

SOCIO ECONOMIC PROFILE : NAYAGARH

1. **LOCATION :** *The Nayagarh district is located towards the west of Puri district surrounded by Cuttack district in the North, Phulbani district in the West, Ganjam district in the South and Khurda district in the East. It lies between 19°54' to 20°32' North latitude and between 84° 29' to 85° 27' East longitude. It has an average elevation of 178 meters (583 feet). This town has Rukhi mountain to the South and Balaram mountain in North. These mountain mitigated the effects of the 1999 Odisha Cyclone on Nayagarh. This district is situated in the hilly ranges in the West and its North Eastern part has formed a small well cultivated fertile valleys intersected by small streams. It's in the higher altitude than the sea level and above flood level. The River Mahanadi flows in the Eastern boundary.*
2. **CLIMATE :** *The climate of the district carries a high temperature in Summer and cooler in Winter. The monsoon generally breaks in between the month of June & July. Annual rainfall of the district was 1169.3 M.M. in 2011 which is lower than the normal rainfall i.e. 1354.3 M.M.*
3. **AREA AND POPULATION :** *The district has an area 3890 Sq. Kms and 9.63 Lakhs of population as per 2011 Census. The district accounts for 2.50 percent of the State's territory and shares 2.29 percent of the State population. The density of population in this district is 248 person Per Sq. Kms as against 270 person Per Sq. kms of the State. It consist of 1695 nos. of Villages (Including 164 nos. Un-Inhabited Villages) covering 8 Blocks, 8 Tahasils & 1 Sub-division. As per 2011 Census the Schedule Caste population was 136399 (14.20 %) and Schedule Tribe population was 58691 (6.10 %) . The Literacy percentage of the district covers 80.40 against 72.90 of the State. The decennial growth rate as per 2001-2011 was 11.40% as against 14.00% of the State.*
4. **AGRICULTURE :** *During the Year 2010-11 the net area shown was 103 thousand hectares area against 4681 thousand hectares area of the State. The production of Paddy was 2370988 Qtls., Wheat 19 Qtls, Maize 10206 Qtls , Ragi 1130 Qtls , Mung 52335 Qtls., Biri 12018 Qtls., Kulthi 7217 Qtls., Tli 1536 Qtls.,*

Ground Nut 3005 Qtls., Mustard 463 Qtls., Potato 182 Qtls., Sugarcane 1649794 Qtls. During 2010-11 the total fertilizer used in Nayagarh district is about 7076.10 M.T with a breakage of 5111.25 M.T. Nitrogenous, 1281.12 M.T. Phosphatic, and 683.73 M.T. Potassic. and consumption of fertilizer per hectare is 36(Kg.)

5. **IRRIGATION :** *During the year 2010-11, It is reported by the Deputy Director Agriculture that the irrigation potential created during Kharif & Rabi are 46063 Hectares & 18346 Hectares respectively through major / medium irrigated projects namely Budhabudhiani of Odagoan block, Sunamunhi of Khandapada block & Kunaria of Dasapalla block & different sources in the district.*
6. **EDUCATION :** *There were 752 nos. of Primary Schools, 463 nos. of Middle Schools, 226 nos. of Secondary Schools and 33 nos. of general colleges in the district during the year 2010-11.*
7. **HEALTH :** *The Medical facilities are provided by different Agencies like Govt.& Private individuals in the district. There were 55 nos. of the Allopathic institution with 409 nos. of beds facilities, 16 nos. of Ayurvedic dispensaries and 20 nos. of Homeopathic dispensaries in the district during the year 2010-11.*
8. **ANIMAL HUSBANDRY :** *During the year 2010-11, 16 nos. of Hospitals & dispensaries, 68 nos. of Live-Stock aid Centers were functioning in this district to provide veterinary services to the people. In the year 2010-11, 82185 nos of animal treated & 13973 nos. of animals are artificially inseminated.*
9. **INDUSTRY & MINING :** *During the year 2010-11, 93 nos. of Small Scale Industries have establishment with total capital investment of about Rs. 733.00 Lakhs with 565 nos. of Employment generated in Nayagarh district. Besides various kind of handy-craft work like Dhokra, Brass & Bell metal have been developed by the skilled workers & artisans of the district.*

10. **POWER :** Consumption of electricity in Nayagarh district during the year 2010-11 covers 93.170 million units and 1531 nos. villages so far electrified as on 31.03.11 is which constitutes 100 % to the total villages of the district.

11. **TOURIST :** There are 8 nos. of tourist centres such as Nilamadhava (Kantilo), Baramul, Tarabalo Raghunath Jew (Odagaon), Ladubaba (Sarankul), Nayagarh, Jamupatna, Maa Maninaga Devi (Ranapur), Deer Park (Near Kuanria Dam, Dasapalla), Kuturi, Udayapur, Gokulananda Ashram, Sidhamula & Panchupallipragana

12. **TRANSPORT AND COMMUNICATION :** During the year 2010-11, 99 Kms. of National Highways, 531 Kms. of rural road, 370 kms of Forest road, 163 kms. of Major District road and 240 kms. Other district road are operating in the district.

13. **BANKING :** As on March 2011 there were 65 nos. of schedule commercial banks having 89700 Lakhs rupees deposit and 47400 Lakhs rupees credit in the district.


