

INTRODUCTION

While growth and economic development are matters of paramount concern, particularly of the developing societies, the complexities of the components and processes governing them and the indicators to measure progress are not easily understood. There is no universal unanimity on what constitutes development. The components also change from time to time, as the societies progress and value systems change. There have been historical shifts in the importance of market forces and government in the process of economic growth and development. At the present juncture, need for effective government intervention is being widely recognised, though the exact nature of intervention will vary from country to country. Planning has been one such government intervention in India.

As part of planning process, we have been analysing the present status, setting the objectives and goals, determining indicators, formulating strategies and finally measuring the progress. Along with growth, the societies also seek minimisation of inter-personal and inter-regional inequalities, so that all sections of society lead quality life and increase their access to resources, skill, knowledge, better health, services provisioned under different schemes, so on and so forth. Hence it is imperative to pay attention to drawing a linkage between the micro and macro determinates of growth and development, with simultaneous focus on equity and equality of opportunity. In spite of launching and implementation of various programmes and schemes aiming at equality in all spheres of life, the fact remains that regional disparities persist across states. There is wide Intra-State disparity of incomes also.

The goals of governments at various levels are set in a context. For example, a developing country looks at the attainments of the developed world; a backward state within the country seeks to achieve what has already been achieved by developed states more than a decade back or even the national average. Similarly, a backward district of a large state tends to compare its levels with the developed district in its neighbourhood. India is such a vast country that its states are compared to bigger countries. In such a situation, we should not be surprised if some of the Indian states strive to achieve and target the developed world. Another dimension of the issue is that a state or a district may be an achiever in some

indicators while at the same time lagging in certain other aspects. This is because all territories operate in a particular socio-cultural context.

To make the development and planning process more and more participative, efforts have recently been initiated to involve the communities in general and Panchayati Raj representatives in particular. To make the planning exercise intelligible to the common masses and public representatives, and to help them appreciate the regional dimensions of growth and development in its various facets, an effort has been made to capture various indicators in both figures and maps. The Planning Atlas has tried to measure the existing inequities at national, state and district level on important socio-economic and development indicators. It is hoped that it will provide a basis for better formulation of strategies and re-setting of priorities both at the state and district level.

The planning Atlas has two clearly discernible parts.

Part I : State -wise position on important indicators

Part II : District- wise position on important indicators

A total of 44 indicators have been selected for inter-state comparisons, whereas districts of Bihar have been ranked and categorized on 84 indicators. They do not capture the entire gamut, because any such attempt at documentation has to resort to prioritization, partly because of availability of comparable data but also because of limitations of space. Utmost care has been taken to provide updated, reliable & corrected information as far as possible.

Devinfo software has been used for making maps from the available data. Since the .SHP file (for making map) of Arwal district is not available, we have added the data of Arwal district in the data of Jehanabad district, as the mother district of Arwal was Jehanabad.

Data for this publication has been sourced from the Census of India, Agriculture Census, Economic Census and statistical Abstract of India published by Central Statistical Organization, All India Economic Census, District Level Household Survey – III, National Family Health Survey, Directorate of Economics and Statistics and several departments of the State Government.

Planning is such a vast exercise that there are infinite dimensions of works involved in facilitating the planning process. 




























































































































