# SALIENT FEATURES OF THE DISTRICT

#### Introduction:

Tirunelveli District was formed in 1790 by the East India company, later came under the direct control of the British Crown Queen Victoria. The name Tirunelveli has been composed from the three Tamil words i.e. 'Thiru – Nel – Veli' meaning Sacred Paddy Hedge. i.e. Protecting the sacred paddy from rain by the 'Lord Siva'



#### **Geographical Location:**



Tirunelveli District having geographical area of 3876.06 sq.kms which lay in the South eastern portion of Tamil Nadu is triangular in shape. The Tirunelveli district is located in the world map, lies between 8°.08' and 9°.23' of the latitude and 77°.09' and 77°.54' of longitude.

#### **Topography:**

The district is located in the southern part of Tamil Nadu and surrounded by state of Kerala, Tenkasi District, Thoothukudi District, Gulf of Mannar and Kannyakumari District. The lifeline of the district river Tamiraparani feeds the district and quenches the thirst of residents of Tirunelveli and Tuticorin district too and also supplying drinking water to Virudhunagar.

#### **Administrative Setup:**



Tirunelveli District has been bifurcated into that Tirunelveli and Tenkasi Districts (as per GO.No.426, Revenue Administration Wing [RA(1)] Section dated.21.12.2019) with effect from the 12<sup>th</sup> November 2019.

After the bifurcation, The Tirunelveli District has 2 Revenue Divisions consisting of 8 Taluks, 30 Firkas, 370 Revenue Villages (as per GO.No.476, Revenue Administration Wing [RA(1)] Section dated 21.12.2019) and 9 Development Blocks and 204 Village Panchayats(as per Tirunelveli District Gazette Notification by the District Collector/Inspector of Panchayat, Dated 14.02.2020).

#### Climate and Rainfall:

The district has a peculiar climatic condition throughout year and receiving rainfall in all the seasons. In the current fasli year 1200.0 mm of rainfall was received [Fasli 1431-2021-2022] Apart from that the mean maximum and minimum temperature have been decreased when compared with the last year (Table 2.1).



The maximum precipitation is contributed by the North East monsoon (841.2 mm) followed by summer (167.0 mm), south west monsoon (122.5 mm) and winter (69.3 mm). However the current year was good rainfall.

#### **Demographic Details:**

The population of the District was 2723988 in 2001 Census and stood at 1636438 as per 2011 census after bifurcated. The projected population for the year 2021 is about 1919702. The Density of Population per sq.km. was increased from 399 in 2001 census and 422 persons in 2011 census. Tirunelveli, Palayamkottai, are the most densely populated Taluks in the District as per 2011 census.

The Sex ratio is 1023 females for every 1000 males. The Literacy rate is 77.51% in the District as per 2011 census.

Out of total population, males were 1333939 and females were 1390049 in 2001 census and raised as males are 806697 and females are 829741 in 2011 census. Population for 2021 was projected as 1848684 whereas male 911326 and female 937358. Total Schedule caste population is 276814 which represents 16.9% to the total population as per 2011 census. Schedule Tribes are found to be very small in numbers of 6614 which is 0.40% to the total population.

#### Occupation:

Agriculture playing a vital role in the District's economy. The total cropped area was 87849.345 hectares, which covers 22.66% to the total geographical area of 387606.195 hectares. When compared with previous year i.e. 2020-21, the total cropped area was increased by 3.34%.



The Paddy, Maize, Cholam, Blackgram, Green gram and other minor millets are the important food crops. Cotton, Chillies, Sugarcane and Groundnut are other the important commercial crops. Out of total cultivated area of 87849.345 hectares 16642.711 hectares were sown more than once. Apart from agriculture, Beedi rolling, Cattle rearing, Poultry farming, mining and quarrying, Construction work and power woods are providing employment opportunities and earnings as subsidiary income to the people of this district.

#### Irrigation:




The District is blessed with the Western Ghats, from which all the perennial rivers are flows and drain towards the east. The surface water of the District is drained into major river basin viz., Thamiraparani. Thamiraparani is the major river basin in the District. The other Streams which are seasonal in nature ie. Servallar, Manimuthar, which are drain into the Tamiraparani river.

The sources of irrigation are Canal, Tank and Well, which cover the area of 74705 hectares. Among the total area irrigated, Open Well irrigation covers 27585 hectares.

#### **Industry:**

There are many medium and major industries such as Cement, Cotton yarn, Calcium carbide, Rice bran oil, Printing papers and flour Mill etc are running in the district. The other industries like Pin, Clip, Matches, Beedi rolling, Vessels making and Engineering industries are important are providing employment opportunity. The important Village industries functioning in the district are Power loom, Brick kiln, and Jaggary production.



The products of Handloom and Power loom like lungi, sarees etc., are marketed in northern India. The fine Korai mats from Pathamadai have one of the world fame. Kallidaikurichi Pappads, Karukurichi mud pots and Tirunelveli "Halva" are specialties which earned many laurels to the District.

#### **Top Attractions:**

#### Sulochana Mudaliyar Bridge (Nov. 28, 1843)



The Sulochana Mudaliyar bridge connects the twin cities of Tirunelveli and Palayamkottai. The bridge resembles the bridge over the Thames River in London. Though the British Indian government constructed the bridge, a private citizen financed the bridge construction. His name was Thiru. Sulochana Mudaliyar. Thus, it was the first bridge in India named after a private citizen by the British Indian government.

#### **Thiruvalluvar Two Tier Bridge (1972)**

The two tier over bridge, namely Thiruvalluvar Bridge at Tirunelveli Junction was constructed to avoid the railway line crossing. The total length of bridge is 800 metres. This type of two tier bridge constructed in Tirunelveli is the first of its kind in India. This bridge was opened for traffic in 1972. This two tier over bridge consists of 25 spans of which 13 are of bow string arch, each with a width of 30.30 metres and 12 are single tier R.C.C. girder each having a width of 11.72 metres.



#### Iruttu Kadai Halwa



Tirunelveli city is well known for Halwa. Almost 95 years ago the original Tirunelveli Halwa Shop, which was fondly called by people all around the world as "IRRUTUKADAI" owing to its ambience was started by Krishnasingh and his son Bijlisingh, from Rajasthan. The Irrutu Kadai still functions in the same building without any modification except that the Old Hurricane lamp was being replaced by the Incandescent Bulb of 40 watts.

Starting from the cash tray to the halwa carrying containers everything is age old. One could clearly see and identify the shop owing to its prime location in the Tirunelveli Town opposite to the Nellaiappar Temple main entrance and its age old building among other modern buildings. The shop is most celebrated that it does not even have a nameboard, open only for few hours a day with immense amount of people even including the foreigners visiting the Tirunelveli waiting patiently to get it. This particular shop does not follow a single marketing strategy and truly believes in the quality of product what it provides to the customers and the word of mouth from people who had it. The owners also believe that the Thamirabharani river water is also responsible for its mouth-watering taste.

#### **Tourist spots:**

Pappanasam Agasthiar falls also attracts the tourist and pilgrims. There is a Wild life sanctuary at Kalakkadu Mundanthurai and Thalai Anai Kalakkadu. Spotted deers, Lion tailed monkeys, Elephants and **Tigers** plenty. are Koonthankulam Birds sanctuary Nanguneri Taluk is also attract the tourists.



#### **Religious Significance:**

The Nellaiappar temple at Tirunelveli, The Vanamaamalai Perumal Temple at Nanguneri are the land marks of the District signifying the Hindu Culture. Palayamkottai has many Christian missions and Athankarai pallivasal have considered to be important sacred places for Muslims.



Terracotta Clay Products crafted include water drawing and storing pots and cooking vessels. During the harvest festival of Pongal old pots in the house are replaced by new cooking pots, vessels for storing grain and a new container for the auspicious tulasi/holy basil plant. The pots symbolize continuity of life, creating, destruction and rebirth. In Tamil Nadu, potters are known as Kuyavar, Kulalaar or Velar.Potters from Karukurichi village situated on the banks of the river Thamirabarani and neighboring Kuniyur village of Cheranmahadevi Tirunelveli District craft terracotta products.



## **Wooden Lacquer ware**

Miniature kitchen sets, familiar to almost every child who grew up in Tamil Nadu in the 1980s and 1990s, come from Ambasamudram, Tirunelyeli district.



# **Wood Carving**

A wood carving is a decorative piece of wood that has been carved in an artistic way.



### **Kora Grass Fine Mats**

Soft and pliable silk mats are produced in a village called Pattamadai, in Tirunelveli district of Tamil Nadu. These are different from the pais or mats which are commonly available. The mats are made of kora grass, which grows in river beds and other marshy lands, harvested in September/October or February/March.

#### 43. TRANSPORT

Tirunelveli has an extensive transport network and is well-connected to other major cities by road and rail. The corporation maintains a total of 763.3 km (474.3 mi) of roads. The city has 134.88 km (83.81 mi) of concrete roads, 375.51 km (233.33 mi) of BT roads, 94.291 km (58.590 mi) of water-bound macadam roads, 76.31 km (47.42 mi) of unpaved roads and 82.3 km (51.1 mi) of highways. Twenty-two Kilometer (fourteen miles) of highway are maintained by the State Highways Department and thirty Kilometer (nineteen miles) by the National Highways Department. In 1844 a bridge was built by Colonel Horsley across the Tamirabarani River, connecting Tirunelveli to Palayamkottai. The city is located on NH 7, 150 km (93 mi) south of Madurai and 91 km (57 mi) north of Kanyakumari. NH 7A, an extension of NH 7, connects Palayamkottai with Tuticorin Port. Tirunelveli is also connected by major highways to Kollam, Tiruchendur, Rajapalayam, Sankarankovil, Ambasamudram and Nazareth.

The main bus stand (popularly known as the New Bus Stand), opened in 2003, is located in Veinthaankulam and there is regular bus service to and from the city. Other bus stands (for intracity service) are the Junction and Palay bus stands. The Tamil Nadu State Transport Corporation has daily service to a number of cities, and the corporation operates a reservation centre in the main bus stand. It also operates local buses serving the city and neighbouring villages. The State Express Transport Corporation has intercityand inter state service to Bangalore, Chennai, KanyakumariTiruvendrum and other cities.

Tirunelveli Junction railway station is one of the oldest railway stations in India. The line from Tirunelveli to Shengottai was opened in 1903; the connection to Quilon, which was completed later, was the most important trade route to Travancore province in British India. Tirunelveli is also connected to major Indian cities with daily service to Chennai, Tiruchirappalli, Madurai, Kanyakumari, Mumbai, Guruvayur, Howrah, Delhi and Trivandrum. There is passenger service to Madurai, Tiruchendur, Tiruchirapalli and Kollam.

The nearest airport to Tirunelveli is Tuticorin Airport (TCR) at Vaagaikulam in Thoothukkudi District, 32 km (14 mi) east of the city, which offers daily flights to Chennai. The nearest interairports are Madurai International Airport, 150 km (93 mi) away and Thiruvananthapuram International Airport (TRV), about 130 km (81 mi) away.

## 44. TOURISM

#### Places of Importance in Tirunelveli District

#### Manjolai Hills

Located between 1,000 metres (3,300 ft) and 1,500 metres (4,900 ft) of elevation, the Manjolai area is set deep within the Western Ghats within the Kalakad Mundanthurai Tiger Reserve in the Tirunelveli District. Located on top of the Manimuthar Dam and the Manimuthar Water Falls, the Manjolai area comprises tea plantations, small settlements, the Upper Kodaiyar Dam and a windy view point called Kuthiravetti.



The whole of the Manjolai Estates and the tea plantations are operated by The Bombay Burmah Trading Corporation Ltd on forest land leased by the Government of Tamil Nadu. There are three tea estates within the Manjolai area: Manjolai Estate, Manimutharu Estate and Oothu Estate. The Estates are located at elevations ranging from 700 metres (2,300 ft) to 1,300 metres (4,300 ft).

#### **Tiger Reserve**



The 900 square kilometers (350 sq mi) Kalakkad Mundanthurai Tiger Reserve was established in 1962. The reserve, at 8°39′N77°23′E, is about 45 km west of Tirunelveli and is known as KMTS to forest and tiger researchers. Kalakkad is the nearest town. Kalakkad has a temple called Malainambi tample with a falls.

## Papanasam



Papanasam is a famous picnic spot in Tirunelveli district in the Indian state of Tamil Nadu. It falls under the Ambasamudram Taluk. It is situated 50 km from Tirunelveli. The site is popular with tourists attractions like Thamirabarani River, Agasthiyar Falls, Siva Temple, Papanasam dam and Hydro Electric Power Plant.

## **Bird Sanctuary**





A tiny village in the far south, Koonthankulam in Nanguneri Taluk of Tirunelveli District is emerging as a new favourite of the migratory birds. It is just 38 kilometres (24 mi) away. About 35 species of birds visit this calm but congenial village for breeding. The painted storks are coming from North India and East European Countries to this place. Similarly the flamingoes which flew in mainly from the Rann of Kutch have hatched and reared their young in the village.

#### Swamy Nellaiappar and Kanthimathi Ambal Temple



The Nellaiappar Temple is located in Tirunel velidistrict. It is rooted in tradition and history, and is known for its musical pillars and other sculpted figures. The nearest airport is Tuticorin (TCR) at Vagaikulam. 30-minute drive (32 km) from Tirunel veli.

#### Athankarai Pallivasal



The pilgrim centre, Athankarai Pallivasal is located in between Thiruchendur and Kanyakumari on the coast road, about 46kms from Thirunelveli. The shrine has two domes of Sufi saints who were believed to grant all desires of devotees. One dome is dedicated to Syed Ali Fathima and another to Hazrath Sheik Mohammed. During the festival held in September, thousands of devotees gather here to pay their homage and seek blessings.

#### Melaseval Navaneethakrishnan Temple

The Navaneethakrishnan Temple at Melasevel Village, 16 km (9.9 mi) from Tirunelveli Town on the road leading to Ambasamudram, is around 730 years old. Adhithyavarneshwar Temple, devoted to Lord Siva is also famous in this village. Twice a year, the sun's rays fall straight on the Lingam in the morning.



#### Krishnapuram Venkatachalapathy temple

Krishnapuram Venkatachalapathy temple (also called Krishnapuram Temple) in Krishnapuram, a village in Tirunelveli district in the South Indian state of Tamil Nadu, is dedicated to the Hindu god Vishnu. It is located 10 km from Tirunelveli. Constructed in the Dravidian style of architecture, the temple is a storehouse of Nayak architecture.




