

This study presents an analysis of trends in respect of Indian Students and Trainees who had gone abroad for higher studies during 1987-88. Basic data for the study was collected from the Reserve Bank of India's list of Indian Students/Trainees going to foreign countries for studies/training in different subjects fields and disciplines. The information so collected was processed on Computer to generate the different Statistical tables appearing in the publication.

The study has projected the data country-wise State-wise, sex-wise and also gives the analysis of financial assistance received by students/trainees, duration of study etc. We are grateful to the Reserve Bank of India for providing the useful data for this study.

I would like to place on record, my deep appreciation of the team effort and the work done by the Project Staff namely, S/Shri Jai Ram Singh, R.N.Khera and N.H. Dave, Lakhan Singh, in bringing out his useful publication and to the staff of CMIS Unit for computerised processing of data.

Part - I - ABSTRACTS

INDIAN STUDENTS GOING ABROAD - 1987-88

The total number of INdian Students who went abroad for higher studies increased from 3489 in 1986-87 to 4284 in 1987-88. The number of girl students slightly increased to 594 during the year from that of 449 in 1986-87. The girl students constituted 13.9% of the total Indian students who went abroad in 1987-88.

GEOGRAPHICAL PATTERN

The following table gives the trend in the annual outflow of the Indian students going to different continents :-

The above analysis makes two trends distinctively clear. Firstly, the three continents viz. America, Europe and Asia put together account for 96.6% in 1987-88, leaving a very small fraction to Oceania and others. Secondly, the continent of America alone accounts for more than 87% during the last two years. Country-wise break-up reveals the predominant position of the United States of America (3686). The next two positions in descending order are U.K. (202) and Canada (63). The details are given in Table II.

STATES OF ORIGIN

The largest number of students visiting foreign countries are from Maharashtra (1067) Delhi (678), Andhra Pradesh (631) and Tamil Nadu (497).

It may be observed that not even a single students went abroad from Arunachal Pradesh, Manipur, Mizoram, A & N Islands, Dadra & Nagar Haveli, Lakshadweep, Daman & Diu & Pondicherry. The details are given in Table No. 1.

Fields of Study :-

The distribution of students by fields of study is given in the table below :-

The above table indicates that the largest number of students go to foreign countries for studying in Engg. & Arch. Courses followed by science and other courses. It is interesting to note that Medicine accounts for an insignificant portion of the total outflow.

Female candidates were attracted mostly Engineering, Science & Arts Courses. The largest number of female students went abroad for studying Science subject followed by Engineeries & Arts (Humanities & Social Sciences) discipline.

In Engg. Subjects, the largest number of students went from Maharashtra followed by Andhra Pradesh and Tamil Nadu.

In Science subjects also, Maharashtra topped the list followed by Delhi and Andhra Pradesh.

Some interesting trends emerge about USA wherein most of the Indian students preferred to go for studying of higher courses in Engg., Science and Technology/Industrial courses. In fact USA attracts as many as 92% and 92.6% of all the Indian students visiting foreign countries for studying of Engg. and Science Subject respectively.

Table IV gives the detailed distribution of students by field of study and the countries visited by them during the year.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE :

The pattern of financial assistance is given in the table below :-

It will be observed from the above table that a good portion of the students went abroad for pursuing higher education on their own expensed. Details may be seen in table V.

Out of 82 students who visited foreign countries for Higher Studies under Scholarships/Fellowship and other financial assistance offered by foreign Universities, U.S.A. accounted for as high as 77 followed U.K 2. The details are given in Table VI.

AVERAGE DURATION

The average duration of study of Indian Scholars in foreign countries works out to 27 months in 1987-88. Out of 4284 students as many as 2472 (57.7%), opted for courses having a duration of 13-24 months in 1987-88. Details are given in Table No. VIII.

INDIAN GOING ABROAD FOR TRAINING

Total number of Indian who went abroad for Training was 4823 in 1987-88 of which the share of females was insignificant (57 or 1.2% only).

Continents to which they go:

The following table gives the country-wise break-up of the Indian trainees who went for foreign training during 1987-88.

The trend indicated in the above table reveals the predominance of Europe which accounted for 39.7%. USA topped the list by having 865 trainees in 1987-88 whereas U.K. attracted as many as 698 trainees. The details are given in Table X.

State of Origin:

Delhi topped the list in sending the largest number of trainees viz. 1469. Notable feature is that not even a single trainee visited any foreign country from H.P., J&K, Nagaland, Orissa, Dadra & Nagar Haveli, Mizoram, Manipur, Daman & Diu, Lakshadweep & Pondicherry. The details are given in Table No. IX.

Field of Trainees :

The following table give the distribution of trainees by subject field of training.

Engineering and Architecture attracted the largest number of Indian trainees, whereas Commerce, Agriculture and Forestry and Medicine attracted very few. The details can be seen from Table XI.

In Engineering and Architecture, the first three top positions were held by U.S.A., U.K and Japan respectively. The details are available in table XII.

It is observed from the above table that a good percentage of the trainees went abroad at the expenses of Indian Companies only. The details are given in Table XIII.

It could also be seen that the largest number of trainees were deputed to U.S.A. by Indian Company's. Details can be seen in Table XIV.

AVERAGE DURATION

The average duration of foreign training in respect of the Indian trainees works out to be 7.09 weeks for the year 1987-88 which was less than that for the Indian trainees for which the average duration comes to 7.42 weeks during the year 1986-87.


