SOCIO ECONOMIC PROFILE : SUBARNAPUR

1. **Location** : Subarnapur district is one of the Western located districts in Odisha. It lies between 83°27' to 84°15'E longitude and between 20°30' to 20°10'N latitude. It is bounded by the Sambalpur district in north, Boudh district in south, Anugul district in the east and Bolangir district in the west.
2. **Climate** : The climate condition of the district is generally hot with high humidity during March to May and cold during December to February. The monsoon generally breaks during the month of June. Annual rainfall of the district was 1009.8 M.M in 2011 which is less than the normal rainfall (1418.5 M.M).
3. **Area and Population** : The district has an area of 2337 sq.kms and 6.10 lakhs of population as per 2011 census. The district accounts for 1.50 percent of the states territory and shares 1.45 percent of the states population. The density of population of the district is 261 per sq. kms. as against 270 person per sq.km of the state. It has 959 villages (including 130 un-inhabited villages) covering 6 blocks 6 Tahasils and 2 Subdivisions. As per 2011 census the schedule caste population is 1,56,219 (25.60%) and schedule tribe population 57,192 (9.40%). The literacy percentage o the district covers 74.4 against 72.9 of the state.
4. **Agriculture** : During the year 2010-11, the net area sown was 106 thousand hectares against 4681 thousand hectares of the state. The production of paddy was 4673607 quintals, 673 quintals wheat, 278 quintals maize, 8519 quintals mung, 332 quintals biri, 4120 quintals kulthi, and 331 quintals til, 6129 quintals groundnuts, 229 quintals mustard, 797 quintals potatoes and 31503 quintals sugarcane. During 2010-11, the total fertilizers used in Subarnapur district is about 10.52 thousand MT with a breakage of 5.92 MT thousand nitrogenous, 2.86 thousand MT phosphatic and 1.74 thousand MT pottasic and the consumption of fertilizer per hectare is 54 Kg.

5. **Irrigation** : During the year 2010-11, it is reported by District Agriculture Officer that the irrigation potential created during Kharif and Rabi are 71405 hectares and 50672 hectares respectively through different sources including major / medium irrigation projects namely Hariharjore, Hirakud (P), Lower Suktel (P), Ong. Stage Exten. (P) and Ong. Stage- I (P) irrigation projects in the district.
6. **Education** : There were 880 nos. of primary schools, 341 nos. of middle schools, 108 nos of Secondary Schools and 33 nos. of general colleges in the district during 2010-11.
7. **Health** : The medical facilities are provided by different agencies like Govt., Private individuals and voluntary organizations in the district. There were 116 nos. of the Govt. Allopathic medical institutions with 376 beds facilities. 5 nos. of AYUSH (Homoeopathic), 14 nos. of AYUSH (Ayurvedic) medical institution in the district during the year 2010-11.
8. **Veterinary Services** : During the year 2010-11, 10 nos. of Hospitals and dispensaries, 37 nos. of livestock Aid centers and 37 nos. of Artificial insemination were functioning in Subarnapur district of provide veterinary services to the people.
9. **Industry and Mining** : During the year 2010-11, 57 nos. of small scale industries have established with total capital investment of about Rs. 381.00 lakhs with 241 nos. of Employment generated in Subarnapur district.
10. **Power** : Consumption of electricity in Subarnapur district during the year 2010-11 covers 54.768 million units and villages so far electrified as on 2010-11 is 421 which constitutes 50.8% to the total villages of the district.

11. **Tourist** : There are 6 nos. of important tourist center such as Charada, Binioka (Papakhaya ghat), Sonepur, Khaliapalli, and Chandalipat (Pajadunguri) & Katasmali identified by department of Tourism and Culture, Odisha. During 2011 the numbers of Domestic tourists were 470910 and foreign tourists were 40 who visited the tourists spots of the district.

12. **Transport & Communication** : During 2010-11, 46 Kms. of National Highways, 40 Kms. of state highways, 68 Kms. Major district roads, 50 kms of other district roads, 438 Kms of village roads 2616 Kms, of Gram Panchayat roads ,629 km of Panchayat Samiti Roads and 40 Kms of forest roads are operating in the district. Besides, 12.13 kms. of Railway lines with 1 no. of railway station are continuing in the district.

13. **Banking** : As on March 2011, there were 34 nos. of schedule commercial banks having 533 crores rupees deposit and 256 crores rupees credit in the district.
