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DISTRICT PROFILE : NAWARANGPUR

1. **Location :** *The district of Nawarangpur came into existence on 2nd October 1992 after being carved out of the erstwhile Koraput district. The district is located in south western corner of Odisha and bounded by Kalahandi and Koraput districts in east and south, and the Raipur and Bastar districts of Chattisgarh in the north and west respectively. Nawarangpur district is located at 81°52' to 82°53'E longitude and 19°09' to 20°05'N latitude and stretches over an area of approximately 5291 sq.km.*
2. **Climate :** *Nabarangpur district falls under East Coast Plains and Hills as per the GOI's Agro-Climatic Zonal Planning. Entire district except Dabugan block, falls under 'Eastern Ghat High lands'. Dabugan block falls under 'Western undulating lands'. The climate is subtropical to temperate. It is characterized by hot and dry summer, cool and humid monsoon and cold and dry winter. The district has different types of soils like red and laterite. The soil PH is neutral to alkaline and its salinity is normal. In 2011 Normal rainfall of the district was 1569.5 mm and the actual rainfall was 1432.8 mm.*
3. **Population :** *As per 2011 census, the total population of Nabarangpur district is 12,20,946 comprising above 11,33,321 rural and 87,625 urban population. The SC and ST population works out to 14.5 % and 55.8 % respectively. The district is predominantly inhabited by tribals like Kandha, Paraja, Soura etc. The density of population per sq.km is 231 with decadal growth of 19.0 for the district, as against population density of 270 person per sq.km and decadal growth of 14.0 for the state. It has 901 census villages (including 25 un-inhabited villages) covering 10 Blocks and 10 Tahasils. The literacy percentage of the district is 46.4 against 72.9 of the state.*
4. **Agriculture :** *Agriculture is the prime occupation/activity in the district. During the year 2010-11, the net area sown was 239 thousand hectares against 4681 thousand hectares of the state. The major crops grown are paddy, ragi, maize, niger, pulses and wheat. Maize is being grown extensively in Umerkote, Raighar and Jharigan Blocks. The production of paddy was 4298904 quintals, 671 quintals of wheat, 2438873 quintals of maize, 18332*

quintals of Ragi, 731 quintals of mung, 39677 quintals of biri, 11221 quintals kulthi, 1720 quintals groundnuts, 18 quintals of mustard, 14147 quintals potatoes and 294969 quintals sugarcane. During 2010-11, the total fertilizer used in this district is about 31472 MT with a breakage of 18802 MT Nitrogenous, 7231 MT Phosphatic and 5440 MT Pottasic and the consumption of fertilizer per hectare is 129 Kg

5. **Irrigation :** *It is reported by the D.A.O, Nawarangapur during 2010-11. The irrigation potential created during Kharif and Rabi are 39273 and 22418 hectares respectively from different sources.*
6. **Education :** *During 2010-11, there were 1147 nos. of primary schools, 521 nos. of middle schools, 108 nos. of secondary schools and 12 nos. of general colleges in the district.*
7. **Health :** *The medical facilities are provided by different agencies like Govt., Private individuals and voluntary organizations in the district. During 2010-11, there were 3 nos Allopathic medical Institutions/Hospital, 10 nos. of CHCs, 37 nos. of PHCs, 289 nos. Sub-centres and one no of private Hospital functioning in the district taking care of by only 38 Doctors with 308 beds facilities. Only 15 nos. of Homoeopathic dispensaries and 22 nos. of Ayurvedic dispensaries in the district.*
8. **Animal Husbandry :** *Animal Husbandry offers a good potential for rural employment in Nabarangpur District, owing to the longer tradition of homestead animal husbandry practiced by the tribal population and abundance of ingredients of feed i.e maize, horse gram and oil cakes. During 2010-11, Milk production is 17.30 thousand MT, production of eggs is 215.60 lakhs nos. and production of meat is 531.71 MT in this district. During 2010-11, 16 nos. of Hospitals and Dispensaries, 65 nos. of Livestock Aid centers and 59 Artificial Insemination Centres were functioning in this district.*
9. **Industry and Mining :** *The industrial scenario of the district is not very satisfactory. The only medium scale industry in the district is Mangalam Timber Products Ltd. In addition to this there are few rice mills, an oil mills, a cotton spinning unit and a pharmaceutical units. There is huge potential for*

Maize processing industries. The growth of small and large industries are impeded because of lack of raw materials, proper transportations, power etc. and also attributable to basic agrarian structure of the economy, infrastructural deficiencies and hilly terrain etc. During the year 2010-11, 66 nos. of small scale industries have established with total capital investment of about Rs.282.00 lakhs with 410 nos. of employment generated in this district. Artisan clusters are there in the field of tribal jewellery, terracotta, wood/bamboo craft, lacquer work, weaving, dhokra casting, paddy craft, etc. No mines are there in this district.

10. **Power :** *consumption of electricity in Nawarangapur district upto 31st March 2011 was 65.341 Million Units & So far only 458 revenue villages are electrified as on February' 2011 which constitutes 52.3% to the total villages of the district.*
11. **Tourist :** *There are 18 nos. of tourist spots in this district, out of which 5 nos. of tourist centre such as Kelia Lord Siva Temple, Nabarangpur, Papdahandi, Podagada and Umerkote has been identified by Department of Tourism and Culture, Odisha. During 2011 the numbers of Domestic tourists were 364145 who visited the tourist spots of the district.*
12. **Transport & Communication :** *The district is not connected with railway routes. The district has 42 kms. of National Highways, 68 kms. of State Highways, 900 kms. of Rural Roads, 116 kms. of Forest Roads, 1142 kms. of Panchayat Samiti Roads and 3682 kms. of Gram Panchayat Roads. All the Block Headquarters are connected with the State Capital by road only. Inter-State buses are plying to Andhra Pradesh (Vizianagram, Visakhapatnam, etc.) and Chattisgarh (Raipur, Jagdalpur, etc.).*
13. **Banking :** *As on March' 2011, there were 38 nos. of Schedules Commercial Banks having 59800 lakhs rupees deposit and 29400 lakhs rupees credit in the district.*
