Population Trend in Mizoram (1901-2011)

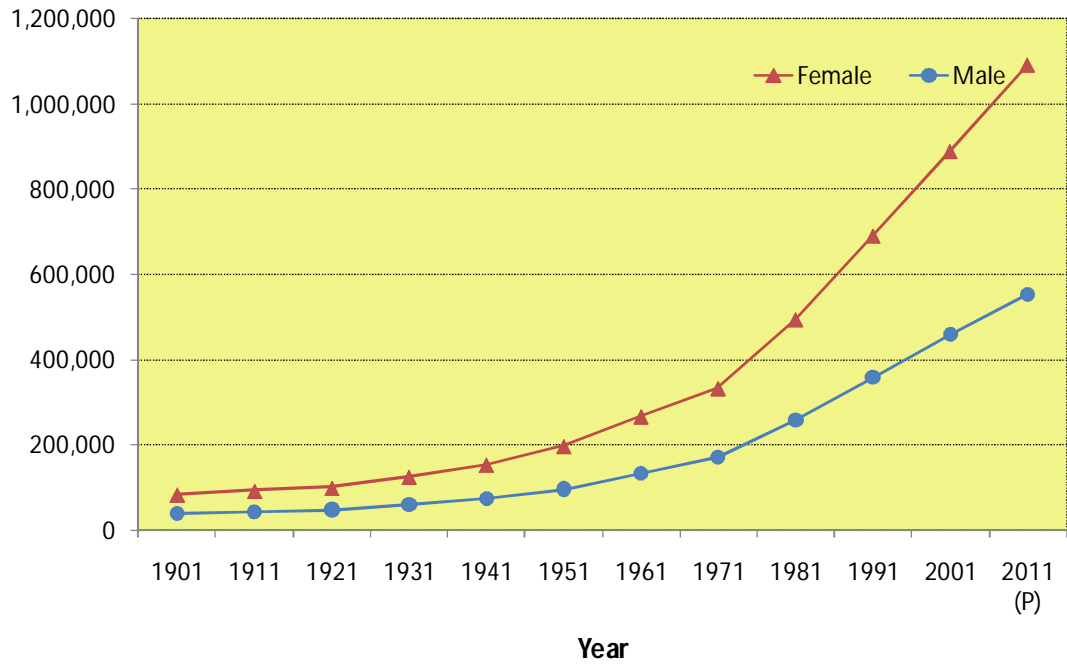

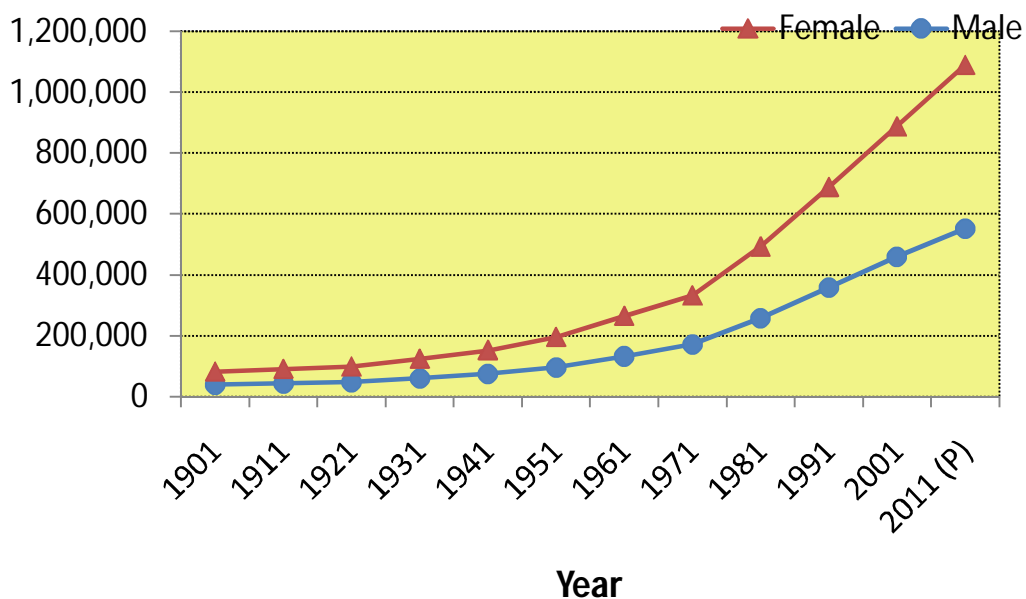

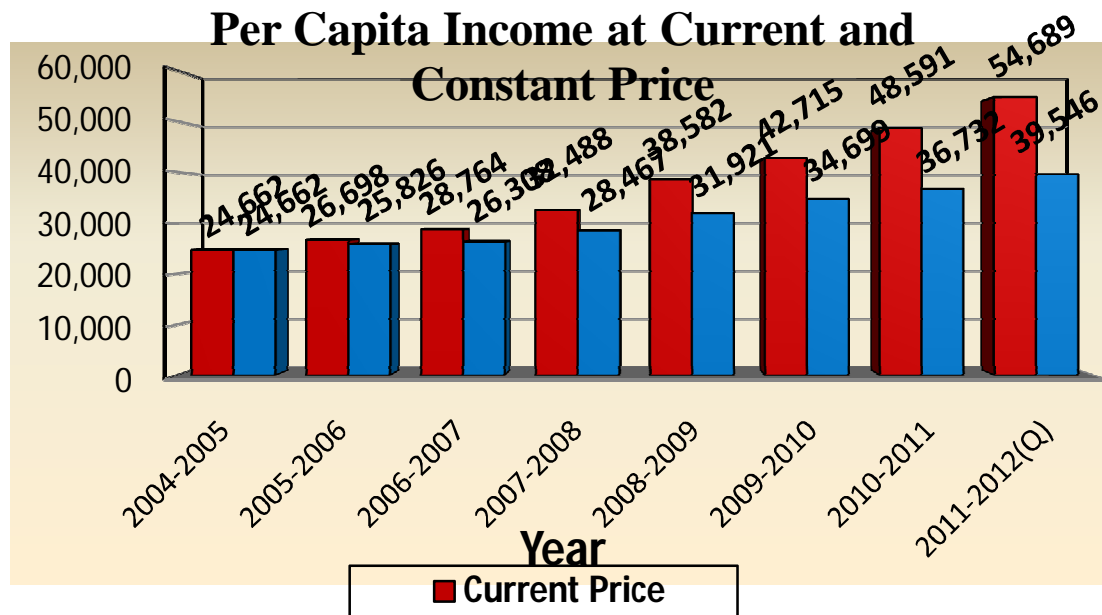

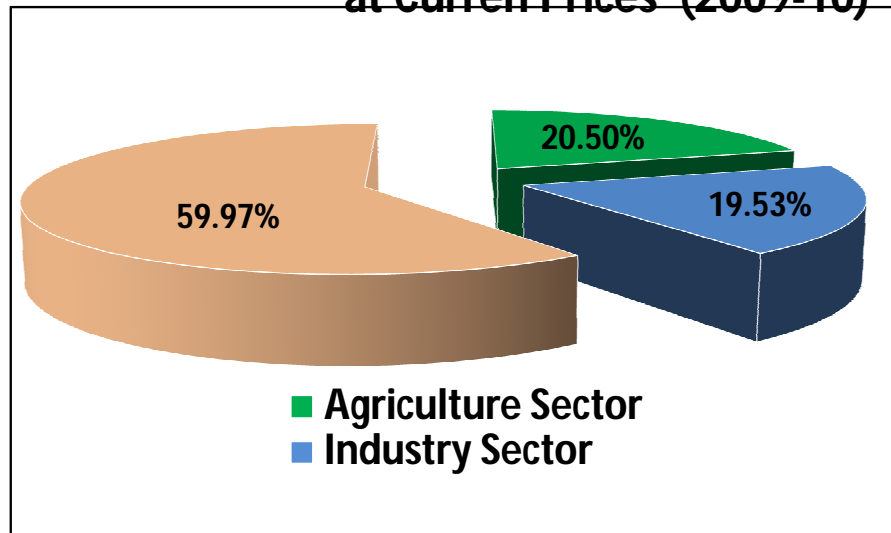

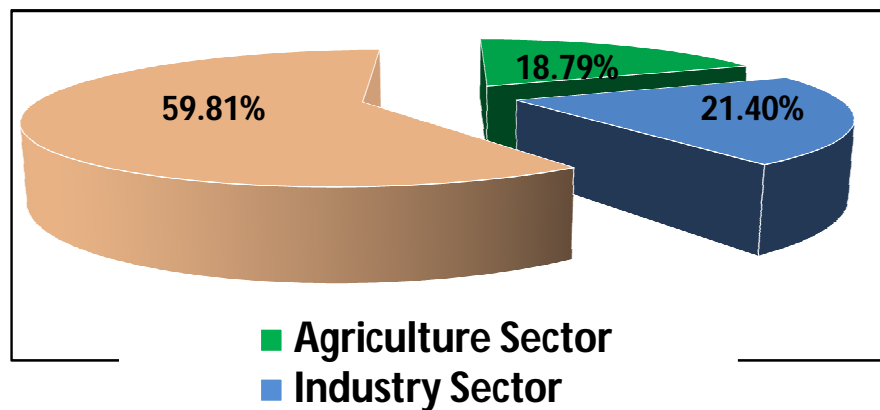
