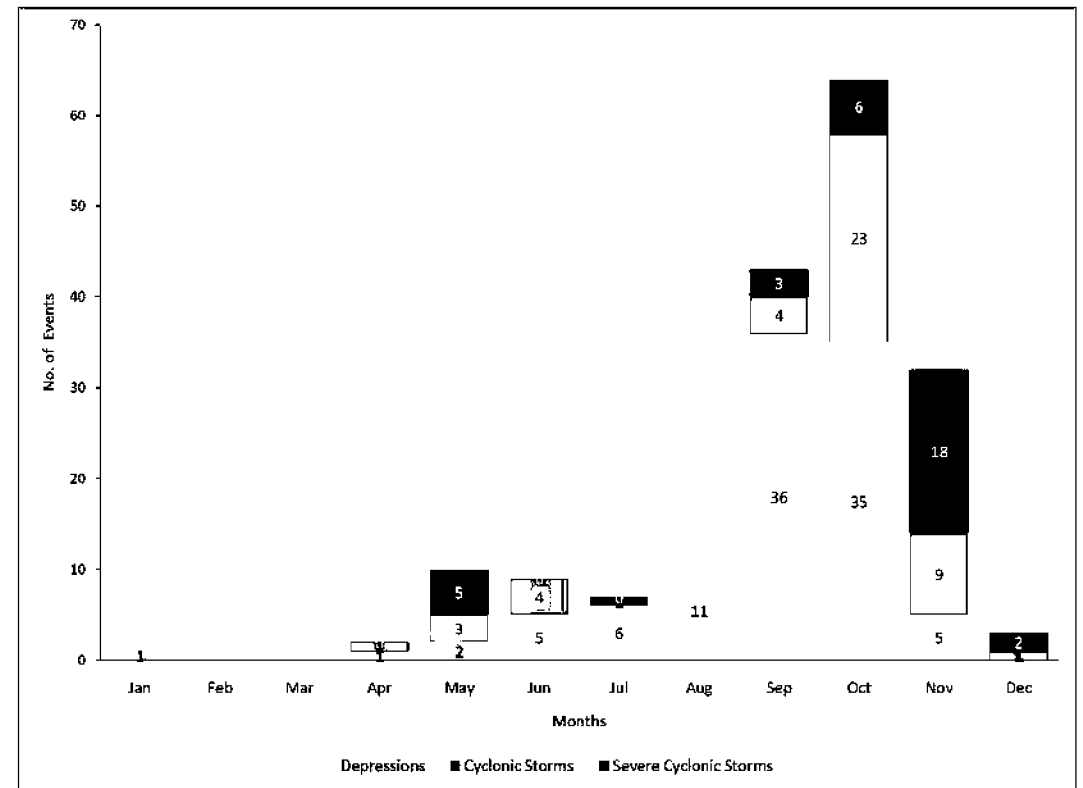


Frequency of Various Storms

District Wise Frequency of Various Storms



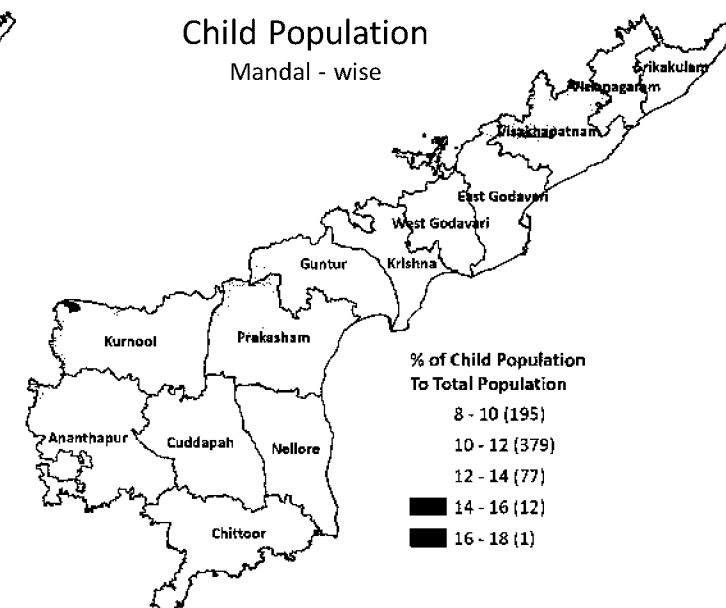
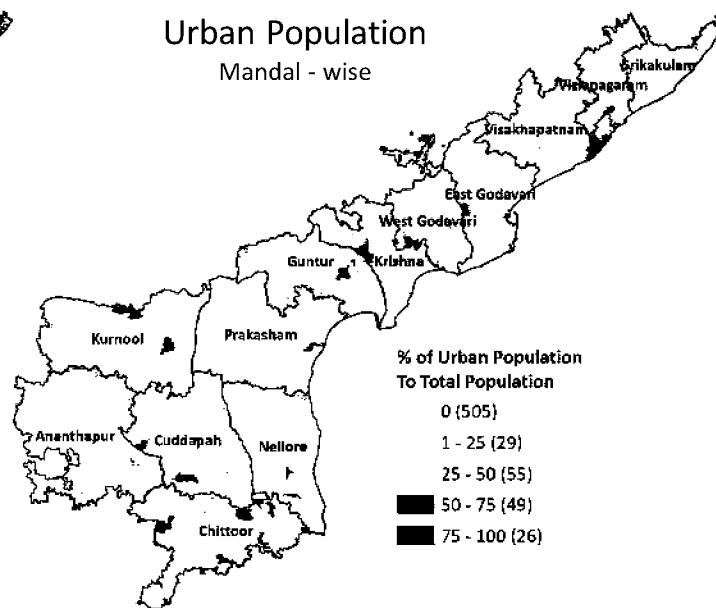
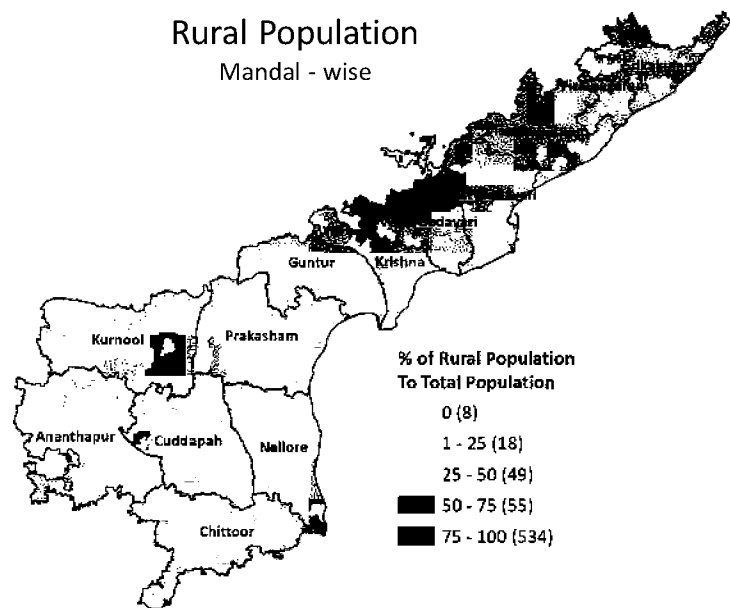

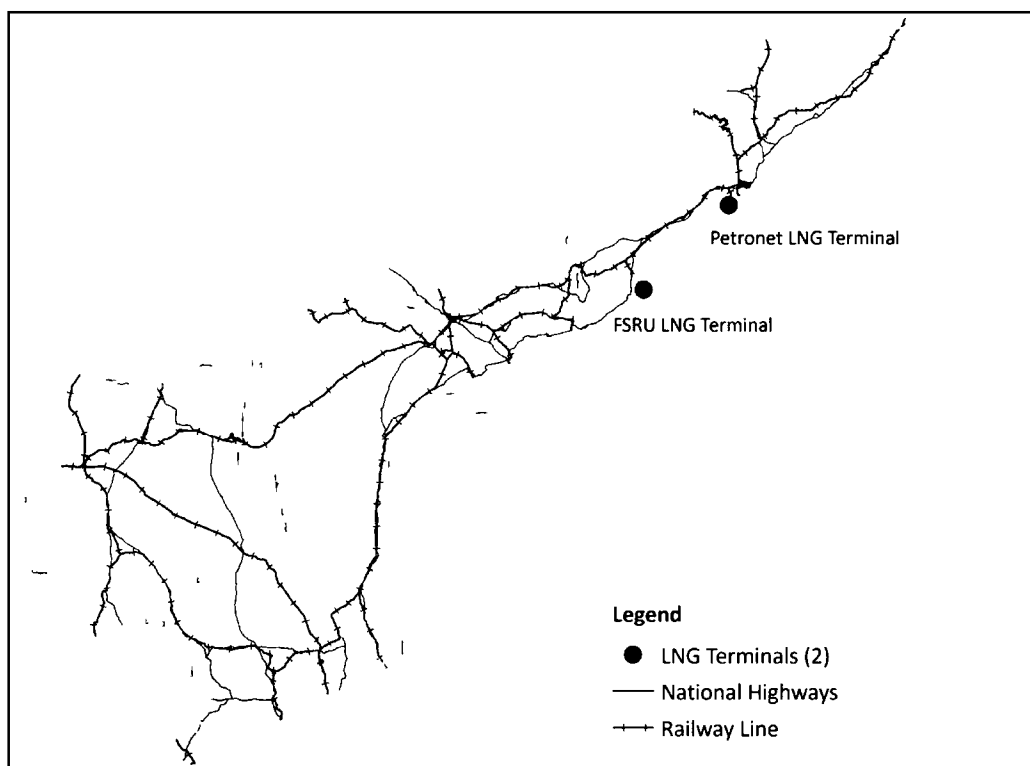

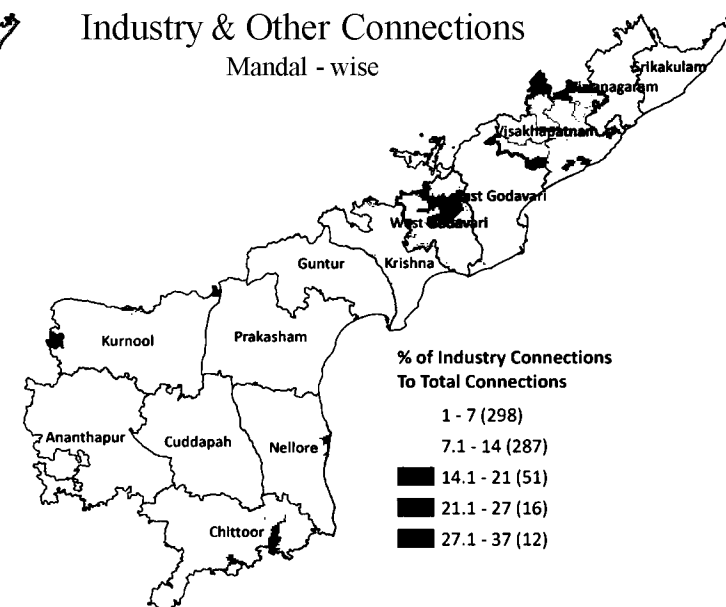
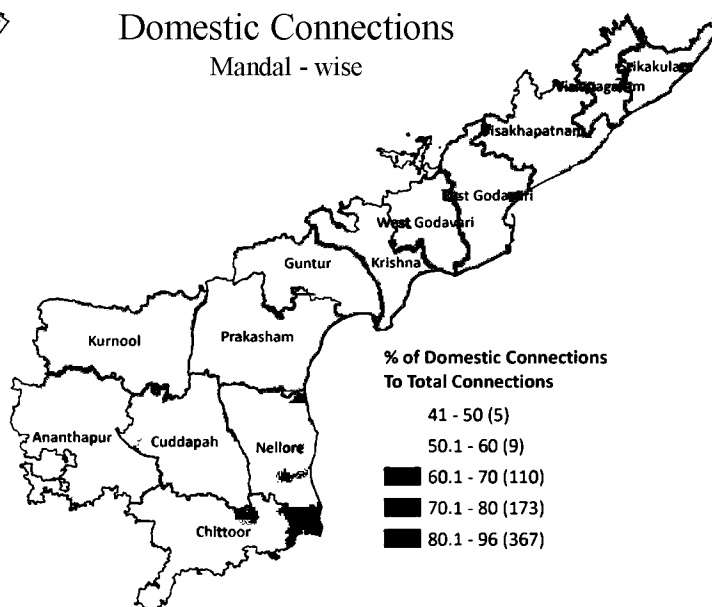
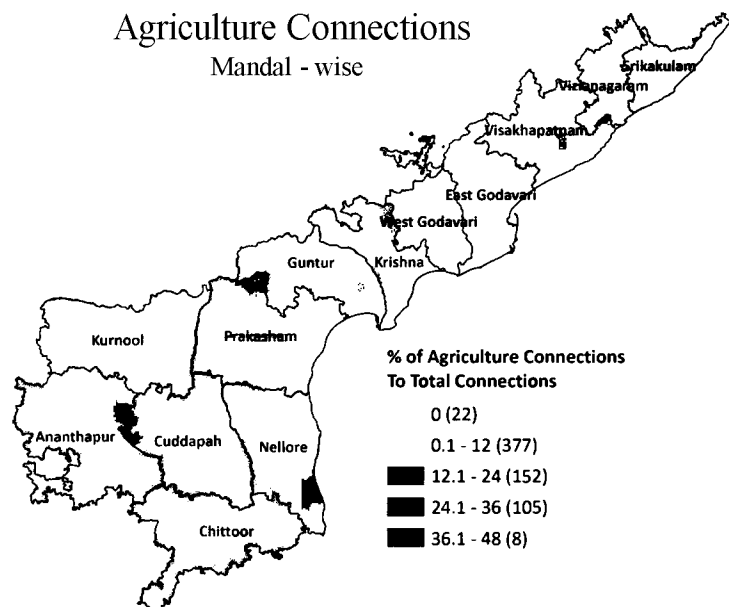
Spatial Distribution of Hydro Power Plants

Spatial Distribution of Tourist Locations



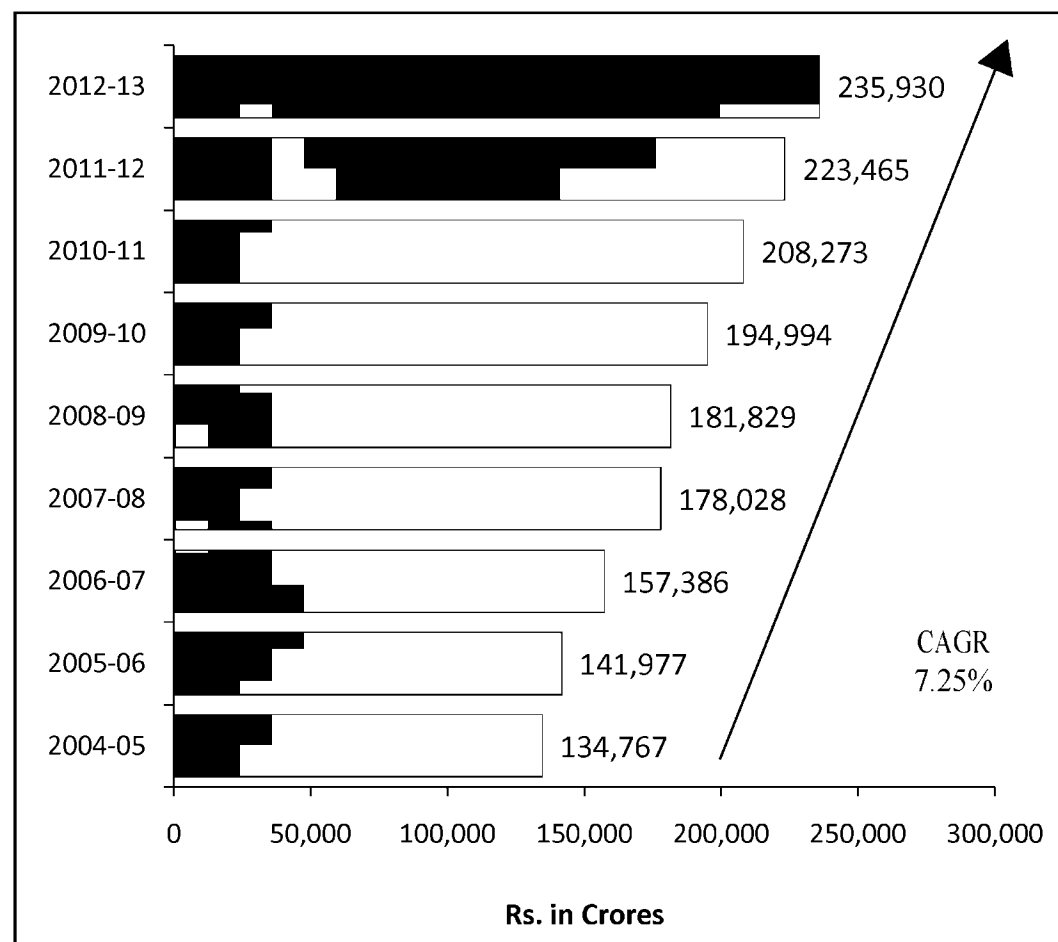

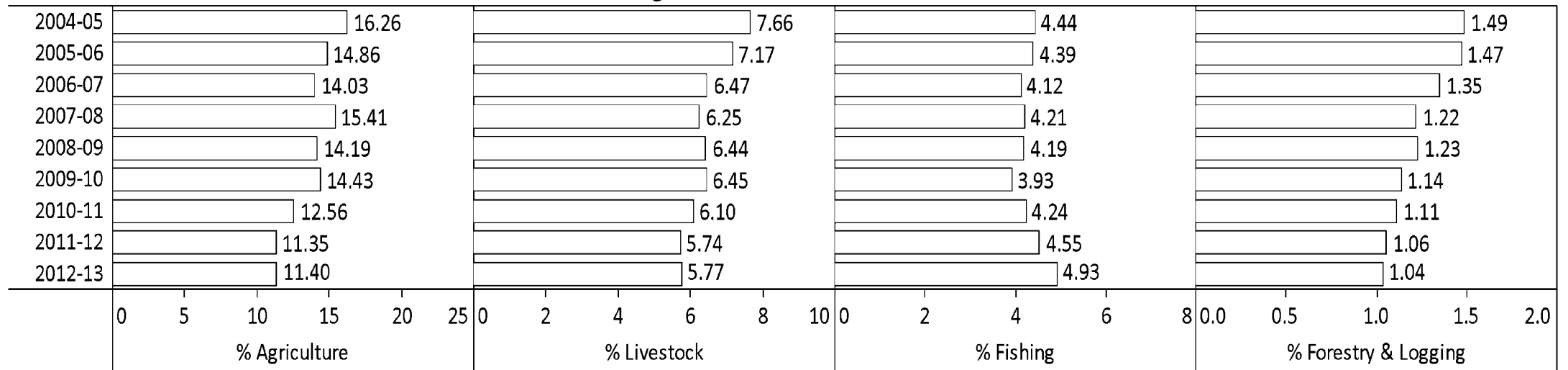


Agriculture Subsector Wise GSDP (Constant Prices)

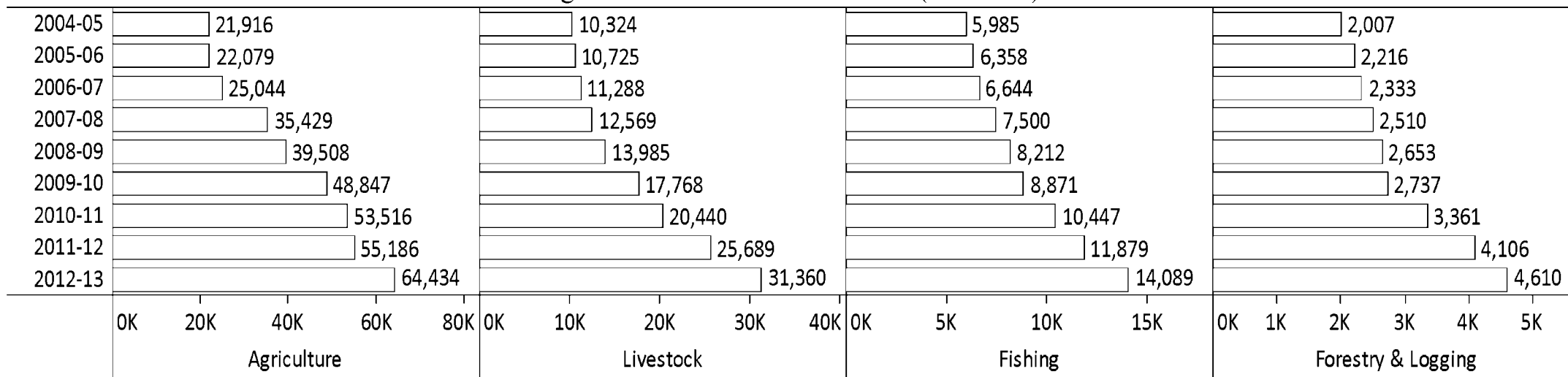

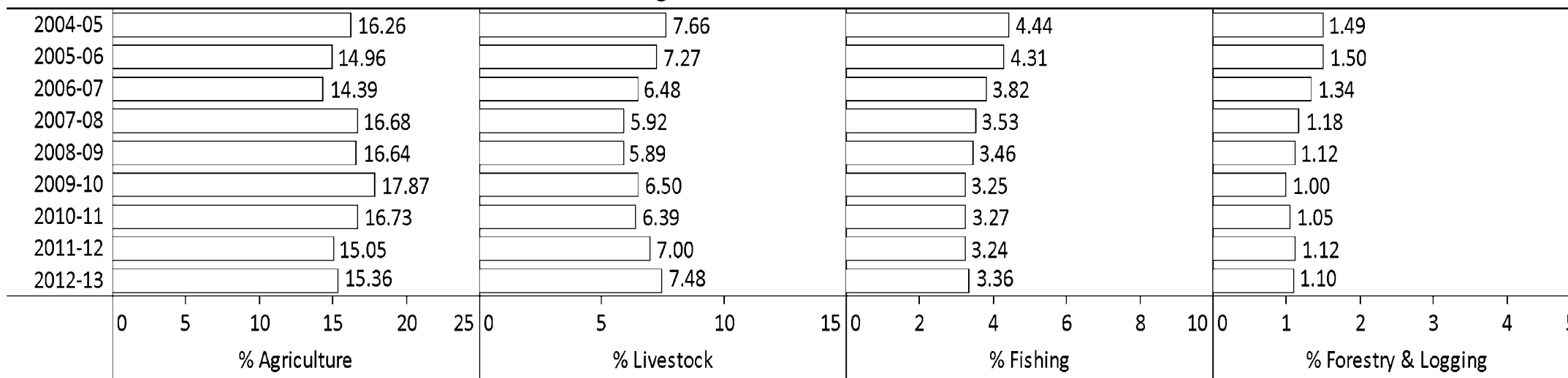

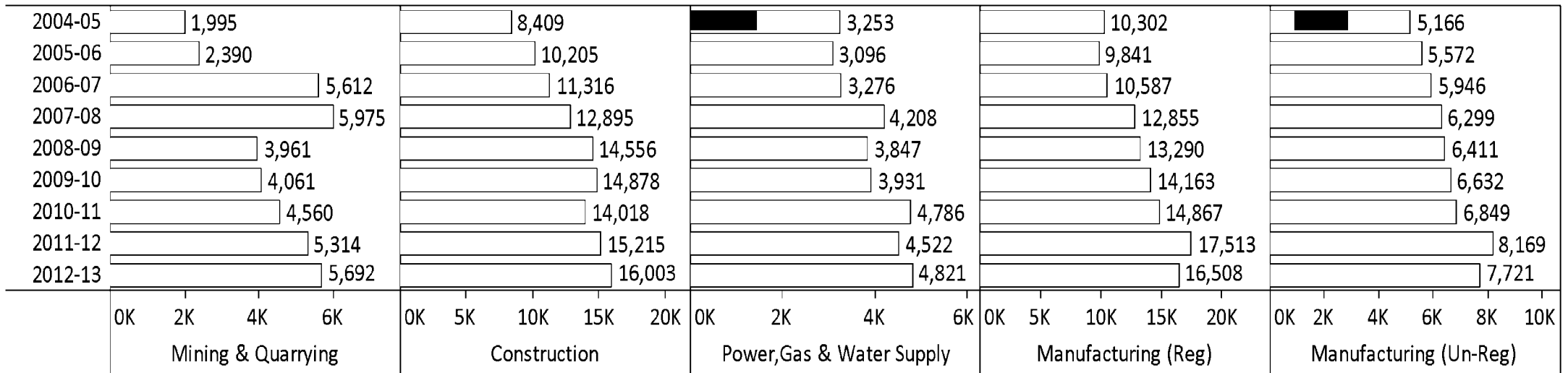


% of Agriculture Subsector Wise GSDP

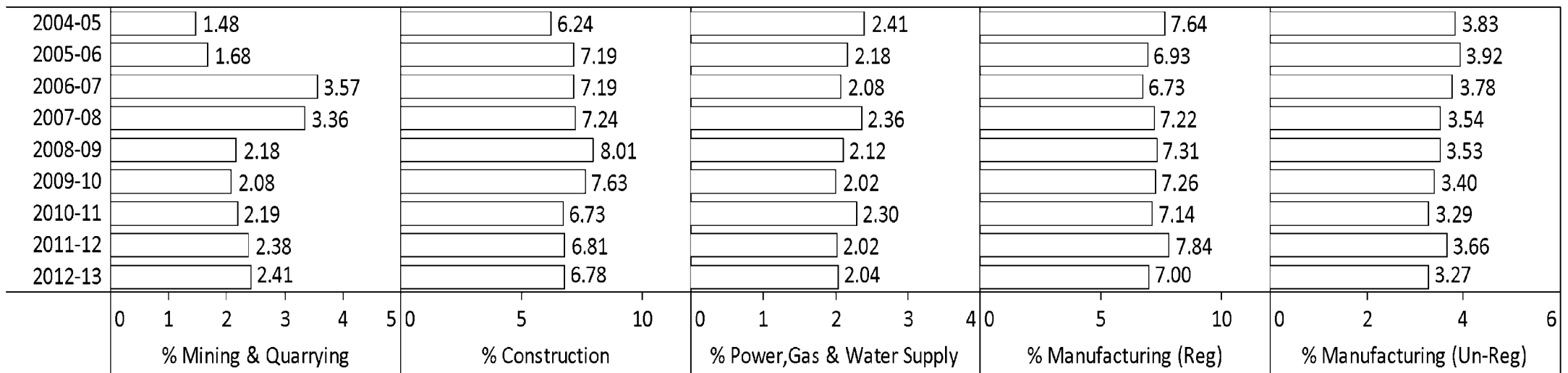

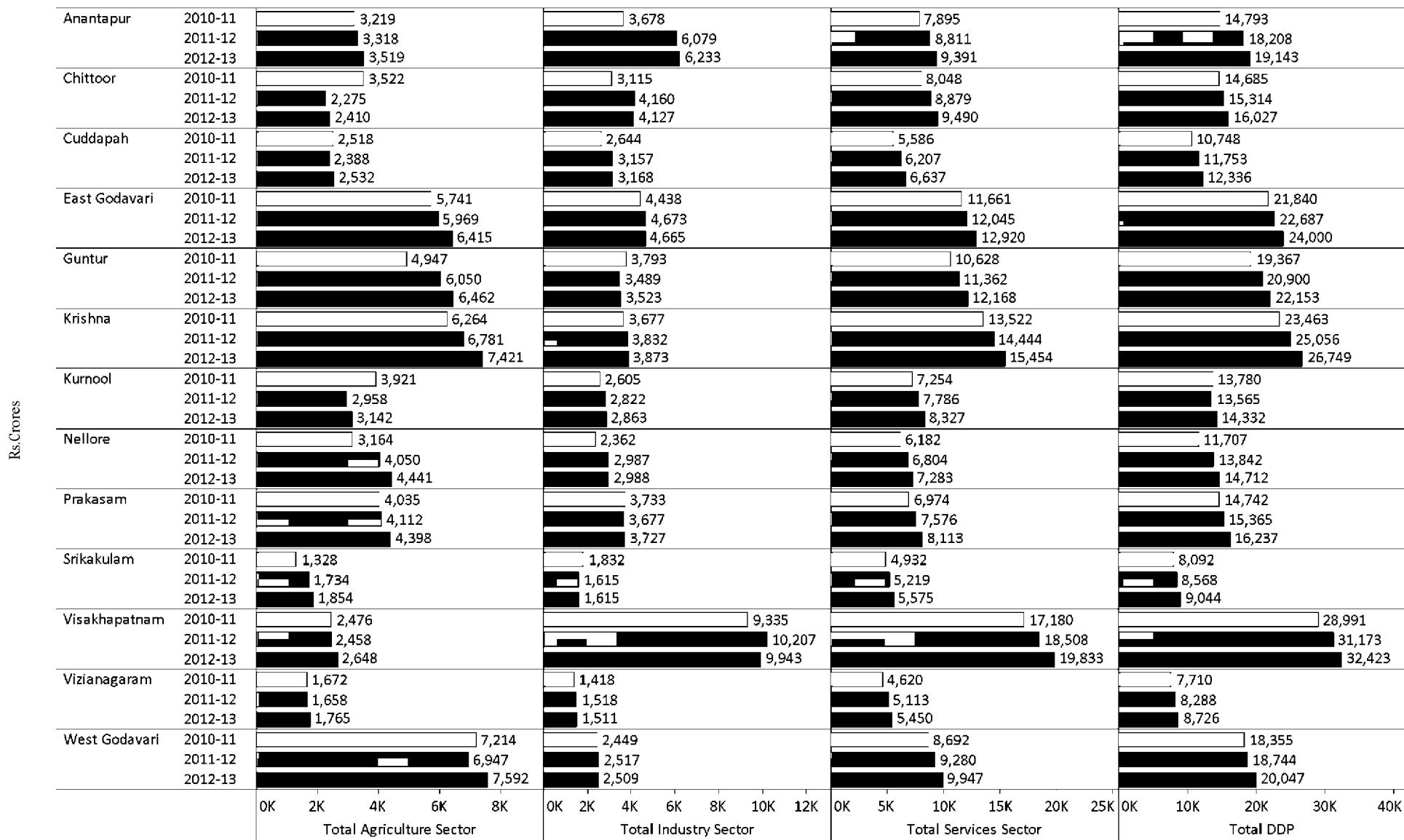
% Distribution of Subsector Wise GSDP By District



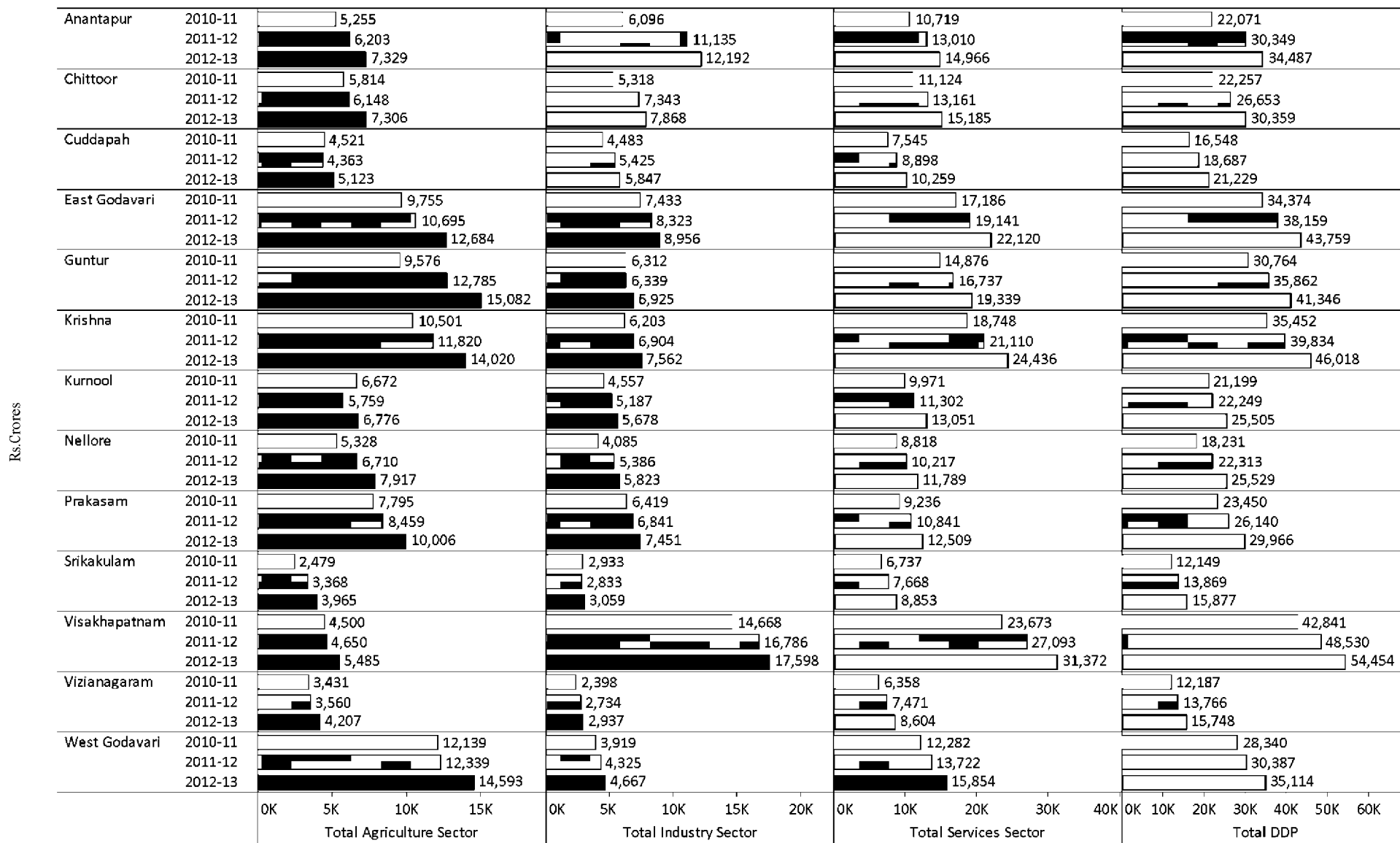

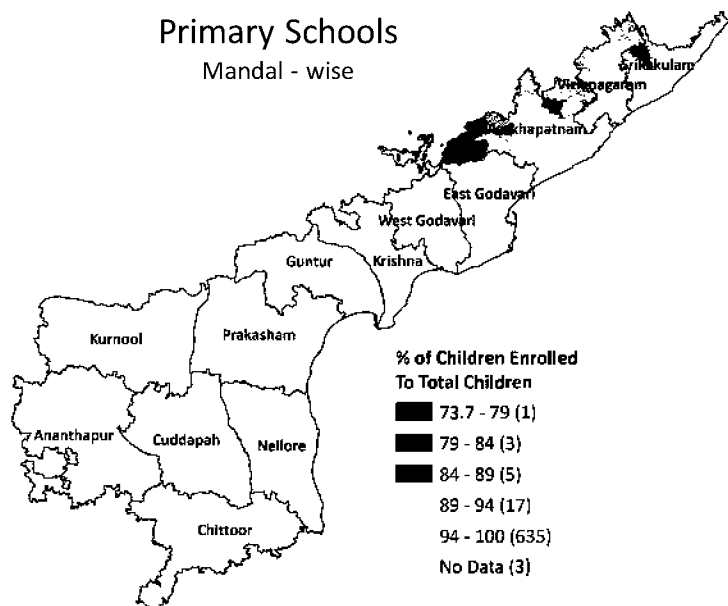

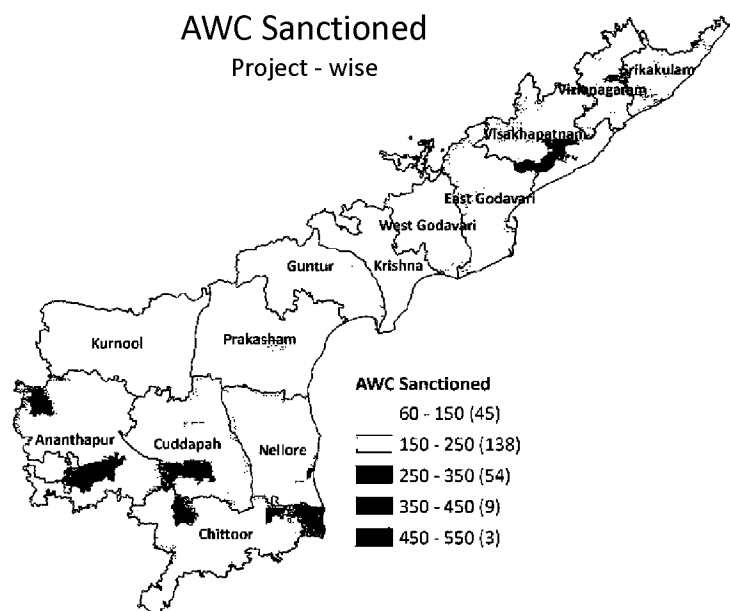
Spatial Distribution of District Hospitals, Area Hospitals & Community Health Centers



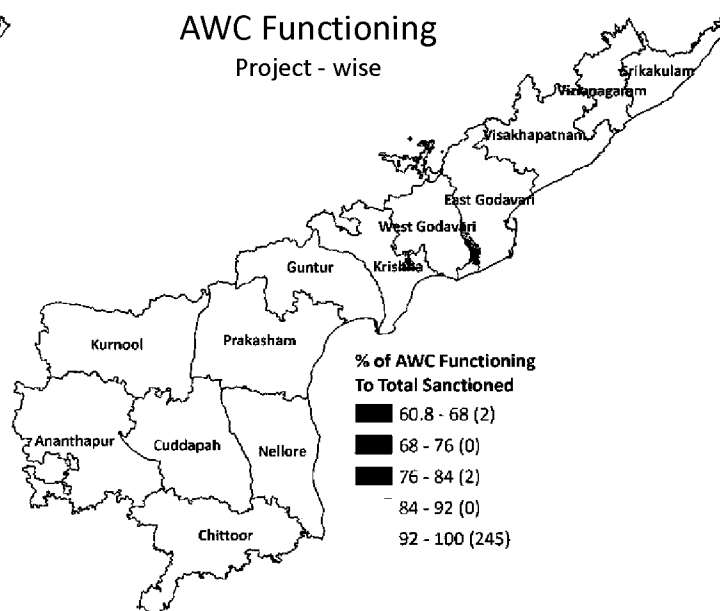

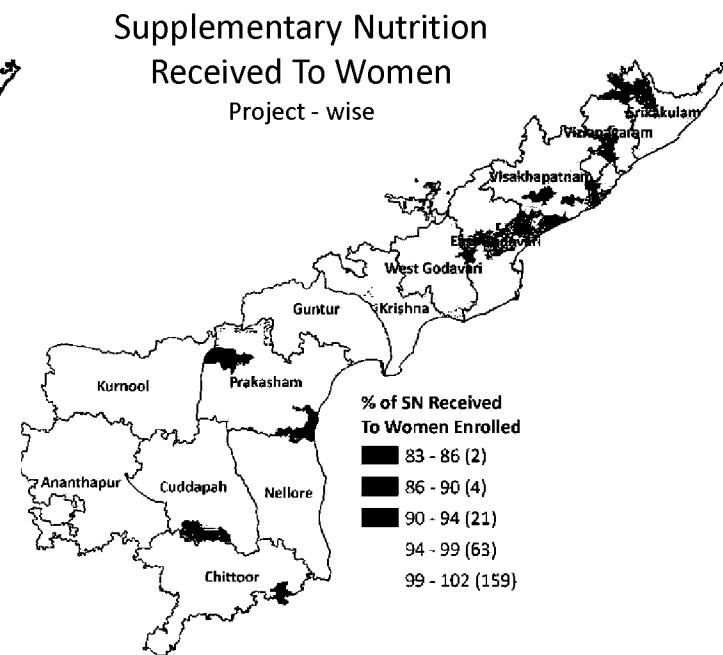
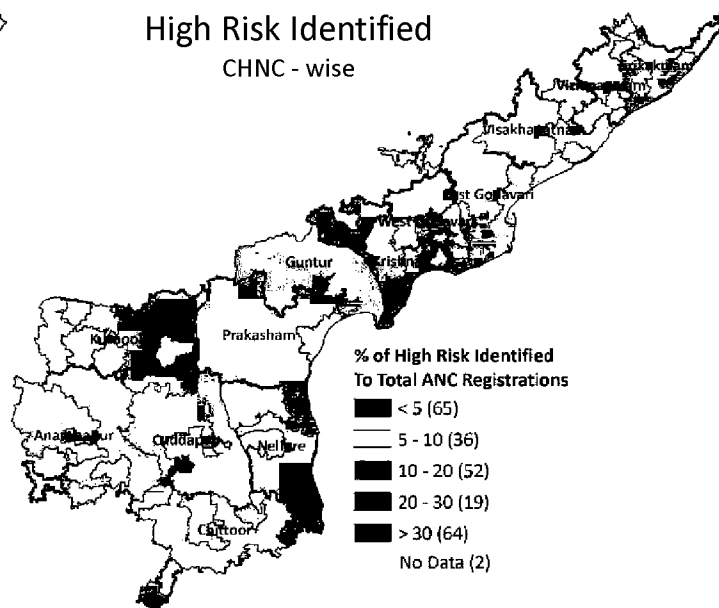
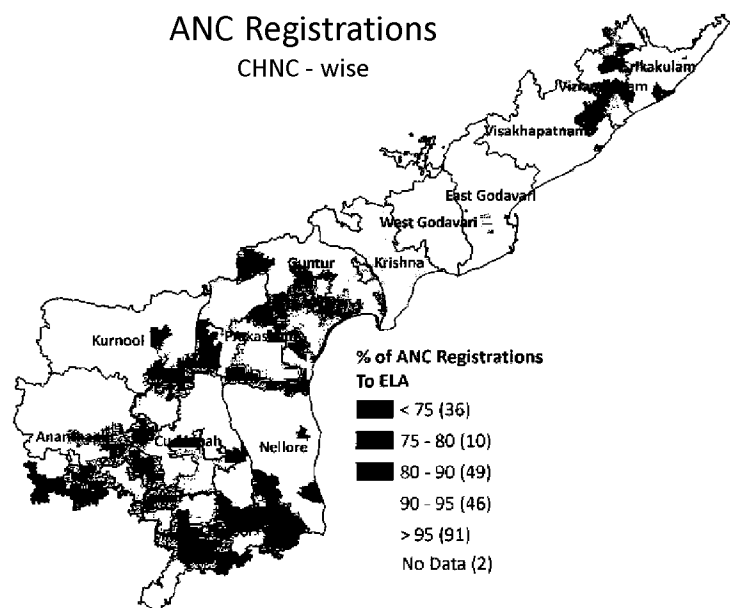
Infant Mortality Rate

Public Distribution System (Number)

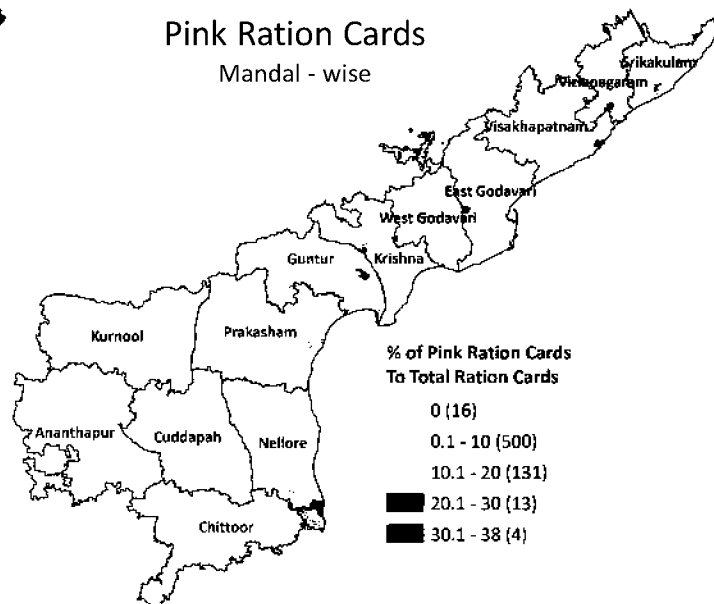

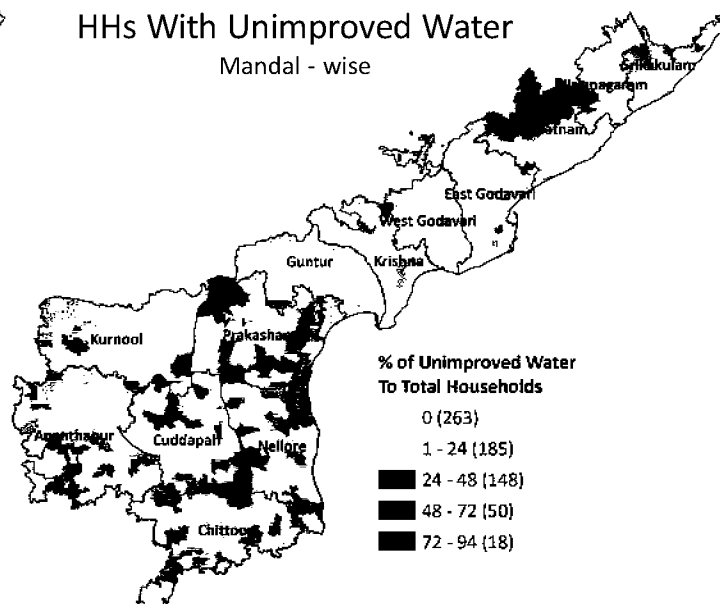

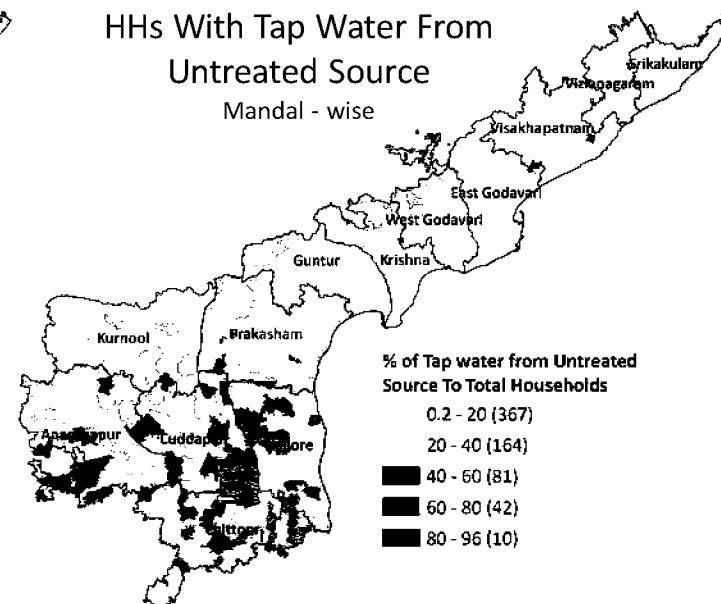

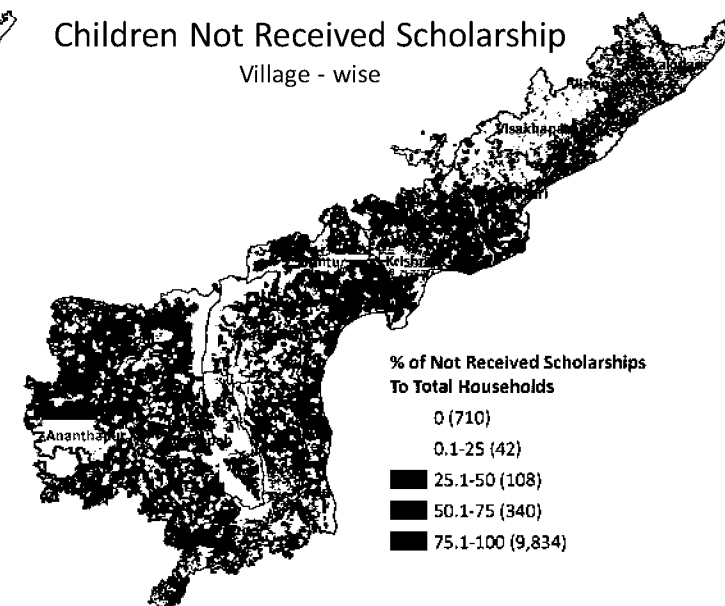

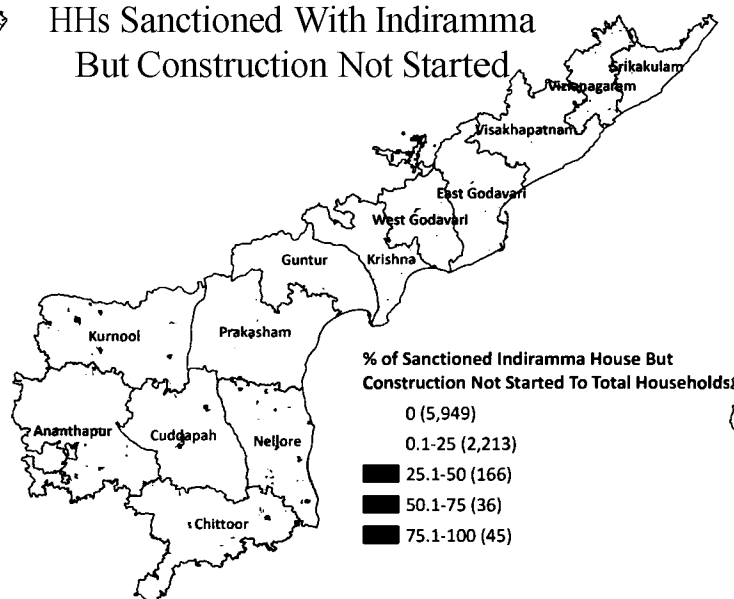

HHs Eligible For Indiramma But Not Sanctioned



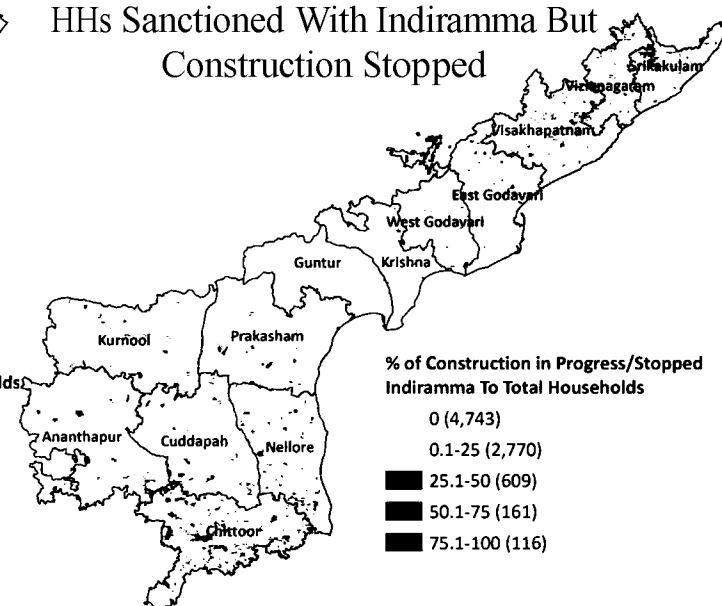
