The Vice-Chancellor shall be appointed on such terms and conditions as may be prescribed by the statutes for a term of five years by the Chancellor.

- If in the opinion of the Vice-Chancellor any decision of any authority of the University is outside the powers conferred by this Act, Statutes or is likely to be prejudicial to the interest of the University, he shall request the concerned authority to revise its decision within seven days from the date of his decision and in case the authority refuses to revise such decision wholly or partly or fails to take any decision within seven days, then such matter shall be referred to the Chancellor and his decision thereon shall be final.
- (6) The Vice-Chancellor shall exercise such other powers and perform such other duties as may be laid down by the Statutes or the Rules.
- (7) The Vice-Chancellor shall preside at the convocation of the University in the absence of both Visitor and Chancellor and Chairman of the sponsoring Body, for conferring degrees, diplomas, Designations or Certificates.
- (8) The Chancellor is empowered to remove the Vice-Chancellor after due enquiry. It will be open to the Chancellor to suspend the Vice-Chancellor during enquiry depending upon the seriousness of the charges, as he may deem fit.
