

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SOCIO ECONOMIC PROFILE : MAYURBHANJ

1. **Location** : *Mayurbhanj district is one of the Centrally located districts in Odisha. It lies between 85°40' to 87°11' East longitude and between 21°16' to 22°34' North latitude. It is bounded by the Jharkhand state in north, Balasore district in south, West Bengal State in the east and Keonjhar district in the west.*
2. **Climate** : *The climate condition of the district is generally hot with high humidity during April to May and cold during November to December. The monsoon generally breaks during the month of June, Annual rainfall of the district was 1674.4 m.m in 2011, which is higher than the normal rainfall (1600.6 m.m).*
3. **Area and Population** : *The district has an area of 10418 sq.kms and 25.20 lakhs of population as per 2011 census. The district accounts for 6.69 percent of the states territory and shares 6.00 percent of the states population. The density of population of the district is 242 per sq. kms. as against 270 person per sq.km of the state. It has 3950 villages (including 202 un-inhabited villages) covering 26 blocks, 26 Tahasils and 4 Subdivisions. As per 2011 census the schedule caste population is 184682 (7.30%) and schedule tribe population 1479576 (58.70%) . The literacy percentage of the district covers 63.20 against 72.90 of the state.*
4. **Agriculture** : *During the year 2010-11, the net area sown was 292 thousand hectares against 4681 thousand hectares of the state. The production of paddy was 3960990 quintals, 8263 quintals wheat, 31191 quintals maize, 7204 quintals mung, 4171 quintals biri, 4139 quintals Horsegram, and 1401quintals til, 21678 quintals groundnuts, 1074 quintals mustard, and 5166 quintals potatoes and 2580 quintals sugarcane. During 2010-11, the total*

fertilizers used in Mayurbhanj district is about 20.52 thousand MT with a breakage of 10.47 MT thousand nitrogenous, 7.18 thousand MT phosphatic and 2.87 thousand MT pottasic and the consumption of fertilizer per hectare is 43 Kg.

5. **Irrigation** : During the year 2010-11, it is reported by Deputy Director Agriculture that the irrigation potential created during Kharif and Rabi are 116166 hectares and 48859 hectares respectively through all sources including major/medium irrigation projects namely Baladiha, Bankabal, Deokunda, Deo (P), Kala, Katra, Khadakhai, Nesa, Subarnarekhal (P), Sunei (P) and Sunei Extn. Irrigation projects in the district.
6. **Education**: There were 2962 nos. of primary schools, 1181 nos. of middle schools, 542 nos. of Secondary Schools and 91 nos. of general colleges in the district during 2010-11. Besides, there are 4 nos. of engineering schools and 5 nos. of engineering colleges in the district during year 2010-11 to impart technical education.
7. **Health**: - The medical facilities are provided by different agencies like Govt., Private individuals and voluntary organizations in the district. There were 118 nos. of the Allopathic medical institutions with 909 beds facilities 44 nos. of Homoeopathic dispensaries and 44 nos. of Ayurvedic dispensaries in the district during the year 2010-11.
8. **Veterinary Services** : During the year 2010-11, 42 nos. of Hospitals and dispensaries, 166 nos. of livestock Aid centers were functioning in Mayurbhanj district of provide veterinary services to the people.

9. **Industry and Mining** : During the year 2010-11, 262 nos. of small scale industries have established with total capital investment of about Rs. 2367.00 lakhs with 1040 nos. of Employment generated in Mayurbhanj district.
10. **Power** : Consumption of electricity in Mayurbhanj district during the year covers 218.064 million units and villages so far electrified as on 2010-11 is 2625 which constitutes 70.00 % to the total villages of the district.
11. **Tourist** : There are 18 nos. of tourist center such as Samilipal, Khiching, Haripur, Jashipur, Kuliana, Baripada, Kuchai, Devkund, Bangiriposhi, Jamsola, Bhimkunda, Bisoi, Manatri, Rairangapur, Samibrukhyia and Suleiput, Deuli & Rasgovindpur identified by department of Tourism and Culture, Odisha. During 2011, the numbers of Domestic tourists were 1081490 and foreign tourists were 231 who visited the tourists spots of the district.
12. **Transport & Communication** : During 2010-11, 193 Kms. of National Highways, 282 Kms. of state highways, 200 Kms. Major district roads, 449 kms of other district roads 1660 Kms of PS roads, 7970 Kms. of Gram Panchayat roads and 959 Kms of forest roads are operating in the district. Besides, 112.10 kms. of Railway lines with 14 nos. of railway stations and passenger halts are continuing in the district.
13. **Banking** : As on March' 2011, there were 164 nos. of schedule commercial banks having 3118 crores rupees deposit and 1404 crores rupees credit in the district.
