## S U M M A R Y

This Brochure gives the educational statistics - some important items - at the all-India level and also for the States and Union Territories for the year 1968-69 as on 1st August, 1968.

2. The following statistics pertaining to 1968-69 are important. The number of institutions was as under:-

(1) Primary/Junior Basic Schools	3,99,109
(2) Middle/Senior Basic Schools	83,943
(3) High/Higher secondary/Post Basic Schools	32,433
(4) Colleges of Arts, Science and Commerce	2,163
(5) Teacher Training Colleges and Schools	1,653

3. The enrolment in the school stage was 54.2 million in classes I-V, 12.4 million in classes VI-VIII and 6.2 million in classes IX and above. In B.A., B.Sc., B.Com., Pass and Honours courses the total enrolment was 10.3 lakhs and in M.A., M.Sc. and M.Com. courses the enrolment was 1.11 lakhs. The enrolment in I.A., I.Sc., I.Com. and Pre-University classes in Arts, Science and Commerce was 8.34 lakhs. The enrolment in Teacher Training Schools and Colleges was 2.09 lakhs.

4. The total number of teachers in all types of general school education institutions was 21.36 lakhs; 22.9% of them were women and 75.9% were trained.
