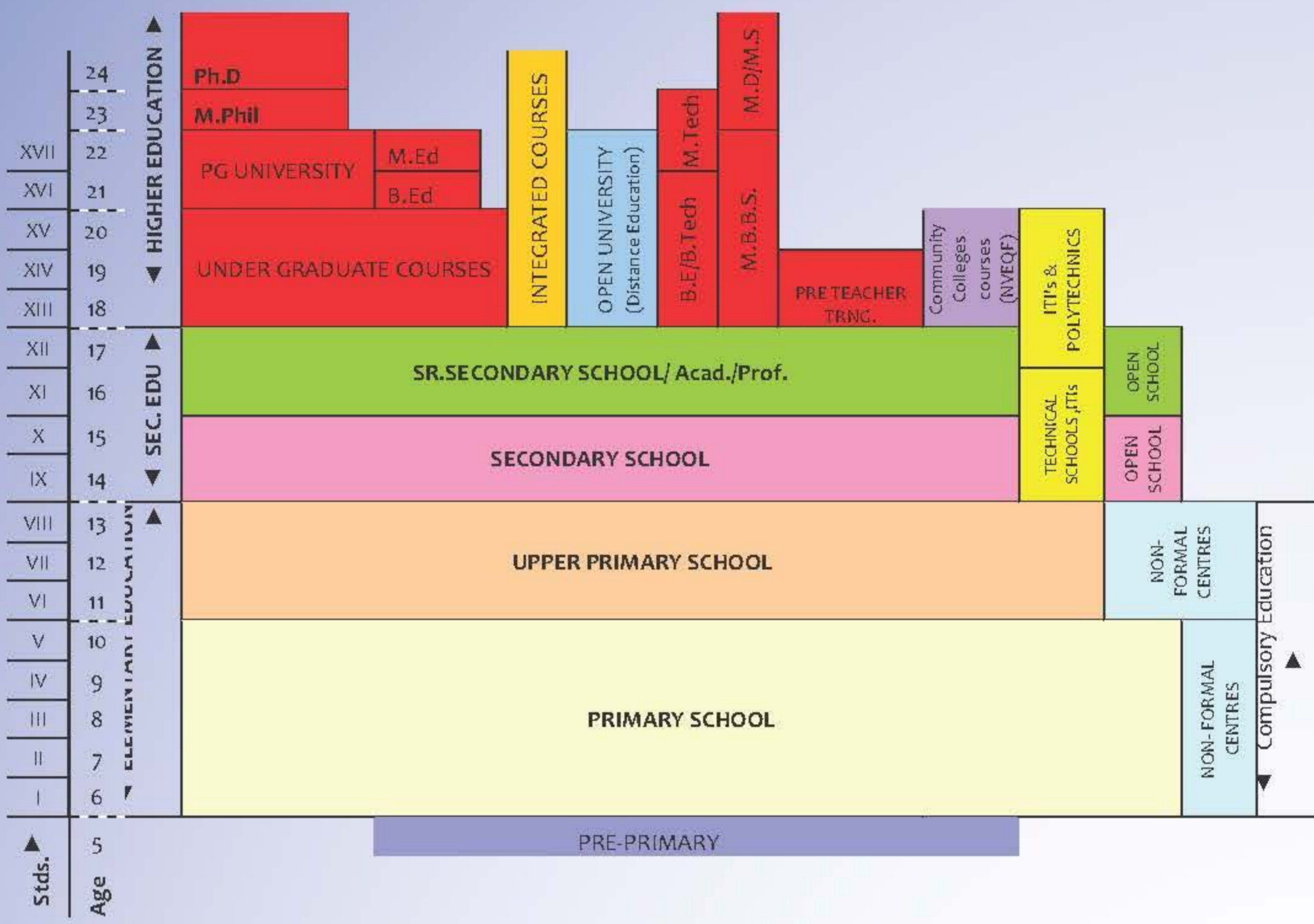

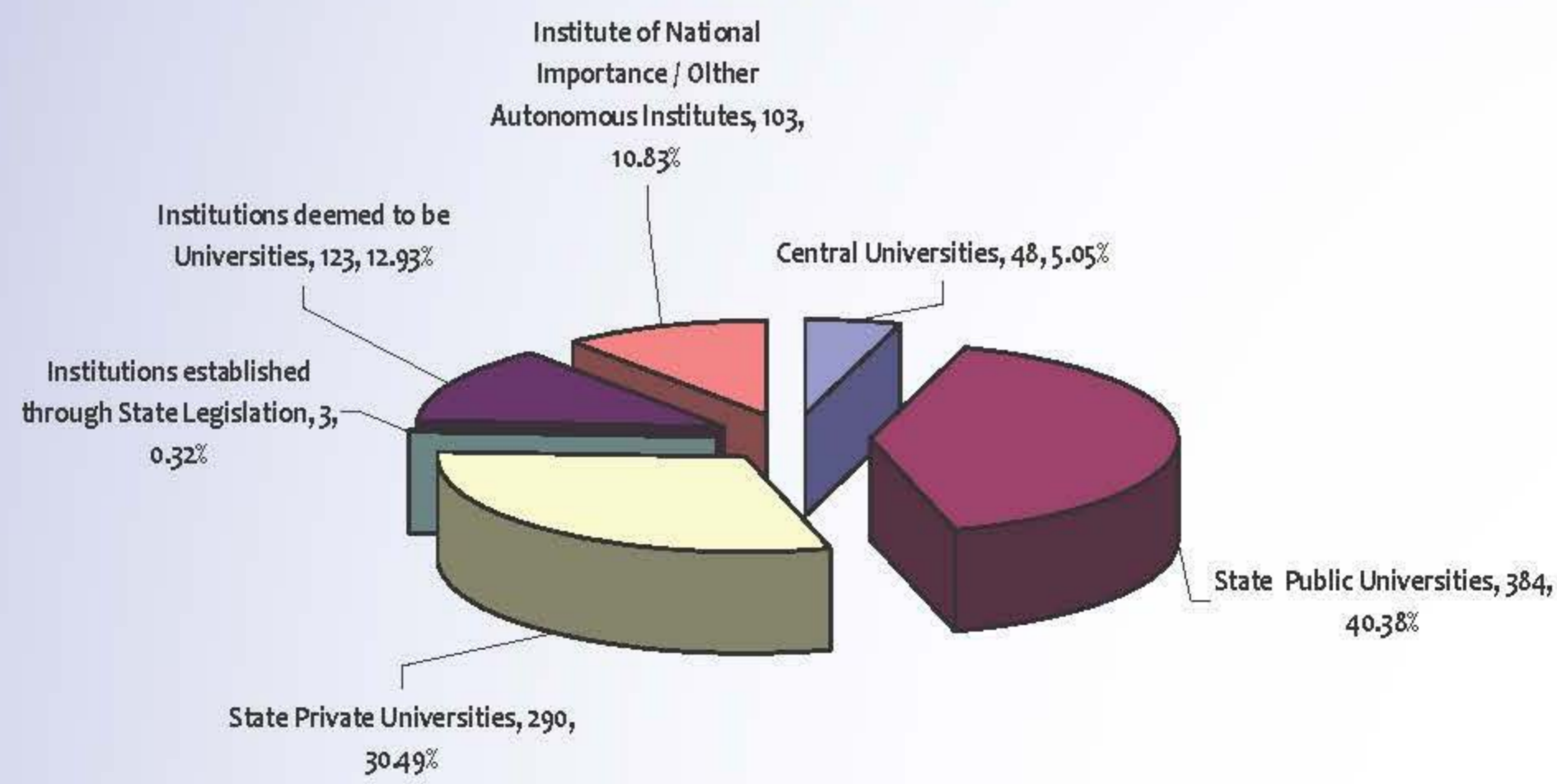

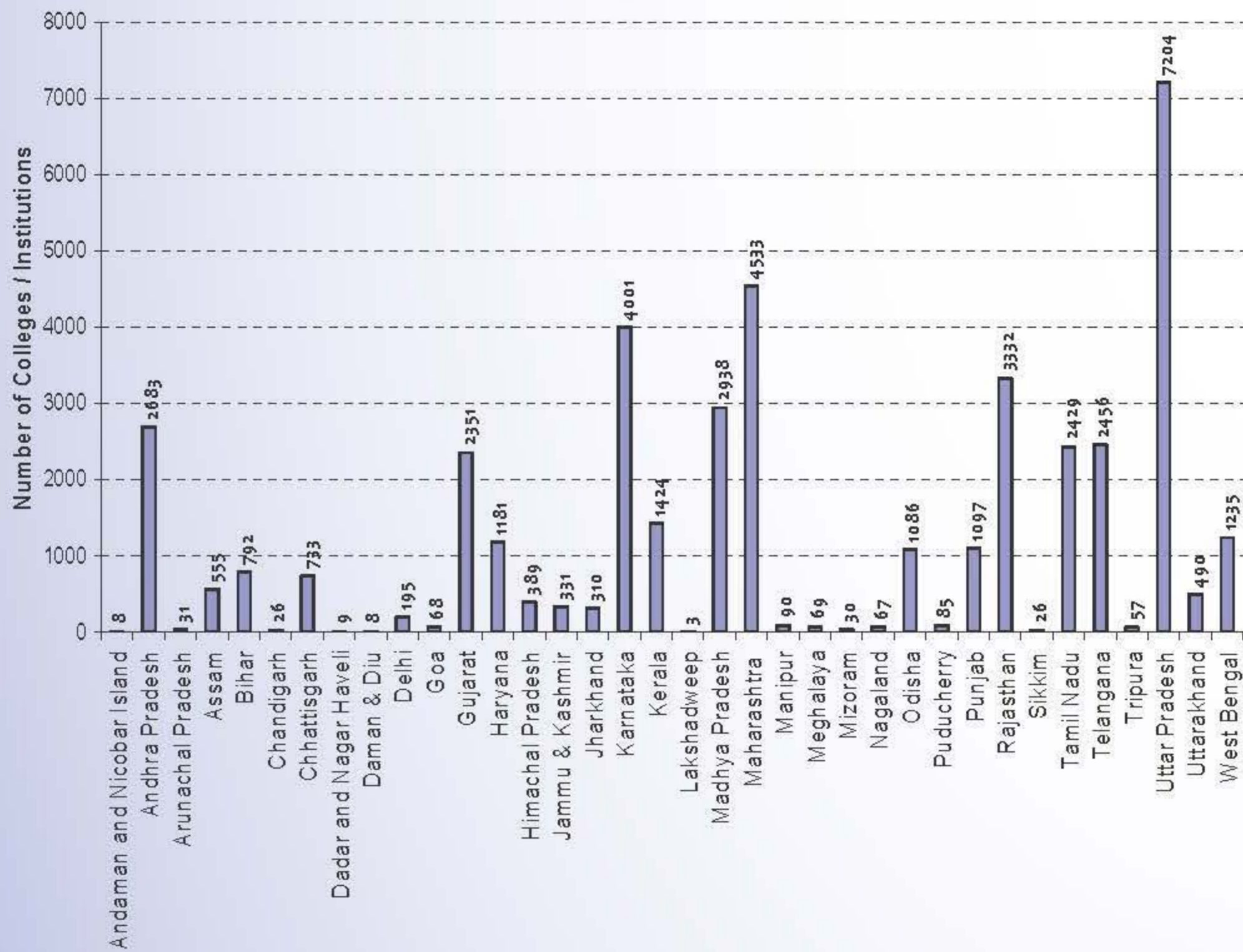


Type-wise Distribution of Universities / University Level Institutions January, 2018

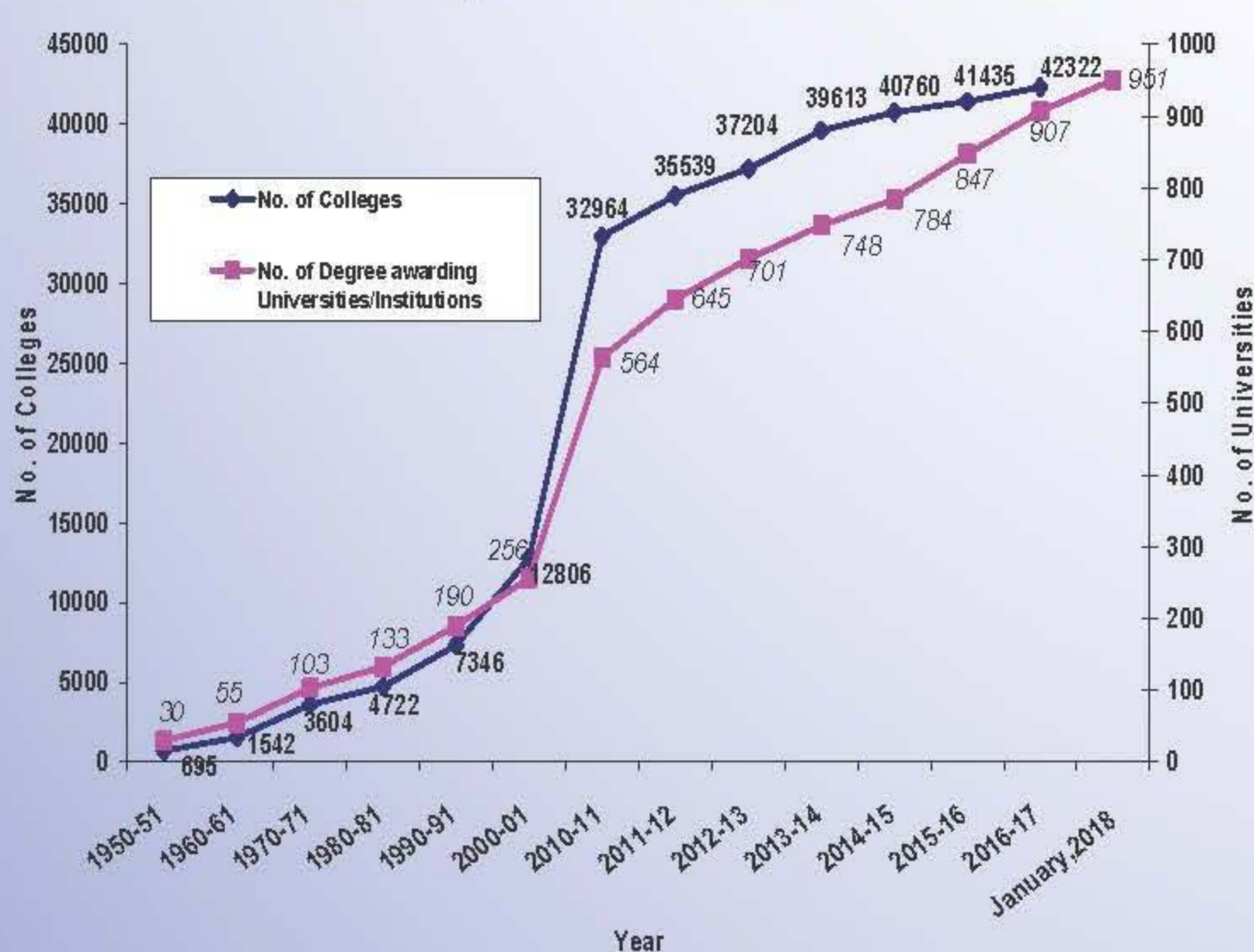

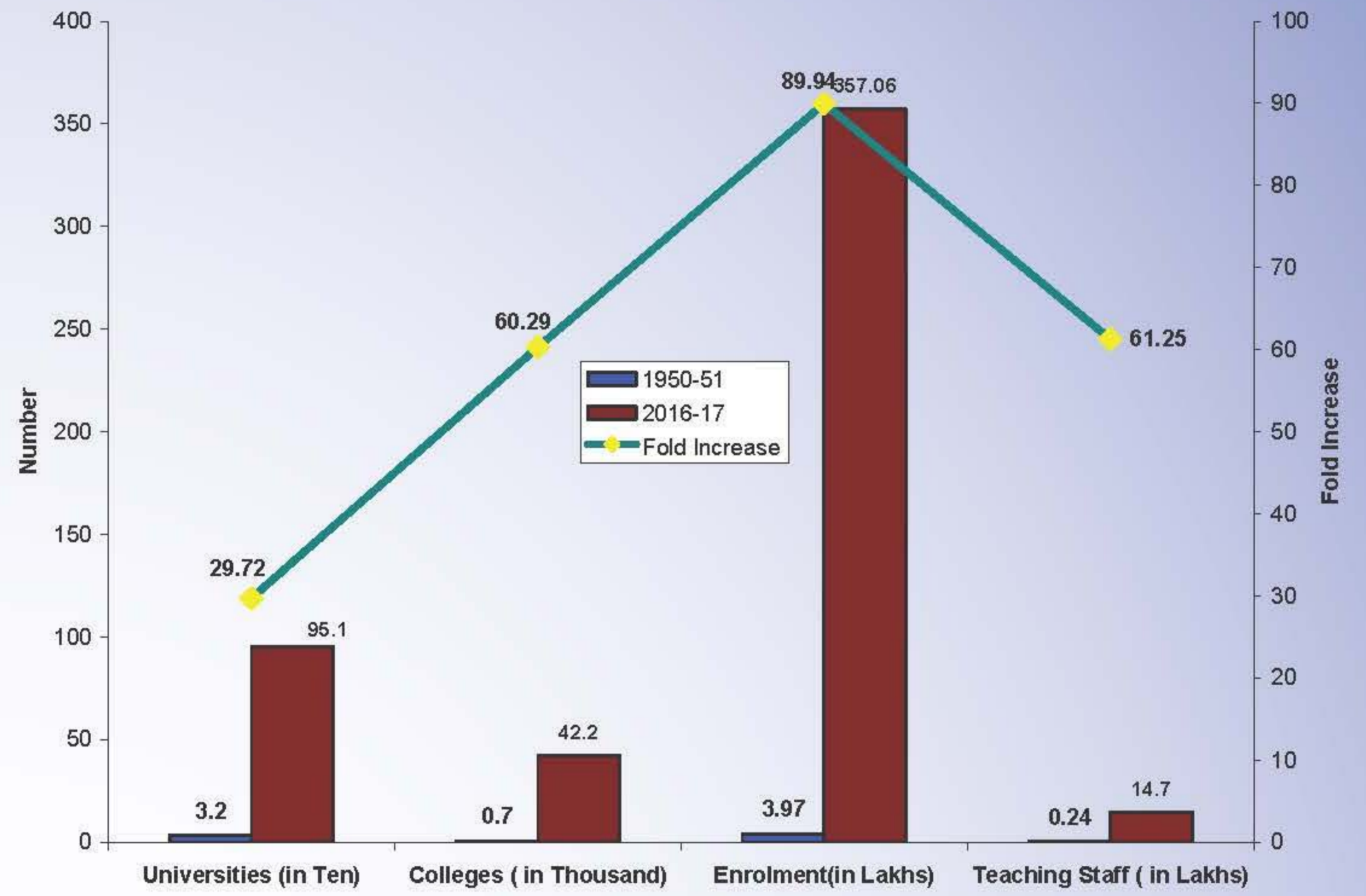


Growth of Higher Education Institutions

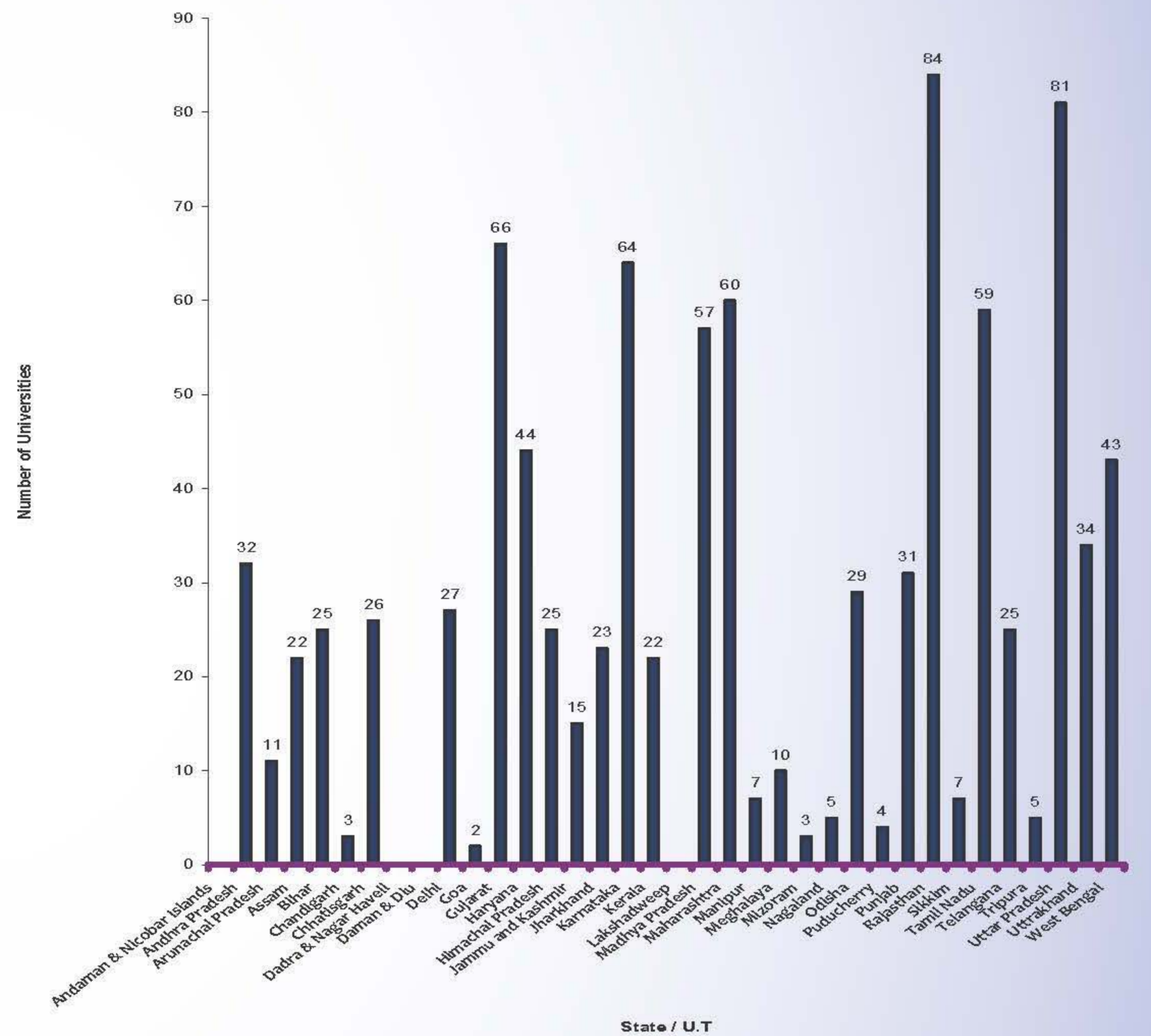

State-wise Number of Universities / University Level Institutions (January, 2018)

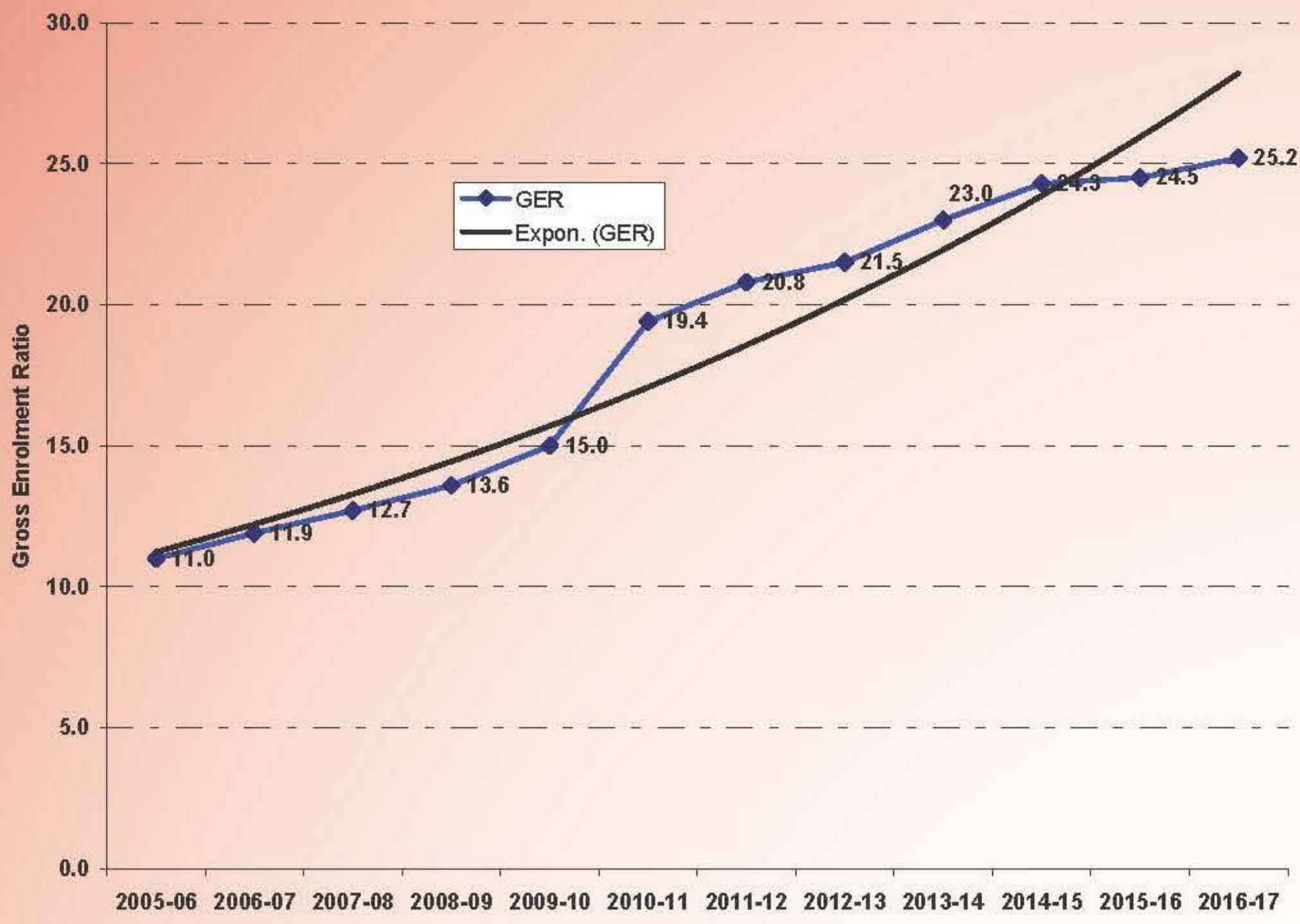


Growth of Students Enrolment ('000') in Higher Education (Regular Courses)



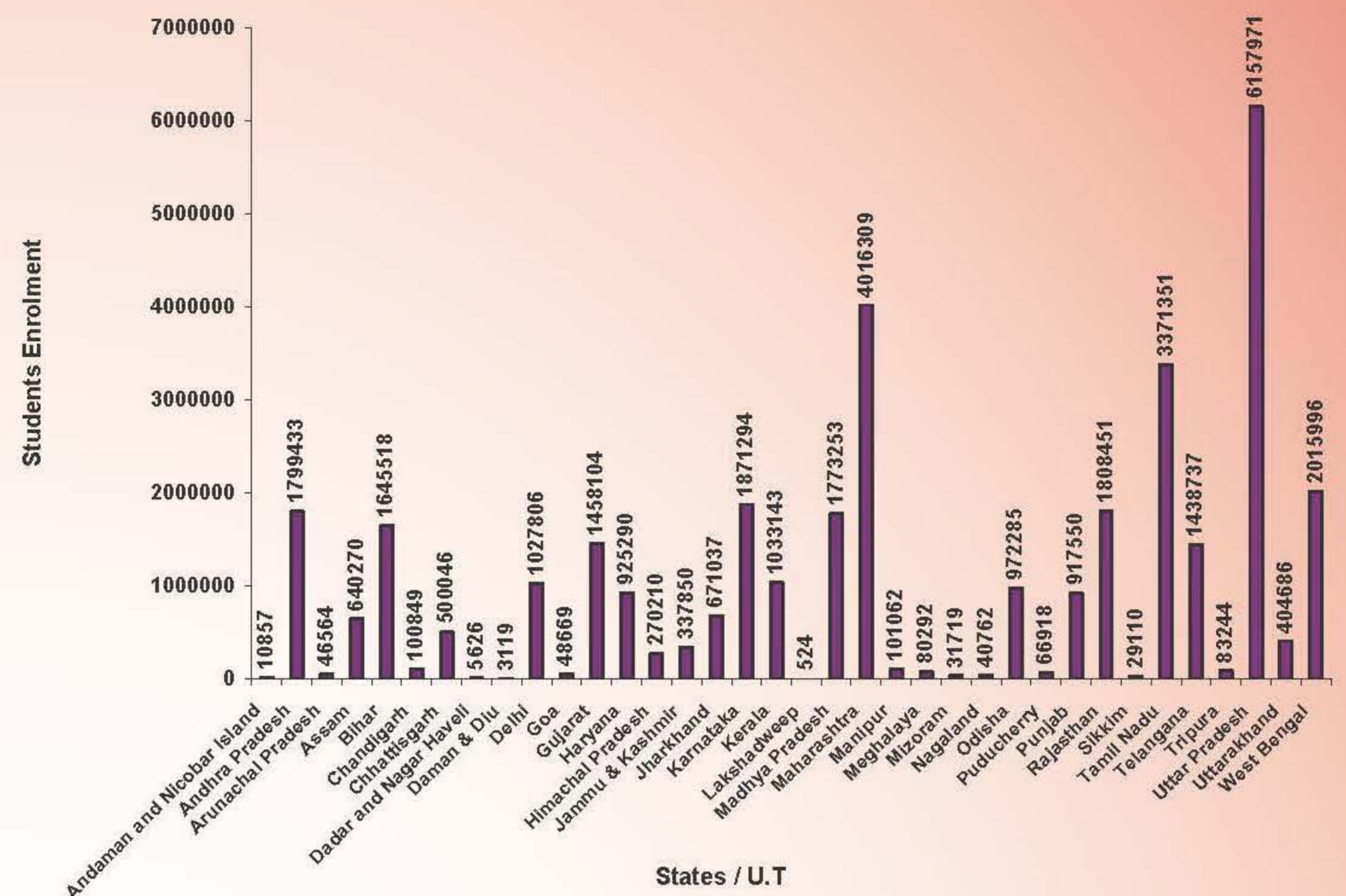

Growth : Gross Enrolment Ratio (GER)



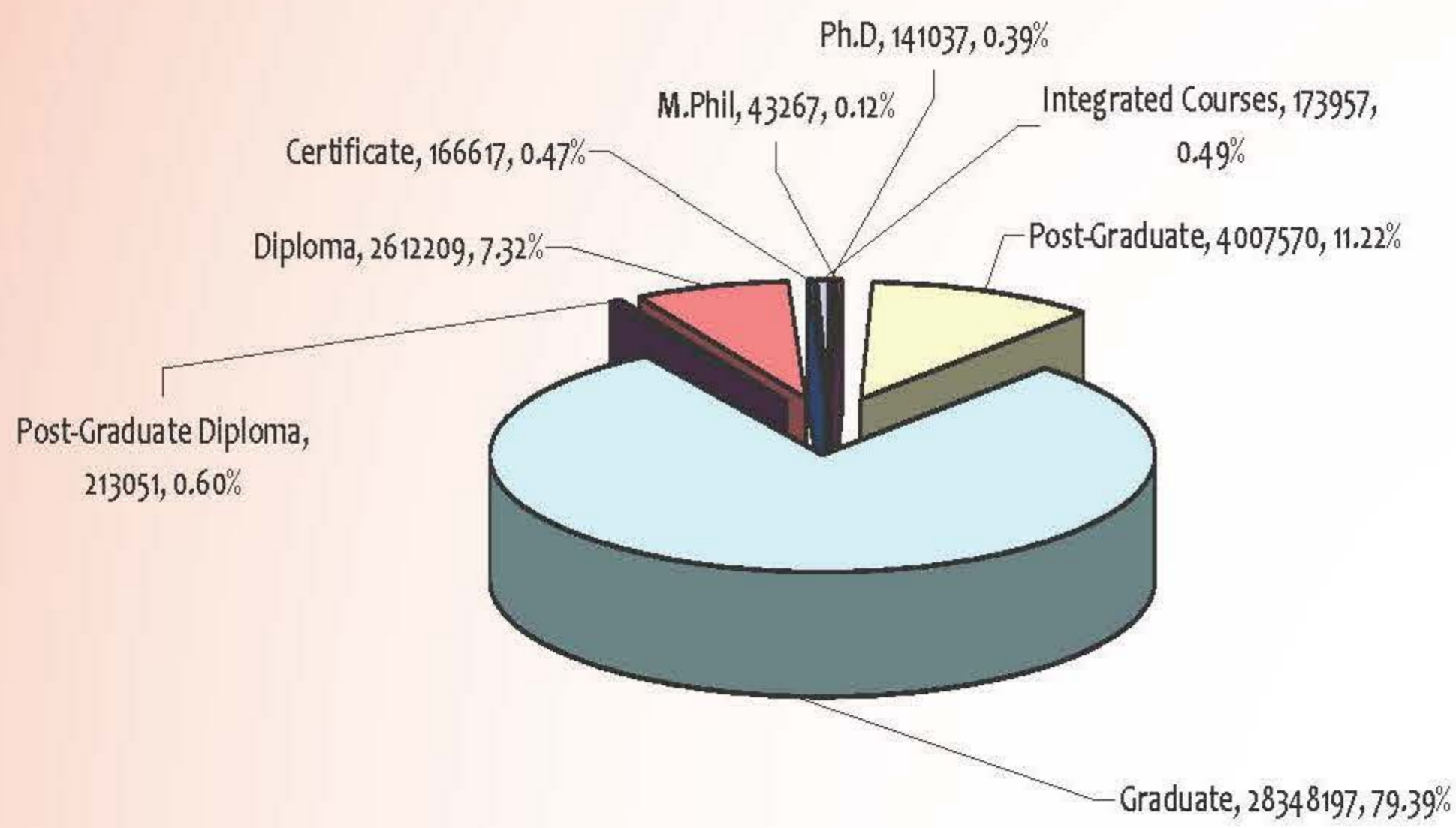

Statewise Students Enrolment : 2016-17

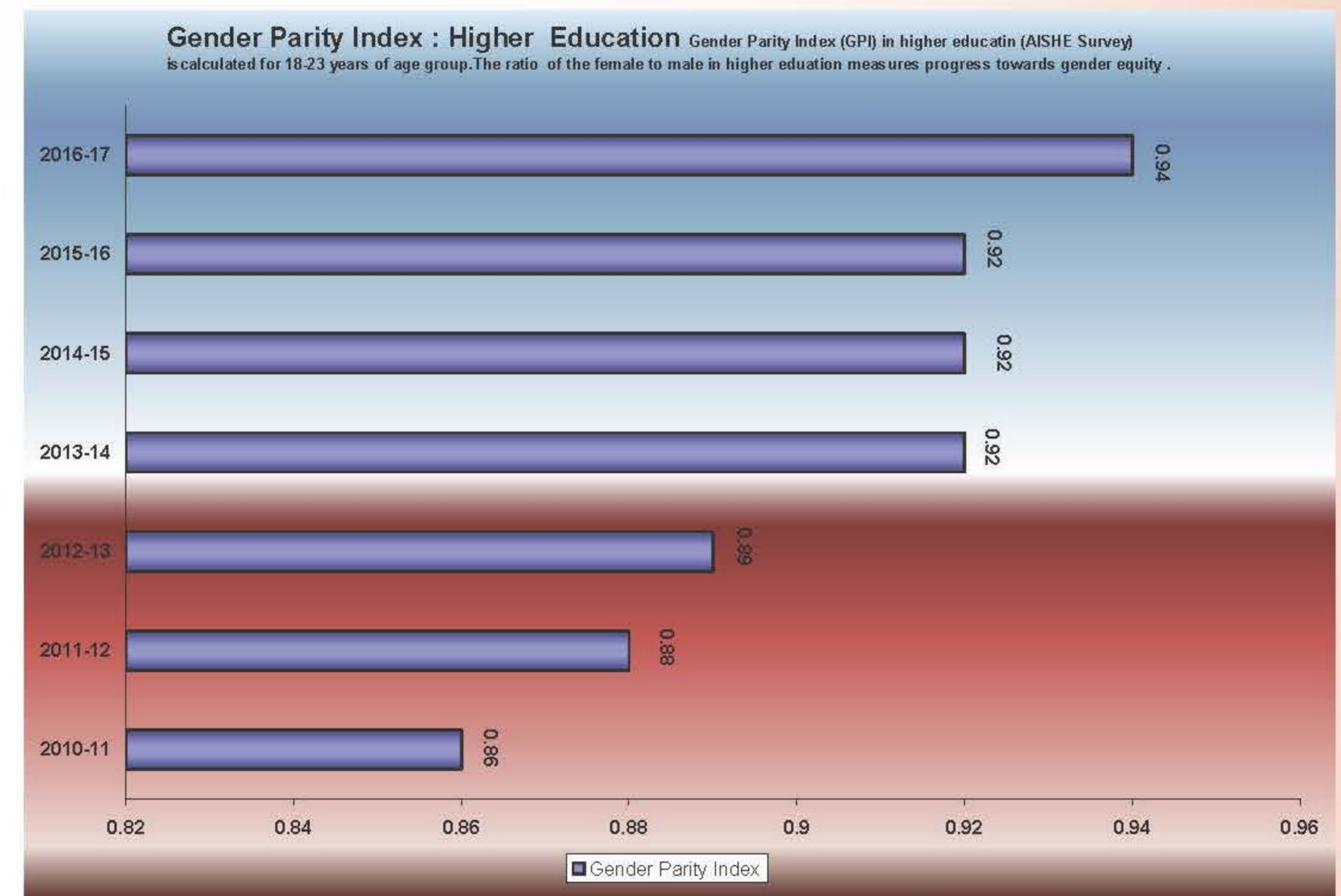

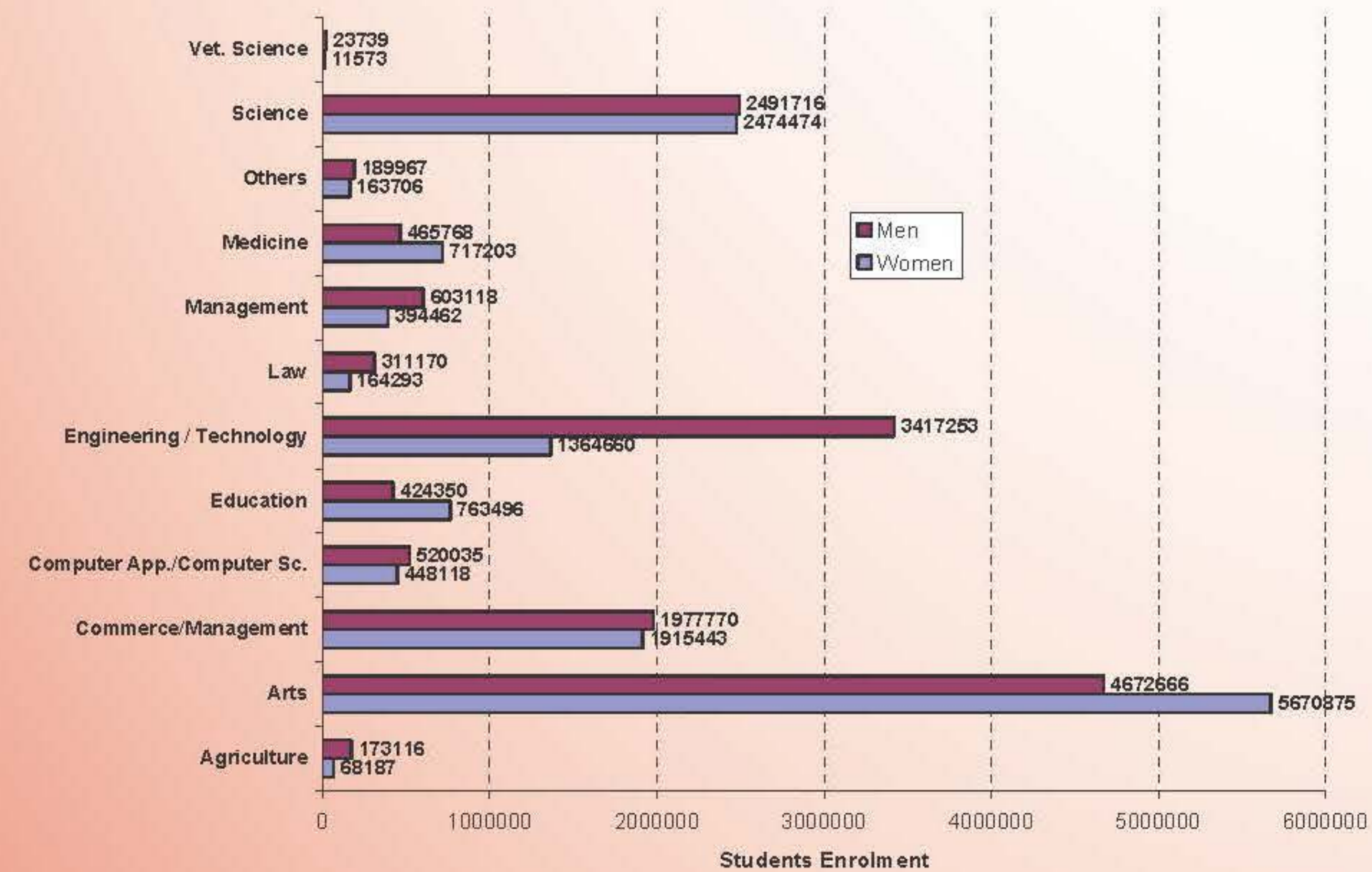

Growth of Teaching Staff in Universities and Colleges



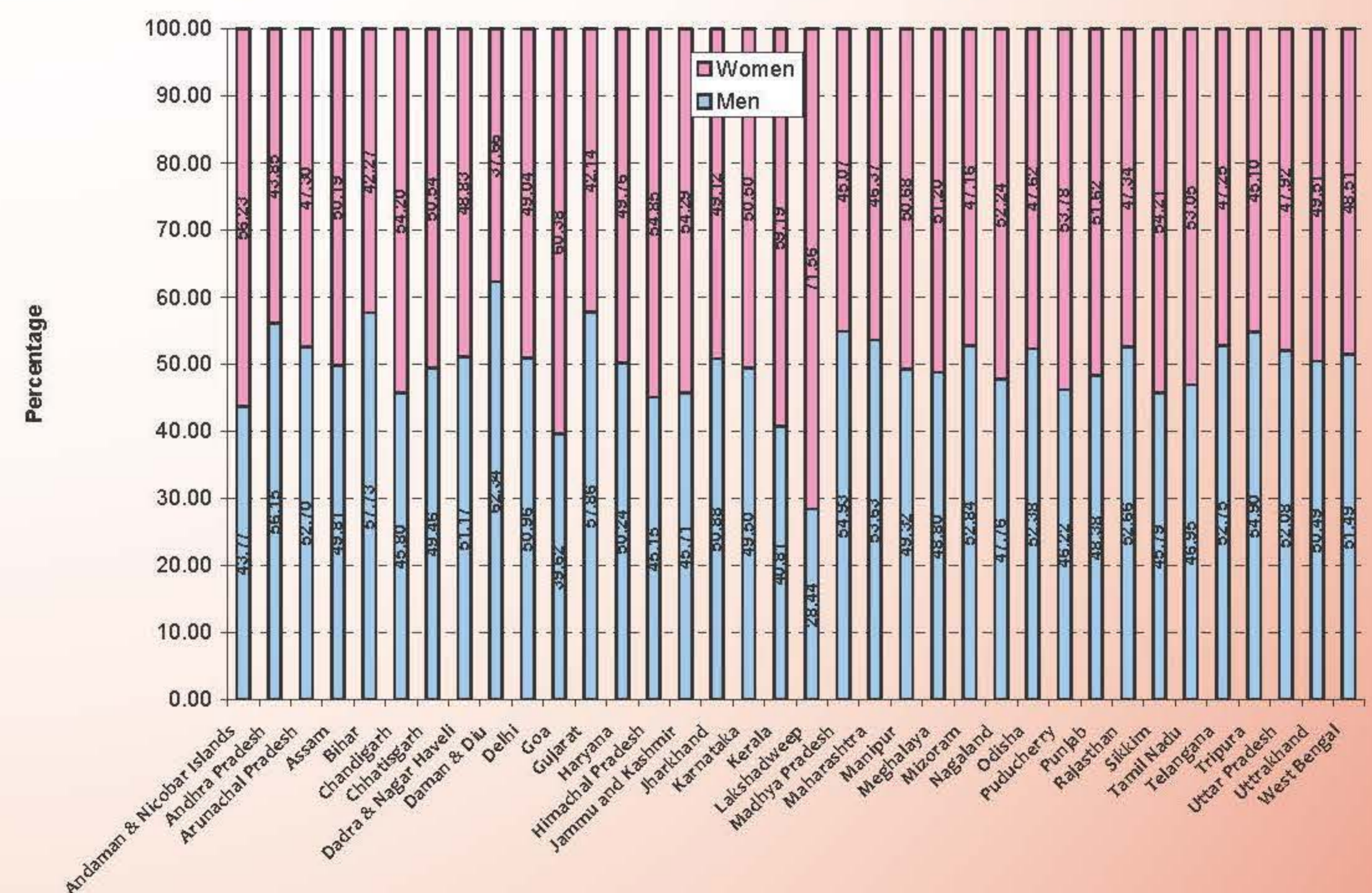

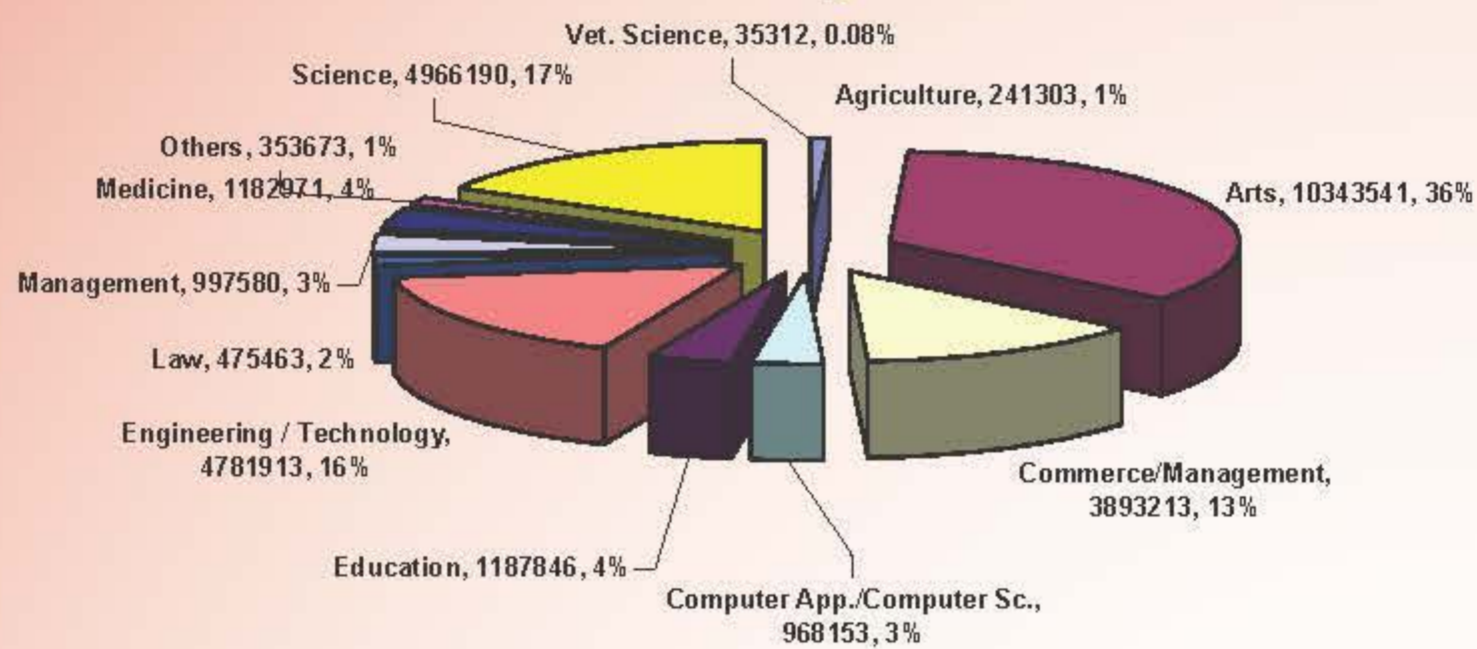
State-wise : Gender-wise distribution of Students Enrolment (Regular Courses) : Universities and Colleges : 2016-17

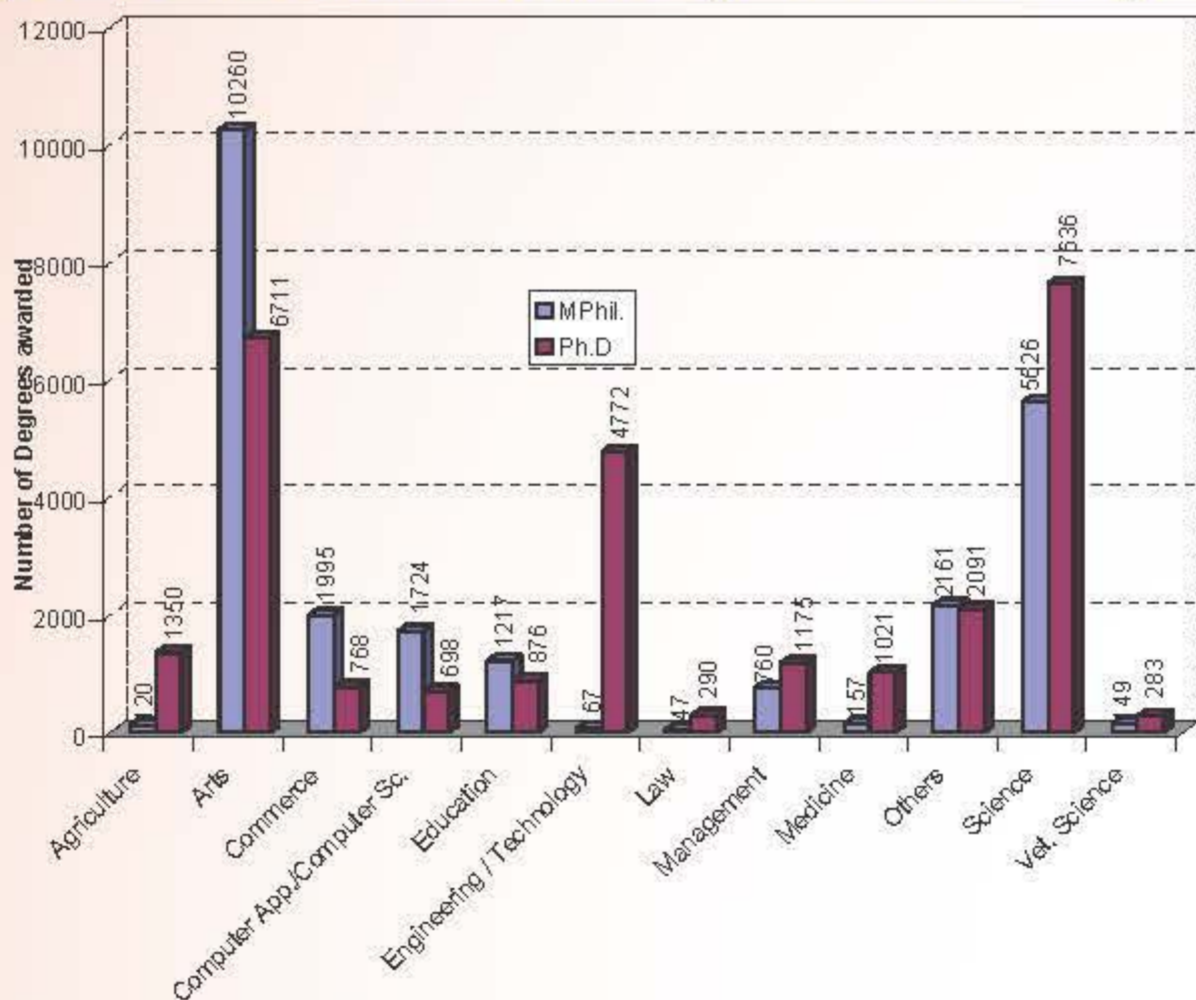

Faculty-wise Students Enrolment* (Regular Courses) : Universities and Colleges : 2016-17



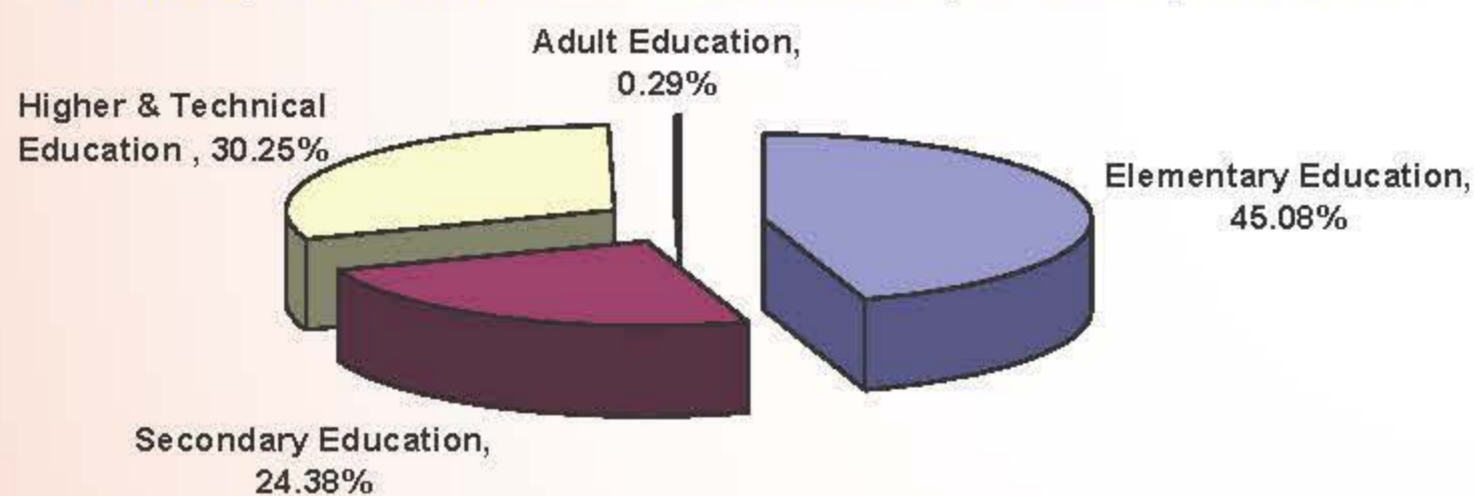

Public Expenditure on Education-Sector-wise (Provisional) : 2014-15



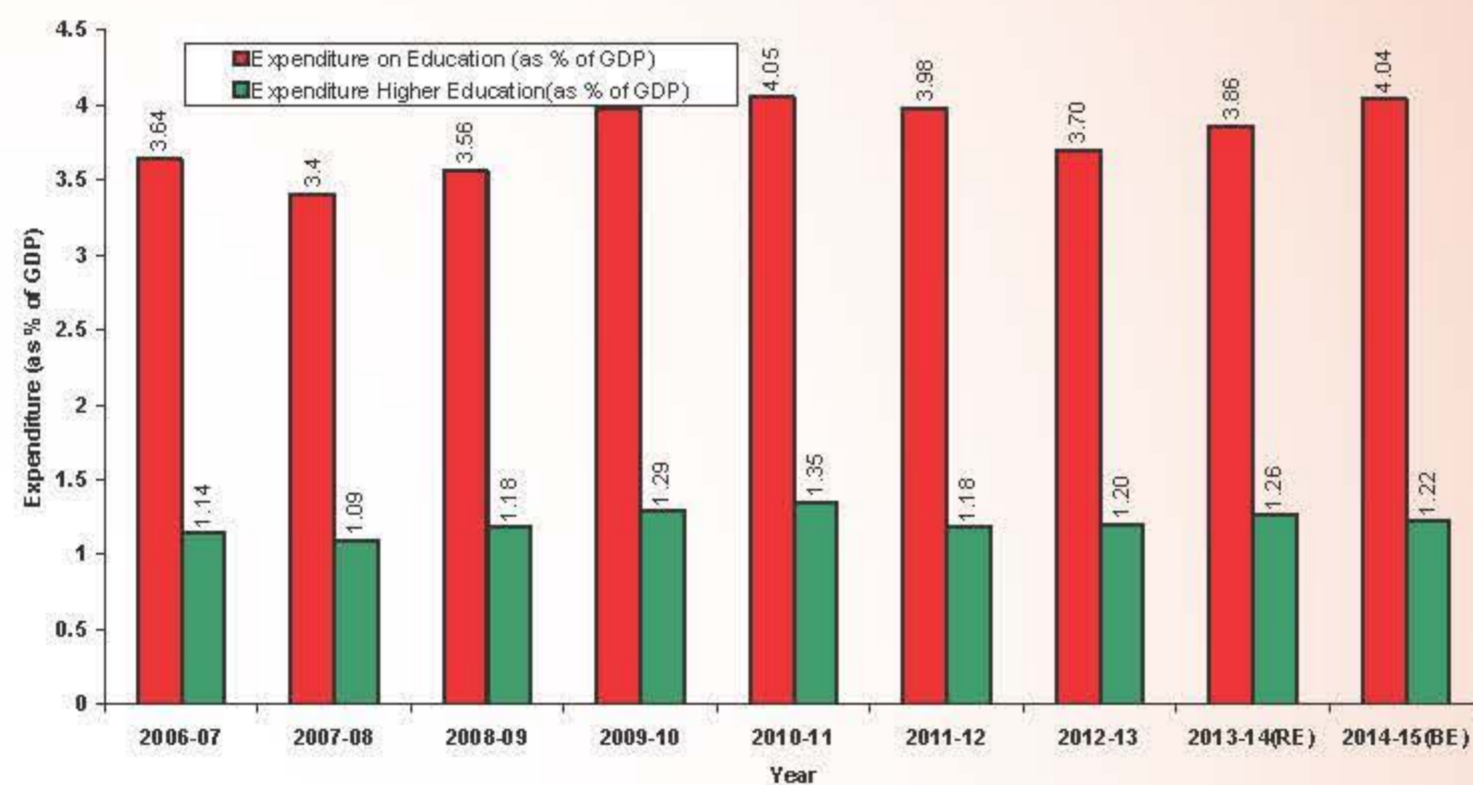

Educational Expenditure as % of Public Expenditure & GDP



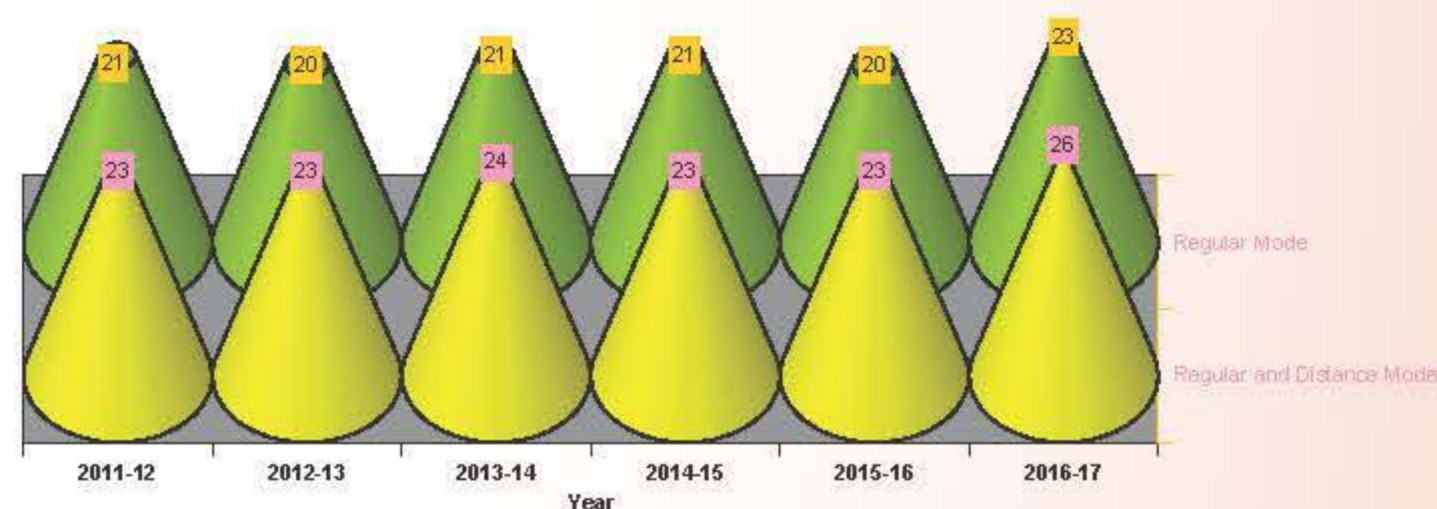

ICT Initiatives

- Public Finance Management-System (PFMS), a web based application for payment, accounting and reconciliation of Government transactions and integrates various existing standalone of systems has been implemented in UGC. It is new mandatory that the grantee institutions should have registered on PFMS.
- e-PG Pathashala : The national Mission on Education through Informatics & Communication Technology (NME-ICT is envisaged as a centrally sponsored Scheme to leverage the potential of ICT, in teaching and learning process for the benefit of all the learners in Higher Education Institutions at any time any where mode.
- UGC is the National co-ordinator for Central Sector Scheme for reproposing of e-content developed under e-PG Pathashala Programme into MOOCs (Massive Online Open Courses) whose objective is seamless integration of conventional education with Massive open line courses through SWAYAM Platform (Study web of Active Learning by Young and Aspiring minds), 72 Non Technology Post-Graduate MOOCs are hosted on SWAYAM Platform for 1st Phase of MOOCs.
- The UGC (Credit Frame work for online learning courses through SWAYAM) Regulations published in Gazette of India on 20.07.2016.
- UGC implemented e-Governance project the realize the objective of inter-operability of various e-governance applications. e-office has been implemented in the UGC to create a paperless environment with regard to receipt and movement of files, maintaining of pay slips, e-leave, personel information system knowledge management system of employees.
- UGC approved the Triperitite Agreement-Signed by UGC with NSDL Data base management-Limited (NDML) and CDSL Venture Limited (CVL) for establishment of National Academic Depository (NAD).
- The UGC-approved List of Journals includes Journals covered in i) Web of Science; ii) Scopus; iii) Indian Citation Index (ICI); iv) Journals recommended by the Standing Committee on Notification on Journal and Language Committee; and v) Journal recommended by Universities; A note on scope, coverage and methodology used for compiling UGC-approved List of Journals is available at <https://www.ugc.ac.in/journalist/methodology.pdf>.

Distance Education

- All the Degree/Diploma/Certificates including technical education degree/diploma awarded through open and Distance learning mode of education by the Universities established by an Act of parliament or state legislature, Institutions Deemed to be Universities under Section 3 of UGC Act, 1956 and Institutions of National Importance declared under an Act of Parliament stand automatically recognized for the purpose of employment to posts and services under the Central Government, provided they have been approved by the UGC — Vide MHRD Gazette Notification No. 6-1/2013 dated 10.06.2015 (Published in Gazette dt. 25.07.2015).
