[8th August, 1986]
An Act further to am:nd the Andhra University, Sri Venkateswara University, The Osmania University, The Nagariuna University, The Kakatiya University, Sri Krishna Devarayan University, The Andhra Pradesh Open University, Sri Padmavathi Mahila Viswavidyalayam and the Telugu University Acts.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Andhra Pradesh in the Thirty-seventh Year of the Republic of India as follows:
