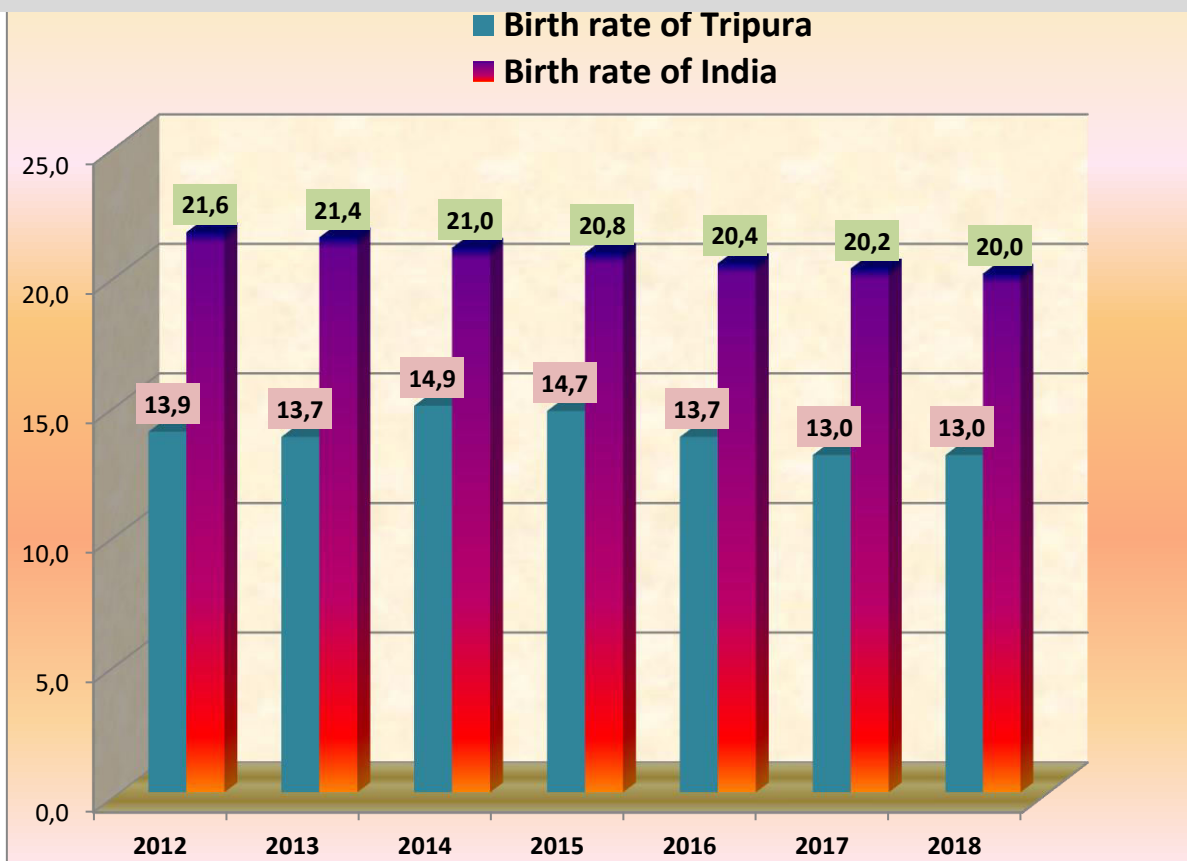

Population over the years

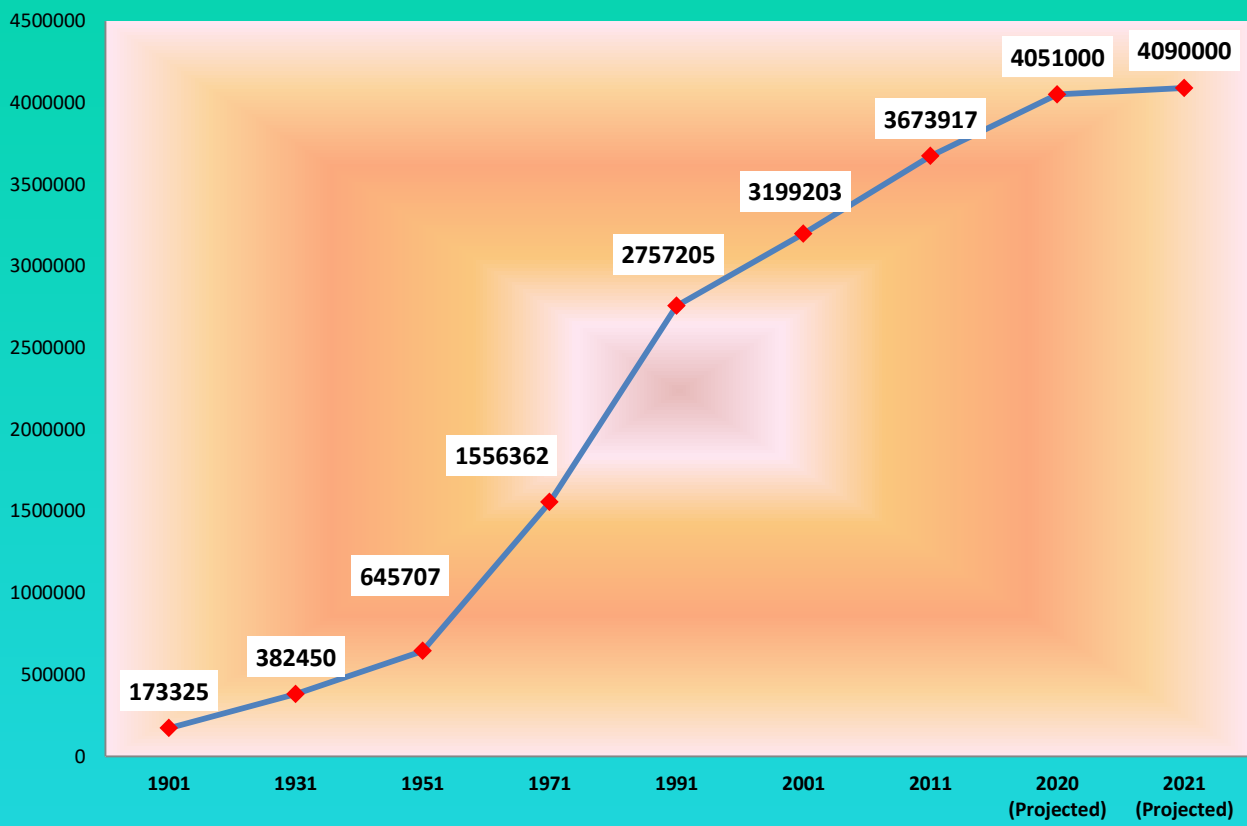
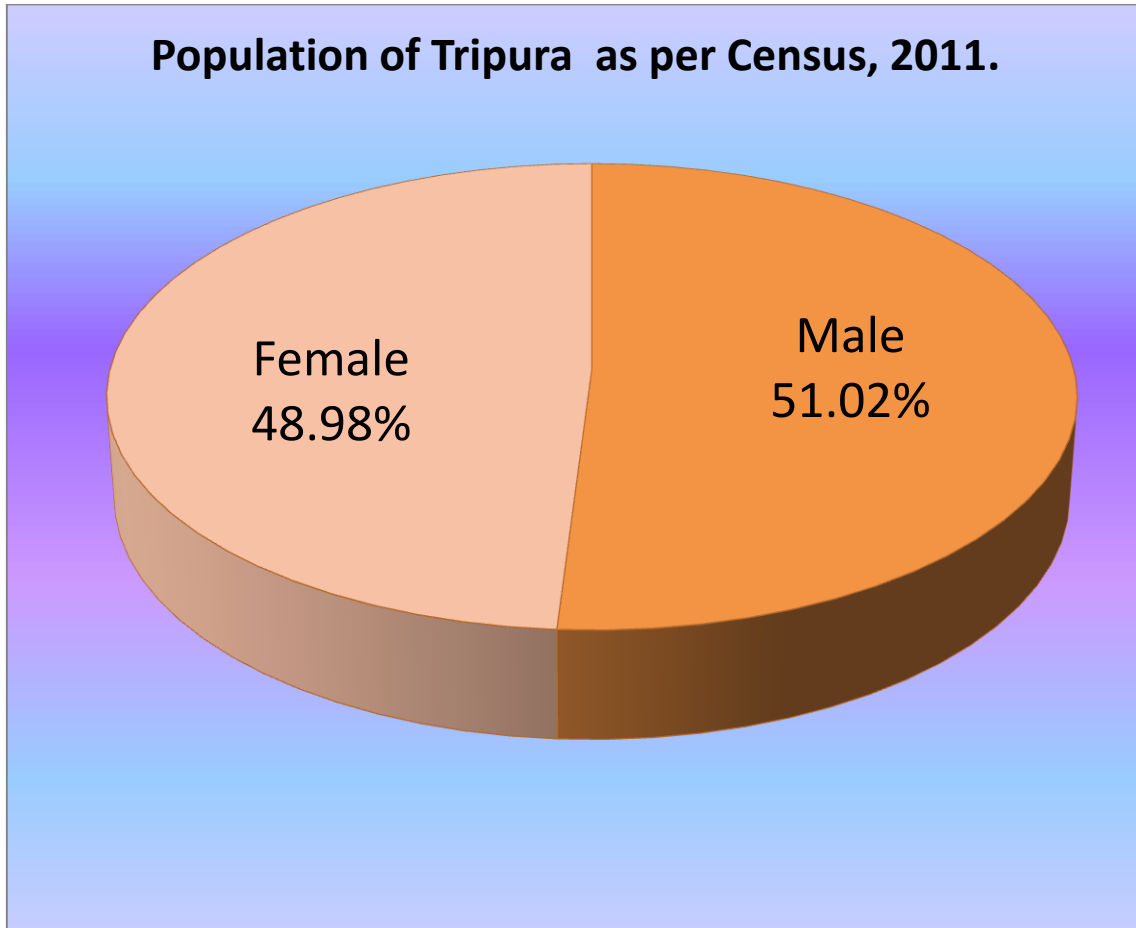

Districtwise Percentage of Literates to total Population in Tripura Census, 2011.

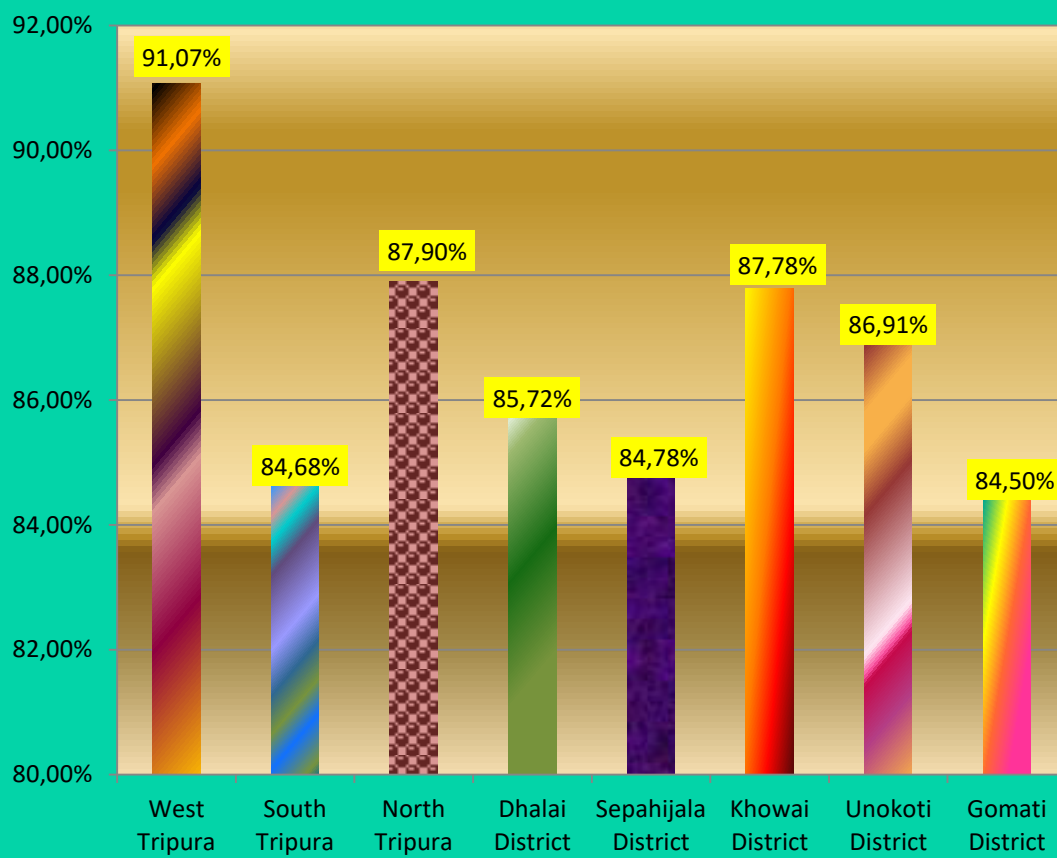
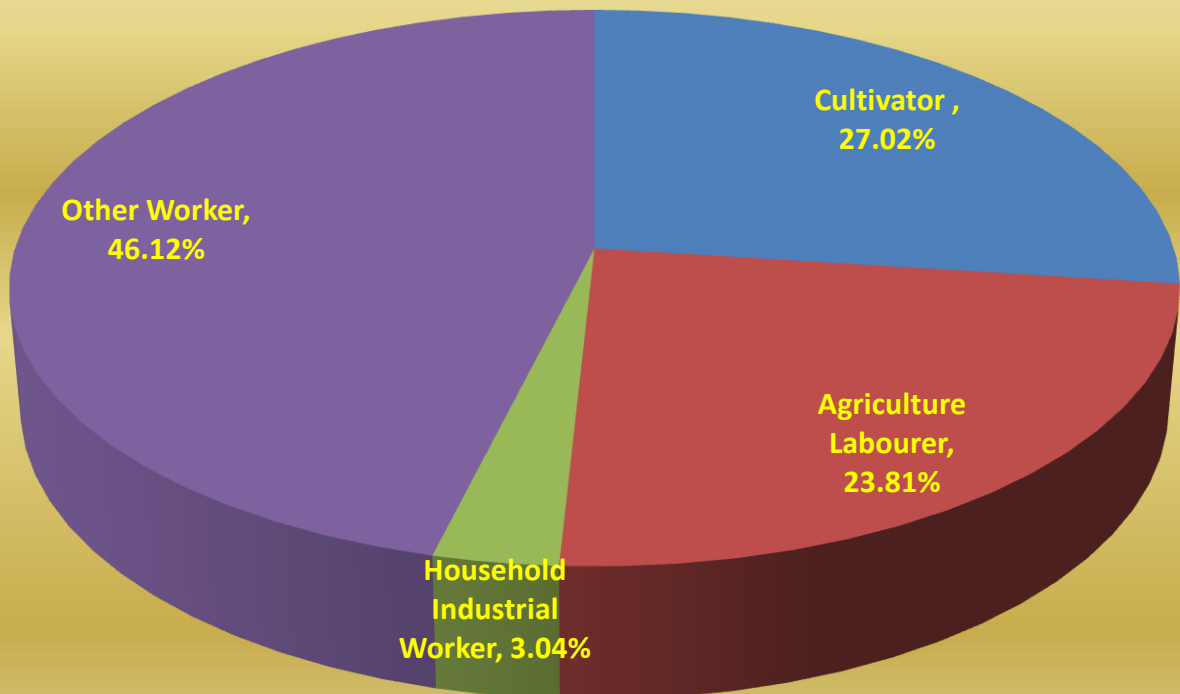


CHART -VI

Districtwise Rural and Urban Population in Tripura Based on Census 2011

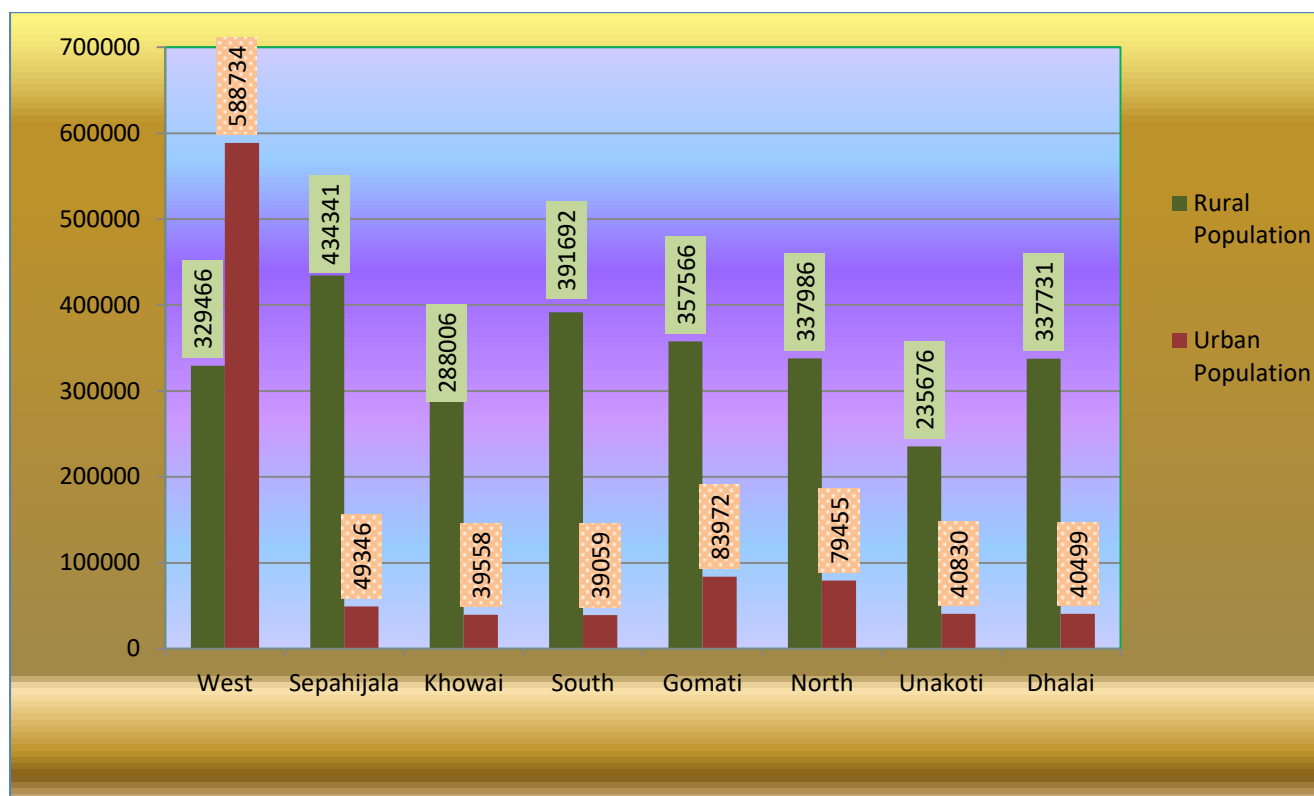

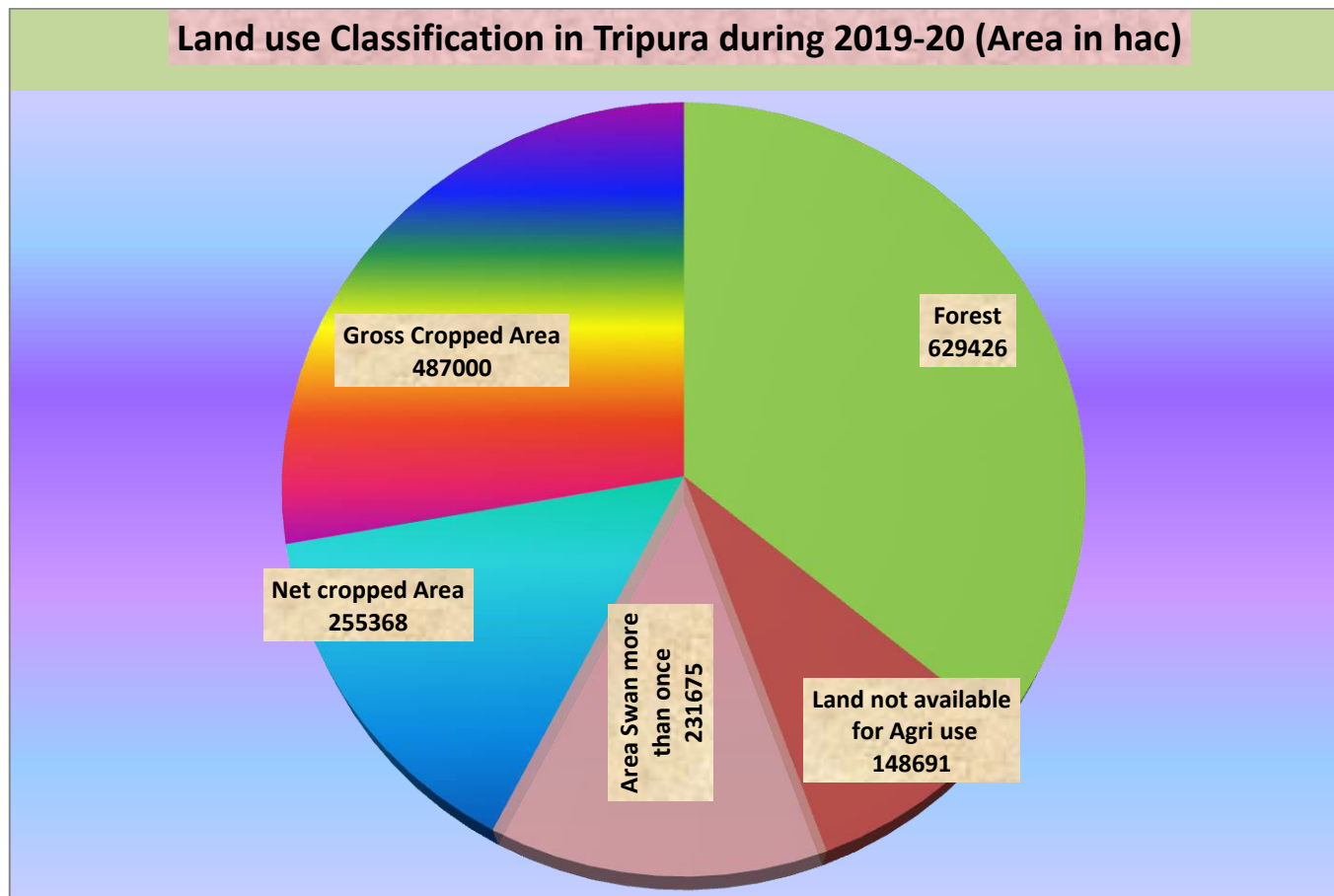

Rice Production (MT) , 2014-15 to 2019-20

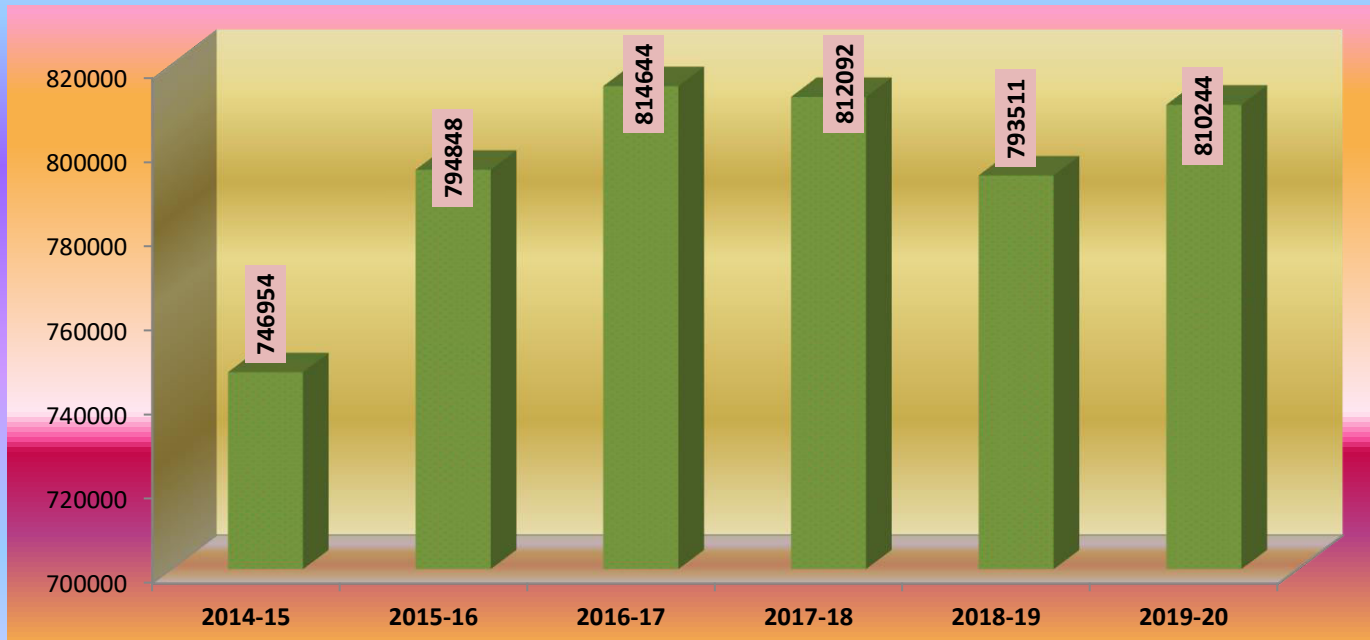

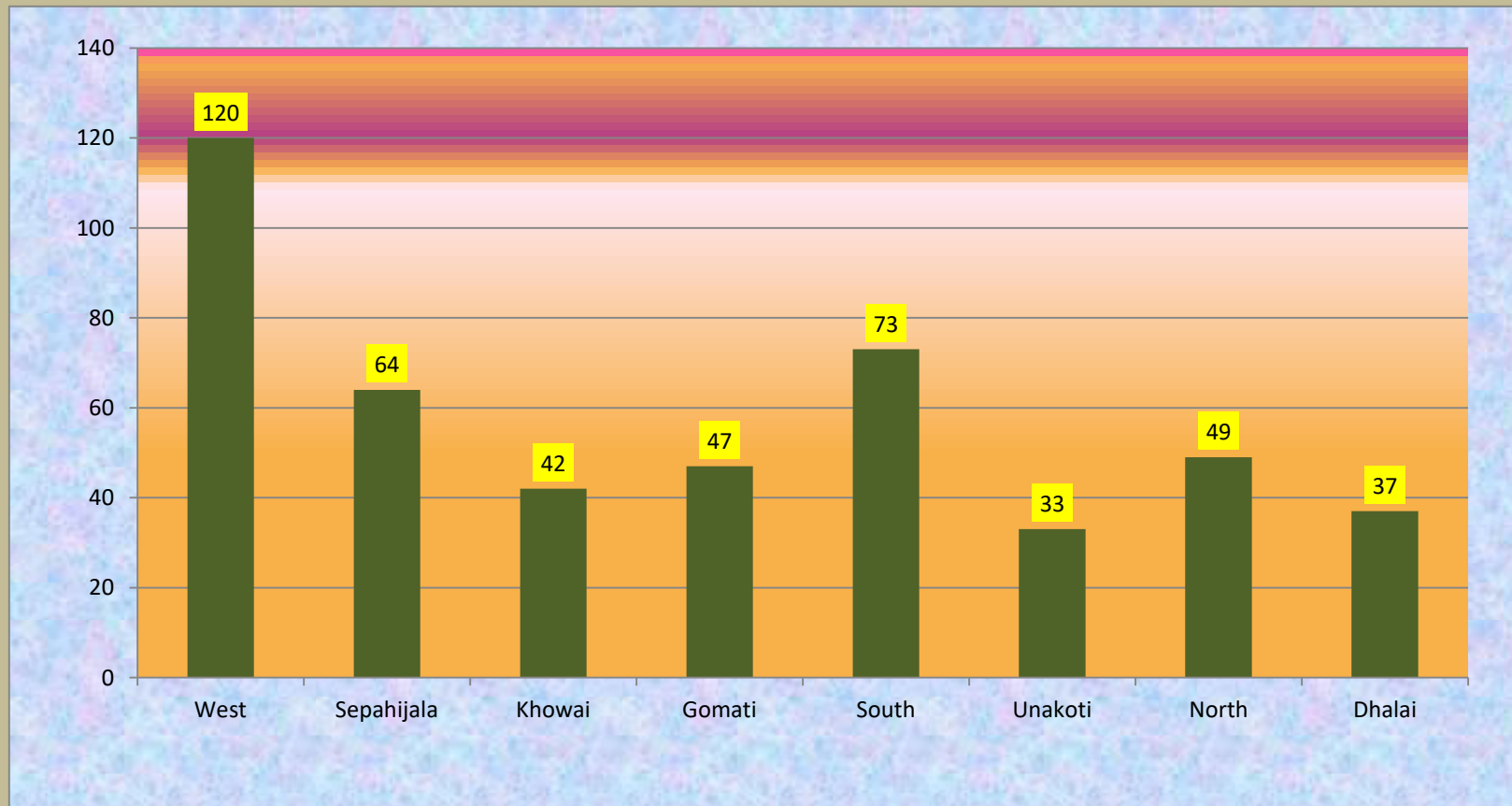

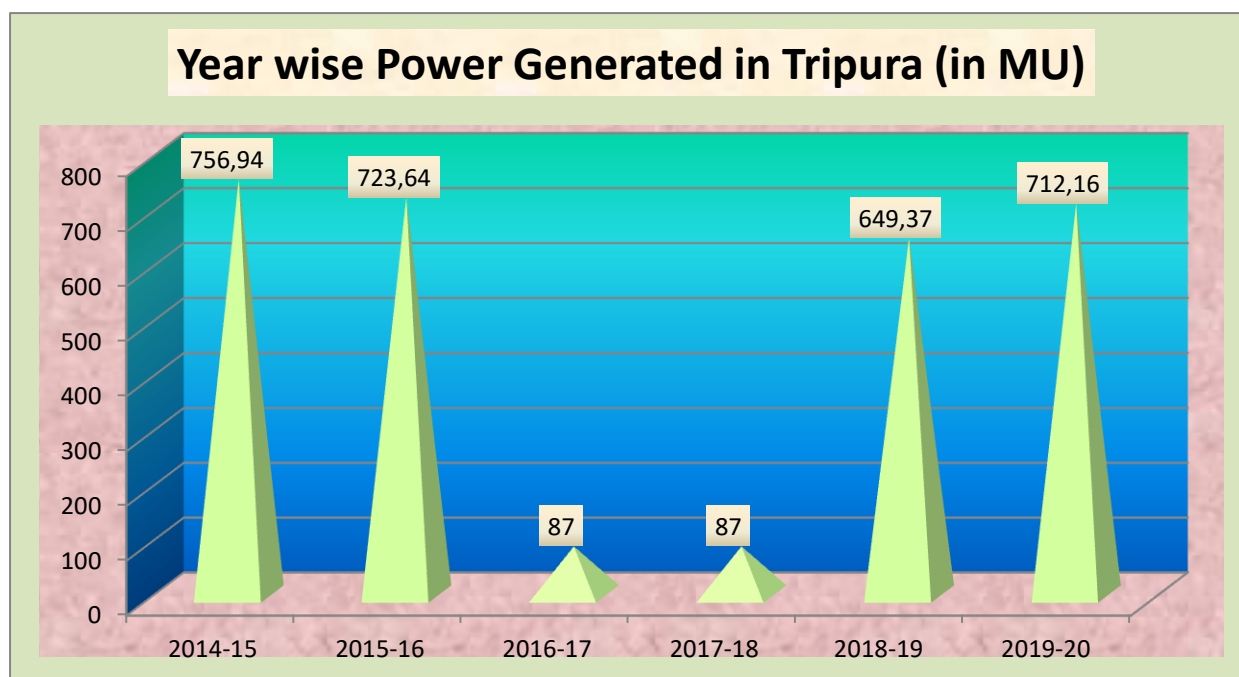

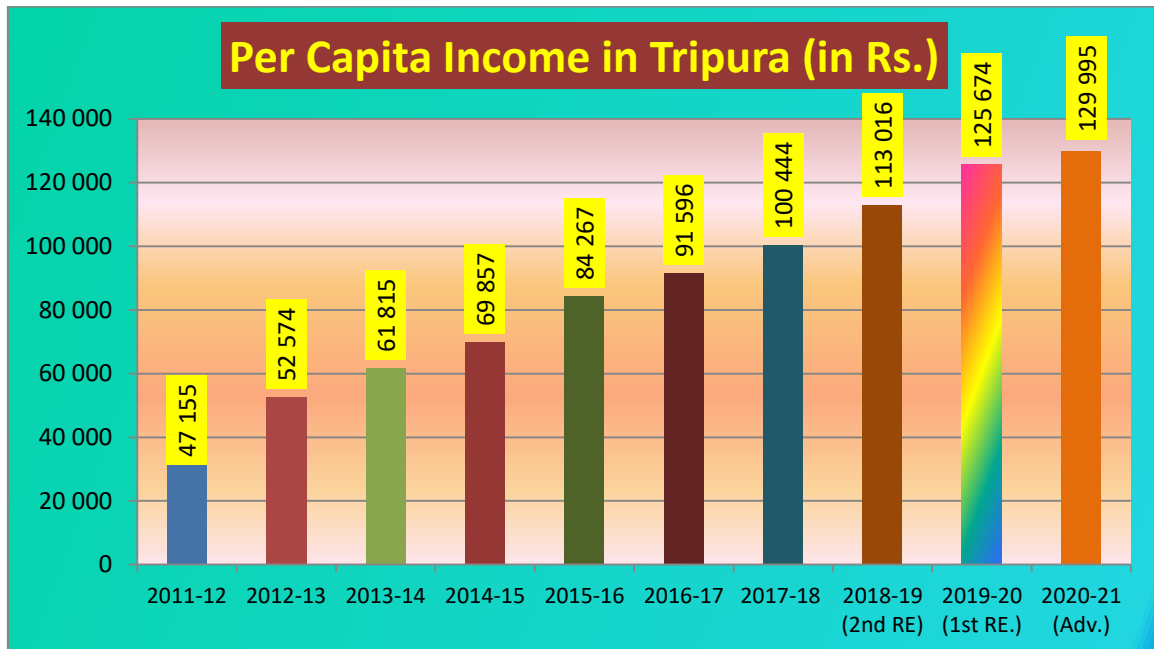
