

SOCIO ECONOMIC PROFILE: MALKANGIRI

1. **Location:** Malkangiri district is one of the Southern located districts in Odisha. It lies between 81° 22' to 82° 25' Longitude East and between 17° 40' to 18° 43' latitude North. It is bounded by the Chhatisgarh State in North, Andhra Pradesh in South, Chhatisgarh in the East and Koraput district in the west.
2. **Area and Population:** The district has an area of 5791 sq.kms and 6.13 lakhs of population as per 2011 census. The rural and urban population is 563664 and 49528 respectively. The level of urbanization stands at 8.08% of the total district population as against the 0.70% in the State. The district accounts for 3.72 percent of the state territory and shares 1.46 percent of the state population. The density of population of the district is 106 per sq. kms as against 270 person per sq.km of the state. It has 1055 villages (including 60 un-inhabited villages) covering 7 blocks 7 Tahasils and 1 Sub-divisions. As per 2011 census the schedule caste population is 138295 (22.6%) and schedule tribe population 354614 (57.42%). The literacy percentage of the district covers 48.5 against 72.9 of the state.
3. **Climate:** The climate condition of the district is generally hot with high humidity during April to May and cold during November to December. The monsoon generally breaks during the month of June, Average annual rainfall of the district is 2164 m.m. in 2020 which is less than the normal rainfall (1667.6 m.m.).
4. **Agriculture:** During the year 2019-20, the net area sown was 121 thousand hectares against 4202 thousand hectares of the state. The production of paddy was 3514187 quintals, 2440 quintals maize, 23421 quintals ragi, 765 quintals mung, 5867 quintals biri, 2945 quintals kulthi, and 20562 quintals til and 184265 quintals groundnuts. During 2019-20, the total fertilizers used in Malkangiri district is about 9976 MT with a breakage of 5980 MT nitrogenous, 2732 MT phosphatic and 1264 MT pottasic and the consumption of fertilizer per hectare is 46.50 Kg. which is 10th position of the State.
5. **Irrigation:** During the year 2019-20, it is reported by the Chief District Agriculture Officer that the irrigation potential created during Kharif and Rabi are 73776 hectares and 68738 hectares through irrigation projects of the district.

6. **Co-operation:** *The district has 8 agricultural Co-operative societies with a membership of 97878. The loan advances is to the tune of Rs. 11266.71 lakh and loan outstanding stood at Rs.10588.69 lakhs as of 2019-20. The agricultural credit Co-operative societies are more or less evenly distributed across the 7 Blocks of the district. Besides there are 16 non-agricultural credit Co-operative Societies in the district.*
7. **Forest:** *District of Malkangiri has abundant of Forest area that contributed 61.16% of the total geographical area of the district.*
8. **Veterinary Services:** *During 2019-20, Milk production is 39.14 thousand MT, production of eggs is 173.74 lakhs nos. and production of meat is 3.68 thousand MT in this district. During 2019-20, 13 nos. of Hospitals and Dispensaries, 54 nos. of Livestock Aid centers and 66 Artificial Insemination Centers, 16 nos. of VAS & Additional VAS were functioning in the district.*
9. **Industry and Mining:** *During the year 2019-20, 362 nos. of Micro small and Medium Enterprisers have been established with total capital investment of about Rs. 1980.21 lakhs with 1519 nos. of Employment generated in Malkangiri district.*
10. **Power:** *During the year 2019-20, villages so far electrified as on 30.03.2020 is 995 which constitutes 100 % to the total villages of the district.*
11. **Transport & Communication:** *During 2019-20, 160 Kms. of National Highways, 84.42 Kms. of state highways, 83.43 Kms. Major district roads, 238.95 Kms of other district roads, 2789.55 kms of Inter-village road, 1212.60 kms of Intra-village road, 820.03 Kms of village roads and 113.52 Kms of forest roads are operating in the district.*
12. **Education:** *There were 821 nos. of primary schools, 369 nos. of Up-primary schools, 128 nos. of secondary schools and 26 nos. of general colleges in the district during 2019-20. Besides, there are 1 nos. of polytechnic school in the district during year 2019-20 to impart technical education. The pupil- teacher ratio in the primary, upper primary, Secondary School stood at 47, 18 and 22 respectively.*

13. **Health:** *The medical facilities are provided by different agencies like Govt., Private individuals and voluntary organizations in the district. There were 3 no. DHH, 6 nos. CHC, 26 nos. PHC of the Allopathic medical institutions including 158 nos. of Sub Centre in the district during the year 2019-20. There were 8 nos. of Homoeopathic dispensaries and 6 nos. of Ayurvedic dispensaries in the district during the year 2019-20.*
14. **Banking:** *As on December, 2020, there were 51 nos. of All Banks having 1804.55 crore rupees deposit and 630.26 crore rupees credit in the district. The district has banking branches network of 51 out of which 0 (0%) were in the urban area, 19 (37.25%) in semi-urban area and 32 (62.74%) in rural areas. The total number of ATMs in the district stood at 39.*
15. **Collection of Land Revenue:** *The total collection of land revenue in the district for 2019-20 was Rs. 192.26 lakh. The total collection of Tax in the district during 2019-20 was Rs. 3314.86 Lakh.*
16. **Poverty Alleviation Programme:** *In the district total no. of Job card issued was 1.12 Lakh and total no. of person days generated was 18.76 lakh during the year 2019-20.*
17. **Disaster Scenario:** *In terms of Disaster activity the district is graded as high risk zone & slight zone for wind & cyclone, liable to get flooded & protected areas for flood, high risk zone for drought, very low damage zone for earthquake & minor accident prone areas for accident.*
