

SOCIO ECONOMIC PROFILE: JHARSUGUDA

1. **Location:** *Jharsuguda district is one of the northern located districts in Odisha. It lies between 83° 27' to 84° 23' east longitude and between 21° 31' to 22° 3' north latitude. It is bounded by the Sundergarh district in north, Bargarh district in south, Sambalpur district in the east and Chhattisgarh State in the west.*
2. **Area and Population:** *The district has an area of 2114 sq. kms which shares 1.36 % of landmass of the State and occupies 29th rank in term of area. The total district population was 5.80 lakhs which shares 1.38% of the state population as per 2011 census. The rural and urban population is 3.49 lakh and 2.31 lakh respectively. The level of urbanization stands 39.89% of the total district population as against the 3.30% in the State. The density of population of the district is 274 per sq. kms as against 270 person per sq.km of the state. It has 351 villages (including 4 un-inhabited villages) covering 5 blocks 5 Tahasils and 1 Subdivisions. As per 2011 census the schedule caste population is 104620 (18.10%) and schedule tribe population 176758 (30.50%). The literacy percentage of the district covers 78.9 against 72.9 of the state.*
3. **Climate:** *The climate condition of the district is generally hot with high humidity during March to June and cold during October to February. The monsoon generally breaks during the month of June. Actual annual rainfall of the district was 1875.0 m.m in 2020 which is higher than the normal rainfall (1362.8 m.m).*
4. **Agriculture:** *During the year 2019-20, the net area sown was 52 thousand hectares against 4102 thousand hectares of the state. The production of paddy was 2645190 quintals, 497 quintals maize, 184 quintals mung, 192 quintals kulthi, 333 quintals till, 916 quintals groundnuts, 376 quintals mustard, and 5400 quintals potatoes. During 2019-20, the total fertilizers used in Jharsuguda district is about 6026 MT with a breakage of 3726 MT nitrogenous, 1738 MT phosphatic and 562 MT pottasic and the consumption of fertilizer per hectare is 71.80 Kg...*
5. **Irrigation:** *By the end of June 2017-18, it is reported by District Agriculture Officer,, Jharsuguda that the total irrigation potential created during Kharif and Rabi are 20898 hectares and 3502 hectares respectively through major / medium irrigation projects in the district.*
6. **Co-operation:** *The district has 32 agricultural Co-operative societies with a membership of 50907. The loan advances is to the tune of Rs. 18941.60 lakh and loan outstanding stood at Rs. 15407.33 lakhs as of 2019-20. The agricultural credit Co-operative societies are more or less evenly distributed across the 5 Blocks of the district. Besides there are 1 non-*

agricultural credit Co-operative Societies and 1 marketing Co-operative Societies in the district.

7. **Forest:** District of Jharsuguda has abundant of Forest area that contributed 21.64 % of the total geographical area of the district.
8. **Veterinary Services** During 2019-20, Milk production is 21.23 thousand MT, production of eggs is 58.60 lakhs nos. and production of meat is 4.47 thousand MT in this district. During 2019-20, 9 nos. of Hospitals and Dispensaries, 32 nos. of Livestock Aid centers and 32 Artificial Insemination Centers, 13 nos. of VAS & Additional VAS were functioning in the district.
9. **Industry and Mining:** During the year 2019-20, 1709 nos. of small scale industries have been established with total capital investment of about Rs. 10410.11 lakhs with 11880 nos. of Employment generated in Jharsuguda district. Besides various kinds of handicraft works have been developed by the skilled workers and artisans of the district.
10. **Power:** During the year 2019-20, villages so far electrified as on 31.03.2020 is 347 which constitutes 100.00 % to the total villages of the district.
11. **Transport & Communication:** During 2019-20, 105.60 Kms. of National Highways, 26.75 Kms. of state highways, 4.00 Kms. Major district roads, 1007.37 Kms of other district roads, 1024.64 kms of Inter-village road, 1025.57 kms of Intra-village road, 290.30 Kms of village roads and 23.00 Kms of forest roads are operating in the district.
12. **Education:** There were 358 nos. of primary schools, 306 nos. of Up-primary schools, 142 nos. of secondary schools and 40 nos. of general colleges in the district during 2019-20. Besides, there are 1 nos. of polytechnic school in the district during year 2019-20 to impart technical education. The pupil teacher ratio in the primary, upper primary, Secondary School stood at 12, 16 and 26 respectively.
13. **Health:** The medical facilities are provided by different agencies like Govt., Private individuals and voluntary organizations in the district. There were 1 no of DHH, 6 nos. CHC, 19 nos. PHC of the Allopathic medical institutions including 66 nos. of Sub-Centre in the district during the year 2019-20. There were 8 nos. of Homoeopathic dispensaries and 9 nos. of Ayurvedic dispensaries in the district during the year 2019-20.
14. **Banking:** As on December, 2020, there were 102 nos. of All Banks having 5604.98 crore rupees deposit and 3593.88 crore rupees credit in the district. The district has banking

branches network of 102 out of which 3 (2.94%) were in the urban area, 58 (56.86%) in semi-urban area and 41 (40.20%) in rural areas. The total number of ATMs in the district stood at 134

15. **Collection of Land Revenue:** The total collection of land revenue in the district for 2019-20 was Rs. 2681.99 lakh. The total collection of Tax in the district during 2019-20 was Rs. 45400.98 Lakh.
16. **Poverty Alleviation Programme:** In the district total no. of Job card issued was 0.72 Lakh and total no. of person days generated was 13.79 lakh during the year 2019-20.
17. **Disaster Scenario:** In terms of Disaster activity the district is graded as slight zone for wind & cyclone, protected area for flood, very high risk zone for drought, moderate risk and less damage zone for earthquake & major accident prone area for accident.
