**LITERACY FOR AGE GROUP 7 AND ABOVE : 1981 - 1991
(PROVISIONAL)**

BASED ON CENSUS DATA

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FOREWORD

1991 Census for the first time has adopted age group 7 and above for canvassing the literacy question. In the earlier censuses, this question was addressed to population aged 5 years and above. Office of the Registrar General & Census Commissioner of India has brought out papers containing provisional population totals and information on literates of the age group 7 and above. Population for the age group 7 and above on the basis of 1991 census has not been released so far. State-wise estimates of the population were made by Registrar General's Office for working out provisional literacy rates upto State/Union Territory level.

Literacy digest based on 1991 census data was brought out by the Directorate of Adult Education in 1991. National Institute of Adult Education set up by the Deptt. of Education, Ministry of Human Resource Development, has taken the initiative scientifically build up a statistical data base for literacy which is an important resource base for planning and implementation of literacy programmes at different levels and conducting of research in this area.

A project on comparative analysis of literacy data for age group 7 and above has been taken up by the NIAE as part of its statistical data base for literacy. On the basis of an analysis of 1981 census records, comparable data for this age group for 1981 has been compiled at national, state and district levels. In this booklet, an attempt has been made to present comparative position of literacy statistics of the age group 7 and above for the years 1981 and 1991. Decadal growth rate of literacy for 1981-91 and change in the index of gender equality during this period reflects the improvement in the field of literacy and in narrowing down the disparity between male and female literacy.

District has now been accepted as an important unit of planning for total literacy programmes. District literacy campaigns have already been taken up in 165 districts of the country either fully or partially. Eighth Five Year Plan envisages to extend these campaigns to 345 districts of the country by 1997-98. Data on rate of literacy, progress made during 1981-91 and the size of illiterate population at the district level are essential requirements for planning literacy campaigns. District level rates of literacy and size of illiterate population for 1991 which were not included in the literacy digest 1991 have been included here. These are based on population estimates for age group 7 and above. These have been worked out by applying State level ratios to the total district population. These estimates will give a fair idea of the literacy rates and the illiteracy situation for planning purposes and will be revised after the final data from Census is available.

Planning and compilation of the booklet has been done by **Shri Prem Chand, Fellow** in the National Institute of Adult Education. **Shri Swarnendu Biswas and Ms. Vinita Gupta, Project Assistants** have helped in the compilation and processing of the data for this booklet. I would like to record my deep sense of appreciation for the initiative taken and tremendous efforts put in by Shri Prem Chand. I also appreciate the work done by Shri Biswas, Ms. Vinita Gupta and others in bringing out this booklet in time for being released at the International Literacy Day, 1992.

INTRODUCTION & BRIEF ANALYSIS

1.0 National Level:

Table-I gives distribution of literates and illiterates among population aged 7 years and above by sex in India for the years 1981 and 1991. Provisional Population Totals paper-I brought out by the Office of Registrar General of India indicated total population of all age groups and total number of literates aged 7 years and above for India excluding Jammu and Kashmir, as 843.9 million and 361.7 million respectively. Due to small changes in case of States/UTs like Andhra Pradesh, Gujarat, Kerala, Maharashtra, Sikkim, Pondicherry etc., the total population and number of literates aged 7 years and above according to Provisional Population Totals paper-2 was revised to 844.3 million and 362.2 million respectively. Literacy rate for the population of age group 7 and above works out to 52.1% on the basis of estimated population of age group 7 and above. This means that for the first time, number of literates has exceeded the number of illiterates in the country. The estimated number of illiterates for India excluding Jammu and Kashmir comes to 332 million 1981 census data when analysed for the age group 7 and above indicates that there were 236 million literates and 305 million illiterates of this age group in 1981 in India excluding Assam where 1981 census was not held. The table-I indicates that the number of literates has been growing at a fast rate. Rate of literacy during this period has increased from 43.6% in 1981 to 52.1% in 1991. Not only the percentage increase during 1981-91 is higher than that of the earlier decades, the literacy rate of 1991 has crossed the landmark of 50%. The table also indicates that the literacy rate in case of females during 1981-91 increased by 9.6 percentage points as compared to 7.5 percentage points in case of males.

Though the progress rate of literacy in 1981-91 in respect of females was better, yet huge disparity between male and female literacy rates continued to exist. As against literacy rate of 63.9% for male, literacy rates for females was 39.4%. In 1981 there were 204 male literates as compared to 100 female literates. This ratio decreased to 175 male literates to 100 female literates in 1991. Index of Gender Equality* which ideally should be 100, improved from 68.31 in 1981 to 75.61 in 1991. Literacy rate in rural areas which was 36.0% in 1981 improved to 44.2% in 1991. Large disparity between rural and urban literacy rates continued to exist. The table also reveals that the problem of illiteracy is mainly centred in rural areas where 86.6% of the illiterates reside as against the rural population forming 79.6% for the total population. Females form about 60% of the illiterate population as against their share of 48.1% in the total population. Comparison of 1981-91 data in terms of absolute number of literates and illiterates is possible (i) by excluding Jammu and Kashmir from 1981 and Assam from 1991 so that both the figures relate to India minus Assam and Jammu and Kashmir. (ii) by including Estimates for Assam in 1981 and for Jammu and Kashmir in 1991 so that both the figures relate to whole of India. Comparative figures of India minus Assam and Jammu and Kashmir and whole of India for 1981-91 have been worked out as under:

The above data indicates that the decadal increase in the number of literates was about 50% whereas increase in the number of illiterates was around 7%. To reach the target of achieving literacy rate of 70% by 1997 as envisaged in the Eighth Five Year Plan, the number of literates will have to be raised substantially through effective formal and non-formal primary education and adult literacy programme. Projections of population made by the standing committee on population projections indicated that the total population of the country is expected to rise to about 940 million by 1997. The estimated population of the age group 7 and above will be around 785 million. To achieve the target of 70%, number of literates will need to be raised to about 550 million from the figure of 364 million in 1991.

2. State Level:

Table-2 contains data on state wise comparative position of literates and literacy rates of all persons aged 7 years and above for 1981 and 1991. It is observed that about 84 percent of the total increase in the number of literates in the country during 1981-91 was contributed by 11 states of U.P. (17.6 million), Maharashtra (14.0 millions), West Bengal (10.8 million), Andhra Pradesh (9.3 million), Madhya Pradesh (9.2 million), Bihar (9.1 million), Tamil Nadu (8.2 million), Karnataka (7.1 million) Gujarat (6.7 million), Rajasthan (5.4 million) and Kerala (5.1 million) where the increase in the number of literates was more than 5 millions in each case. Orissa, Assam, Punjab and Haryana contributed another about 10% of the increase in the literates of the country. Decadal growth rate in the number of literates during 1981-91 was very high in some of the small states/UTs like Arunachal Pradesh (120%), Nagaland (93%), Chandigarh (81%), Sikkim (80%). It was 60% or more in case of states/UTs of Daman & Diu (68%) Dadar and Nagar Haveli (67%), Rajasthan (66%), Madhya Pradesh (64%), Haryana (67%), Delhi (61%) and Andhra Pradesh (60%) as compared to the national average of about 50%.

Literacy rate in 1991 was the highest in Kerala (90.6%) followed by Mizoram, Lakshadweep, Chandigarh and Goa where it was more than 75 percent. At the lowest end was Bihar with 38.5% literacy rate preceded by Rajasthan, Dadra & Nagar Haveli, Arunachal Pradesh, Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, where the literacy rate was below 45%. In terms of ranking of states/UTs on the basis of literacy rates of 1981 and 1991, it is observed that Kerala, Mizoram, Lakshadweep and Chandigarh have maintained their ranking from first to fourth position. Goa, Tamil Nadu, Himachal Pradesh, Sikkim, Nagaland, Arunachal Pradesh, Manipur, Orissa and Meghalaya have improved their positions and Delhi, Maharashtra, Gujarat, Karnataka, Meghalaya and Bihar have gone down. Bihar which was above Arunachal Pradesh and Rajasthan in 1981 has now moved to the last position. Increase in the literacy rate during 1981-91 was above 100 percent in cases of Arunachal Pradesh, Goa, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Manipur, Nagaland, and Lakshadweep. It was below 5% only in case of Delhi. Main reason for depressing the increase in literacy rate in Delhi was very high population growth rate.

Tables 3 and 4 give state wise comparison of literates and literacy rates for male and female population aged 7 years and above for 1981 and 1991. It is observed from the data that the trend of increasing number of female literates as compared to male literates was observed in all the states and Union Territories. In Uttar Pradesh where the number of male literates was 316 in 1981 as against 100 female literates, it came down to 243 in 1991. Similarly it came down from 301 to 250 in Bihar. Number of male literates as against 100 female literates came down to 103 in Kerala and 119 and 121 in Mizoram and Meghalaya respectively. The data indicates that there was good improvement during the decade in this direction, but still there are states/UTs like Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Bihar, Andhra Pradesh, Gujarat, Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan, Haryana, Karnataka, Maharashtra, Manipur, Orissa, Sikkim, Uttar Pradesh, West Bengal, A&N Island, Dadar & Nagar Haveli etc. where the number of male literates is more than 150 as compared to 100 female literates. It is observed that the index of gender equality improved in case of all the states/Union Territories during 1981-91. The index rate of 90 or above for 1991 for the states like Kerala, Chandigarh, A&N Islands, Lakshadweep, Meghalaya and Mizoram indicates that the ratio of female literates to total literates is moving close to the ratio of female population to total population. But the value of this index which ideally should be 100 is still quite low in case of States/UTs of Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Dadar & Nagar Haveli, Uttar Pradesh & Bihar etc. where it ranges between 50-65.

Table 5 gives state-wise comparative position of the illiterates of the age group 7 and above by sex for 1981 and 1991. It is observed that number of illiterates during the decade increased in most of the states. There was marginal decrease in respect of States/UTs of Goa, Himachal Pradesh, Kerala, Manipur and Lakshadweep. There was substantial decrease in case of Kerala while in case of Pondicherry, number of illiterates was almost the same as in 1981. From 1991 data of illiterates it is observed that more than half of the illiterates of the country are concentrated in 4 states of Uttar Pradesh (65.6 million), Bihar (42.8 million), Madhya Pradesh (30.6 million) and Andhra Pradesh (30.2 million) each of them having more than 30 million illiterates. Another 7 states having illiterates between 10 to 30 million each in Maharashtra (25.0 million), West Bengal (24.0 million), Rajasthan (21.5 million), Tamil Nadu (17.3 million), Karnataka (16.6 million), Orissa (13.7 million) and Gujarat (13.6 million) account for another 2/5th of the total illiterates of the country.

3. District Level

Table 6 gives district wise comparative literacy position of population aged 7 and above for 1981 and 1991. Frequency distribution of districts by literacy rates in respect of all persons emerging from table 6 is given below:-

State wise frequency distribution of districts by literacy rates for 1981 and 1991 for all persons is given in annexures 1 & 2 respectively. List of 24 districts having literacy rate below 30% in 1991 is enclosed as annexure 3.

Table 7 gives district wise comparative literacy position of population aged 7 years and above for 1981 and 1991 in respect of males and females. Frequency distribution of districts by literacy rates in respect of females only deduced from table 7 is given below.

State-wise frequency distribution of districts by literacy rates for 1981 and 1991 separately for females only is given in Annexures 4 and 5. List of 70 districts having female literacy below 20% for 1991 is given in Annexure 6. Table 7 also gives index of gender equality for 1981 and 1991. Value of the index of gender equality has improved in respect of all the districts during this decade. It is observed that in some of the cases the value of this index is reaching 100 which indicates that the ratio of female literacy corresponds almost fully to the proportion of female population. But there are still 98 districts where the index of gender equality has not even reached 60 as compared to the national average of 75. These districts are mainly located in the states of Bihar, Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan and Uttar Pradesh.

Table 8 gives district-wise comparative statement of illiterates of the age group 7 and above by sex for 1981-91. While 1981 data is based on the analysis of 1981 census reports for 1991 it has been worked out on the basis of the estimated population for age group 7 and above for different districts except in case of Kerala where all the districts have been covered by Total Literacy Campaigns by applying the State level ratios. This data indicates that the number of illiterates during 1981-91 has increased in most of the districts. Number of female illiterates continues to be more than male illiterates in almost all the districts of the country.

Data in respect of 1991 is not comparable in case of districts newly created during the decade 1981-91 or in case of districts where the geographical boundaries have changed during this period.
