SOCIO ECONOMIC PROFILE: SUNDERGARH

1. **Location:** Sundergarh district is one of the Northern Area located districts in Odisha. It lies between $83^{\circ} 32'$ to $85^{\circ} 22'$ East longitude and between $21^{\circ} 35'$ to $22^{\circ} 32'$ North latitude. It is bounded by the Jharkhand State in north, Jharsuguda district in south, Chhattisgarh State in the east and Keonjhar district in the west.
2. **Area and Population:** The district has an area of 9712 sq. kms and 20.93 lakhs of population as per 2011 census. The rural population is 1355340 and urban population is 738097. The level of urbanization stands at 35.26% of the total district population as against the 10.54 in the State. The district accounts for 6.24 percent of the state territory with 2nd rank and shares 4.99 percent of the state population. The density of population of the district is 216 per sq. kms as against 270 person per sq.km of the state. It has 1762 villages (including 49 un-inhabited villages) covering 17 blocks, 18 Tahasils and 3 Subdivisions. As per 2011 census the schedule caste population is 191660 (9.2%) and schedule tribe population 1062349 (50.7%). The literacy percentage of the district covers 73.3 against 72.9 of the state.
3. **Climate:** The climate condition of the district is generally hot with high humidity during July to September and cold during December to January. The monsoon generally breaks during the month of June. Annual rainfall of the district was 1585.2 m.m. in 2020 which is higher than the normal rainfall (1422.4 m.m.).
4. **Agriculture:** During the year 2019-20, the net area sown was 198 thousand hectares against 4202 thousand hectares of the state. During the year 2019-20, the production of paddy was 5074617 quintals, 409 quintals wheat, 10288 quintals maize, 128 quintals ragi, 2805 quintals mung, 1659 quintals biri, 1117 quintals til, 3619 quintals kulthi, 6927 quintals groundnuts, 4010 quintals mustard, and 33384 quintals potatoes. During 2019-20, the total fertilizers used was 14469 MT in the district with a breakage of 8537 MT nitrogenous, 4286 MT phosphatic and 1646 MT pottasic and the consumption of fertilizer per hectare is 40.20 Kg which is 8th position of the State.
5. **Irrigation:** During the year 2019-20, it is reported by District Agriculture Officer that the irrigation potential created during Kharif and Rabi are 83747 hectares and 54548 hectares respectively through all sources including major / medium irrigation projects namely Kansabahal, Pitamahal, Sarafgarh, Talsara, Rukura & I.B. (P) irrigation projects in the district.
6. **Co-operation:** The district has 44 agricultural Co-operative societies with a membership of 389022. The loan advances is to the tune of Rs. 64089.05 lakh and loan outstanding stood at Rs. 61214.60 lakhs as of 2019-20. The agricultural credit Co-operative societies as more or

less evenly distributed across the 8 Blocks of the district. Besides there are 78 non-agricultural credit Co-operative Societies in the district

7. **Forest:** District of Sundergarh has abundant of Forest area that contributed 45.38% of the total geographical area of the district.
8. **Veterinary Services:** During 2019-20, Milk production is 58.90 thousand MT, production of eggs is 526.54 lakhs nos. and production of meat is 6.13 thousand MT in this district. During 2019-20, 30 nos. of Hospitals and Dispensaries, 124 nos. of Livestock Aid centers and 142 Artificial Insemination Centers were functioning in the district.
9. **Industry and Mining:** During the year 2019-20, 5814 nos. of micro small and medium enterprises have been established with total capital investment of about Rs. 18435.27 lakhs with 12364 nos. of Employment generated in Sundergarh district.
10. **Power:** During the year 2019-20, villages so far electrified as on 30.03.2020 is 1713 which constitutes 100 % to the total villages of the district.
11. **Transport & Communication:** During 2019-20, 168.01 Kms. of National Highways, 257.24 kms of state highways, 304.30 kms. Major district roads, 638.57 kms of other district roads, 6871.77 kms of Inter-village road, 3795.99 kms of Intra-village road, 1880.75 Kms of village roads and 677.55 kms of forest roads are operating in the district.
12. **Education:** There were 1592 nos. of primary schools, 911 nos. of Up-primary schools, 474 nos. of Secondary schools and 93 nos. of general colleges in the district during 2019-20. Besides, there are 6 nos. of Engineering schools and 5 nos. of engineering colleges in the district during year 2019-20 to impart technical education. The pupil - teacher ratio in the primary, upper primary, Secondary School stood at 16, 19 and 25 respectively.
13. **Health:** The medical facilities are provided by different agencies like Govt., Private individuals and voluntary organizations in the district. There were 5 no. DHH, 21 nos. CHC, 69 nos. PHC of the Allopathic medical institutions including 390 nos. of Sub Centre in the district during the year 2019-20. There were 26 nos. of Homoeopathic dispensaries and 33 nos. of Ayurvedic dispensaries in the district during the year 2019-20.
14. **Banking:** As on December, 2020, there were 275 nos. of All Banks having 21748.13 crore rupees deposit and 10213.75 crore rupees credit in the district. The district has banking branches network of 275 out of which 105 (38.18 %) were in the urban area, 51 (18.55 %) in semi-urban area and 119 (43.27 %) in rural areas. The total number of ATMs in the district stood at 359.

15. **Collection of Land Revenue:** The total collection of land revenue in the district for 2019-20 was Rs. 3576.04 lakh.
16. **Poverty Alleviation Programme:** In the district total no. of Job card issued was 3.13 Lakh and total no. of person days generated was 69.73 lakh during the year 2019-20.
17. **Disaster Scenario:** In terms of Disaster activity the district is graded as moderate risk zone & slight zone for wind & cyclone, protected areas for flood, very high risk zone for drought, moderate damage zone & less damage zone for earthquake & major accident prone areas for accident.
