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## **SOCIO ECONOMIC PROFILE: KANDHAMAL**

1. **Location:** Kandhamal district is one of the coastal districts of Odisha. It lies between 83° 30' to 84° 35' East longitude and between 19° 34' to 20° 34' North latitude. It is bounded by the Boudh district in north, Gajapati district in south, Nayagarh district in the east and Kalahandi district in the west.
2. **Area and Population:** The district has an area of 8021 sq.kms and 7.33 lakhs of population as per 2011 census. The district accounts for 5.15 percent of the state territory and shares 1.75 percent of the state population. The density of population of the district is 91 per sq. kms as against 270 person per sq.km of the state. It has 2587 villages (including 170 un-inhabited villages) covering 12 blocks 12 Tahasils and 2 Subdivisions. As per 2011 census the schedule caste population is 115544 (15.8%) and schedule tribe population 392820 (53.6%). The literacy percentage of the district covers 64.1 against 72.9 of the state.
3. **Climate:** The climate condition of the district is generally hot with high humidity during April and May and cold during December and January. The monsoon generally breaks during the month of June. Annual rainfall of the district was 1637.9 m.m in 2020 which is higher than the normal rainfall (1427.9 m.m).
4. **Agriculture:** During the year 2019-20, the net area sown was 45 thousand hectares against 4102 thousand hectares of the state. The production of paddy was 1099817 quintals, 8121 quintals maize, 88 quintals mung, 774 quintals biri, 1908 quintals kulthi, 475 quintals groundnuts, 1500 quintals mustard and 18557 quintals potato. During 2019-20, the total fertilizers used in Kandhamal district is about 5902 MT with a breakage of 1939 MT nitrogenous, 2853 MT phosphatic and 1110 MT potasic and the consumption of fertilizer per hectare is 35.64 Kg.
5. **Irrigation:** During the year 2019-20, it is reported by Chief District Agriculture Officer, Kandhamal that the irrigation potential created during Kharif and Rabi are 32223 hectares and 12774 hectares respectively from different sources.
6. **Co-operation:** The district has 24 agricultural Co-operative societies with a membership of 151980, the loan advances is to the tune of Rs. 11014.99 lakh as of 2019-20. The agricultural credit Co-operative societies are more or less evenly distributed across 12 Blocks of the district.
7. **Forest:** District of Kandhamal has abundant of Forest area that contributed 71.19% of the total geographical area of the district.

8. **Veterinary Services:** During 2019-20, Milk production is 24.73 thousand MT, production of eggs is 146.74 lakhs nos. and production of meat is 3.63 thousand MT in this district. During 2019-20, 23 nos. of Hospitals and Dispensaries, 81 nos. of Livestock Aid centres, 99 Artificial Insemination Centres and 37 nos. of VAS and Additional VAS were functioning in the district.
9. **Industry and Mining:** During the year 2019-20, 804 nos. of Micro Small and Medium Enterprises have been established with total capital investment of about Rs. 3181.62 lakhs with 2233 nos. of Employment generated in Kandhamal district. Besides various kinds of handicraft works like Handloom have been developed by the skilled workers and artisans of the district.
10. **Power:** During the year 2019-20, villages so far electrified as on 31.03.2020 is 2417 which constitutes 100.00 % to the total villages of the district.
11. **Transport & Communication:** During 2019-20, 203.00 Kms. of National Highways, 231.87 Kms. of state highways, 76.98 Kms. of Major district roads, 415.96 Kms of other district roads, 332.18 kms of forest roads, 3954.15 kms of Inter-village roads, 3076.87 kms of Intra-village road and 1191.49 Kms of village roads are operating in the district.
12. **Education:** There were 898 nos. of primary schools, 713 nos. of Up-primary schools, 225 nos. of secondary schools and 43 nos. of general colleges in the district during 2019-20. Besides, there are 2 nos. of polytechnic school in the district during year 2019-20 to impart technical education. The pupil- teacher ratio in the primary, upper primary, Secondary School stood at 13, 17 and 27 respectively.
13. **Health:** The medical facilities are provided by different agencies like Govt., Private individuals and voluntary organizations in the district. There were 1 no of DHH, 14 nos. of CHC, 40 nos. PHC of the Allopathic medical institutions including 176 nos. of Sub Centre in the district during the year 2019-20. There were 19 nos. of Homoeopathic dispensaries and 16 nos. of Ayurvedic dispensaries in the district during the year 2019-20.
14. **Banking:** As on December, 2020, there were 74 nos. of all Banks having 2517.78 crore rupees deposit and 963.80 crore rupees credit in the district. The district has banking branches network of 74 out of which 36 (48.65%) in semi-

urban area and 38 (51.35%) in rural areas. The total number of ATMs in the district stood at 64.

15. **Collection of Land Revenue:** *The total collection of land revenue in the district for 2019-20 was Rs. 1506.59 lakh. The total collection of Tax in the district during 2019-20 was Rs. 578.21 Lakh.*
16. **Poverty Alleviation Programme:** *In the district total no. of Job card issued was 1.54 Lakh and total no. of person days generated was 40.55 lakh during the year 2019-20.*
17. **Disaster Scenario:** *In terms of Disaster activity the district is graded as slight zone for wind & cyclone, protected area for flood, moderate risk zone for drought, very low damage zone for earthquake and less damage zone for earthquake & minor accident prone area for accident.*
