

# *Achievements of Higher Education Department for* *2009-10*

## *CONSOLIDATION*

- Construction of all the 18 colleges setup during 2005 shall be completed by March, 31<sup>st</sup> 2010.,
- Seven colleges namely Govt. Degree College, Dooru, Budgam, Thanamandi, Akhnoor, R.S.Pura, Hiranagar and Women College Kathua shifted to their campuses.
- Land acquisition process of 18 colleges setup during 2008 is in full progress. Land of all the 18 colleges have already been identified.
- Revenue Papers for seven new colleges authenticated and funds in full placed at the disposal of Deputy Commissioner concerned.
- Rs. 683.18 lakh funds released to various Deputy Commission/s for acquisition of land.
- Presently five buildings at Govt. Degree College Thanamandi, Budgam, Dooru, Bandipore, Women College Sopore and Basohli are ready.
- Govt. Degree College Ganderbal inaugurated by the Hon'ble Chief Minister on 5<sup>th</sup> of December, 2009.
- UC's of three colleges under construction and being funded by MHRD/UGC sent to University Grants Commission.

## *ACADEMICS*

- New subjects including Sciences and Commerce being introduced in the new colleges, where buildings are ready from the ensuing session.
- Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) setup in all the colleges of the State to monitor the academic standard in the Colleges.
- To boost the private sector 74 NOC's in respect of MBA, MCA, BCA, BBA, PGDCA courses have been issued to various Societies / Trusts.

- For modernization of college libraries through INFLIBNET training programme was organized at Kashmir University and Govt. College for Women Gandhinagar, Jammu.
- Govt. College for women Baramulla accredited by NAAC with Grade B thus raising the number of NAAC accredited colleges in the State to 24.
- Edusat Hubs Setup at Govt. College for Women M.A.Road, Srinagar and Govt. College for Women Gandhinagar, Jammu activated with general awareness programmes for common students .
- 1000 ROT's agreed for schools by Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) are to be received by March, 31<sup>st</sup> 2010.
- UGC / NAAC sponsored seminars, workshops and Sensitization Awareness and Motivation Programmes (SAM) through 09 Women Study Centers organized in different colleges of the State.

### **WELFARE PROGRAMME**

- For non-gazetted staff 04 DPC's were held and 72 promotions granted to the employees.
- Orders for 18 new appointments in non-gazetted cadre have been issued.
- Orders for 64 In-situ promotions have been issued.
- Jammu and Kashmir Higher Education (Subordinate ) Service Recruitment Rule 2009 notified under SRO-64 dated 16/03/2009 for the welfare of non-teaching employees.
- 127 posts of Non-Gazetted referred to SSB for selection.
- 322 posts of lecturers Gazetted Cadre referred to PSC for Selection.
- 05 SRO -43 cases have been cleared till date.
- 505 orders for placement of lecturers in different scales cleared.
- 67 Promotions as Principals through DPC/ PSc
- Appointment of 160 lecturers in different discipline have been made till date. Similar order of 59 candidates are under process and are pending because of court intervention.

## FUTURE TARGETS

- Shifting of all the 18 colleges to the newly constructed buildings from the next academic session.
- To identify the agency and to start so as to start the construction of 18 colleges setup during 2008.
- To prepare the project for Women Colleges at District Headquarters in the entire State.
- To submit the proposal of 16 colleges already agreed by MHRD on 50/50 funding basis.
- Introduction of more professional, technical courses in the Colleges which shall be of market value.
- To get all the colleges covered under 12(b) of UGC accredited by NAAC.
- To submit the projects of Women hostels to UGC for 100% funding.
- To procure e-learning material from 250 Website bases course under the National Programme in Technology enhanced learning NPTEL from IIT, Madras.
- To utilize Broad Band Connectivity as can be provided for all the Colleges under the National Mission on Education through ICT.
- Cover all the libraries of the State colleges under INFLIBNET, consortium in order to reach journals which should have been enhancing the research ambience.
- To have 100% computer literacy in the Collegiate Sector.
- More focus on Quality Education.
