## GLOSSARY

**Growth Rate:** - Percentage of Increase in the reference period over previous period.

**Density of population:** - Number of persons per square kilometer

**Sex ratio:** - Number of females per thousand males in the population

**Urban:** - All places where civic affairs are managed by an urban local body like a municipality, corporation, a cantonment or a notified area committee are automatically treated as urban areas and referred to as statutory towns. The villages or panchayats satisfying the following criteria are also treated as urban areas:

- i) A minimum expected population of 5,000.
- ii) A minimum population density of 400 persons per square kilometer.
- iii) Atleast 75% of the male working population should be engaged in non-agricultural pursuits.

Such urban areas are referred to as census towns or non-statutory towns.

**Household:** - A group of Persons who commonly live together and would take their meals from a Common Kitchen unless the exigencies of work prevented them from doing so. A Household may be of Persons related by blood or unrelated Persons or having a mix of both.

**Household size:** - The number of normally resident members of a household. It will include temporary stay away but exclude temporary visitors and guests.

**Main workers:** - Persons who have worked for a major part (183 days or more in a year) of the year preceding the enumeration

**Marginal workers:** - Persons who have worked any time at all during the year preceding year of enumeration but who have not worked for more than 183 days in the year preceding the enumeration

**Total Workers:** - Include all Main Workers and Marginal Workers

**Work force:** - Persons engaged in any gainful activity are considered workers (or employed). They are the persons assigned any one or more of the nine activity categories under the first broad activity category (i.e.) working or employed.

**Work Participation Rate:** - Percentage of Participation of Persons in some gainful economic activity to total population.

**Slum:** - An areal unit having twenty five or more katcha structures mostly of temporary nature, or fifty or more households residing mostly in katcha structures, huddled together, or inhabited persons with practically no private latrine and inadequate public latrine and water facilities.

**Poverty line:** - The level of per capita per day expenditure, which meets a normative minimum standard of living, deemed reasonable.

**Birth Rate:** - Number of Live Births Per thousand Population in a given Year.

**Death Rate:** - Number of Deaths Per thousand Population in a given Year.

**Infant Mortality Rate:** - Number of Infants dying under one year of age in a given Year per thousand Live Births.

$$\text{IMR} = \frac{\text{Number of infants death during the year}}{\text{Number of live births during the year}} \times 100$$

**Expectation of life at birth:** - Average number of years a new born child is expected to live under current mortality conditions

**General fertility rate:** - Number of live births per thousand women in the reproductive age group (15-49 years) in a given year

**Total Fertility Rate:** - The average number of children that would be born to a woman if she experiences the current fertility pattern throughout her reproductive span (15-49 years).

**Effective Couple Protection Rate:** - Number of couples currently protected by different methods of family planning.

**Forests:** - All actually forested areas and the lands classed or administered as forests under any legal enactment dealing with forests whether state owned or private.

**Net Area Sown:** - Area sown to crops counting areas sown more than once in the same year, only once.

**Total Cropped Area:** -The sum of the areas covered by all the individual crops, area sown with crops for more than once during the year being counted as separate areas for each crop.

**Net Area Irrigated:** - The total of all the areas irrigated from different sources, counting each area irrigated only once even though it was irrigated more than once in the same year.

**Operational Holding:** - All land which is used wholly or partly for agricultural production and is operated as one technical unit by one person alone or with others without regard to the title, legal form, size or location.

**Operated Area:** - Operated Area will include both cultivated and uncultivated area, provided part of it is put to agricultural production during the reference period.

**Marginal Holding:** - A Holding having an area of below one Hectare.

**Small Holding:** - A Holding having an area between 1-2 Hectares.

**Registered factory:** - A factory which is registered under sections 2 m (i) and 2 m (ii) of the Factories Act, 1948.

**Workers:** - Persons employed directly or through any agency whether for wages or not, and engaged in any manufacturing process or in cleaning any part of the machinery or premises used for manufacturing process or any other kind of work incidental to or connected with the manufacturing process or subject of the manufacturing process.

**Employees:** - All workers and persons receiving wages and holding supervisory or managerial positions, or engaged in administrative office, store keeping section and welfare section, sales department as also those engaged in purchase of raw materials etc. or production of fixed assets for the factory and watch and ward staff.

**Fixed Capital:** - Depreciated value of fixed assets owned by the factory as on the closing day of the accounting year.

**Working Capital:** - Total of the physical working capital and the cash deposits in hand and at bank and the net balance of amount receivable over amounts payable at the end of the accounting year.

**Net Value Added:** - The increment to the value of goods and services that is contributed by the factory and is obtained by deducting the value of total inputs and depreciation from value of output.

**Industrial Dispute:** - Temporary stoppage of work by all employees or a group of employees of an establishment (strike) to express a grievance or to press a demand. Similarly temporary withholding of work from a group of employees by employer (lockout).

**Man Days Lost:** - Adding up of the actual resultant vacancies caused directly and/or indirectly during work stoppage in each shift of each potential working day (excluding weekly offs and other holidays).

**Plant Load Factor of Electricity Generation:** - It indicates the percentage of actual power generation to the total generating capacity of the machine per annum.

**System Loss:** - System Loss means electrical energy loss during transformation, transmission and distribution of electrical energy for ultimate consumption within the system of state/UT including component of electrical energy unaccounted for TD & D losses corresponding to inter system transfer.

**Literate:** - A person who is 7 years and above and who is able to read and write with understanding in any one language

**Primary School:** - A school up to class IV standard. However, in some states, schools up to class V standard are also considered as primary schools.

**Middle/Secondary School:** - Middle school is one, which provides education; generally up to class VIII and secondary school provides education upto class X.

**Higher Secondary School/Intermediate College:** - It is a school providing education upto 10+2 standard. An intermediate college having classes 10+2 in the present system of education.

**Enrolment Ratio for Primary Stage (I-V) : -**

**Dropout Rate at Primary Stage (I-V) : --**

Enrolment in class I preceding four years

**Teacher-Pupil Ratio:** - The average number of students per teacher for a particular type of school.

Total enrolment in the school

Teacher-Pupil Ratio in a school = -----  
Total number of teachers in the school

**Pucca structure:** - A structure whose walls and roof (atleast) are made of pucca materials, such as, cement, concrete, oven burnt bricks, stone, stone blocks, cement plastered reeds, iron and other metal sheets, timber, tiles, slate, corrugated iron, asbestos cement sheets etc.

**Semi-pucca structure:** - A structure, which has either the walls or the roof, but not both, made of pucca materials.

**Katcha structure:** - A structure, whose walls and roof are made of non-pucca materials, such as, unburnt bricks, bamboo, mud, grass, leaves, reeds and / or other thatch.

**Gross State Domestic Product at Factor Cost:** - The gross output of all commodities, industries etc. evaluated at factor cost less the purchasers' value of intermediate inputs within the geographical boundaries of the State.
