1. Academic Year For the sake of uniformity, the academic taken to coincide with the financial year April 1<sup>st</sup> of one year to March 31<sup>st</sup> of the year. THE NUMERICAL DATA IS REF AS ON 30<sup>TH</sup> SEPTEMBER OF THE ACADEMIC YEAR.
2. Government Includes both Central and UT Administr: unless otherwise provided for.
3. Local Bodies Include Municipal School, Cantonment Board Zila Parishads, etc.
4. Pre-Primary School / Classes Include all Nursery, infants, Kindergarten and other such school classes.
5. Attached Classes Secondary/Sr. Secondary Schools having Middle / Primary classes or Middle Schools having Primary and Pre-Primary classes will be classified according to the highest class and remaining classes will be treated as attached classes.
6. Senior Secondary Schools (10+2 pattern) Are those schools after passing out from which the students can be admitted in degree classes of Universities..
7. Private All unaided Schools.
8. Government Aided School Are those schools which received 95 % Grant-in-aid from the UT Administration.

## **Andaman and Nicobar Educational Statistics – 2008-09**

### **Growth of Institutions**

The number of schools stood at 82 during 196-61, which rose to 396 during 2008-09. There were no pre-primary schools during 1960-61, during 2008-09 their number stood at 25. Out of 37 inhabited Islands, 18 Islands have schools

### **Enrolment in Schools**

85267 students were enrolled in various schools during 2008-09 of which 6265 were studying in Pre-primary stage, 3502 in Primary stage, 22647 in Middle stage, 12809 in Secondary stage and 854 in Senior secondary stage. Out of total enrolment of 85267 students 5556 students (65.16%) are in rural areas and 29707 students (34.84%) in urban area.

### **ST Enrolment in Schools**

The enrolment of ST students during 2008-09 were 66 in Pre-primary stage, 2511 in Primary stage, 1760 in Middle stage, 91 in Secondary stage and 770 in Senior secondary stage.

### **Schools by Management**

Out of 396 schools, 306 schools are run by Andaman and Nicobar Administration which is nearly 77 percent. Central Govt. has 4 schools, 2 schools are aided by Administration, 13 schools are managed by the local bodies and 71 schools are in private sector.

### **Schools in Rural areas**

Out of 396 schools, 336 (84.5%) are in rural areas and 60 in urban areas during 2008-09. The distribution of schools in South Andaman District at 186, North & Middle Andaman District at 14 and Nicobar District at 49.

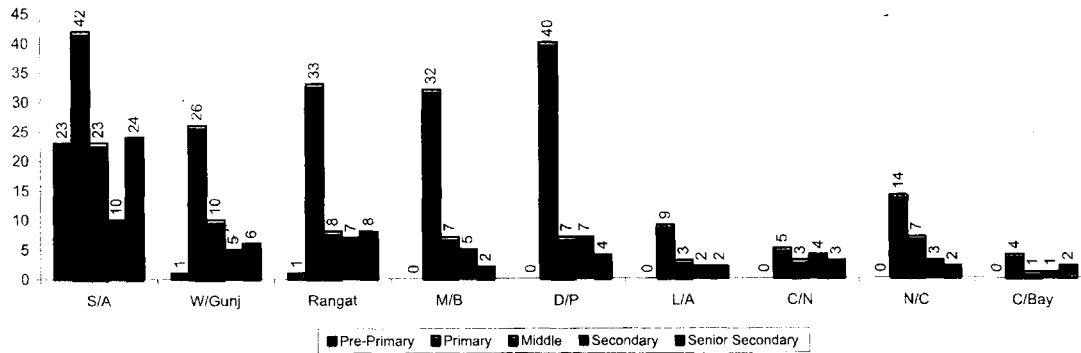

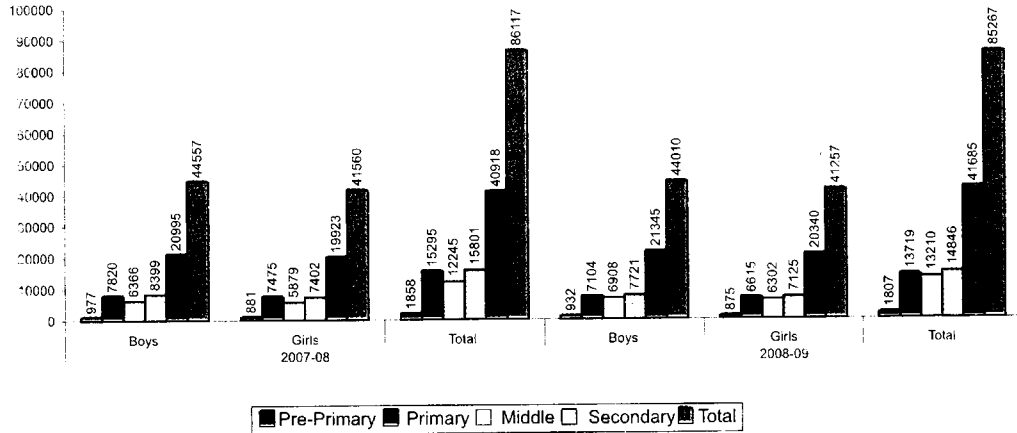

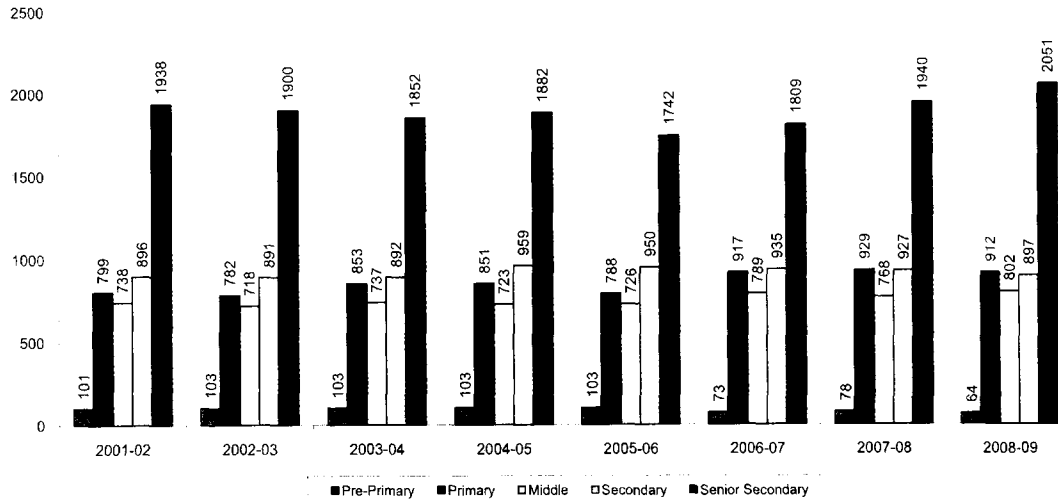

## **Girls in Schools**

The enrolment of girls has shown a marked increase. During the year 1981-82 the enrolment of girls was 20242 (44.43%) out of total enrolment of 45560 whereas during the year 2008-09 the enrolment was 41257 (48.38%) out of total enrolment 85267.

## **Teachers in Schools**

The number of teachers in various schools has gone up to 4726 in 2008-09 as compared to 4249 during 1999-2000. The teacher pupil ratio now stands at 1:18. The percentage of female teacher was 56.62% during 2008-09.

## **Results**

There has been significant improvement in the results of CBSE exams for both Secondary and Senior Secondary Examinations. During the year 2008-09 the pass percentage of Secondary exams was 53.04 as compared to 33.86 during 1999-2000. At Senior Secondary Examinations the pass percentage was 85.85 during 2008-09 as compared to 73.27 during 1999-2000.

## **Drop out rate**

During the year 2008-09, the drop out rate in Primary level was 2.87 which shows a nominal increase as compared to 2.27 in the year 2000-01. The drop out rate of 3.87 in Middle level and 16.87 in Secondary level in the year 2008-09 shows a decrease as compared to 17.20 and 26.58 respectively during 2000-01
