ICICI FOUNDATION

Integrated Teacher and School Education Project

Mumbai



As a critical part of its focus area of elementary education, ICICI Foundation for Inclusive Growth (ICICI Foundation) strives to enable teaching and learning processes to move away from rote methods of instruction to interactive pedagogy to nurture creativity, learning and knowledge construction in elementary



schools. Under the reformed education programme, teachers are expected to be critical, reflective and sensitive. To support teachers in making this shift, ICICI Foundation has partnered with Muktangan for its three-year professional teacher education programme, which is aimed at improving pre-service teacher education. Muktangan is a Mumbai based NGO that addresses issues and challenges endemic to the mainstream school educational system. The strength of Muktangan lies in its unique, intensive system of teacher education where pre-service training is largely school-based, thereby integrating theory with practice.

The objective of the programme is to evolve sustainable, replicable inclusive



models of quality child-centred teacher education and school programmes in partnership with marginalised communities and to advocate them to the larger system.

The pre-service teacher training programme comprises of a one-year foundation course and internship, followed by two years of school-based residency and elective courses for aspiring teachers. These courses are in compliance with the relevant norms and policies of National Curriculum Framework (NCF 2005), Right to Education (RtE) Act, 2009 and National Curriculum Framework for Teacher Education (NCFTE), 2009. The newly trained teachers are then formally placed in Government schools where Muktangan provides ongoing classroom support.

Akshar & Saksham



AKSHAR

AKSHAR is a 6 year functional English proficiency program for children studying in Government Schools. It promotes English learning through Fun and Learn method which would in turn make the children more confident and capable to face the challenges posed by the Global Environment.

Akshar employs the natural curiosity of children and excites them about the process of learning and also encourages them to learn new concepts & ways of thinking.

Akshar is a six year program, children undergoing the program for continuous six years would be 100% functional English Proficient.

It's a fun and interactive way of learning that creates interest among children and they look forward to these sessions. The Akshar sessions also gives children the opportunity to think out of the box, put their views forward. The Akshar syllabus is exclusively developed by referring to books from a number of publishers, world over.





SAKSHAM

RPG Foundation saw the need to guide under-privileged school students to take-up technical education as an alternative to Academic/Service sector courses.

“Saksham”- making them able - is a first of its kind program under taken by a Corporate in India.

The pilot program has been launched in four Govt. Schools of Directorate of Vocational Education & Training from June 2012.

- 1) Elphinstone Technical School, Dhobi Talao, Mumbai.
- 2) RV Technical High School, Khar, Mumbai.
- 3) Government Technical School, Pune.
- 4) Government Technical School, Nagpur.

The Saksham program, adopted four schools in Maharashtra. Through a 360 degree engagement (academic; co-curricular; infra; advocacy etc), it endeavors to transform them into Model Tech Schools of India. These Schools follow the SSC

Syllabus with technical Subjects- Elements of Engineering (Mechanical & Electrical). This is a six year direct intervention program (3 + 2 + 1years) in three stages as shown:

- **At Govt. Tech Schools:** SSC + Technical subjects + others- Student mobilization. Aptitude tests, social workers home visits, attendance incentives; teacher development program; psychometric tests; soft skill training, English, remedial classes; hobby classes etc - Classes 8, 9, 10.
- **Career counseling:** admission to Plus 2(MCVC or Bi-Focal) - Continued interventions: E-Classes, counseling, Soft skill, industry visiting faculty, educational tours/films, student exchange program, specialized training. Depending on students' aptitude, we guide them into courses as diverse as Engineering, Medicine, and Fashion Designing etc.
- **A one year apprenticeship** at RPG Plants, transforms the student into an educated/ skilled technician.

(i) Need for Alignment of CSR Activities

The Education Department is responsible for management and development of the education system that covers more than one lakh schools in the state. The Department has taken up various initiatives towards building of the education system in the state so as to be able to meet its aim of providing quality education to each and every child studying in the schools. Large programs like teacher training, capacity building, promotion of vocational education, infrastructure development, facilitating schools with ICT labs, etc., have been taken up by the department during the last few years and these programs now have started to demonstrate positive results towards achieving the Departments aim.

However, the achievements attained by the department can only be considered as a stepping stone towards reaching its larger goal. A lot of work still needs to be done towards the areas of basic infrastructure development of the schools, training of teachers and ensuring that capacity building, aligning the subjects and teaching methodologies to the needs of the modern student. The challenges are great when the size and volume of schools in the state are considered. Added to this is the justified increase in expectations from the parents and the students.

The Corporates on the other hand have been doing a great job by the way of contributions through CSR especially in the area of School Education. It is the belief of the Department that there could be an impetus in the development activities concerned with the education system in the state if these independent CSR activities could get aligned to the needs of the department. Deliberations with the corporate representatives evoked positive response on the subject and a structured CSR policy from the department has been called for. A few areas that have been identified wherein the corporates can pitch in with their support are mentioned below:

CSR Activities that may be ‘point solutions’ which may be faster to implement

- Build school infrastructure (classrooms, toilets, playground, drinking water facilities, study centers, libraries, computer labs, etc.)
- Organize Sports and Health camps
- Provide student scholarships based on academic or non-academic criteria
- Provide logistics and other material support (i.e., mid-day meals, school buses, toys, uniforms, books, etc.)

- Build infrastructure of the residential hostels
- Develop and manage a competition or awards program for ‘Best Teacher’; ‘Best Head Master’; ‘Best Administrator’; ‘Best School’; etc.

CSR Activities that may be ‘system-wide solutions’ which may have longer timelines

- Establish Model Schools in various districts based on a comprehensive approach to support and improve schools including infrastructure, teacher support (training and mentorship), principal support, administrator support, curriculum matched lesson planning, continuous & comprehensive evaluation (CCE), School Management Committee (SMC), etc.
- Organize and provide support structure for counseling school children – providing guidance on studies (identifying key areas of interests/skills) as well as overall personality development
- Provide need-based teacher training and mentoring support
- Provide ICT based tools including content and appropriate training for teachers, students, head masters and administrators
- Provide assistance in delivering vocational education in schools including content, materials, infrastructure and career guidance to students based on skills/interest
- Adopt specialized schools like Shasakiya Vidya Niketans and KGBV’s
- Develop and provide teaching methods and tools for students with disabilities

(ii) CSR Policy

Based on the various inputs received through deliberations with the corporate representatives, a draft CSR policy has been prepared by the State Education Department. The policy shall create a framework to support the corporate efforts and channelize them so that they get adequate support from the government side and their contribution adds to the objectives of the department in general.

The objective of this policy would be to create a framework that shall facilitate, coordinate and monitor Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) support and activities in Maharashtra in the field of School Education.

It has been proposed that a special State CSR cell under senior Education Department official shall be created. The following shall be the key functions of the state CSR cell:

- To create a framework for management and facilitation of school related CSR activities
- To evaluate and approve requests for CSR activities in the category of system wide solutions by reviewing the need/ issues addressed as well as the proposed plan, timelines, and projected outcomes
- The cell shall facilitate execution of the CSR activities by connecting to the relevant directorates, District/Block Education Officer, Extension Officer, Cluster Head, and other relevant enablers in the School Education System
- To monitor and support the execution and completion of CSR activities
- To develop and implement actions to enable sustainability of implemented CSR activities.
- To gather and maintain appropriate reports highlighting the baseline, midline and end-line metrics achieved due to the implementation of the CSR activities
- To propose and initiate request for CSR support to augment initiatives undertaken by the School Education and Sports Department
- To publish information regarding requirements for infrastructure or other support at various schools (by district, block, cluster)
- To facilitate matching of CSR interest and need at the community/local level

(iii) Announcement of CSR activities on 1st May 2013

The State Education Department has received huge response to the idea of aligning the CSR activities of the corporate bodies with the Education Department requirements. On 1st of May 2013 on the auspicious occasion of Maharashtra Day few of the corporates shall kick start the aligned CSR activities in various schools of the state.

We are extremely pleased to announce the below activities taken up by reputed organizations in accordance with the needs of the Education:

1. RPG GROUP

Besides the Akshar and Saksham Programs that the company has been already running in over 60 schools across the country, a special initiative of setting up of libraries in two schools has been announced to begin with. The two schools that have been chosen for this intervention are:

- a. Ashram School at Bhiwandi – Vasai Highway
- b. The Worli Municipal School, Mumbai

2. LARSEN & TOUBRO LTD.

Larsen and Toubro Charitable trust besides their regular activities through the Vidya Project, shall initiate interventions like Providing Drinking Water Facilities, Construction of Girls Toilet, Purchase Books for Library, etc in 16 Schools of the state. The schools that the company has chosen to work in are in the distant tribal regions of Maharashtra. A few of these schools are mentioned below:

3. ICICI FOUNDATION

ICICI Foundation intends to work towards teacher preparation and professional development as per National Curriculum Framework, 2005 and Right to Education, 2009 in two Raigad Zila Parishad schools. One school is located in Tara village and the other is in Palaspe town. Both, these schools were mentioned in the list circulated by Dr. Suvama S. Kharat. The schools were selected post a visit by the Foundation staff and interaction with the school Head Master and teachers. The details about the intervention are in the process of being finalised.

The names of the schools are :

- a. Raigad Z.P. School Tara
- b. Raigad Z.P. School Palaspe

{ School Leadership Development

Developing leadership capacity of school headteachers and officials in Maharashtra



School Leadership is part of the state government's overall initiative to bring about a step change in the quality of the school education system and deliver a more effective and rigorously monitored programme of leadership development for school officials at all levels including schools, blocks and districts. Leadership development of headteachers and school officials will be a significant component of the newly launched CSR initiative to be delivered through CSR support, with the

British Council as the lead content and training partner.

It is hoped that as a result of this leadership programme, the headteachers and the school officials will gain new knowledge, acquire new skills and develop confidence to be able to apply the learning in their individual spheres of work to make a significant contribution to the quality improvement of the state's school education system.

The key objectives of the leadership development programme will be:

- To equip school headteachers and school officials in leadership roles with core leadership skills for positive transformation and quality improvement of the schools and the teams they lead
- To use an integrated approach for involving school professionals at different levels of leadership in a district to develop a common understanding of leadership standard's and develop leadership capacity for shared responsibility and collective action for quality improvement
- To provide enabling stimulus for the district teams to plan and implement a leadership change project that helps in addressing their specific need for quality improvement at the school, block and district level.

The leadership development programme will use an integrated approach by bringing together the Education Officers at district and block levels along with a group of school headteachers to a common training programme. Though the specific goals and objectives for the different levels of participants will be distinct, the entire unit will have the opportunity to examine common leadership challenges, collectively review the major gaps in quality areas within the district, create a common unified vision for school quality improvement and agree action plans which demonstrate linkages between the different levels.



The programme will be implemented in a phased manner which will include face to face training (Phase 1) in a residential environment and a small-sized manageable leadership change project (Phase 2) to be designed and implemented within the district during the period before the second face to face training (Phase 3). The participants will present their change projects for peer review and formal assessment during Phase 3.

It is envisaged that the state department will provide a formal recognition for the leadership development programme and will also explore avenues for embedding the programme as part of a formal qualification for potential/ new headteachers and education officers. Further, the state could consider instituting a District Leadership Award for innovative school leadership change projects.

British Council and leadership development

With an experience in the school sector spanning over 12 years and a strong track record of delivering global school programmes such as Connecting Classrooms, Global School Partnerships, International School Award, UKIERI, English Partnerships, the British Council has developed a suite of leadership modules for current and prospective school leaders who may have qualifications and experience, but no formal leadership training. Working closely with school sector experts from organisations such as the National College of Teaching and Leadership (erstwhile National College of School Leadership) and experienced headteachers, the leadership programme is designed to significantly improve the standard and performance of leadership in schools.
