SOCIO ECONOMIC PROFILE : JAJPUR

1. **Location** : Jajpur district is one of the centrally located districts in Odisha. It lies between 85°40' to 86°44' East longitude and between 20°33' to 21°10' North latitude. It is bounded by the Keonjhar district in north, Cuttack district in south, Bhadrak district in the east and Dhenkanal district in the west.
2. **Climate** : The climate condition of the district is generally hot with high humidity during May to June and cold during December to February. The monsoon generally breaks during the month of June, Annual rainfall of the district was 1645.4 m.m. in 2011 which is higher than the normal rainfall (1559.9 m.m).
3. **Area and Population** : The district has an area of 2899 sq.kms and 18.27 lakhs of population as per 2011 census. The district accounts for 1.86 percent of the states territory and shares 4.35 percent of the states population. The density of population of the district is 630 per sq. kms. As against 270 person per sq.km of the state. It has 1778 villages (including 203 un-inhabited villages) covering 10 blocks, 10 Tahasils and 1 Subdivisions. As per 2011 census the schedule caste population is 433387 (23.7%) and schedule tribe population 151432 (8.3%). The literacy percentage of the district covers 80.1 against 72.9 of the state.
4. **Agriculture** : During the year 2010-11, the net area sown was 135 thousand hectares against 4681 thousand hectares of the state. The production of paddy was 2623951 quintals, 123 quintals wheat, 499 quintals maize, 28335 quintals mung, 26208 quintals biri, 4698 quintals kulthi, and 10 quintals till, 152500 quintals groundnuts, 185 quintals mustard, 33063 quintals potatoes 13600 quintals jute and 59696 quintals sugarcane. During 2010-11, the total fertilizers used in Jajpur district is about 16441 MT with a breakage of 8434 MT nitrogenous, 4546 MT phosphatic and 3461 MT pottasic and the consumption of fertilizer per hectare is 117Kg.

5. **Irrigation:** During the year 2010-11, it is reported by Deputy Director Agriculture that the irrigation potential created during Kharif and Rabi are 65040 hectares and 39751 hectares respectively from different sources.
6. **Education :** There were 1387 nos. of primary schools, 924 nos. of middle schools, 434 nos. of Secondary School and 61 nos. of general colleges in the district during 2010-11.
7. **Health :** The medical facilities are provided by different agencies like Govt., Private individuals and voluntary organizations in the district. There were 334 nos. of the Allopathic medical institutions including 260 nos. of Sub centers with 383 beds facilities. Besides 21 nos. of Ayurvedic dispensaries and 25 nos. of Homoeopathic dispensaries in the district during the year 2010-11.
8. **Veterinary Services :** During the year 2010-11, 19 nos. of Hospitals and dispensaries, 96 nos. of livestock Aid centers were functioning in Jajpur district of provide veterinary services to the people.
9. **Industry and Mining :** During the year 2010-11, 280 nos. of small scale industries have established with total capital investment of about Rs. 630.00 lakhs with 931 nos. of Employment generated in Jajpur district.
10. **Power :** Consumption of electricity in Jajpur district during the year covers 992.812 million units and villages so far electrified as on 2010-11 is 1506 which constitutes 95.6% to the total villages of the district.
11. **Tourist :** There are 13 nos. of tourist center such as Ashokjhan, Baruneswarpitha, Chandikhol, Chhatia, Gokarnika, Jajpur, Kuransa, Mahavinayak, Patharajpur, Ratnagiri & Udayagiri, Satyapira, Singhapur and Vyasa Sarovar identified by department of Tourism and Culture, Orissa. During 2011, the numbers of Domestic tourists were 1035866 and foreign tourists were 633 who visited the tourist spots of the district.

12. **Transport & Communication** : During 2010-11, 154 Kms. of National Highways, 2 Kms. of state highways, 134 Kms. Major district roads, 338 kms of other district roads 3187 Kms. of Gram Panchayat roads, 1235 Kms. of village roads and 43 Kms of forest roads are operating in the district. Besides, 131.66 kms. of Railway lines with 10 nos. of railway stations and one no. of passenger halt are continuing in the district.
13. **Banking** : As on 31st March, 2011, there were 111 nos. of schedule commercial banks having 2373 crores rupees deposit and 1172 crores rupees credit in the district.
