SOCIO ECONOMIC PROFILE: KEONJHAR

1. **Location:** Keonjhar district is one of the Northern located districts in Odisha. It lies between $85^{\circ} 11'$ to $86^{\circ} 22'$ East longitude and between $20^{\circ} 1'$ to $22^{\circ} 10'$ North latitude. It is bounded by the Jharkhand state in north, Jajpur district in south, Angul district in the east and Mayurbhanj district in the west.
2. **Area and Population:** The district has an area of 8303 sq. kms and 18.02 lakhs of population as per 2011 census. The district accounts for 5.33 percent of the state territory and shares 4.29 percent of the state population. The density of population of the district is 217 per sq. kms as against 270 person per sq.km of the state. It has 2123 villages (including 59 un-inhabited villages) covering 13 blocks. 13 Tahasils and 3 Subdivisions. As per 2011 census the schedule caste population is 209357 (11.6 %) and schedule tribe population 818878 (45.4 %). The literacy percentage of the district covers 68.2 against 72.9 of the state.
3. **Climate:** The climate condition of the district is generally hot with high humidity during April to May and cold during December to January. The monsoon generally breaks during the month of June. Annual rainfall of the district was 1718.5 m.m. in 2020 which is higher than the normal rainfall (1487.7 m.m.).
4. **Agriculture:** During the year 2019-20, the net area sown was 180 thousand hectares against 4102 thousand hectares of the state. During the year 2019-20, the production of paddy was 7947761 quintals, 22923 quintals maize, 8 quintals ragi, 1889 quintals mung, 1934 quintals biri, 1403 quintals kulthi, 915 quintals til, 6418 quintals groundnuts, 561 quintals mustard, 7876 quintals potatoes, 100 quintals jute and 14760 quintals sugarcane. During 2019-20, the total fertilizers used was 16005 MT in the district with a breakage of 9490 MT nitrogenous, 5068 MT phosphatic and 1447 MT pottasic and the consumption of fertilizer per hectare is 45 Kg.
5. **Irrigation:** During the year 2019-20, it is reported by Chief District Agriculture Officer that the irrigation potential created during Kharif and Rabi are 105525 hectares and 54260 hectares respectively through all sources including major / medium irrigation projects in the district.
6. **Co-operation:** The district has 44 agricultural Co-operative societies with a membership of 240536. The loan advances is to the tune of Rs. 42309.17 lakh and loan outstanding stood at Rs. 34269.01 lakhs as of 2019-20. The agricultural credit Co-operative societies as more or less evenly distributed across the 13 Blocks of the district. Besides that there are 26 non-agricultural credit Co-operative Societies in different blocks of Keonjhar district.
7. **Forest:** District of Keonjhar has abundant of Forest area that contributed 39.38 % of the total geographical area of the district.

8. **Veterinary Services:** During 2019-20, Milk production is 64.87 thousand MT, production of eggs is 678.35 lakhs nos. and production of meat is 8.25 thousand MT in this district. During 2019-20, 22 nos. of Hospitals and Dispensaries, 150 nos. of Livestock Aid centers and 134 nos Artificial Insemination Centers were functioning in the district.
9. **Industry and Mining:** During the year 2019-20, 2300 nos. of micro small and medium enterprises have established with total capital investment of about Rs. 8118.66 lakhs with 5453 nos. of Employment generated in Keonjhar district.
10. **Power:** During the year 2019-20, villages so far electrified as on 31.03.2020 is 2064 which constitutes 100 % to the total villages of the district.
11. **Transport & Communication:** During 2019-20, 341.30 Kms. of National Highways 52.33 kms of state highways, 68.98 kms. Major district roads, 973.83 kms of other district roads, 3930.23 kms of Inter-village road, 2964.06 kms of Intra-village road, 2133.77 Kms of village roads and 249.98 kms of forest roads are operating in the district.
12. **Education:** There were 1666 nos. of primary schools, 1034 nos. of Up-primary schools, 508 nos. of Secondary schools and 102 nos. of general colleges in the district during 2019-20. Besides, there are 2 nos. of engineering schools and 1 no of Engineering College in the district during year 2017-18 to impart technical education. The teacher pupil ratio in the primary, upper primary, Secondary School stood at 25, 18 and 31 respectively.
13. **Health:** The medical facilities are provided by different agencies like Govt., Private individuals and voluntary organizations in the district. There were 3 nos. DHH, 17 nos. CHC, 67 nos. PHC of the Allopathic medical institutions including 363 nos. of Sub Centre in the district during the year 2019-20. There were 34 nos. of Homoeopathic dispensaries and 49 nos. of Ayurvedic dispensaries in the district during the year 2019-20.
14. **Banking:** As on December, 2020, there were 217 nos. of All Banks having 14722.18 crore rupees deposit and 5298.53 crore rupees credit in the district. The district has banking branches network of 217 out of which 98 (46.16%) in semi-urban area and 119 (54.84%) in rural areas. The total number of ATMs in the district stood at 242.
15. **Collection of Land Revenue:** The total collection of land revenue in the district for 2019-20 was Rs. 6568.37 lakh.
16. **Poverty Alleviation Programme:** In the district total no. of Job card issued was 3.34 Lakh and total no. of person days generated was 58.16 lakh during the year 2019-20.

17. ***Disaster Scenario:*** In terms of Disaster activity the district is graded as very high risk zone, high risk zone and moderate risk zone for wind & cyclone, protected areas for flood, high risk zone for drought, less damage zone and very low damage zone for earthquake & major accident prone area for accident.
