## INTRODUCTION

This Report surveys the provision of educational facilities for children belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes in India during 1967-68. This publication gives mostly the statistical data as supplied by the State Governments and Administrations of Union Territories in a prescribed form entitled 'Form A-1'. Besides showing the progress of educational facilities during the year 1967-68, it gives inter-alia a comparative picture with the previous year.

2. The coverage of this publication is mainly restricted to the enrolment of children belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes at different levels of education beginning from pre-primary education up to the highest stage of education with all the possible bifurcation into different standards of education. It also gives sex-wise and State-wise comparison of the progress of education among the children belonging to these castes. The extent of coverage at different levels of education in respect of these communities has also been given where desirable.

3. The population statistics included in this Report relate to 1971 Census Data and no attempt has been made to estimate the population of these communities for the year under report. Further, no attempt has been made to draw any conclusion or insinuation based upon the factual data depicted in the report, although some analysis of the data has been given wherever desirable with a view to show at a glance the progress of education among the children of various age-groups belonging to these communities.

4. Appendices 'A' and 'B' give respectively the State-wise details of progress made in providing educational facilities to the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe Communities.

5. Opportunity is taken to convey the thanks of the Ministry of Education & Social Welfare to all the State Governments and Administrations of Union Territories who supplied the basic statistics for the preparation of this publication. Suggestions for making publication more useful in future may please be addressed to the Director (Internal Finance & Planning) in this Ministry.

S U M M A R Y

Substantial increase has been noticed in the provision of educational facilities since Independence. There has been a phenomenal increase in the number of institutions of different types, enrolment therein, number of teachers employed and the educational expenditure incurred thereon. Table I below, which gives the percentage of coverage of the population of different school-going age-groups, indicates at a glance the significant developments that have taken place in the field of education during the post-Independence period:-

2. Although all-round expansion of education has been witnessed in the post-Independence era, it has not spread over uniformly in the country. There still remain certain areas and social communities as well as some groups of population which lag far behind others in the development of education. Some special efforts are, therefore, required to accelerate the pace of educational development in such backward areas, social groups of population, like; girls, Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, backward classes and other communities living in hill areas.

3. The percentage enrolment of Scheduled Castes to the total enrolment in the country decreased from 11.1 in 1966-67 to 10.8 in 1967-68. Similarly, the corresponding percentage increase for Scheduled Tribes is shown to have gone down from 4.2 in 1966-67 to 4.1 in 1967-68. Consequently, the extent of coverage also decreased from 76.00 in 1966-67 to 74.00 in 1967-68 in the case of Scheduled Castes and from 60.9 to 59.4 respectively in the case of Scheduled Tribes. The decrease in the percentage and extent of coverage in both cases may be due to greater increase in the population of these communities. However, there is a case for making efforts to improve the percentage enrolment of these communities to total enrolment in the country as well as the coverage of population of these communities.

Table 2 below indicates the comparative position of enrolment of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes in various types of institutions in India for the years 1966-67 and 1967-68 and also gives the extent of coverage(\*)

The details of enrolment of children belonging respectively to the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes, studying in various educational institutions in different States and Union Territories are given in the statements included in Appendices 'A' and 'B' of the Report.

4. If a fair deal had been given to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes, the extent of coverage should have been 100 or in other words, the percentage enrolment of Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes to total enrolment should have been equal to the percentage population of Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes to total population. An index of greater than 100, implies that the educational advance of Scheduled Castes/Tribes is more than that of the total population and thereby shows that there are some other social groups whose condition is even worse than that of the general population. If this index is less than 100 it may be concluded that the Scheduled Castes/Tribes have still some lee-way to make. In such cases, special efforts are needed to be made to improve their enrolment. The smaller the extent of coverage, the greater the need for making such efforts.

5. For analysis of this subject in detail as well as because of the different position obtaining amongst Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes so far as educational facilities are concerned, it has been felt desirable to divide this report into two parts. Part I deals with educational development of Scheduled Castes and Part II gives out the educational development of Scheduled Tribes.

P A R T - I

EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES FOR SCHEDULED CASTES

POPULATION OF SCHEDULED CASTES

6. The population of Scheduled Castes recorded at the 1971 Census was about 80.00 million which formed 14.6% of the total population of India. The following Table gives State-wise break-up of the population of this community as well as its percentage to total population.

It will be seen that the largest population of Scheduled Castes (24.7%) was found in Panjab followed by Himachal Pradesh (22.2%) and Uttar Pradesh (21.0%). The smallest proportion of Scheduled Caste population (0.1%) was reported by Arunachal Pradesh.

7. The population of Scheduled Castes for the year 1968 is not available, but for the purpose of this Report it has been assumed that the percentage of Scheduled Caste population to the total population of each State as recorded in 1971 Census holds good for 1968 as well.

Enrolment of Scheduled Castes

8. Table 4 below depicts the all-India picture of the total enrolment of Scheduled Castes in various types of institutions during the years 1966-67 and 1967-68:-

81.46 lakhs in 1966-67 to 83.05 lakhs in 1967-68, giving an increased rate of 2.0% during this period. The girls' enrolment included in the total, however, increased from 22.91 lakhs in 1966-67 to 23.76 lakhs in 1967-68. Additional enrolment during the one year period was of the order of 1.59 lakhs and the major increase of 0.57 lakhs in Primary Schools alone was noteworthy.

9. The percentage enrolment of Scheduled Castes to the total enrolment and the extent of coverage in various types of educational institutions is given in Table 5 as under:-

The overall extent of coverage of Scheduled Caste candidates decreased from 76.0 in 1966-67 to 74.0 in 1967-68. The extent of coverage in respect of universities and colleges for general education is shown to have gone up from 30.8 in 1966-67 to 31.5 in 1967-68.

The extent of coverage of Scheduled Castes in 1966-67 was more than 100 in four States, viz.: Assam, Gujarat, Kerala and Maharashtra and three Union Territories, viz.: Dadra and Nagar Haveli, Manipur and Tripura. In 1967-68 those States and Union Territories (except Gujarat and Manipur) reported extent of coverage as more than 100.

### Progress of Educational Facilities

12. A review of the progress of educational facilities available to Scheduled Caste students during the years 1966-67 and 1967-68 indicated an overall improvement in their enrolment. The position varied from State to State and also over various types of institutions. Statements II to IX in the Appendix 'A' indicate State-wise progress of enrolment of Scheduled Castes in various types of educational institutions.

13. A brief comparative review of the progress of enrolment of Scheduled Castes as percentage to the total enrolment and the extent of coverage for the years 1966-67 and 1967-68 in various types of educational institutions is given in the following paragraphs:-

#### (i) Pre-Primary Schools

While the total enrolment in pre-Primary schools in the country increased from 2.30 lakhs in 1966-67 to 2.40 lakhs in 1967-68, thus, registering an increase of 4.3% during this period, the enrolment of Scheduled Castes decreased from 14,909 (6.5% of the total) in 1966-67 to 14,301 (6.0% of the total) in 1967-68. As seen from Statement II in Appendix 'A', the maximum increase in the enrolment of Scheduled Castes in pre-primary schools was reported by Mysore, where it increased from 2,086 in 1966-67 to 3,725 in 1967-68. The State-wise percentage of enrolment and extent of coverage

(ii) Primary Schools

The total enrolment in the Primary Schools in the country increased from 381.8 lakhs in 1966-67 to 390.5 lakhs in 1967-68, showing an increase of 2.3% during the year 1967-68. The

corresponding enrolment of Scheduled Castes increased from 50.4 lakhs in 1966-67 to 50.9 lakhs in 1967-68, thus, registering an increase of 1% during the year 1967-68. The percentage of enrolment of Scheduled Castes to the total enrolment in Primary Schools decreased from 13.2 in 1966-67 to 13.0 in 1967-68. Consequently, the extent of coverage also showed a decrease from 90.4 in 1966-67 to 89.0 in 1967-68. State-wise position of these percentages is shown in Table 9 below. However, details of enrolment of Scheduled Castes in Primary schools by States and Union Territories for the years 1966-67 and 1967-68 are given in Statement III of Appendix 'A'.

(iii) Middle Schools

The total enrolment in Middle/Senior Basic Schools in the country increased from 175.8 lakhs in 1966-67 to 184.1 lakhs in 1967-68, registering an increase of 4.7% in 1967-68. Corresponding enrolment of Scheduled Caste students increased from 16.8 lakhs in 1966-67 to 16.9 lakhs in 1967-68. Scheduled Caste students formed 9.6% in 1966-67 and this percentage decreased to 9.2% in 1967-68. Corresponding figures of extent of coverage were 65.8 and 63.0 in the years 1966-67 and 1967-68 respectively. State-wise figures of percentage and extent of coverage are shown in Table 10 given below:-

(iv) High/Higher Secondary Schools

Total enrolment in High/Higher Secondary Schools for the country as a whole increased from 135.0 lakhs in 1966-67 to 142.5 lakhs in 1967-68 registering an increase of 5.6% in the year 1967-68. Enrolment of Scheduled Caste students was 10.6 lakhs in 1966-67 which increased to 11.0 lakhs in 1967-68, showing an increase of 3.8% during 1967-68. Percentage enrolment of Scheduled Caste students to the total enrolment was 7.8% in 1966-67 which decreased to 7.7% in 1967-68. Corresponding figures for the extent of coverage were 53.4 and 52.7 in



the years 1966-67 and 1967-68 respectively. Percentage enrolment and extent of coverage are shown in Table 11 below:-

(v) Schools for Vocational and Technical Education

Total Enrolment in Vocational and Technical Schools of the country was 2,25,475 in 1966-67. Of this the number of Scheduled Caste students was 21,864 and formed 9.7 per cent of the total enrolment. In 1967-68, while the total enrolment of all communities in these schools increased to 2,30,141, the enrolment of scheduled caste students decreased to 20,785 and formed 9.0 per cent of the total enrolment. Corresponding extent of coverage was 61.6 in 1967-68. State-wise enrolment percentages and the extent of coverage have been indicated in Table 12:

(vi) Schools for Special Education

Schools for physically & mentally handicapped children and the reformatories are generally taken under Schools for Special Education. In the year 1966-67, 25,871 students from all communities were enrolled in these institutions of which 2,217 were scheduled caste students. These students formed 8.8 per cent of the total enrolment. In the year 1967-68 total enrolment increased to 26,233 of which 2,177 were Scheduled Caste students. Scheduled Caste students formed 8.3 per cent of the total enrolment. The corresponding extent of coverage for Scheduled Caste enrolment in 1967-68 was 56.8. The State-wise figures of percentage enrolment and extent of coverage are delineated in Table 13 as below:-

(vii) Schools for Other Education\*

During 1966-67, 2.35 lakhs Scheduled Caste students were enrolled and they formed 13.4 per cent of the total enrolment of 17.50 lakhs. Total enrolment of all communities in these institutions during 1967-68 was 19.60 lakhs. Of these, Scheduled Caste students were 2.74 lakhs which formed 14.0 per cent of the total enrolment. The extent of coverage for all India in 1967-68 worked out to 95.9. Figures for percentage enrolment and extent of coverage are indicated in Table 14 given below. Enrolment figures for Scheduled Caste students in Special Education Schools and other Education Schools may be seen from Statement VII of the Appendix 'A'

(viii) Schools for Vocational, Special and Other Education taken together

Total enrolment of all communities in all the above categories of schools in 1966-67 was 20.00 lakhs of which scheduled caste students were 2.59 lakhs forming 13.0 per cent of the total enrolment. The corresponding extent of coverage was 89.0. In 1967-68 the total enrolment increased to 22.14 lakhs but the enrolment of scheduled caste students increased to 3.00 lakhs showing 13.6 per cent of the total enrolment. Extent of coverage was recorded as 93.2 in 1967-68.

(ix) Institutions for Higher Education, Universities and Colleges of General Education

The total number of students enrolled in these institutions increased from 14.21 lakhs in 1966-67 to 16.36 lakhs in 1967-68, i.e. an increase of 15.1 per cent during 1967-68. The enrolment of Scheduled Caste students also increased from 64,043 in 1966-67 to 75,160 in 1967-68 including 8,135 girls. That shows an increase of 17.4 per cent during 1967-68. The percentage enrolment of Scheduled Castes was 4.5 per cent in 1966-67 which slightly increased to 4.6 per cent in 1967-68. The extent of coverage too increased from 30.8 in 1966-67 to 31.5 in 1967-68. The comparative percentage enrolment and extent of coverage for those two years have been indicated below in Table 15. Detailed data on enrolment in Universities and Colleges of General Education in 1967-68 have been depicted in Statement VIII of Appendix 'A'.

Enrolment of all communities as a whole was 6.93 lakhs in 1966-67 which increased to 8.20 lakhs in 1967-68. The Scheduled Caste students enrolled were 34,402 (including 4,431 girls) in 1966-67 and this enrolment increased to 39,483 (including 5,081 girls) in 1967-68. Enrolment of Scheduled Caste students as percentage to the total enrolment in 1966-67 was 5.0 per cent which slightly decreased to 4.8 per cent in 1967-68. The extent of coverage was recorded as 34.2 per cent and 32.9 per cent in the years 1966-67 and 1967-68 respectively. Colleges and Schools) during the years 1966-67 and 1967-68 has been shown in Table 17. Total number of students enrolled in these Colleges and Schools was 27.96 lakhs in 1966-67 and it increased to 30.35 lakhs in 1967-68. Of the total, the number of scheduled caste students were 2.92 lakhs in 1966-67 and 3.37 lakhs in 1967-68. Enrolment percentage of scheduled caste students to the total enrolment was 10.6 and 11.1 during the years 1966-67 and 1967-68. Extent of coverage of scheduled caste students increased from 72.6 in 1966-67 to 76.0 in 1967-68.

15. So far, the progress in enrolment of scheduled caste students by type of institutions only has been discussed. Comparative picture of enrolment and extent of coverage for the years 1966-67 and 1967-68 has been shown in respect of different categories of institutions. However, the correct idea about the progress of enrolment of scheduled caste students can be had only from the stage-wise position of enrolment as discussed in the following paragraphs.

Table 20 indicates the enrolment of all communities as well as of scheduled caste students alone by stages of education for the year 1967-68. Enrolment of scheduled castes as percentage to the total enrolment, for different stages of education has also been indicated.

(i) Primary Stage

The number of classes constituting the primary stage of education varies from State to State. For the sake of uniformity, the first five classes of schools have been taken to constitute the primary stage in all States/Union Territories of India. Total enrolment of scheduled castes in classes I-V increased from 62,59,325 in 1966-67 to 62,72,412 in 1967-68. The number of girl students during 1966-67 and 1967-68 was 18,43,007 and 19,21,187 respectively. Percentage enrolment of scheduled caste students to total enrolment was 12.0 in 1966-67 and 11.7 in 1967-68. The extent of coverage of.....

scheduled caste students in these classes was 80.1 in 1967-68.

Enrolment of scheduled caste students at primary stage, percentages to the total enrolment and extent of coverage figures for 1967-68 in respect of each State of India have been indicated in Table 21. Enrolment by classes at Primary stage and by States are included in Statement X of Appendix 'A'.

(ii) Middle Stage -

Number of classes constituting Middle stage too are not the same in all the States and Union Territories. But in most of the States and Union Territories classes VI, VII and VIII are treated as the Middle stage of school education. Hence, for the sake of uniformity classes VI-VIII (3 classes) are taken under middle stage for all the States and Union Territories. In 1966-67 scheduled caste students enrolled at middle stage were 10,60,234 of whom 2,19,382 were girls. Scheduled caste students formed 9.5 per cent of the total enrolment in 1966-67. Corresponding scheduled caste enrolment was 11,11,138 (including 2,28,069 girls) in 1967-68. The students of scheduled caste community formed 9.3 per cent of the total enrolment at this stage during this year. The extent of coverage of scheduled castes under this stage of education was 63.7 in 1967-68. Table 22 depicts the position of the numbers enrolled, enrolment percentages and extent of coverage at middle stage in various States and Union Territories. Class-wise enrolment at middle stage is given in Statement XI of Appendix 'A'.

(iii) High/Higher Secondary Stage

The number of classes which comprises High/Higher Secondary stage also varies from State to State in India. But for the purposes of this report this stage has been taken to comprise of Classes IX and above for all the States and Union Territories. Enrolment of scheduled caste students at this stage was 4,29,237 of whom 62,967 were girls in 1966-67. Scheduled caste students formed 7.8 per cent of the total enrolment.



Corresponding enrolment for 1967-68 was 4,69,631 of whom 80,460 were girls. The students of Scheduled caste community formed 8.1 per cent of the total enrolment at this stage during this year. The extent of coverage of scheduled caste students was 53.4 and 55.5 in 1966-67 and 1967-68 respectively. Position of enrolment and extent of coverage of scheduled caste students in these classes at High/Higher Secondary stage has been depicted in Table 23. Details of class-wise enrolment for classes IX and above by States may, however, be seen in Statement XII of Appendix 'A'.

(iv) Enrolment by Classes at School Stage

Table 24 depicts the percentage of scheduled caste enrolment to total enrolment in various classes (Pre-primary to Higher Secondary stage) and extent of coverage for the year 1967-68. The percentage of scheduled caste students to all the classes at school stage was 11.2 in 1966-67 which decreased slightly to 11.0 per cent in 1967-68. The extent of coverage of scheduled caste students at school stage was 75.3 in 1967-68.

(v) Vocational, Special and Other Education  
(School standard)

Vocational Education includes inter-alia Agriculture, Commerce, Teacher Training, Technical/Industrial and Arts and Crafts schools etc., Special Education includes institutions for mentally and physically handicapped children and reformatory schools and Other Education relates to institutions of oriental studies, social (Adult) education and other specified education. During the year 1966-67, the enrolment of scheduled caste students in Vocational Education was 22,692 forming 8.4 per cent of the total enrolment. Corresponding figures for Special and Other Education were 2,217 and 2,36,471 forming 8.8 and 13.0 per cent respectively of the total enrolment of all communities at these stages of education. In 1967-68 the scheduled caste students enrolled were 22,021 in Vocational Education forming 7.9 per cent of the total enrolment. Scheduled caste enrolment in schools for Special Education and Other Education was 2,169 and 2,74,379 respectively. The percentage to the total enrolment in this year were 8.2 and 13.5 respectively. Enrolment percentages and the extent of coverage in respect of Vocational, Special and Other Education (School Standard) has been indicated in detail in Table 25. Details of the enrolment for Vocational, Special and Other types of education (School Standard) are given in Statements XIII and XIV of Appendix 'A'.

(vi) Higher Education (General)

In 1966-67 the enrolment of scheduled caste students in General Higher Education was 83,609 (including 7,843 girls), forming 5.6 per cent of the total enrolment. Scheduled Caste girls formed 2.1 per cent of the total girl students in these classes. In 1967-68 scheduled caste enrolment was 94,890 of whom 9,575 were girl students. During this year, scheduled caste students formed 5.5 per cent of the total enrolment. Corresponding extent of coverage was 37.7 in 1967-68. Table 26 indicates the enrolment of scheduled castes by different stages of general higher education.

Enrolment of scheduled castes in 1966-67 was 37,816 of whom 4,312 were girls. In 1967-68 scheduled caste enrolment at this stage of education increased to 44,371. Percentage enrolment of scheduled castes to total enrolment was 4.9 in 1967-68 and the extent of coverage was 33.6. Stage-wise distribution of scheduled castes has been given in Table 28.

There was much variation regarding enrolment of scheduled caste students in Professional and Other Higher Education courses in various States which may be mainly due to population variation in States and Union Territories.

16. According to 1971 Census the population of scheduled tribes was about 38.02 million and it formed 6.9% of the total population of the country. Table 31 below gives State-wise break-up of the population of this community as well as its percentage to total population:

It will be seen that the percentage of population of scheduled tribes was the highest in Nagaland (38.6%) and lowest in Uttar Pradesh (0.2%) among States. Among Union Territories, the highest percentage of scheduled tribe population (92.9%) was reported by L.M. & A. Islands and the least (0.9%) was reported by Goa, Daman and Diu. Among the States, Haryana, Jammu & Kashmir and Punjab had no population of scheduled tribes. Similarly, the Union Territory of Chandigarh, Delhi and Pondicherry had no population of scheduled tribes in their respective Territories.

17. The population of scheduled tribes for the year 1968 is not available, but for the purpose of this Report it has been assumed that the percentage of scheduled tribe population to the total population of each State as recorded in 1971 Census holds good for 1968 as well.

#### Enrolment of Scheduled Tribes

18. Table 32 below depicts the all-India picture of the total enrolment of scheduled tribes in various types of educational institutions during the year 1966-67 and 1967-68.

It is seen that the total enrolment of children belonging to scheduled tribes increased from 30.60 lakhs in 1966-67 to 31.50 lakhs in 1967-68, giving an increase rate of 2.9% during this period. Girls enrolment included in the total, however, increased from 8.43 lakhs (27.5%) in 1966-67 to 8.85 lakhs (28.1%) in 1967-68. The percentage of scheduled tribes enrolment to total enrolment was 4.2 during 1966-67 which slightly declined to 4.1 per cent in 1967-68.

#### Progress of Educational Facilities

22. A review of the progress of the educational facilities available to scheduled tribe students during the years 1966-67 and 1967-68 indicated almost constant position of the enrolment in various types of educational institutions, it being varied from State to State. Statement I to XVI in Appendix 'B' indicate State-wise position of the enrolment of scheduled tribes in various types of educational institutions.

23. A comparative review of the progress of enrolment of scheduled tribes as percentage to the total enrolment and the extent of coverage for the years 1966-67 and 1967-68 in various types of educational institutions is given in the following paragraphs:

#### (i) Pre-Primary Schools

Enrolment of scheduled tribe students in Pre-Primary schools decreased from 7,195 (3.1% of the total) in 1966-67,

6,930 (2.9% of the total) in 1967-68. Similarly, enrolment of scheduled tribe girls showed a decrease from 3,452 in 1966-67 to 3,238 in 1967-68. Corresponding percentage of the extent of coverage of scheduled tribe students was 44.9 and 42.0 in 1966-67 and 1967-68 respectively. The State-wise data is delineated in Table 36 as here under:-

whereas the total enrolment in Primary schools in the country as a whole increased from 3.82 crores in 1966-67 to 3.91 crores in 1967-68 enrolment of scheduled tribe students increased from 20.56 lakhs in 1966-67 to 20.58 lakhs in 1967-68. However, the percentage enrolment of scheduled tribes to the total enrolment showed a decline from 5.4 % in 1966-67 to 5.3% in 1967-68. The extent of coverage was 78.3 and 76.8 in 1966-67 and 1967-68 respectively. State-wise position of the percentage enrolment and extent of coverage of scheduled tribes in Primary schools in 1966-67 and 1967-68 is indicated in Table 37 below:-

(iii) Middle Schools

Total enrolment in Middle schools in the country as a whole increased from 1.76 crores in 1966-67 to 1.84 crores in 1967-68 showing an increase of 4.54%. The corresponding enrolment of scheduled tribes increased from 5.86 lakhs to 6.43 lakhs, thus registering an increase of 9.7% in 1967-68. Consequently, the percentage enrolment of scheduled tribe students to the total enrolment of all communities in this type of schools in India registered an increase from 3.3% in 1966-67 to 3.5% in 1967-68. The extent of coverage was 47.8 and 50.7 in 1966-67 and 1967-68 respectively. State-wise position of the enrolment percentage and the extent of coverage is given in Table 30 on next page:-

(iv) High/Higher Secondary Schools

While the total number of students belonging to all communities enrolled in High and Higher Secondary schools

increased from 1.35 crores in 1966-67 to 1.43 crores in 1967-68, the corresponding enrolment of scheduled tribes increased from 2.31 lakhs to 2.42 lakhs during this period. In the case of the former the rate of increase was 5.9%, it was 4.8% in the latter case. Comparative picture of State-wise enrolment for these two years is given in Statement V in Appendix 'B'. The coverage of enrolment of scheduled tribe students as percentage of the total enrolment remained the same at 1.7 during both the years and so also the extent of coverage, which remained at 24.6 during this period. (v) Schools for Vocational and Technical Education

Total enrolment in vocational and technical schools in the country as a whole was 2.25 lakhs in 1966-67 of which only 2.9% formed the enrolment of scheduled tribes. In 1967-68, the corresponding total enrolment of the country as a whole was 2.30 lakhs of which 3.2% constituted the enrolment of scheduled tribe students. The extent of coverage of scheduled tribe students increased from 42.0 in 1966-67 to 46.4 in 1967-68. State-wise enrolment percentage and extent of coverage has been given in Table 40 on next pages.

Total number of students enrolled in schools for Special Education increased from 25,071 in 1966-67 to 26,233 in 1967-68 as against the decrease of scheduled tribes enrolment from 632 in 1966-67 to 527 in 1967-68. Percentage of scheduled tribe

(viii) Institutions for Higher Education, Universities  
and Colleges of General Education

While the total enrolment in these institutions increased from 15.22 lakhs in 1966-67 to 16.36 lakhs in 1967-68, the enrolment of scheduled tribe students increased from 16,214 in 1966-67 to 18,561 in 1967-68. However, the percentage of scheduled tribe students belonging to all communities studying in these institutions remained the same at 1.1 in both the years. Similarly, the extent of coverage also remained at 15.9 during both the years. (ix) Institutions for Professional, Special and Other Education (Colleges & Schools)

Total enrolment of all communities in these types of institutions increased from 27.96 lakhs in 1966-67 to 30.35 lakhs in 1967-68. The scheduled tribes enrolment in these institutions increased from 1.63 lakhs in 1966-67 to 1.32 lakhs in 1967-68 registering an increase of 11.7%. The scheduled tribe students enrolment formed 6.0% of the total enrolment in the country as a whole in 1967-68 as against 5.8% during the previous year. Corresponding figure of the extent of coverage was 84.1 and 87.0 in 1966-67 and 1967-68 respectively. (x) Colleges of Professional Education

The number of students studying in Colleges of Professional Education in the country increased from 6.94 lakhs in 1966-67 to 7.16 lakhs in 1967-68. The corresponding figure of Scheduled tribe students was 7,128 in 1966-67 and 7,635 in 1967-68. The scheduled tribe students formed 1.0% of the total enrolment in 1966-67 and it slightly increased to 1.1% in 1967-68. Corresponding extent of coverage of scheduled tribes in the country as a whole was 19.7 in 1966-67 and 15.9 in 1967-68. General School Education

(1) Primary Stage

As already stated, the number of classes constituting the Primary stage varies from stage to stage. But for the sake of uniformity, classes I-V have been taken to form Primary stage in all States/Union Territories for the purpose of this report. Total enrolment of scheduled tribes at the Primary stage in the country as a whole increased slightly from 24.54 lakhs in 1966-67 to 24.90 lakhs in 1967-68. Correspondingly, the girls' enrolment of this community increased from 6.90 lakhs to 6.98 lakhs. However, percentage enrolment of scheduled tribes to the total enrolment at this stage declined from 4.7 in 1966-67 to 4.6

in 1967-68. Corresponding figures of extent of coverage was 68.1 in 1966-67 and 66.7 in 1967-68. State-wise enrolment at Primary stage in respect of each class is given in Statement X in Appendix 'B'. (ii) Middle Stage

Here also in order to maintain uniformity, Classes VI-VIII have been taken to constitute the middle stage in all the States and Union Territories of the country in respect of the State-wise variation in this regard. Scheduled tribes students enrolled at this stage were of the order 3.17 lakhs in 1966-67. Of this, 0.68 lakh were girls. The corresponding figures of 1967-68 were 3.32 lakhs and 0.78 lakh respectively. Middle stage enrolment of scheduled tribe students formed 2.8 per cent of the total enrolment in both the years under review. Corresponding extent of coverage also remained at 40.6 in both the years. For class-wise enrolment a reference may be made to Statement XI in Appendix 'B'. State-wise enrolment and its percentage to total enrolment as well as extent of coverage are given in Table 48.

(iii) High/Higher Secondary Stage

For the purposes of this Report, the High/Higher Secondary stage of General school Education has been taken to consist of classes IX and above in all the States in respect of the varied system of school classes. The total number of scheduled tribe students studying at this stage was 1.08 lakhs, of whom 19,294 were girls in 1966-67. It increased to 1.21 <sup>lakhs</sup> (including 22,698 girls) in 1967-68. Similarly, percentage of scheduled tribe enrolment to the total enrolment at this stage increased from



2.0 in 1966-67 to 2.1 in 1967-68. Corresponding figures of extent of coverage was 29.0 in 1966-67 and 30.4 in 1967-68. Class-wise enrolment has been furnished in Statement XII in Appendix 'B'. Although enrolment of scheduled tribe students in General School Education (classes Pre-Primary to Higher Secondary) increased from 28.80 lakhs in 1966-67 to 29.50 lakhs in 1967-68, yet the percentage enrolment and extent of coverage decreased from 4.2 and 60.9 to 4.1 and 59.4 respectively.

(v) Vocational, Special and Other stages of School standard

Scheduled Tribe students enrolled in Vocational/Professional schools increased from 6,710 in 1966-67 to 7,842 (including 1,771 girls) in 1967-68. Percentage of scheduled tribe enrolment to the total enrolment increased from 2.5 in 1966-67 to 2.8 in 1967-68. Corresponding extent of coverage was 36.2 in 1966-67 and 40.6 in 1967-68. State-wise break-up of enrolment in various stages of Vocational Education is given in Statement XIII in Appendix 'B'. Scheduled tribe enrolment in Special Education schools decreased from 636 in 1966-67 to 527 (including 81 girls) in 1967-68. It formed 2.5 per cent of total enrolment 1966-67 and 2.0 per cent in 1967-68. Corresponding figure of extent of coverage was 36.2 in 1966-67 and 29.0 in 1967-68. However, the number of scheduled tribe students studying in Other Education schools increased from 1,49,004 in 1966-67 to 1,66,277 in 1967-68. Percentage of the scheduled tribe students enrolled to the total enrolment as well as extent of coverage remained at 8.2 and 118.8 respectively in both the years under review. Scheduled tribe students enrolled in General Higher Education increased from 15,739 (including 2,853 girls) in 1966-67 to 17,597 (including 3,036 girls) in 1967-68. It formed 1.0 per cent of the total enrolment. The corresponding percentage of scheduled tribe girls was 0.8 in 1966-67. In 1967-68 the percentage of scheduled tribe enrolment to the total enrolment remained at 1.0 but the percentage of girls decreased to 0.7.
