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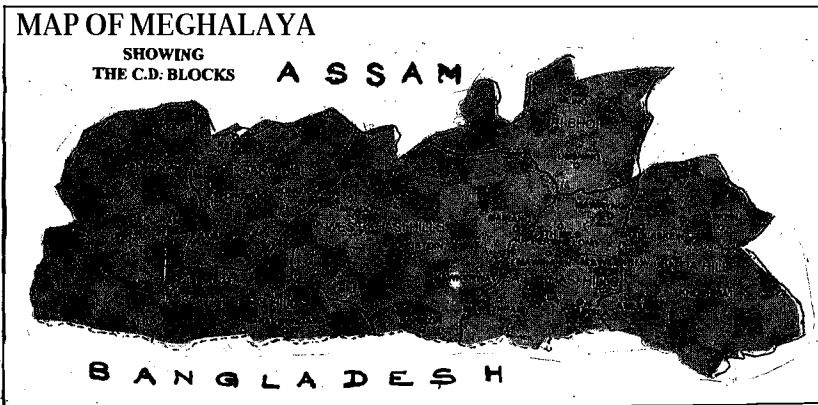

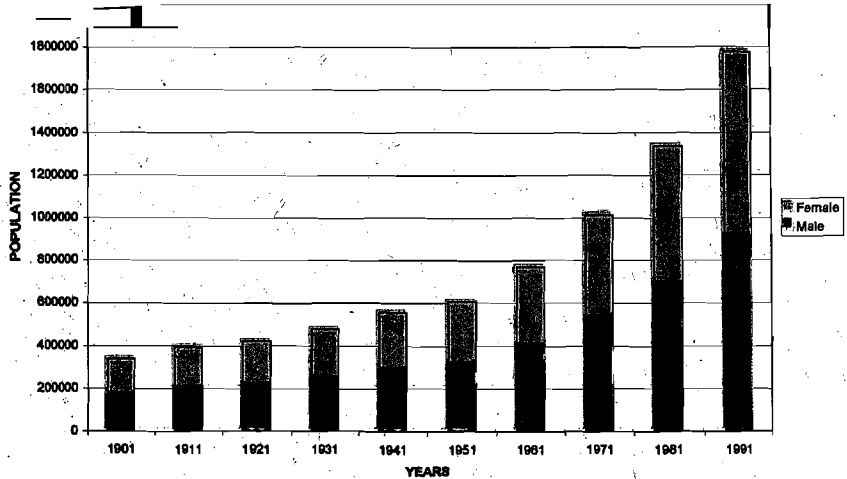

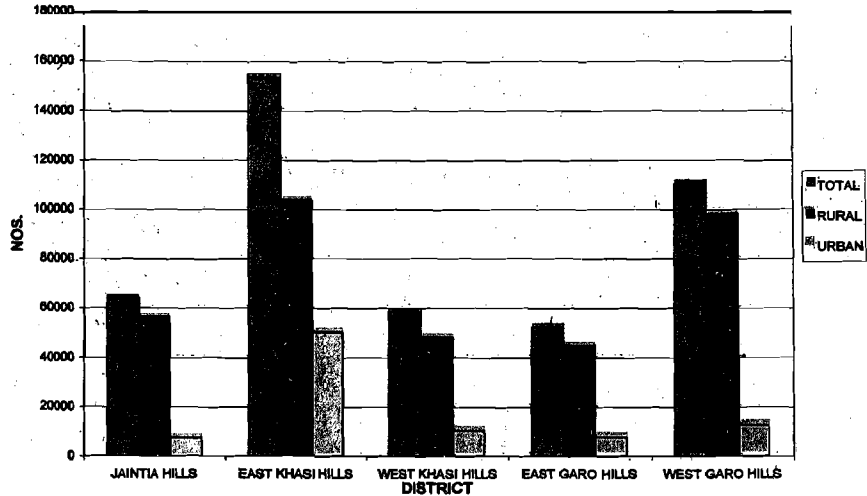

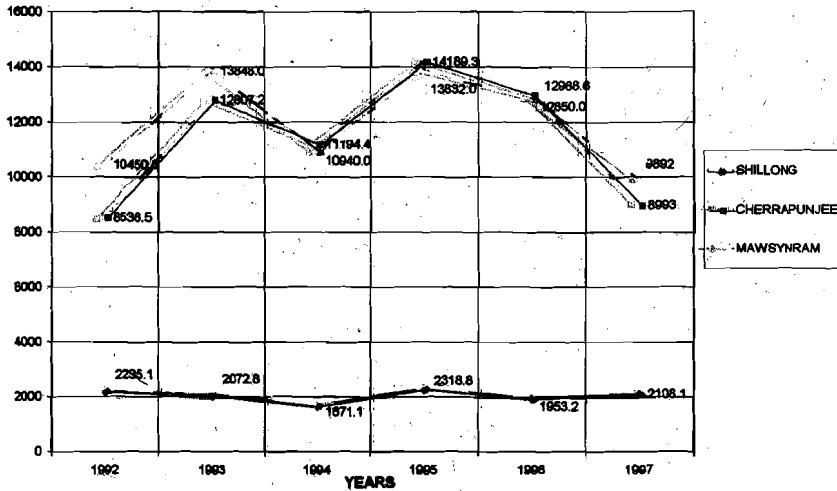

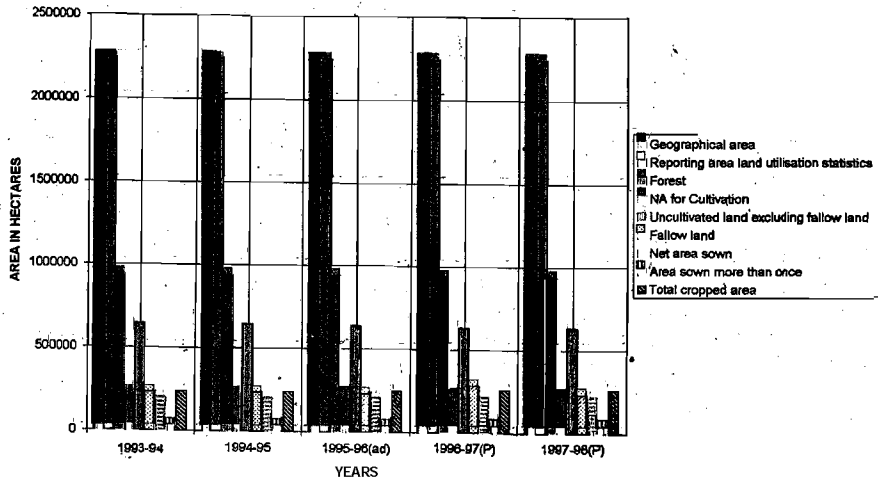

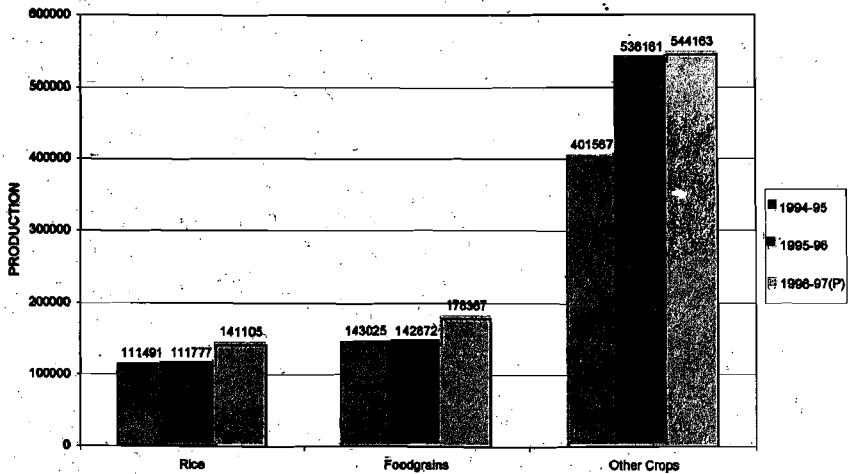

GINGER FOR 1993-94 TO 1997-98**

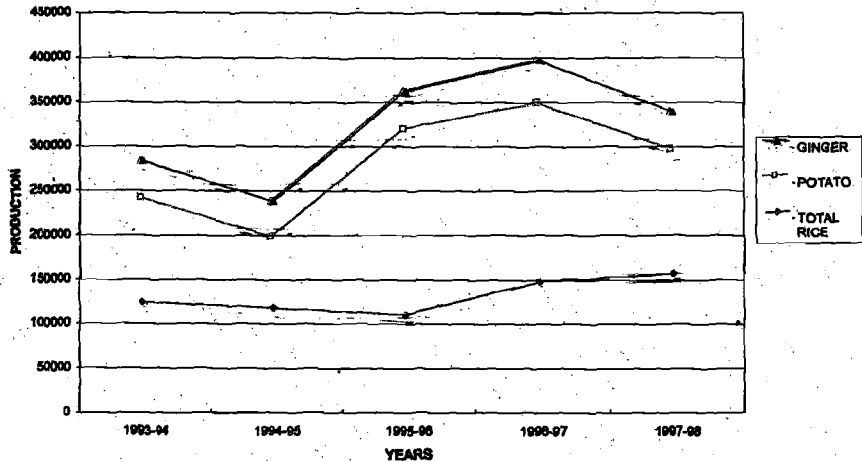

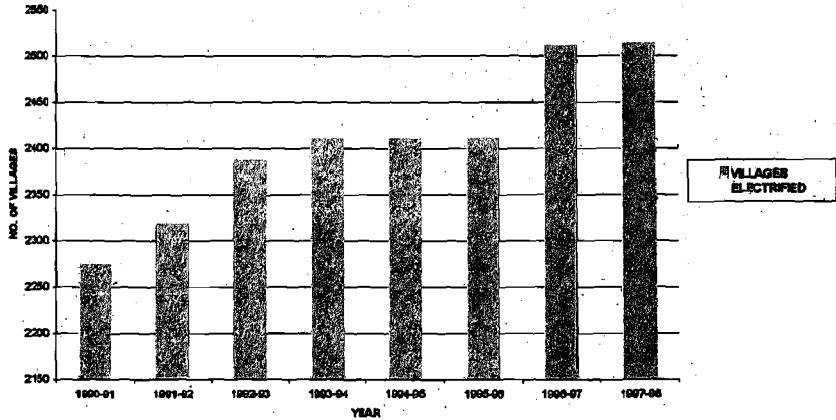

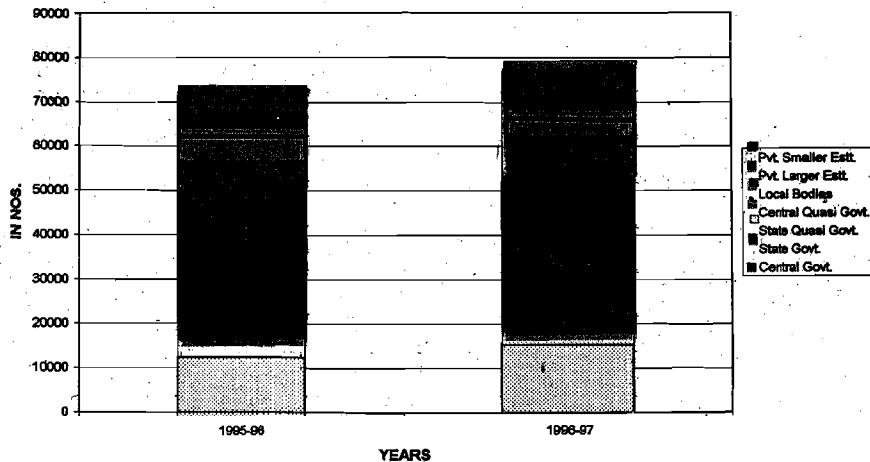

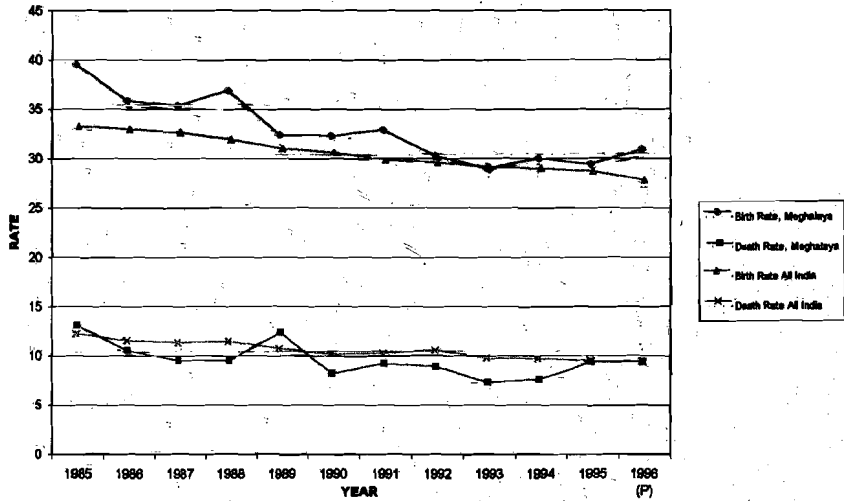

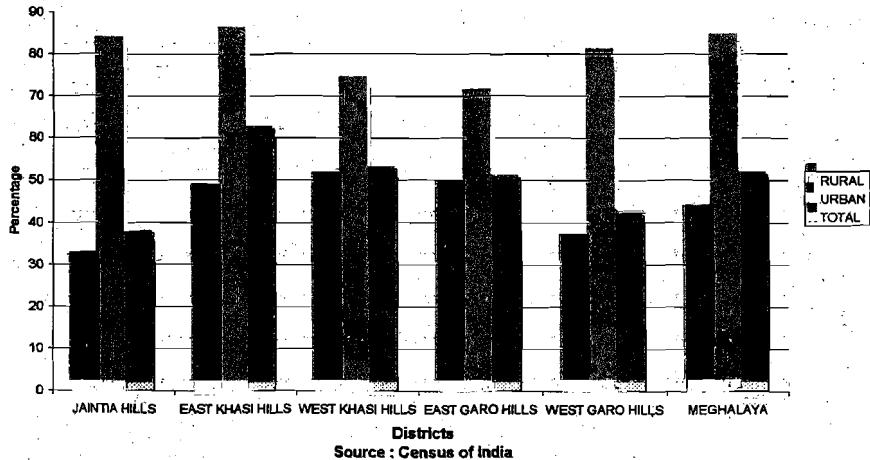

FOR 1995-96 TO 1997-98**

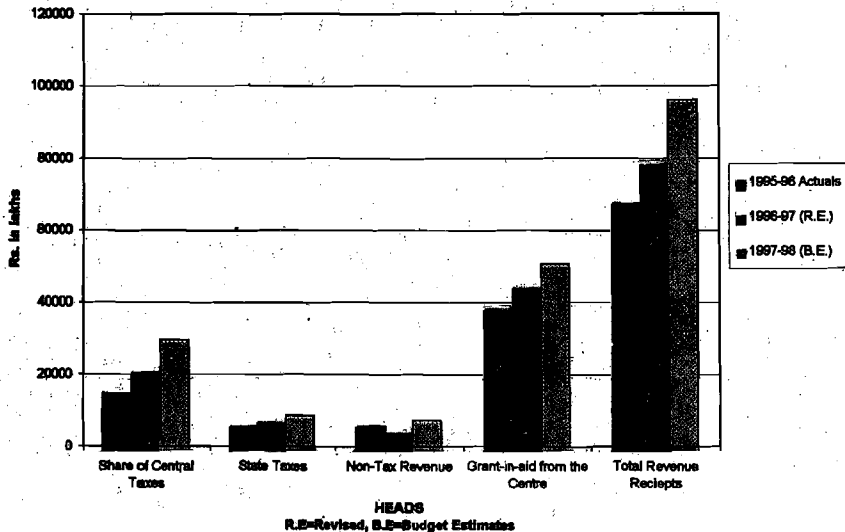

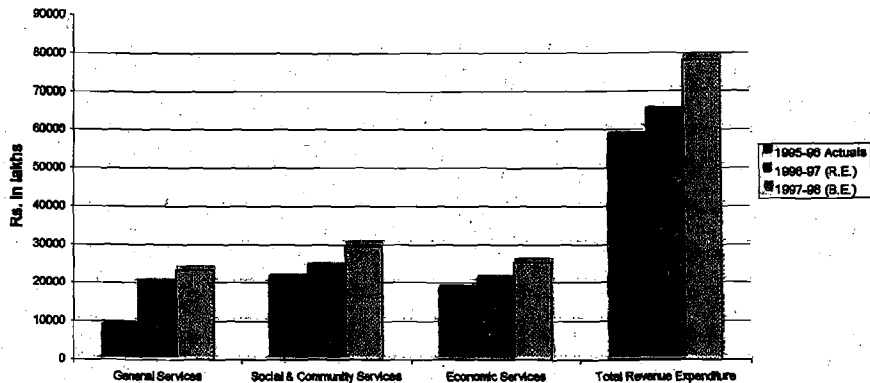

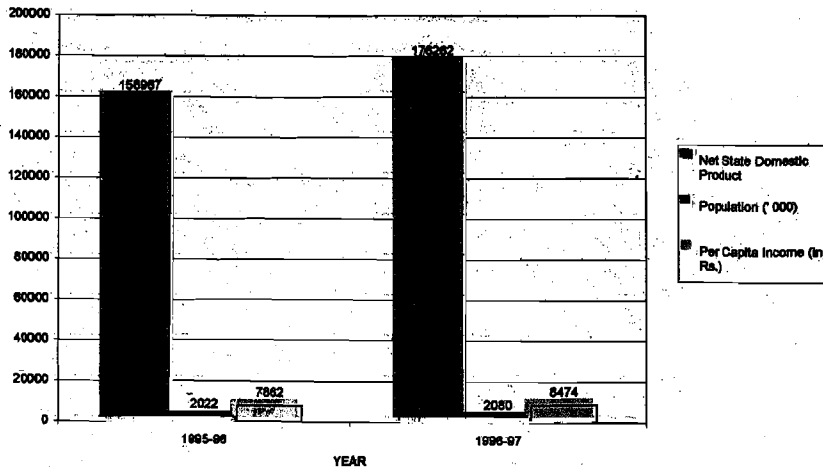
