

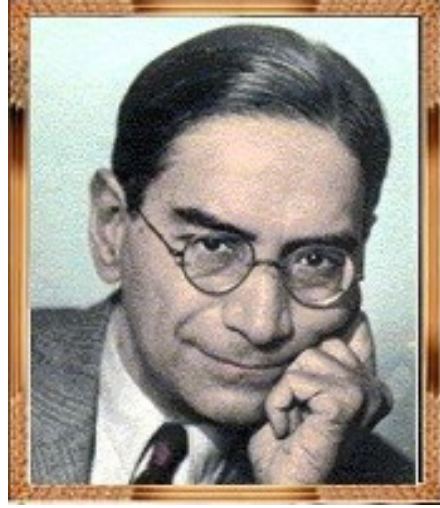



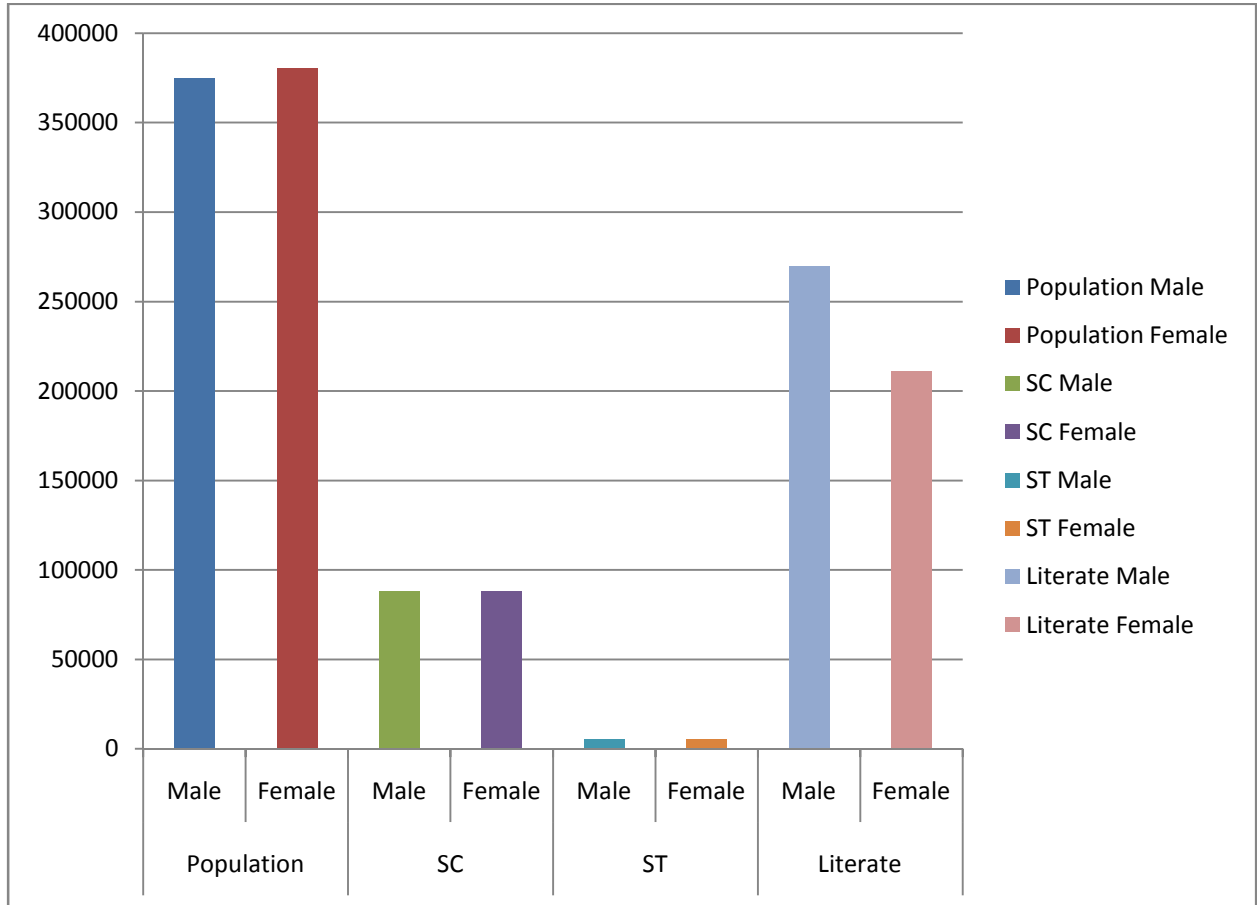

**CHART FOR POPULATION, LITERATES, SC'S, ST'S- SEXWISE**

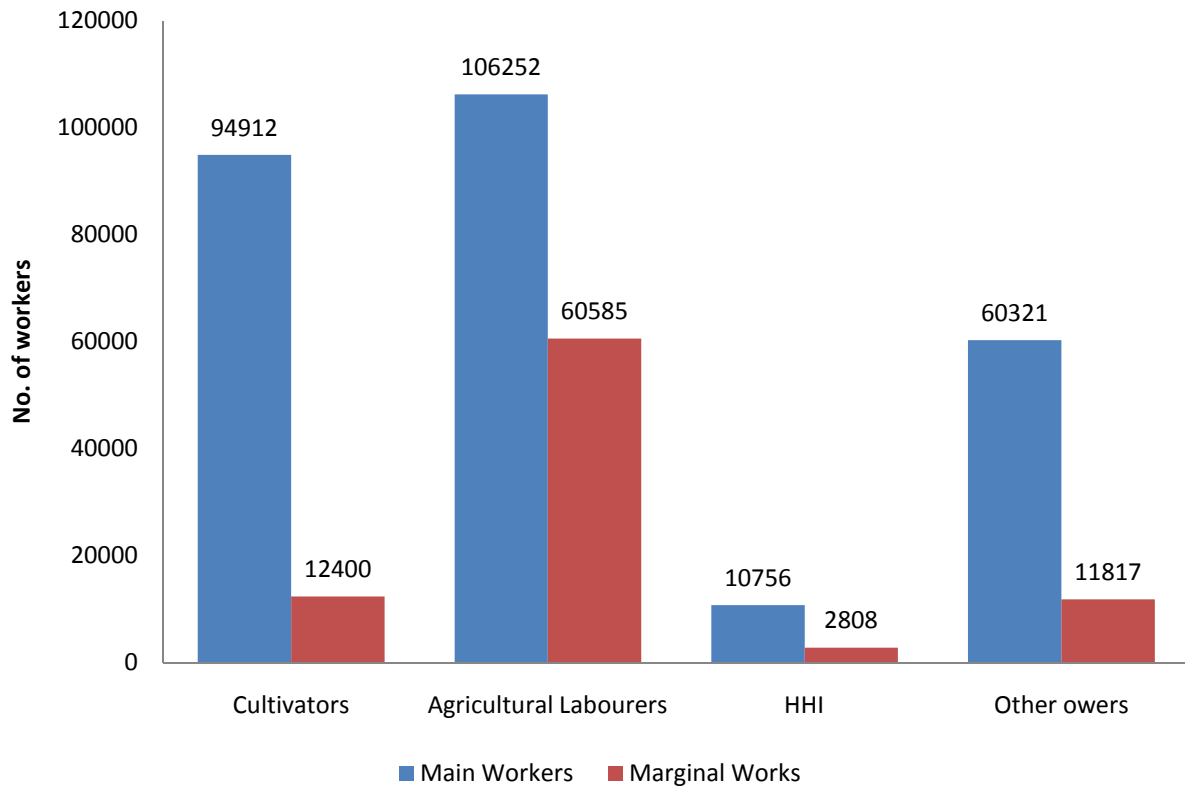

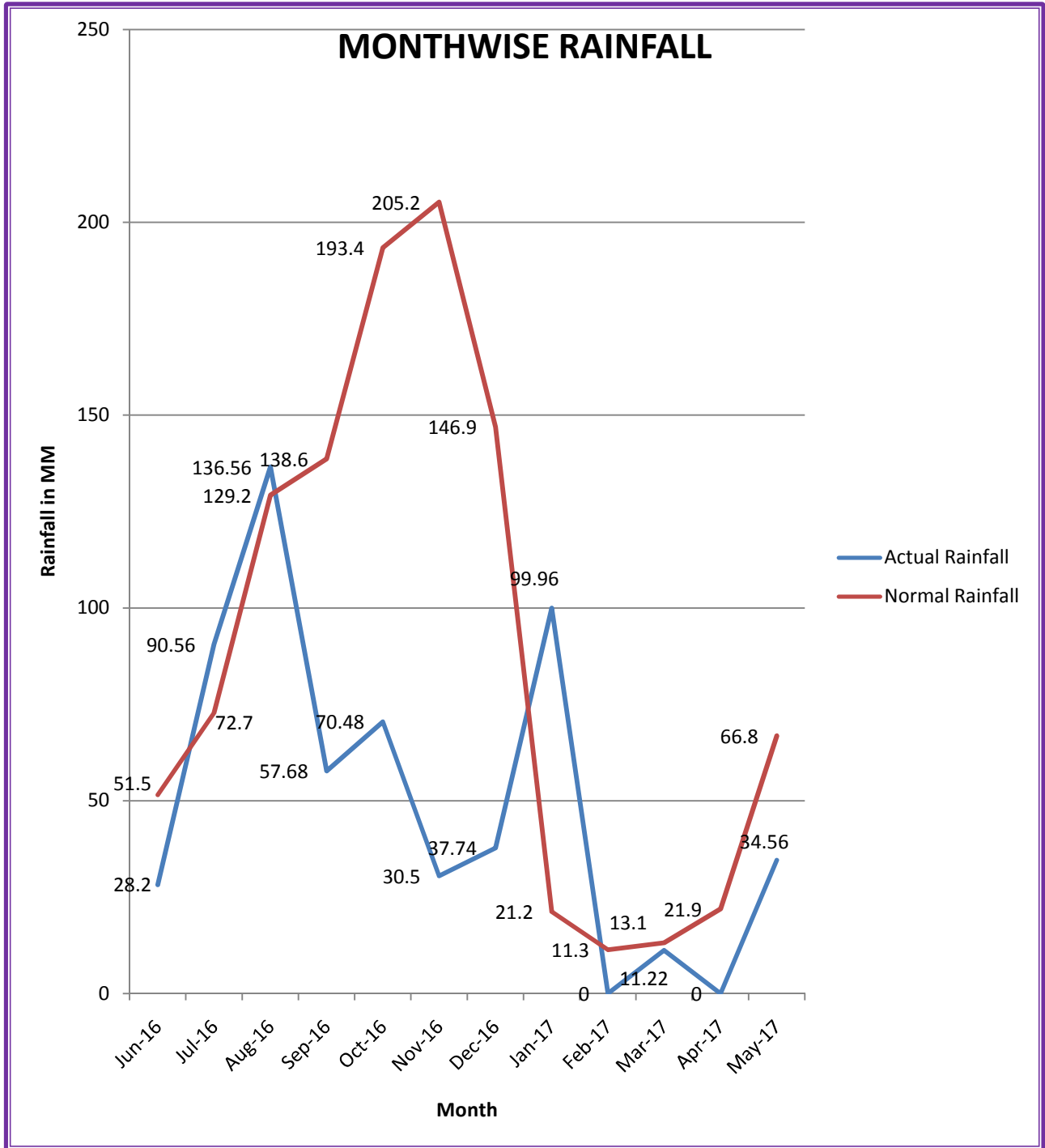

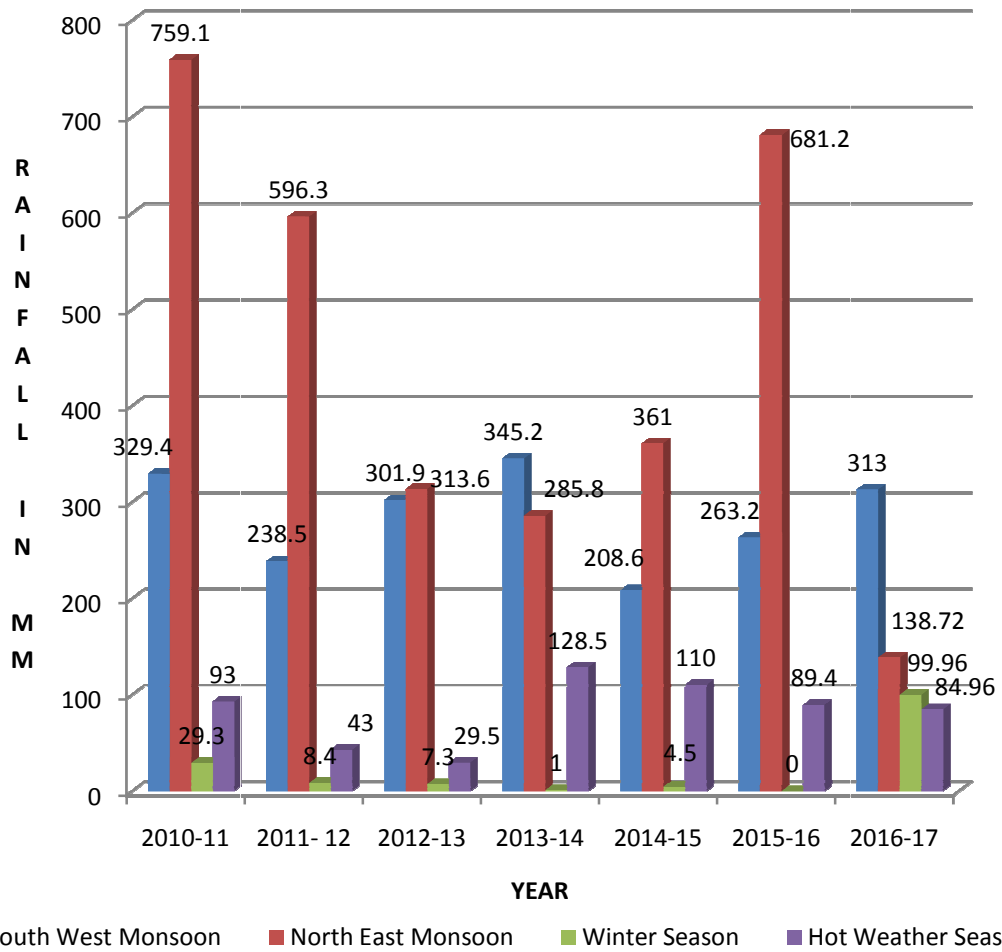

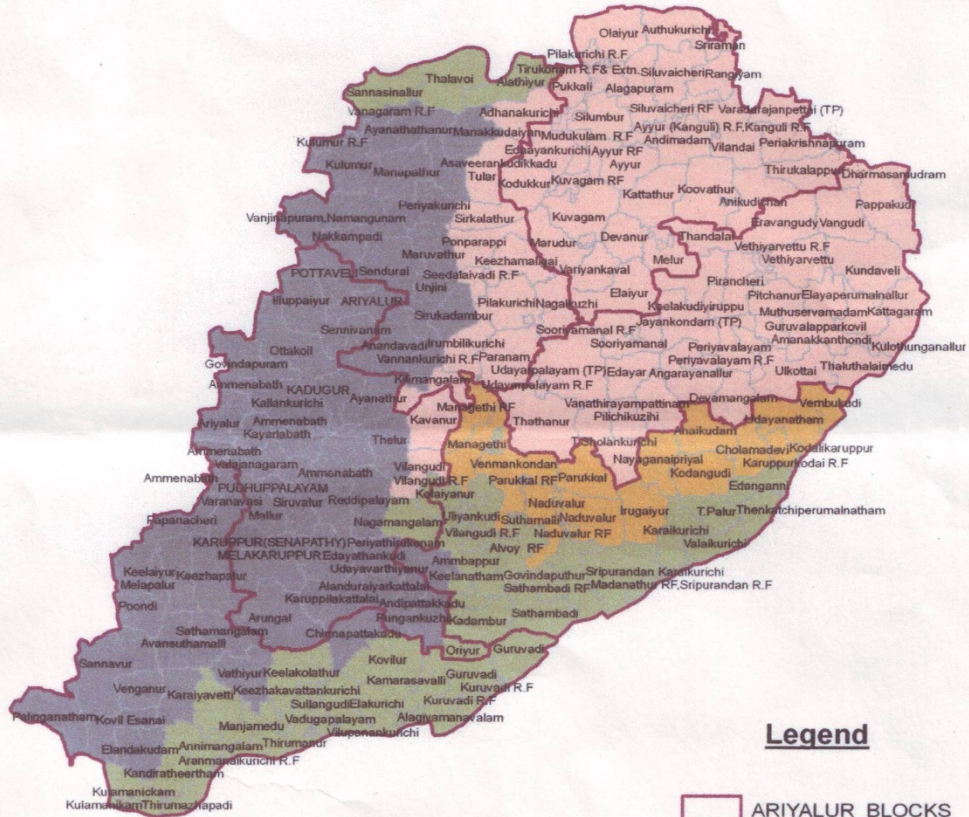

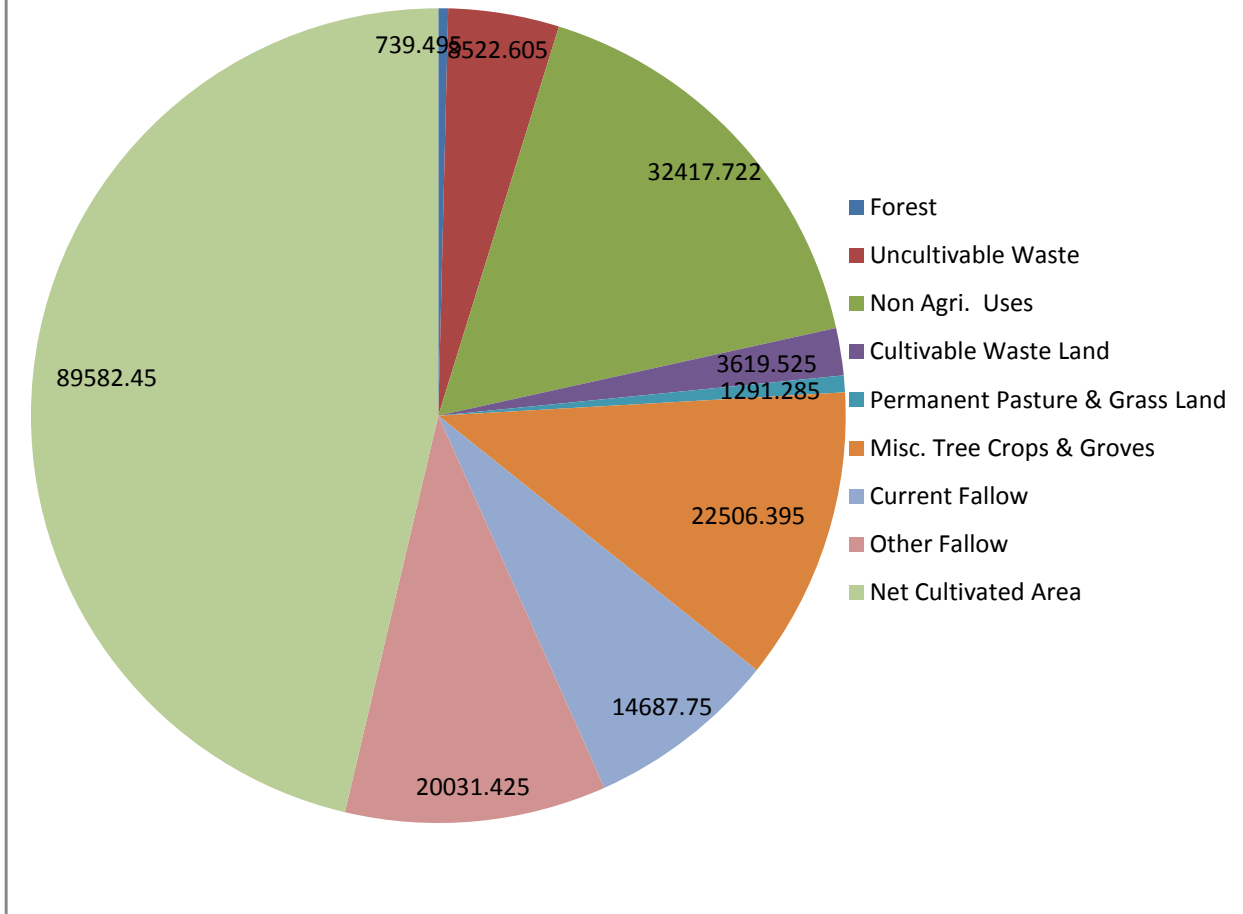

## LAND CLASSIFICATION FOR 2016-17



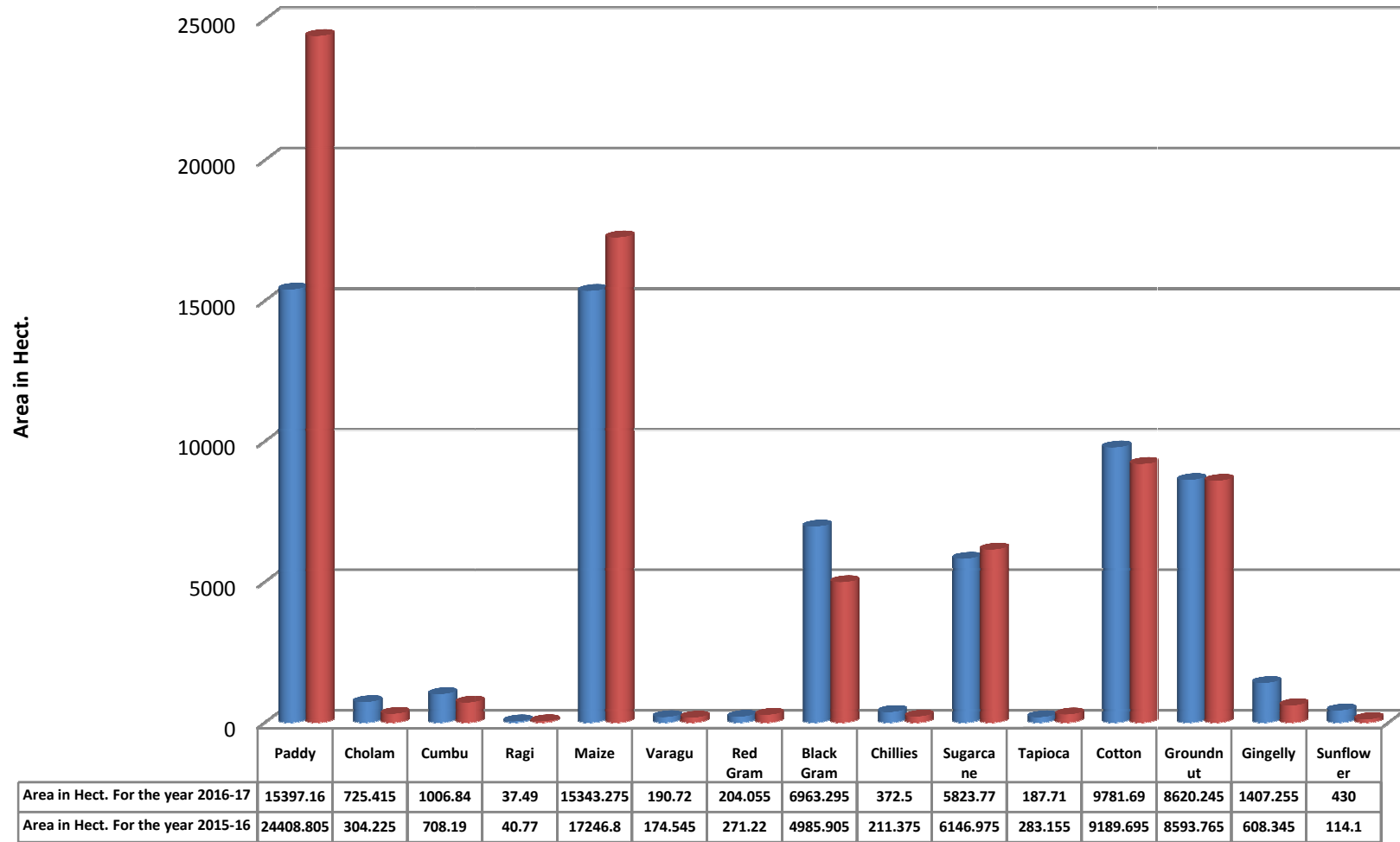

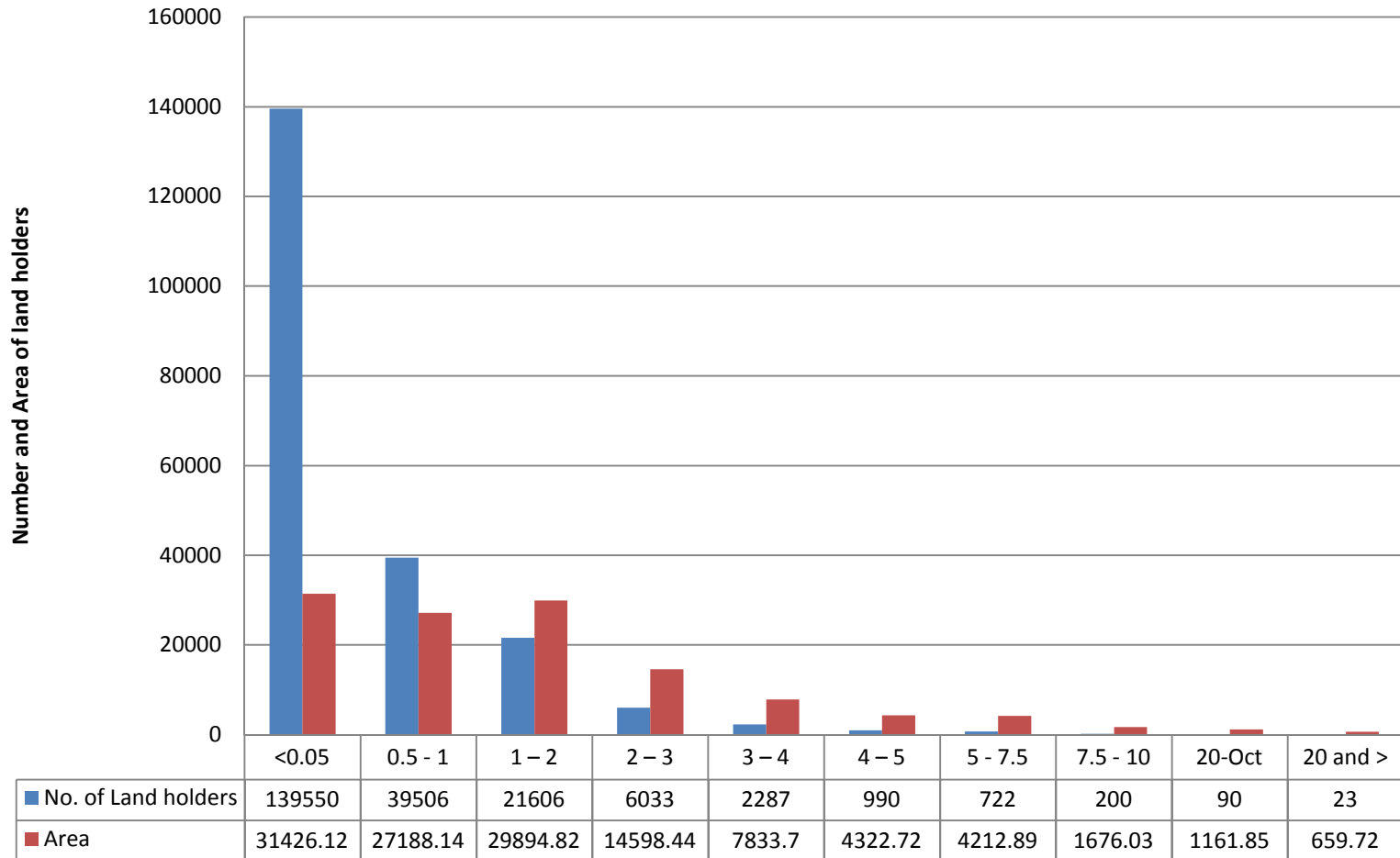
