

The OPERATION BLACK BOARD Programme as an adjunct to the fulfilment of the gaals of achieving universalisation of Elementary Education in conformity with 'he National Policy on Education 1986, envisages providing schooling facilities to all the Primary Schools in the country.

In Karnataka, as per the guidelines given by the Government of India, 36 blocks have been selected and the focus is on all Lower Primary Schools. This project includes all primary schools under 36 blocks covering different aspects of providing facilities like accomodation, teachers, learning materials and other ancillary facilities to provide a congenial learning atmosphere for the children in the schools.

The Scheme for implementing the Operation Black Board

Introduction

In the conference of Education Secretaries and Directors of Education held on 25th April 1987 at New Delhi the scheme Operation Black Board was discussed. This scheme envisages to provide every Primary School in the Country with the minimum facilities considered essential for improvement in the quality of education—school building with separate toilets for boys and girls, additional teacher in single teacher schools, furniture and learning and teaching material. During the year 1987-88 the provision of these essential facilities is limited to 20 per cent of the blocks/ municipal areas:

The National Policy on Education 1986 and the Programme of Action also emphasises the importance of this scheme with a view to achieve universalisation of elementary education.

In Karnataka as on to-day there are 38,396 primary schools in the State with an enrolment of over 59.02 lakhs children. The number of class-rooms has not kept pace with the increased enrolment. Of these Primary Schools there are 14,180 single teacher schools. There is wide gap between physical facilities necessary and physical facilities available. In many a places, schools are now being run on adhoc basis in temples or the thatched sheds and in the open places, namely, under the trees. These conditions are not at all conducive to the Universalisation of Elementary Education.

Besides the issue of lack of accommodation there are other lacuna in the system, they are :

(i) Single Teacher Schools have got only one teacher which is very detrimental to provide adequate learning facility to all the children that come to the school;

(ii) There are no adequate equipments;

(iii) The children have got no furniture to sit;

Hence it is a case of almost a crisis where we have to pay our immediate attention for providing minimum essential facilities. Among other things, the national policy on education lays emphasis on not only mobilising resources already available but also to enlist the active community participation in providing these facilities. Thus has emerged the scheme Operation Black Board which contemplates to provide these facilities on a priority basis.

During the year 1987-88, 20 per cent of the blocks are contemplated to be covered. Subsequently 30 per cent during 1988-89 and the remaining 50 per cent during the year 1989-90.

During the year 1987-88, 36 blocks/taluks in Karnataka State have been selected to implement the scheme—Operation Black Board. Care has been taken to see that no District is ignored and while selecting the talukas, the guidelines given by the Government of India have been adhered to.

Having selected the talukas, survey has been conducted to pool the existing facilities in the schools based on which the requirements are assessed.

Objectives

The major objectives of the scheme—Operation Black Board are as below :---

(i) To provide at least one more room to every single teacher school where there is already one room;

(ii) To provide atleast 2 rooms to each of the primary schools where there is no room at all;

(iii) To provide one additional teacher to all the single teacher schools in the project area;

(iv) To provide teaching/learning materials in the form of black board, chalks, science equipments, teaching aids, teaching materials, audio-visual equipment;

(v) To provide furniture to all the students in the primary schools;

(vi) To provide sanitary facilities to all the primary schools.

The class-rooms proposed would have dimension $25' \times 15'$. The estimated cost for a class-room is Rs 52,000 on an average. Karnataka has wide range of clumatic conditions from the Hilly rainfall areas to some arid planes. The type of class-room buildings best suited to each area has been identified and suitable type-designs prepared.

The sitting arrangements for children will be at the rate of 4 children per bench.

The other equipment that is needed at minimum for every school has been identified and proposed.

Location of the Project

The Operation Black Board is going to be implemented in 36 selected talukas of the State.

Existing Position

In the 36 talukas there are 4975 Lower Primary Schools i.e., I to IV standards. Out of these 3277 are single-teacher-scho 1s. Total number of sections in all these Lower Primary Schools 19868. Out of the 3277 single-teacher-schools at present, 2937 have rooms.

Similarly the existing number of teachers is 3277.

The requirements vis-a-vis the existing availability is reflected in the individual sheets for the talukas.

As envisaged in the Operation Black Board, it is very neccessary to provide the minimum essential facilities so as to create a permissive learning environment in the schools. The major objectives are :

(1) To provide one more room in all single teacher schools where there is one room and to provide at least two rooms in the schools where there is no room. Similarly to provide one room per class in the multi-teacher Lower Primary Schools depending upon the existing facility;

(2) To provide one additional teacher for every single-teacher-school;

(3) To provide the teaching equipments, such as, black-board, chalk, duster, teachers' guides etc.;

(4) To provide benches to all the students;

(5) To provide furniture for teachers and storage equipment to all the schools;

(6) To provide drinking water facilities and electricity;

(7) To provide sports and play materials;

(8) To provide learning material and audio-visual aids;

(9) To provide Science kit ;

(10) To provide for contingent charges.

Survey

In the beginning the protorma designed by the N.C.E.R.T. was translated into Kannada and the Assistant Educational Officers from all the 36 talukas were briefed and given adequate training regarding collection of information.

The Assistant Educational Officers were also directed to get adequate number of these proformae printed and collect the information in triplicate from all the primary schools.

Survey Analysis

18 A. 18 . . .

The information so collected was brought to the headquarters and compilation was made in the headquarters. The compilation was made in three different stages. The proforma was designed to assess schoolwise information from each taluka regarding the existing available facilities. In the second stage, based on the existing facilities, requirements were assessed and the approximate cost was also worked out. The cost pattern is as below :---

(1) Rs. 52,000 per class room. This class-room will be all-weather-conditioned. Rs. 52,000 is the average cost per room; each room will be measuring $25' \times 15'$ with a verandah of 6 feet on one side.

(2) Sanitary facilities including separate urinals/lavotaties for boys and girls at a cost of Rs. 6,000 per unit has been provided.

(3) Drinking water facilities—Only storage facilities have been provided, presuming that there is source of water at the nearest point to the school, such as draw-wells, bore-wells or taps.

(4) It is proposed to provide one more teacher to all the single teacher schools. The approximate cost is Rs. 18,000 per annum.

(5) Each school will be provided with one black board per section, one bell, chalks, duster, one trash can per section, one almirah per school. The cost of the items is appended.

(6) Each class-room will be provided with one chair, one table and benches at the rate of 4 students per bench will be provided.

(7) Each school will be provided with Rs. 5,000 for purchase of books both for teachers and children.

(8) Each school will be provided with a set of musical instruments costing Rs. 3,000. This set contains one harmonium, one set of tabala, and one set of thampura.

(9) Each school will have a provision of Rs. 5,000 for contingencies.

(10) Regarding teaching materials, the following are proposed to be provided :---

Teachers guide for every teacher;

One set of 10 maps to each school;

One globe to each school;

One set of 10 charts to each school;

One primary school science kit costing Rs. 5,000;

One mini-tool kit costing Rs. 1,000;

A provision of Rs. 500 for magazines and journals : and One two-in-one equipment costing Rs. 1,800.

(11) Similar play-materials and toys such as wisdom blocks, surface tansion toys, magnifying glass, one set of balance and weights, one magnet per section, one measuring tape per school will be provided.

(12) Under games equipments, ten skipping ropes per school, one foot ball, one volley ball, one rubber ball, one air pump 10 rings and one swing will be provided.

Project reports pertaining to each taluka are also appended.

Funding

As envisaged in the scheme for implementation of Operation Black Board, 100 per cent assistance is available from the Central Government towards the salary component on teachers and learning and teaching material.

The construction cost is to be drawn from the NREP and RLEGP funds.

Implementation Strategies

(1) **Teachers.**—The State Government will create an equal number of posts for Primary School Teachers in single teacher schools as are required to provide one additional teacher to every single teacher school.

Arrangements for recruitment of teachers will be made through D.L.R.Cs. in the Ristricts where the talukas are located in the project area.

(2) Class rooms.—The State Level Committee for the coordinating NREP and RLEGP meets would allot a portion of the funds available for class rooms. Then districtwise need is decided. The allocation would be made to Zilla Parishad. The Chief Secretaries of Zilla Parishad will be requested to utilise funds available under RLEGP and NREP programmes to construct the required number of clas-rooms. Instructions from the Government also will be issued to release these funds.

(3) Aids/equipment.—The learning/teaching material, furniture, storage equipment wil be purchased through any one of the following procedures.

(a) through the approved firms under the rate contract as per Stores Purchase Department regulations of the State Government;

(b) the Industrial Training Institutions and polytechnics where these materials will be available will also be tapped to supply the materials;

(c) by calling tenders from renowned firms who are in a position to supply the material in bulk and also subject to the condition that the talukawise supplies are made at the Assistant Educational Officer's Office.

(4) Monitoring and Supervision.—The entire programme of implementing Operation Black Board requires timely supervision, monitoring and accounting. Therefore an infrastructure in the office

of the Commissioner for Public Instruction is very necessary. This infrastructure for such a monitoring system is suggested as below:

(i) One officer of the rank of Deputy Director of Public Instruction who will not only monitor and supervise Operation Black Board programme; but also look after the implementation of the several programmes under National Policy on Education.

(ii) Two officers of the cadre of Junior Class I Officers (Education Officer/Senior Assistant Director of Public Instruction) to assist the Deputy Director of Public Instruction.

(iii) Supporting clerical staff consisting of : one stenographer, two first division assistants and two second division assistants to maintain the office. The cost statement will be submitted later.

The project reports in respect of each taluka are appended to this report.
