P R E F A C E

This publication is 4th in the series. The reference date for the collection of data of this brochure is 30th Sept., 1972. Some of the States, however, have furnished data as on 31st March, 1972. The object of bringing out this brochure is to make available some latest data on selected items in respect of Educational Statistics at an early date. In an attempt to make this publication available quickly the data is not fully reconciled and may, therefore, be treated as provisional.

2. The statistics given in this brochure have been compiled from the returns received from the State Governments and Union Territories as well as some material already available in the Statistics and Information Division of this Ministry. However, the requisite information for this publication has not been received from West Bengal and, therefore, information pertaining to the previous year available in this Ministry has been shown against that State. The data on population included in this publication has been obtained from the Office of the Registrar General of Census, India. The gaps in the data, wherever the requisite information was not available, have been filled by estimating or giving the figures of the ~~preceding~~ years.

3. Since it is proposed to discontinue our publication 'Selected Educational Statistics', the important items of that publication also have been included in this brochure. However, the complete information about enrolment of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes has not been received with the result that it has not been possible to collect figures for this item on all-India basis. So information in respect of those States only which have supplied information on this item has been included in this brochure.

4. The Ministry of Education and Social Welfare highly appreciates the assistance of the Directorates of Education of all States and Union Territories and other Agencies who supplied data and made it possible for us to bring out this brochure.

5. I would like to place on record the good work done by Shri S.S. Chandi, Senior Investigator and Shri V.P. Pasrija, Statistical Assistant in collecting and compiling the data for this brochure under the able guidance of Mrs. V.Bhushan, Deputy Director and Shri G.Khurana, Assistant Education Officer.

ABSTRACT

1. Population: The estimated population of India in 1972 was 559 million of which about 45 million belonged to age-group 6-11, 40 million to age-group 11-14 and 36 million to age-group 14-17.
2. Institutions: There was almost no discernable increase in the number of educational institutions. Table I below gives a comparative position of selected types of institutions in 1971 and 1972.

3. Enrolments: The number of students in classes I-V and VI-VIII increased from 59.35 million and 134.44 million in 1971 to 61.43 million and 140.92 million respectively in 1972. Although there was an apparent slight decrease in the number of students in school classes IX and above i.e., from 7.28 million in 1971 to 7.08 million in 1972, yet the decrease was mainly due to inclusion of the enrolment of intermediate classes (Classes IX & XII) of U.P. in the enrolment in 1971 whereas in 1972, in case of U.P., the enrolment of classes IX-X only has been included under school classes IX and above and those of classes XI & XII has been included under Intermediate in Arts and Sciences. Table 2 below shows the percentage of children in classes I-V, VI-VIII & IX and above to the corresponding age-groups.

The enrolment ratio in respect of class's IX and above in 1971 was worked out uniformly in respect of all States with the age-group 14-17 whereas in 1972 the enrolment ratio has been worked out with the corresponding age-groups, for example two years (14-16) in case of U.P. where the enrolment of class's IX & X only has been taken and 4 years (15-18) in case of Assam where the enrolment in classes IX to XII has been taken into account.

**4. Teachers:-** The number of teachers in middle and high/higher secondary schools increased from 6.06 lakhs and 5.37 lakhs in 1971 to 6.71 lakhs and 6.30 lakhs respectively in 1972. There was a slight decrease in the number of teachers in primary schools from 11.12 lakhs in 1971 to 10.97 lakhs in 1972. This decrease was on account of more middle sections being attached to middle and high/higher secondary schools. However, the number of teachers in all types of schools for general education increased from 23.26 lakhs (17.76 lakh men & 5.50 lakh women) in 1971, to 23.87 lakhs (18.13 lakh men & 5.74 lakh women) in 1972, the rate of increase being 2.6 percent. The percentage trained teachers in primary, middle and high/higher secondary schools w.r.t. 82.6, 85.1 & 78.6 respectively.

**5. Budget Provision:-** The total budgeted expenditure on education for all States and Union Territories increased from Rs.1000.12 crores in 1971-72 to 1093.86 crores in 1972-73 giving an increase of 9.4 percent. The percentage of budgeted expenditure on education to total State budget ranged from 11.3 percent in J&K to 36.8 percent in Kerala in respect of States and from 6.0 percent in Arunachal Pradesh, to 38.3 percent in Delhi in case of Union Territories. The per capita budgeted expenditure on education was the lowest in Bihar (Rs.10.3) and the highest in Haryana (Rs.69.4) in respect of State Governments, and the lowest in Mizoram (Rs.6.6) and the highest in Chandigarh (Rs.90.9) in respect of Union Territories.
