CHAPTER - I

POPULATION

District Udhampur extending over an area of 2,380 Sq. Kms comprises of 357 Villages including 4 un-inhabited villages. It has a population of 557689 as per 2011 census. The district has recorded population growth rate of 20.78% during the decade 2001-2011. Population is mostly rural and only 20% of it reside in towns. Working force accounts for 44% of population. The main occupation engaging the working force are cultivation, construction, livestock, hunting, trade and commerce engaging 100% of the working force. Details of population by Tehsils, Blocks rural and urban areas, religious groups, age groups, distribution of working force, etc. are given in this chapter.

CHAPTER - II

VITAL STATISTICS

Births and deaths occurring are recorded through chowkidars in rural areas and sanitary supervisors in the urban areas. The police stations and the local body offices functions as registration office. The field staff and officers of the Directorate of Health and Directorate of Economics and Statistics conduct supervisions of field work. Data are technically tabulated in the central tabulation unit of the Directorate of Economics and Statistics. However, as in the rest of the country, registration is far from complete and would take some time to improve.
