Suggestions for improvement are always welcome.

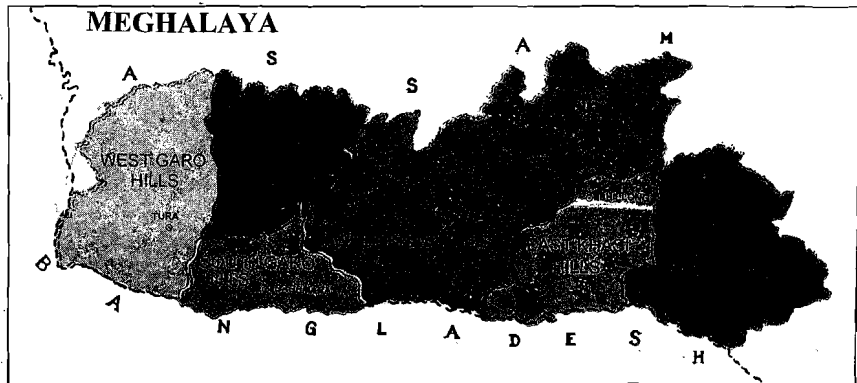

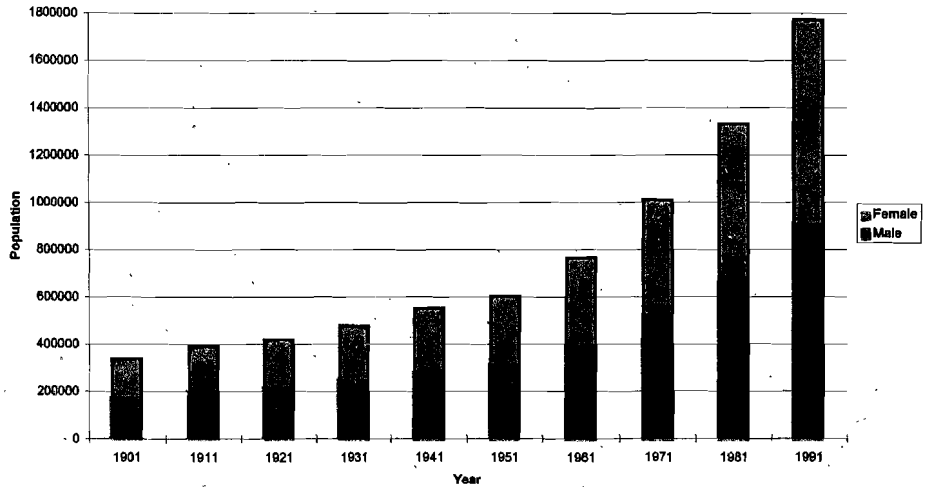

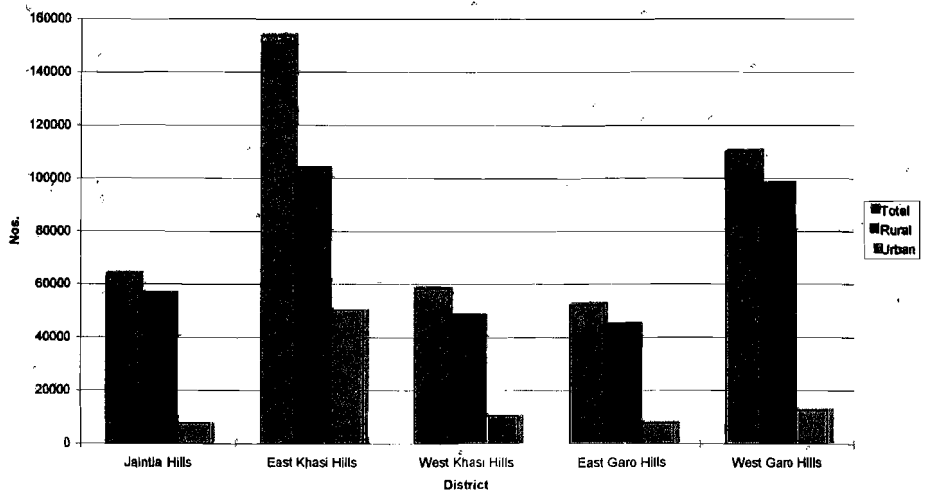

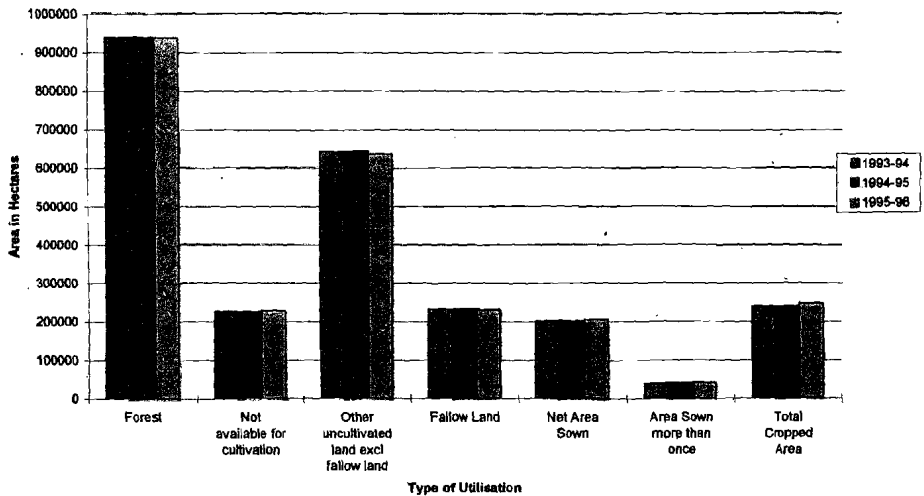

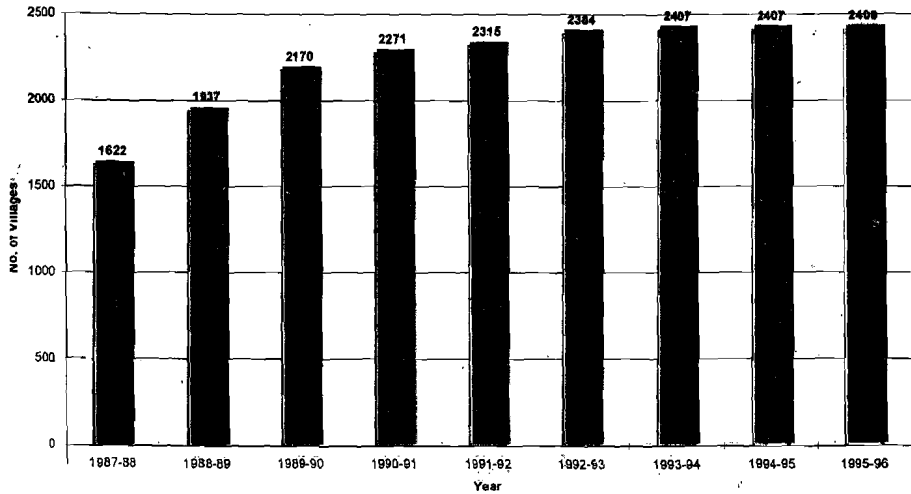

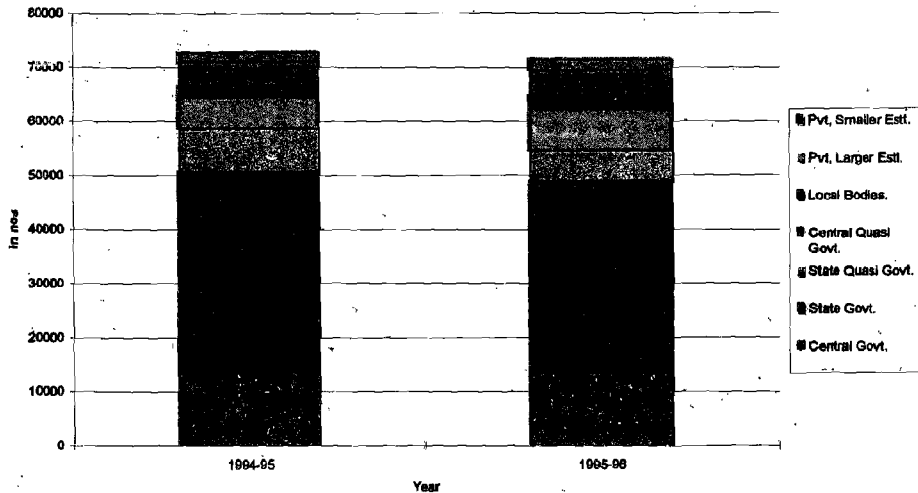

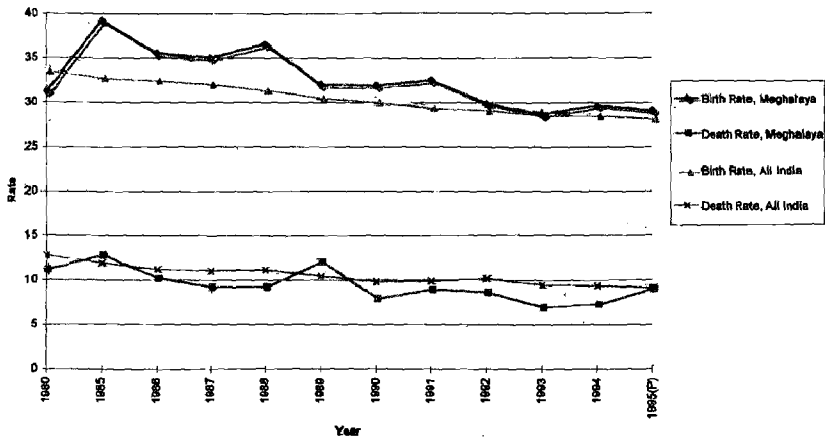

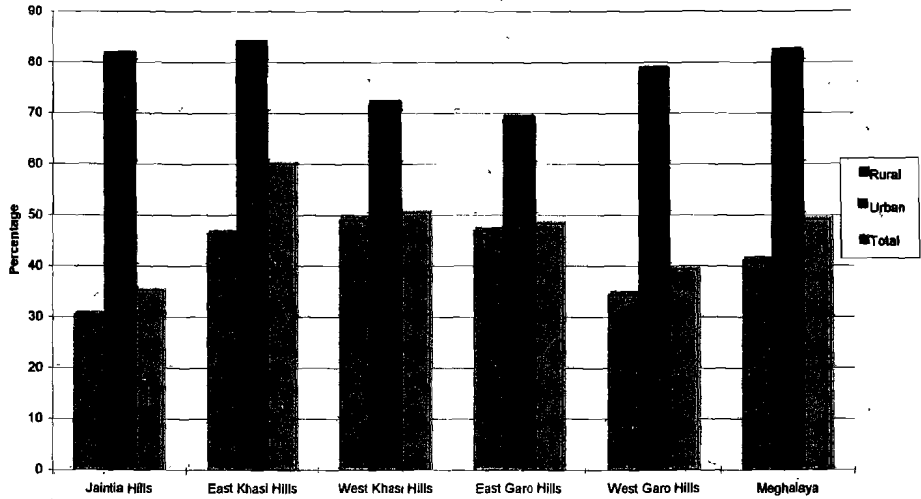

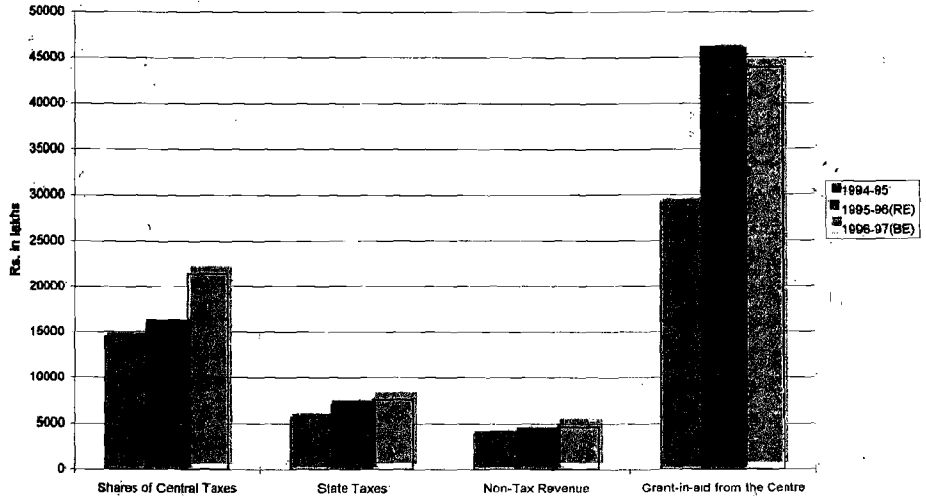

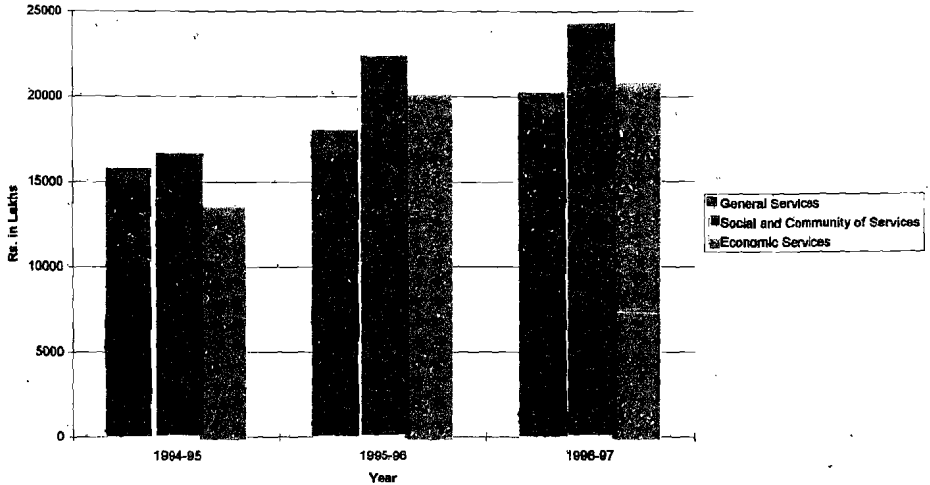
