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PREFACE

"Education of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes" is an annual publication brought out by the Department of Education, Ministry of Human Resource Development. It contains numerical data of 1988-89, on scheduled castes and scheduled tribes at school level.

The educational development of these communities, as shown in this publication, indicates increase in the enrolment of the children belonging to these communities in various type of educational institutions at school level, right from the pre-primary to senior secondary. In addition, detailed data relating to teachers belonging to scheduled castes and scheduled tribes have also been incorporated. The demographic data included in this publication are based on the census data relating to 1991 census.

While every care has been taken to make this publication as accurate as possible, suggestions for improvement and corrections if any, will be welcomed. It is hoped that this publication will be useful for educational planners and policy makers as well as to those engaged in research & development and are interested in studying the educational aspects of these communities.

I would like to place on record my thanks for the cooperation extended by the States/UT Administrations in supplying the relevant data for this publication. It would, however, be necessary to accelerate the pace of data collection and compilation so that latest data are available to facilitate educational planning. I would, therefore, appeal to all States/UT Administrations to bestow their cooperation in the efforts to reduce the time lag, by giving data collection and compilation a very high priority.

I would also like to place on record my appreciation for the efforts made by the Project staff of the SC/ST Cell and NIC in bringing out this Publication.

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INTRODUCTION

Article 46 of the Constitution states that "The State shall promote with special care the educational and economic interests of the weaker sections of the people, and, in particular of the Scheduled Castes and Schedule Tribes, and shall protect them from social injustice and all forms of social exploitation." Articles 330, 332, 335, 338 to 342 and the entire Fifth and Sixth Schedules of the Constitution deal with special provisions for implementation of the objectives set forth in Article 46. These provisions need to be fully utilized for the benefit of these weakest sections in our society.

After independence, the Government of India have taken a number of steps to strengthen the educational base of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes. Provision of educational institutions on priority basis in the areas predominantly inhabited by these communities provision of incentives like scholarships, freeships, mid-day meals, uniforms, books and stationery, reservation of seats in educational institutions, relaxation of standards for admission to institutions of higher learning, provision of coaching classes for competitive examinations, remedial coaching, and provision of hostels are some of the steps which have contributed a great deal in raising the educational levels of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes.

But these communities still have to go a long way to come-up to the level of other communities in the field of educational development.

Apart from other disparities, there are some special problems involved in the educational development of these communities which are mostly socio-economic. Although the educational facilities have been extended to almost all the habitations of these communities, they are still not able to utilise these facilities fully mainly on account of their socio-economic backwardness. With the introduction of Special Component Plan for Scheduled Castes and Tribal Sub-Plan for Scheduled Tribes, it is hoped that their socio-economic status will improve further and this will have a positive impact on the educational development of these communities. However, it is observed that in education sector, the present quantum of incentives provided to the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes for improving their participation and retention has been inadequate in achieving the objectives.

Various programmes have been included in the Eighth Five Year Plan for improving the situation; and, it is hoped that, as a result of these programmes the participation and retention of the children belonging to these communities will improve significantly.

GENERAL REVIEW

1. POPULATION PROFILE

(a) Scheduled Castes

As per 1991 census, the population of scheduled castes is 13.82 crores amounting to 16.33% of the country's total population of 84.63 crores. Out of total scheduled caste population, the male population is 7.19 crores and female population is 6.63 crores which accounts for 16.38% and 16.29% respectively of the country's total population of respective groups. In the States/UTs of Nagaland, A & N Island and Lakshadweep, the scheduled caste population is nil, and in Arunachal Pradesh, Meghalaya, Mizoram, D & N Haveli and Daman & Diu, the scheduled caste population is less than 10,000 while in Andhra Pradesh, Bihar, Tamil Nadu, Uttar Pradesh and West-Bengal it is more than one crore. The scheduled castes form more than 20% of the total population in the states of Himachal Pradesh, Uttar Pradesh, Punjab and West Bengal. The details of the scheduled castes population is given in Table 1.

(b) Scheduled Tribes

The population of scheduled tribes, as per the 1991 census is 6.77 crores accounting for 8.01% of the country's total population. Out of the total scheduled tribe population, males are 3.4 crores and females 3.3 crores, which accounts for 7.8% and 8.2% respectively of the country's total population of the respective groups. There are no scheduled tribes in the states of Haryana, Punjab, Chandigarh, Delhi, and Pondicherry. The 1991

SC/ST POPULATION AS PER 1991 CENSUS



census could not be held in Jammu & Kashmir. The scheduled tribe population in Goa is less than 10,000. In Madhya Pradesh scheduled tribe population is more than one crore. The Scheduled Tribe population in the states of Arunachal Pradesh, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, D & N Haveli and Lakshadweep, is more than 50% of the total population. Percentage of scheduled tribe population is highest in Mizoram accounting for 94.75% of the total population of the state. Table 2 gives the details of scheduled tribe population.

2. LITERACY STATUS

There has been an increase in the literacy rates of SCs/STs since independence, but the present position is far from satisfactory. A comparative statement of statewise literacy rates of 1981 census is given in Table 3. The following figures show comparative picture of literacy rates in the last three decades.

LITERACY OF SCs/STs



3. ENROLMENT

(a) Primary stage (Class I-V):

There has been over all increase in the enrolment of children belonging to scheduled castes and scheduled tribes at all levels after independence. At primary stage, the scheduled castes enrolment has increased from 1.1 crores accounting for 15.11% in 1980-81 to 1.6 crores, i.e., 15.79% of the total enrolment at primary stage in 1991-92. The enrolment of scheduled caste girls has increased from 13.40% in 1980-81 to 14.94% in 1991-92 while the enrolment of scheduled caste boys increased from 16.18% in 1980-81 to 16.39% in 1991-92.

The enrolment of, scheduled tribe children at primary stage increased from 46.60 lakhs in 1980-81 to 80.33 in 1991-92. The enrolment of scheduled tribe girls doubled during the period from 15.27 lakhs in 1980-81 to 30.82 lakhs in 1991-92 while the enrolment of scheduled tribe boys increased from 31.33 lakhs in 1980-81 to 49.51 lakhs in 1991-92.

(b) Middle Stage (Class VI-VIII):

Tables-6 and 7 depict the enrolment of scheduled castes and scheduled tribes at middle stage (Class VI-VIII) from 1980-81 to 1991-92. About 22 lakhs scheduled caste students were enrolled at middle stage in 1980-81 which increased to 46.93 lakhs in 1991-92 accounting 11.20% in 1980-81 and 13.62% in 1991-92 of the total enrolment at middle stage. Percentage enrolment of scheduled caste boys and girls accounting 12.21% and 9.16% in 1980-81 increased to 14.63% and 11.97% in 1991-92 respectively.

The enrolment of scheduled tribes at middle stage increased from 7.42 lakhs in 1980-81 to 17.94 lakhs in 1991-92 accounting for 3.74% in 1980-81 and 5.21% in 1991-92 of the total enrolment.

(c) High School level (Class IX-X)

Table-8 depicts the enrolment of scheduled castes at high school level. The total enrolment at high school level has increased from 8.62 lakhs in 1980-81 to 18.85 lakhs in 1991-92 accounting for 12.07% and 12.54% respectively. In their groups, percentage of scheduled caste boys and girls increased from 13.18% and 9.55% in 1980-81 to 13.52% and 10.61% respectively in 1991-92.

Enrolment of scheduled tribes also increased substantially at high school level from 2.66 lakhs in 1980-81 to 6.41 lakhs in 1991-92 accounting 3.73% and 4.26% respectively. Percentage enrolment of scheduled tribe boys and girls in their respective groups at high school level increased from 3.90 lakhs and 3.36 lakhs in 1980-81 to 4.41 lakhs and 3.98 lakhs respectively in 1991-92. (Table 9)

(d). Senior Secondary level:

Table 10 and 11 depict the enrolment of scheduled castes and scheduled tribes at senior secondary level which includes the enrolment at higher secondary (10+2 pattern), pre-university (one-year course), pre-degree/pre-university (two years course), intermediate/Junior college level. About 2.90 lakhs scheduled caste students accounting for 7.01% of the total enrolment at senior secondary level were enrolled in 1980-81 which increased to 6.96 lakhs accounting for 11.23% in 1991-92. Proportion of scheduled caste girls which was just 3.44% in 1980-81 increased sharply to 8.38% in 1991-92, and the enrolment of scheduled caste boys in 1980-81 accounting 8.27% of the total enrolment increased to 12.58% in 1991-92.

Similarly, scheduled tribes enrolment at senior secondary level increased sharply. It increased from 63 thousands accounting for 1.52% of the total enrolment in 1980-81 to 2.02 lakhs accounting 3.26% in 1991-92. The scheduled tribe girls enrolment which was less than 1% in 1980-81 increased upto the level of 2.61% in 1991-92 while the enrolment of scheduled tribe boys increased upto 3.57% in 1991-92 which was 1.73% in 1980-81.

4. Drop-Out Rates

The drop-out rates for the year 1988-89 amongst general, SC and ST categories are given below:-

Table 12 shows considerable reduction in the drop-out rates of scheduled castes at primary, middle and high school level. At primary level, drop-out rates records considerable reduction from 60.16% in 1980-81 to 49.62% in 1988-89. At middle level, it comes down from 76.84% in 1980-81 to 67.78% in 1988-89 while at High school level it was 86.91% in 1980-81 which comes down to 79.88% in 1988-89.

DROP-OUT RATES OF SCHEDULED CASTES



Table 13 depicts the drop-out rates among scheduled tribes and general categories at primary, middle and high school level. Like scheduled castes, scheduled tribes also record considerable reduction in drop-outs at various levels . At primary level, the drop-out among scheduled tribes in 1980-81 was 75.66% which reduced upto 64.53% in 1988-89. At middle school level the drop-out rates which was 86.71% in 1980-81 reduced to 78.08 in 1988-89 while at high school level it comes down to 86.72 in 1988-89 from 91.18 in 1980-81.

DROP-OUT RATES OF SCHEDULED TRIBES



DROP-OUT RATES OF SCs 1988-89



STATE-WISE DROP-OUT RATES OF SCs- 1988-89



STATE-WISE DROP-OUT RATES OF SCs- 1988-89



STATE-WISE DROP-OUT RATES OF SCs- 1988-89






STATE-WISE DROP-OUT RATES OF STs- 1988-89



STATE-WISE DROP-OUT RATES OF STs- 1988-89



SECTION-I

EDUCATION OF SCHEDULED CASTES

A-ENROLMENT

Table below depicts the All-India picture of the total enrolment of Scheduled Castes in various types of institutions during the year 1978-79 and 1988-89.

It will be observed from the above Table that the total enrolment of Scheduled Caste students increased from 134.25 lakhs in 1978-79 to 222.99 lakhs in 1988-89 giving an increase of 66.10 percent during this period. Additional enrolment during this period was of the order of 88.74 lakhs and a major part of it i.e. 17.77 lakhs was in primary/junior basic schools and 26.59 lakhs in middle/senior basic schools.

B - PROGRESS OF ENROLMENT BY TYPE OF INSTITUTIONS

A general review of the progress of enrolment of Scheduled Castes during the Year 1978-79 and 1988-89 indicates an overall improvement. However, the position varies from State to

State and also over various types of institutions. State-wise progress of enrolment of Scheduled Castes in various types of educational institutions is given in Appendix 'A'.

A brief comparative review of the progress of enrolment of Scheduled Castes as percentage to the enrolment of all communities for each category of schools for the year 1978-79 and 1988-89 is given in the following paragraphs:-

Enrolment by type of Institutions

(i) **Pre-Primary Schools**

The total enrolment of all communities in Pre-Primary schools in the country increased from 5.15 lakhs in 1978-79 to 9.81 lakhs in 1988-89 registering an increase of 90.49% during this period. The corresponding enrolment of Scheduled Castes increased from 66,125 (12.9% of all the communities) in 1978-79 to 90,397 (9.21%) of the all communities) in 1988-89. The details of enrolment figures are given in Appendix 'A' .

(ii) **PRIMARY SCHOOLS**

The total enrolment of all communities in Primary schools in the country increased from 483.99 lakhs in 1978-79 to 644.97 lakhs in 1988-89, showing an increase of 24.96% during this period. The corresponding enrolment of Scheduled Castes increased from 79.26 lakhs in 1978-79 to 97.04 lakhs in 1988-89 registering an increase of 22.43% during the period. Percentage enrolment of Scheduled Castes to the corresponding enrolment of all communities in Primary schools was 16.4% in 1978-79 and 15.05 in 1988-89. Details of enrolment of Scheduled Castes in Primary schools by States and Union Territories for the Year 1988-89 is given in Appendix 'A' .

(iii) MIDDLE SCHOOLS

The total enrolment of all communities in Middle/Senior Basic Schools in the country increased from 265.59 lakhs in 1978-79 to 372.52 lakhs in 1988-89 registering an increase of 40.26%. Corresponding enrolment of Scheduled Caste students increased from 31.08 lakhs in 1978-79 to 57.67 lakhs in 1988-89 at a rate of 85.55. Enrolment of Scheduled Castes to the corresponding enrolment of all communities increased from 11.7% in 1978-79 to 15.48% in 1988-89. Enrolment figures have been given in Appendix 'A'.

(iv) HIGH/HIGHER SECONDARY SCHOOLS

Total enrolment of all communities in High/Higer Secondary schools for the country as a whole increased from 210.93 lakhs in 1978-79 to 370.86 lakhs in 1988-89 registering an increase of 75.82%. Enrolment of Scheduled Caste students was 21.70 lakhs in 1978-79 which increased to 42.03 lakhs in 1988-89, showing an increase of 93.69% during this period. Percentage enrolment of Scheduled Caste students to the corresponding enrolment of all communities was 10.3 in 1978-79 and 11.33 in 1988-89. Enrolment figure are given in Appendix 'A'.

(v) SCHOOLS FOR VOCATIONAL, PROFESSIONAL, SPECIAL AND OTHER EDUCATION

Total enrolment of all communities in the above schools in 1978-79 was 15.17 lakhs of which Scheduled Caste students were 1.75 lakhs forming 11.54% of all communities. In 1988-89, the enrolment of all communities increased to 87.90 lakhs and the enrolment of Scheduled Caste students increased to 20.86 lakhs

forming 23.73% of the corresponding enrolment of all communities.

ENROLMENT BY STAGES OF EDUCATION

So far, the progress in enrolment of Scheduled Caste students by type of institutions has been discussed. However, the correct idea about the progress of enrolment of Scheduled Caste students can be had only from the stage-wise position of enrolment as discussed in the following paragraphs:-

Table - 17 indicates the enrolment of all communities as well as of Scheduled Caste students by stages of education for the year 1988-89. Enrolment of Scheduled Castes as percentage to the corresponding enrolment of all communities for different stages of education is a good indicator of position of enrolment of Scheduled Castes in comparison to other communities. The Scheduled Castes form about 16% of the total population and the difference between this percentage and the percentage of Scheduled Castes enrolment to all communities enrolment stresses the imperative need to find ways to bring the Scheduled Castes at par with other communities in educational opportunities.

The percentage of enrolment of Scheduled Castes to all communities and for girls at all stages of education increased from 13.4 and 12.0 in 1978-79 to 14.47 and 13.85 respectively in 1988-89. The position about each stage of education separately is discussed below:

(i) **PRE-PRIMARY STAGE**

Total enrolment of Scheduled Castes at Pre-Primary stage increased from 0.88 lakhs (including 0.36 lakhs girls) in 1978-79 to 1.31 lakhs (including 0.57 lakhs of girls) in 1988-89. Percentage enrolment of Scheduled Castes to the corresponding enrolment of all communities was 10.0% in 1978-79 and 5.37% in 1988-89.

(ii) **PRIMARY STAGE**

The constitution of classes at primary stage of education varies from State to State. For the sake of uniformity the first five classes of schools have been taken to constitute the primary stage in all States/Union Territories of India. Total enrolment of Scheduled Castes in Classes I to V increased from 103.35 lakhs in 1978-79 to 141.56 lakhs in 1988-89. The number of girl students in these classes increased from 35.62 lakhs to 56.13 lakhs during this period. Percentage enrolment of Scheduled Castes to the corresponding enrolment of all communities was 15.0 in 1978-79 and 15.51 in 1988-89. Enrolment by classes at primary stage and by states is given in Appendix - A.

(iii) **MIDDLE STAGE**

The number of classes constituting middle stage too is not the same in all the States and Union Territories. In most of the States and Union Territories classes VI, VII & VIII are treated as the middle stage of school education. Hence, for the sake of uniformity, classes VI-VIII are taken under middle stage for all the States and Union Territories in India. In 1978-79 Scheduled Caste students enrolled at middle stage were 20.27 lakhs of which 5.33 lakhs were girls. Scheduled Caste students formed 11.2% of the corresponding enrolment of all communities in 1978-79. Corresponding Scheduled Caste enrolment was 39.89 lakhs (including 12.99 lakhs girls) in 1988-89. The students of Scheduled Caste community formed 12.82% of the corresponding enrolment of all communities at this stage during this year. Class-wise enrolment at middle stage is given in Appendix 'A'.

(iv) **HIGH/HIGHER SECONDARY STAGE**

The number of classes which constitute high/higher secondary stage also varies from State to State in India. But for the purpose of this report this stage has been taken to include classes IX and above for all the States and Union Territories. Enrolment of Scheduled Caste students at this stage increased from 7.14 lakhs (including 1.57 lakhs girls) in 1978-79 to 19.37 lakhs (including 5.19 lakhs girls) in 1988-89. Percentage enrolment of Scheduled Castes to the corresponding enrolment of all communities was 9.8 in 1978-79 and 9.44 in 1988-89. Details of class wise enrolment for classes IX and above State -wise may, however, be seen in Appendix 'A'.

(v) **ENROLMENT BY CLASSES**

Total enrolment of Scheduled Caste students in general school education increased from 131.59 lakhs in 1978-79 to 202.13 lakhs in 1988-89. Percentage enrolment of Scheduled Castes to the corresponding enrolment of all communities was 13.8 in 1978-79 which increased to 13.91 in 1988-89.

(vi) - **VOCATIONAL, PROFESSIONAL SPECIAL AND OTHER EDUCATION (SCHOOL STANDARD)**

Vocational education includes ,inter-alia ,Agriculture, Commerce, Teacher Training, Technical/Industrial and Arts and crafts schools etc.. Special education includes institutions for mentally and physically handicapped, reformatory schools and others include the institutions of criminal studies and social(adult) education. During the year 1978-79, the enrolment of Schedules Caste students in vocational education was 1,33,543 forming 13.2% of the corresponding enrolment of all communities.

The enrolment in schools of special and other education was 4,96,735 which formed 17.5% of the corresponding enrolment of all communities. In 1988-89 the Scheduled Castes enrolment was 20.86 lakhs in all vocational, professional, special and other courses against the enrolment of 87.90 lakhs of all communities forming 23.73%. State-wise details of enrolment of these courses are given in Appendix 'A'.

SECTION-II
EDUCATION OF SCHEDULED TRIBES

A - ENROLMENT

Table - 18 below depicts the all India picture of the total enrolment of Scheduled Tribes in various types of educational institutions during the years 1978-79 and 1988-89.

It will be seen from the above Table that the total enrolment of children belonging to Scheduled Tribes increased from 54.27 lakhs in 1978-79 to 92.23 lakhs in 1988-89 registering an increase of 69.95%. Girls' enrolment increased from 17.48 lakhs in 1978-79 to 34.42 lakhs in 1988-89. The percentage of Scheduled Tribes enrolment to the corresponding enrolment of all communities was 5.4% during 1978-79 which increased to 7.19 in 1988-89.

In Appendix 'B', the state-wise position of the enrolment of Scheduled Tribes in various Types of Educational Institutions is given.

A Comparative review of the progress of enrolment of Scheduled Tribes as percentage to the corresponding enrolment of all communities for the years 1978-79 and 1988-89 in various types of educational institutions is given in the following paragraphs:-

SCHOOL EDUCATION

(1) PRE-PRIMARY SCHOOLS

Enrolment of Scheduled Tribes children in pre-primary schools increased from 58,176 (11.3% of all communities) in 1978-79 to 108260 (11.03% of all communities) in 1988-89. Similarly enrolment of Scheduled Tribes girls children showed an increase from 24,666 in 1978-79 to 52821 in 1988-89.

(ii). PRIMARY SCHOOLS

Total enrolment in primary schools in the country as a whole increased from 483.99 lakhs in the year 1978-79 to 644.97 lakhs in 1988-89. The corresponding enrolment of Scheduled Tribes was 33.98 lakhs in 1978-79 and 33.66 lakhs in 1988-89. The percentage enrolment of Scheduled Tribes to the corresponding enrolment of all communities was 7.0% in 1978-79 and 5.17 in 1988-89 .

(iii) MIDDLE SCHOOLS

Total enrolment in Middle Schools in the country as a whole increased from 265.59 lakhs in 1978-79 to 372.52 lakhs in 1988-89 showing an increase of 40.26%. The corresponding

enrolment of Scheduled Tribes increased from 12.79 lakhs to 32.99 lakhs, thus registering an increase of 157.93% during this period. The percentage enrolment of Scheduled Tribes to the total enrolment of all communities in this type of schools was 4.8% in 1978-79 and 8.86% in 1988-89.

(iv) HIGH/HIGHER SECONDARY SCHOOLS

While the total number of students belonging to all communities enrolled in high and higher secondary schools increased from 210.93 lakhs in 1978-79 to 370.86 lakhs in 1988-89. The corresponding enrolment of Scheduled Tribes increased from 5.60 lakhs to 14.57 lakhs during this period. In the case of the former the increase was 75.82%. It was 160.18% in the later case. Comparative picture of State-wise enrolment is given in Appendix 'B'. The coverage of enrolment of Scheduled Tribe students as percentage of corresponding enrolment of all communities increased from 2.7% in 1978-79 to 3.93% in 1988-89.

(v) SCHOOLS FOR VOCATIONAL, PROFESSIONAL, SPECIAL AND OTHER EDUCATION

Whereas the total number of all community students enrolled in schools for special education in the country as a whole increased from 13.30 lakhs in 1978-79 to 87.90 lakhs in 1988-89, Scheduled Tribe students increased from 1.32 lakhs in 1978-79 to 9.94 lakhs in 1988-89. This resulted in increase in the percentage of Scheduled Tribe enrolment from 9.92 in 1978-79 to 1.31 in 1988-89.

ENROLMENT BY STAGES OF EDUCATION

So far, the progress in enrolment of Scheduled Tribe students by type of institutions has been discussed and comparative picture of enrolment for the years 1978-79 and 1988-89 has been shown for different categories of institutions. However, a better picture of enrolment of Scheduled Tribe students can be had from the stage-wise position of enrolment as discussed in the following paragraph.

Table 19 below indicates the enrolment of all communities as well as of Scheduled Tribes by different stages of education for the year 1988-89. Enrolment of Scheduled Tribes as percentage to the corresponding enrolment of all communities for different stages of education has also been indicated for the year 1988-89 in comparison to 1978-79.

GENERAL SCHOOL EDUCATION

(i) PRE-PRIMARY STAGE

Total enrolment of Scheduled Tribes at pre-primary stage increased from 0.72 lakhs (including 0.31 lakhs girls) in 1978-79 to 3.20 lakhs (including 1.55 lakhs girls) in 1988-89. Percentage enrolment of Scheduled Tribes to the corresponding enrolment of all communities increased from 8.7% in 1978-79 to 13.14 in 1988-89.

(ii) PRIMARY STAGE

Total enrolment of Scheduled Tribes at the Primary stage in the country as a whole increased from 43.74 lakhs in 1978-79 to 60.46 lakhs in 1988-89. The corresponding girls' enrolment of these communities increased from 14.46 lakhs to 22.83 lakhs. Percentage enrolment of Scheduled Tribes to the corresponding enrolment of all communities at this stage increased from 6.3 in 1978-79 to 6.62 in 1988-89. State-wise and class-wise enrolment at Primary Stage is given in Appendix B.

(iii) MIDDLE STAGE

Scheduled Tribe students enrolled at this stage were of the order of 6.08 lakhs in 1978-79. Of this, 1.64 lakhs were girls. The corresponding figures of 1988-89 were 12.81 lakhs and 3.93 lakhs, respectively. Percentage enrolment of Scheduled Tribes to the corresponding enrolment of all communities increased from 3.3 in 1978-79 to 4.12 in 1988-89. For class-wise enrolment a reference is given in Appendix 'B'.

(iv) HIGH/HIGHER & SECONDARY STAGE

The total number of Scheduled Tribe students studying at this stage was 2.29 lakhs of which 60,218 were girls in 1978-79. This increased to 5.82 lakhs (including 2.47 lakhs girls) in 1988-89. The percentage of Scheduled Tribes enrolment to the corresponding enrolment of all communities at this stage was 3.1% in 1978-79 and 2.84 in 1988-89. Class-wise enrolment has been furnished in Appendix 'B'.

(v) ENROLMENT BY CLASSES

The enrolment of Scheduled Tribe students at general school stage increased from 52.64 lakhs in 1978-79 to 80.94 lakhs in 1988-89 (excludes 10+2 and intermediate). The percentage enrolment of Scheduled Tribes to the corresponding enrolment of all communities are 5.77 in 1988-89.

(vi) VOCATIONAL, PROFESSIONAL, SPECIAL & OTHER EDUCATION
(SCHOOL STANDARD)

Scheduled Tribe students enrolled in vocational/professional, special and other courses increased from 1.33 lakhs in 1978-79 to 9.94 in 1988-89. Percentage of Scheduled Tribes enrolment to the corresponding enrolment of all communities was 3.8 in 1978-79 and 1.13 in 1988-89. State-wise break-up of enrolment at various stages of vocational, professional, special & other education is given in Appendix 'B'.

SECTION - III

TEACHERS

A. SCHEDULED CASTE TEACHERS

Table 20 below depicts the all India picture of the total number of Scheduled Caste teachers in various types of educational institutions and percentage of women teachers to total number of Scheduled Caste teachers during the year 1978-79 and 1988-89.

It will be observed from the above Table that total number of Scheduled Caste teachers increased from 2.10 lakhs in 1978-79 to 3.31 lakhs in 1988-89. The women Scheduled Caste teachers included in the total, increased from 0.43 lakhs in 1978-79 to 0.84 lakhs in 1988-89. Additional number of teachers during this period was 1.25 lakhs (including 0.40 lakhs Women Teachers) . Major portion of this increase goes to primary school teachers i.e. 0.2 lakhs.

Table 21 below gives the percentage of Scheduled Caste Teachers to total number of teachers.

It will be seen from the Table that the percentage of Scheduled Caste teachers to total number of all Community teachers increased from 6.9% in 1978-79 to 8.02% in 1988-89. The State-wise details of teachers for various types of educational institutions are shown in the table III of Appendix 'A'.

It will be seen from Table 22 that total number of Scheduled Tribe teachers increased from 1.05 lakhs in 1978-79 to 1.6 lakhs in 1988-89. The women Scheduled Tribe teachers

included in the total increased from 0.21 lakhs in 1978-79 to 0.40 lakhs in 1988-89. During this period 0.54 lakhs teachers have been added which includes 0.19 lakhs women teachers.

Table 23 below gives the percentage of Scheduled Tribe teachers to total number of teachers for various types of educational institutions.

Above Table shows that the percentage of Scheduled Tribe teachers to the corresponding number of all community teachers rose up from 3.5% in 1978-79 to 3.88 in 1988-89.

The State-wise details of Scheduled Tribe teachers in various types of educational institutions are shown in Table No.III of Appendix 'B'.

C. **TRAINED AND UNTRAINED SC AND ST TEACHERS**

Another aspect for which information about Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe teachers has been collected relates to the number of trained teachers belonging to these communities working in schools. Since all school teachers are required to be trained, the number of trained teachers among Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes has been compared with the number of trained teachers of all communities.

Table 24 below gives percentage of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe trained teachers working in various types of schools in comparison to the corresponding percentage of total trained teachers belonging to all communities.

From the above Table, it will be seen that the training competence of Scheduled Caste teachers is almost at par with their other counterparts in general but it is quite low in case of Scheduled Tribe teachers. The percentage of Scheduled Caste trained teachers in schools for general education was 86.3% in 1988-89. However, Scheduled Tribe trained teachers were 65.8%, only the percentage of Scheduled Caste trained teachers in all types of schools for general education have shown an increase over the previous years.
