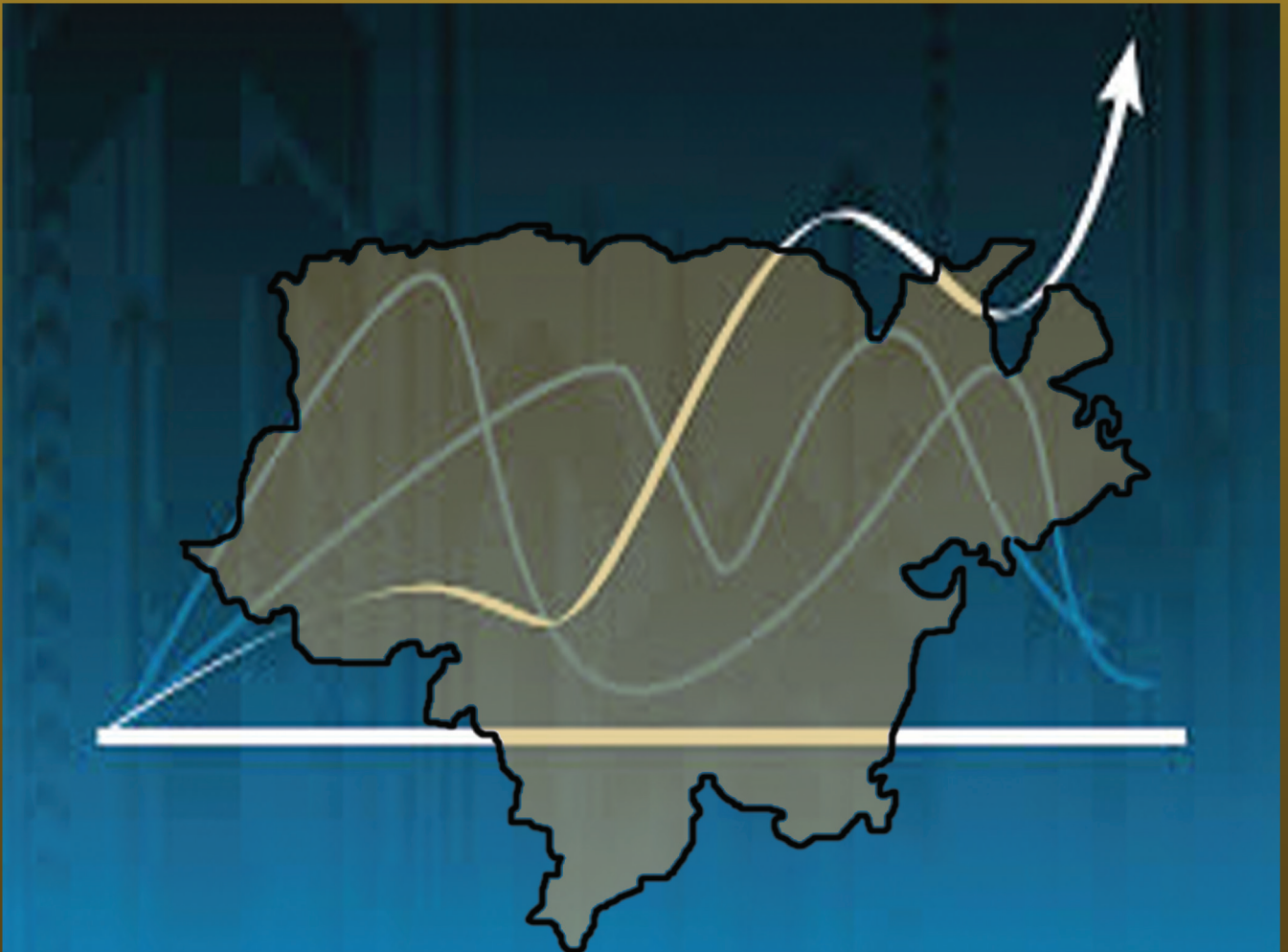

*Diligence and contribution of the Officer and Staff of Publication Division and Computer Centre for bring out the publication are praiseworthy.*



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# **SOCIO ECONOMIC PROFILE: KORAPUT**

- 1. Introduction:** Koraput district becoming a district of Odisha state on 1st April 1936. After reorganization of districts the Geographical area of the district is 8807 Sq kms. The district headquarters situated 2900 ft. above sea level. The district is bounded by Nabarangpur district in North, Vishakapatnam district of Andhra Pradesh in South, Rayagada district and Srikakulam district of Andhra Pradesh in the east and Malkangiri district and Bastar district of Chhatisgarh in the west. It lies between 82°5' E to 83°23' E longitude and between 18°13' N to 19°10' N latitude.
- 2. Area and Population:** The district has an area of 8807 sq. kms and 13.80 lakhs of population as per 2011 census. The rural and urban population is 1153478 and 226169 respectively. The level of urbanization stands 16.39% of the total district population as against the 3.23% in the State. The district accounts for 5.66 percent of the state territory and shares 3.29 percent of the state population. The density of population of the district is 157 per sq. kms as against 270 person per sq. km of the state. The district has 2042 villages (including 101 un-inhabited villages) covering 14 blocks, 14 Tahasils and 2 Subdivisions. As per 2011 census the schedule caste population is 196540 (14.2%) and schedule tribe population 697583 (50.6%). The literacy percentage of the district is 49.2 as against 72.9 of the state. The languages spoken by the people of this district are Tribal, Odia, Telugu, Hindi and English.
- 3. Climate:** The climate condition of the district is generally warm with high humidity during April and May and cold during October to February. The monsoon generally breaks during the month of June. The Average annual rainfall of the district is 1682.4 m.m (during 2020) which is higher than the normal rainfall (1567.2 m.m).
- 4. Agriculture:** During the year 2019-20, the net area sown was 164 thousand hectares against 4102 thousand hectares of the state. The production of paddy was 5484341 quintals, 65811 quintals maize, 161461 quintals ragi, 636 quintals, Mung 7743 quintals, Biri 8662 quintals, Kulthi, 491 quintals till, 37625 quintals groundnuts, 516 quintals mustard, 79516 quintals, potatoes 99871 and 2058730 quintals sugarcane. During 2019-20, the total fertilizers used in district was about 22635 MT with a breakage of 13259 MT nitrogenous, 5603 MT Phosphatic and 3773 MT Pottasic and the consumption of fertilizer per hectare is 67.88 Kg.
- 5. Irrigation:** During 2019-20, it is reported by Chief District Agriculture Officer that the irrigation potential created during Kharif and Rabi from all sources were 94803 thousand hectares and 67134 hectares respectively through major / medium / minor (Flow), lift irrigation projects and other sources.

- 6. Co-operation:** *The district has 20 agricultural Co-operative societies with a membership of 201621. The loan advances is to the tune of Rs. 30445.03 lakh and loan outstanding stood at Rs. 13820.84 lakhs as of 2019-20. The agricultural credit Co-operative societies are more or less evenly distributed across the 14 Blocks of the district. Besides there are 10 non-agricultural credit Co-operative Societies and 4 marketing Co-operative Societies in the district.*
- 7. Forest:** *District of Koraput has abundant of Forest area that contributed 26.75 % of the total geographical area of the district.*
- 8. Veterinary Services:** *During 2019-20, Milk production is 60.49 thousand MT, production of eggs is 409.21 lakhs nos. and production of meat is 6.05 thousand MT in this district. During the year 2019-20, 24 nos. of Hospitals and dispensaries, 123 nos. of livestock Aid centers, 140 nos. of Artificial insemination centers and 37 nos. V.A.S and Additional V.A.S were functioning in Koraput district of provide veterinary services to the people.*
- 9. Industry and Mining:** *During the year 2019-20, 1760 nos. of micro small and medium enterpriser have been established with total capital investment of about Rs.4470.85 lakhs with 6597 nos. of Employment generated in Kopraput district.*
- 10. Power:** *There are 1941 nos. of villages so far electrified as on 31.03.2020 which is covered 100.00 % to the total villages in the Kopraput district.*
- 11. Transport & Communication:** *During 2019-20, 294.34 kms of national highway, 168.04 kms of state highways, 132.12 kms Major district roads, 718.18 kms of other district roads, 1785.69 kms of village roads, 5165.55 kms, of Inter village roads, 3398.10 kms of Intra village roads and 208.75 kms of forest roads are operating in the district.*
- 12. Education:** *There were 1644 nos. of primary schools, 821 nos. of Up-primary schools, 325 nos. of secondary schools and 53 nos. of general colleges in the district during 2019-20. Besides, there is 6 nos. of engineering schools, 1 no. of engineering colleges and 2 nos of Universities in the district during year 2019-20 to impart technical education. The pupil-teacher ratio in the primary, upper primary, secondary school stood at 15, 26 and 48 respectively.*
- 13. Health:** *The medical facilities are provided by different agencies like Govt., Private individuals and voluntary organizations in the district. There were 2 no. DHH, 16 nos. CHC, 51 nos. PHC of the Allopathic medical institutions including 307 nos. of Sub Centre in the district during the year 2019-20. There were 18 nos. of Homoeopathic dispensaries and 18 nos. of Ayurvedic dispensaries in the district during the year 2019-20.*

- 14. Banking:** As on December 2020, there were 128 nos. of all banks having 6211.38 crores rupees deposit and 2763.85 crores rupees credit in the Koprput district. The district has banking branches network of 128 out of which 0 (0%) were in the urban area, 60 (46.88%) in semi-urban area and 68 (53.13%) in rural areas. The total number of ATMs in the district stood at 144.
- 15. Collection of Land Revenue:** The total collection of land revenue in the district for 2019-20 was Rs. 468.25 lakh. The total collection of Tax in the district during 2019-20 was Rs. 24439.64 Lakh.
- 16. Poverty Alleviation Programme:** In the district total no. of Job card issued was 2.96 Lakh and total no. of person days generated was 59.18 lakh during the year 2019-20.
- 17. Disaster Scenario:** In terms of Disaster activity the district is graded as High risk zone and slight zone for wind & cyclone, liable to get flooded and protected areas for flood, high risk zone for drought, very low damage zone for earthquake & minor accident prone areas for accident.
