I - INTRODUCTION

Department of Education collects and publishes the educational Statistics at state level on annual basis. However, keeping in view the wide disparities within a state, educational data is collected and published on quinquennial basis separately for each state. This volume is second in the series of the Educational Statistics District-wise for the year 1981-82.

2. For making inter-district comparison, important school level educational indicators such as enrolment ratio, co-efficient of equality for S.C. and S.T., percentage of trained teachers and population served by a school etc. have been worked out. These indices show wide range of variation among the districts and are of great use for formulating educational development plans at district-level.

II - AREA AND POPULATION

3. Manipur consists of 6 districts. The number of districts in the state remained the same during the period 1977 to 1981. However, the total area of the state has decreased slightly from 22,356 Sq. Kms. in 1977 to 22,327 Sq. Kms. according to 1981 Census Report. Manipur South has the largest area of 4,570 Sq. Kms. followed by Manipur East 4,544 Sq. Kms. and Manipur West 4,391 Sq. Kms. The lowest area was of Manipur Central 2,238 Sq. Kms.

4. In 1977, the estimated total population of the state was 1,298 thousands (6.39 thousands males and 6.59 thousands females) which increased to 1,421 thousands (721 thousands males and 7,00 thousands females) in 1981. In 1981 Manipur Central had the largest population (929 thousands) and the lowest was in case of Tengnoupal, (56 thousands.).

5. The density of population increased from 58 per Sq. Kms. in 1977 to 68 per Sq. Kms. in 1981 at the state level. In 1981 the highest density of population (415) in case of Manipur Central whereas in rest of 4 Districts which reported density of population below state level, it varied from 48 in Manipur South to 14 in Manipur West. The details of area, population and density of population are given in Statement 2. Table No.1

below also depicts percentage share of area and population :-

6. The total population as well as population in the age group 6-11 and age group 11-14 for the year 1981 are based on the population (as on 1st March, 1981) available from the office of the Registrar General of India. The population of the age-group 14-17 for the year 1981-82 have been worked out by using the following formula :-

7. The total population of the age-group 6-11 increased from 161.1 thousands (78.8 thousand boys and 82.3 thousand girls) in 1977 to 204.9 thousands (104.2 thousand boys and 100.7 thousand girls) in 1981 for the State as a whole. The population in this age-group forms 14.4% of the total population in 1981.

8. Similarly population for the age-group 11-14 increased from 94.2 thousands (45.3 thousand boys and 48.9 thousand girls) in 1977 to 97.5 thousands (49.6 thousand boys and 47.9 thousand girls) in 1981 for the State as a whole. The population in this age-group forms 6.9% of the total population in the State.

9. The population in the age-group 14-17 years was 89.8 thousands (43.0 thousand boys and 46.8 thousand girls) in 1977. This is estimated to have increased to 101.1 thousands (50.3 thousand boys and 50.8 thousand girls) in 1981 constituting 7.1% of the total population. If we consider

the total school going population in the age-group 6-17, this work out to 403.5 thousands comprising 204.1 thousand boys and 199.4 thousand girls in 1981. This school going population in the age-group 6-17 forms 28.4% of the total population of the State in 1981.. The district-wise details of population in different age-group are given in Statement No.3.

III - LITERACY

According to 1981 Census, the effective literacy rate viz. number of literates per hundred of the population including 0-4 age-group was 41.4%. The corresponding rates for males and females being 53.3% and 29.1% respectively. Among the districts, the literacy was the highest in case of Manipur South(44.9%) followed by Manipur Central (43.3%) and lowest in case of Manipur West (31%). The corresponding literacy rates for S.C. and S.T, is 33.6% and 39.7% at state level respectively.

11. The district-wise details of literacy rate have been given in Statement No.6.

IV - GENERAL VIEW

(a) INSTITUTIONS

12. The total number of school level institutions decreased from 4469 in 1976-77 to 4095 in 1981-82. The main reason for decrease in 1981-82 was upgradation of Primary Schools to middle schools and amalgamation of Primary Schools with Middle Schools. Apart from this, many primary schools managed by purely private (unaided) bodies were either derecognised or closed. Among the districts the percentage share of institutions is the highest in Manipur Central (53.5%) followed by Manipur South (13.6%) and the lowest in case of Manipur West (6.1%) in 1981-82.

(b) ENROLMENT

13. The total enrolment(School Stage) in school level of institutions increased from 3,15,607 in 1976-77 to 3,30,279 in 1981-82 at an average annual rate of 1%. Of the total enrolment 70.1% accounted for Manipur Central district alone in 1981-82. The enrolment of school level institutions decreased in case of all districts except Manipur Central which shows an increase of 17.5% during the period of 5 years. Percentage share of enrolment was the minimum for Tengnoupal (2.7%).

4. The percentage of girls enrolment was 40.3% in 1976-77 which increased to 43.4% in 1981-82. It is observed that the percentage of girls enrolment increased in all the districts of the state during the period under review. Among the districts the percentage of girls enrolment varied from 45.5% in Tengnoupal to 43.1% in Manipur South. Details are depicted in Statement 4.

c) TEACHERS :

5. The number of teachers in school level institutions in the state increased from 16,112 in 1976-77 to 17,291 in 1981-82. The average annual increase during the period works out to be 1.5%. The increase of teachers has been noticed in all the districts.

6. Among the school teachers only 52.8% were trained (55.7% male teachers and 37.5% female teachers). Among the districts percentage of trained teachers varied from 67.8% in Manipur Central to 20.5% in Manipur South. In 5 of the 6 districts the percentage of trained teachers was below to that of state average. District-wise details of teachers can be seen from Statement No.5.

d) EXTENT OF COVERAGE OF SCHEDULED CASTES AND SCHEDULED TRIBES.:

7. Percentage of enrolment of Scheduled Castes students was only 1.6% (1.5% boys and 1.8% girls) in the state in 1981-82. Out of the six districts, Manipur East and Manipur West did not report any Scheduled Castes enrolment. The percentage of Scheduled Castes population to total population in the state was 1.5% according to 1981 Census. The extent of coverage (Coefficient of equality) of Scheduled Castes therefore works out to be 128.0 for the state as a whole in 1981-82. Extent of coverage for Manipur Central and Manipur North works out below to that of state average. District-wise details are given in Statement No.7.

8. Enrolment of Scheduled Tribes in school level of institutions in the state was 99,274 (55,565 boys and 43,709 girls) in 1981-82. Among the five districts it varied from 26,591 in Manipur North to 7,812 in Tengnoupal district. The enrolment percentage of S.T. in the state was 30.1 (29.7% for boys and 30.5% for girls). Except Manipur Central all the remaining five districts have mostly Scheduled Tribes students studying in these institutions. In these five districts enrolment percentage of this community was more than 88.1%

Percentage of Scheduled Tribes population was 27.3 which varied from 89.5% in Manipur East to Central where the Scheduled Tribes population was only 2.6%. Manipur Central has the highest population but the percentage of S.T. is the lowest. Extent of coverage for the Scheduled Tribes works out to 110.3 for the state as a whole. In Manipur West, the extent of coverage was the highest viz. 204.4. Except Manipur South (102.1) the other five districts reported extent of coverage more than that of state average.

V. PRE-PRIMARY EDUCATION :

19. There was only one Pre-Primary school in the district of Manipur Central during the period under review. Enrolment in this school was 51. in 1976-77 which increased to 53 (32 boys and 21 girls) in 1981-82. However, the enrolment in Pre-Primary classes in the district Manipur Central was 291 which slightly declined to 273 by 1981-82. In this, Pre-primary school there were only 4 teachers in 1976-77 and 1981-82. District-wise position is given in Statement No.9.

VI. PRIMARY EDUCATION

(a) INSTITUTION

20. The number of primary schools decreased from 3,466 in 1976-77 to 2,860 in 1981-82. This decrease is noticed in all the districts in the state during the period of five years. The main reason for decrease in the primary schools in 1981-82 is due to upgradation of Primary Schools to Middle Schools and amalgamation of Primary Schools with Middle Schools. Apart from these reasons, many Primary Schools managed by purely private (Unaided) bodies were either closed or derecognised during the period 1976-77 to 1983-84. In 1981-82 Percentage share of primary schools was maximum in Manipur Centre (49.8 %) and the lowest in Manipur west (6.7 %).

21. The average area served by a Primary school was 6.5 Sq. Kms. in 1976-77. But due to decrease in the number of institutions as mentioned above, the average area served by a Primary school was 7.8 Sq.Kms during 1981-82. Among the districts the facilities of Primary Schools was the maximum in Manipur Central district as for every 1.6 Sq.Kms area are school is available where as the such facilities are mininum in in Manipur west as one school is available for an area of 24.3 Sq.Kms in 1981-82.

22. Population served by a primary school was 267 in 1976-77. Due to decrease in the number of Primary Schools in 1981-82, the population served by a primary school has however increased to 497. The districtwise details are given in Statement No.11.

ENROLMENT -

23. The total enrolment in primary schools decreased from 1,92,689 in 1976-77 to 1,64,594 in 1981-82 for the state as a whole. Similarly, the enrolment in classes I-V decreased from 2,31,754 (1,33,300 boys and 98,544 girls) in 1976-77 to 2,15,164 (1,19,465 boys and 95,699 girls) in 1981-82 with an annual decrease rate of 1.40 % for the state as a whole. Manipur Central district shows an increase of 2.4 % where as the other five districts show decrease in the enrolment. Enrolment ratio of classes I-V is reported 105.0. Three district have reported enrolment ratio below state level figure. Statement No.12 indicates the district-wise position.

(c) ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED CASTES-

24. Enrolment of Scheduled Caste children in Primary classes was only 3,680 forming 1.7 % of the total enrolment. In 1981-82 the estimated percentage of Scheduled Castes population was 1.25 in the state. The coefficient of equality or extent of coverage is defined as :

District-wise position of S.C. enrolment is given Statement 14.

(d) ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED TRIBES -

25. Enrolment of Scheduled Tribe children in primary classes was 75,586 forming 35.1 % in 1981-82. Except Manipur Central in the remaining 5 districts the Percentage of S.T. children to total enrolment varied from 87.0 % in Tengnoupal to 96.4 % in Manipur East. In 1981-82, the estimated percentage of Scheduled Tribe population was 27.3. The coefficient of equality works out 128.6. District-wise is given Statement 15.

(e) TEACHERS -

26. The number of teachers also decreased from 10,518 in 1976-77 to 9515 in 1981-82 in primary schools. The number of trained teachers were 63.5 % (65.7 % male and 49.5 % female) during 1981-82. In Manipur Central the Percentage of trained teachers is 92.5 but in other five districts this Percentage is far below to that state level percentage. Percentage of women trained teachers is 49.5 in the state. The highest percentage is meant for Manipur Central (62.3) and in other remaining five districts it is below state level figure. The Pupil teacher ratio in primary schools was 17 in 1981-82. Nearly half of the total number of teachers were recorded in Manipur Central district alone. District-wise position of teachers is given in Statement 13.

(f) INSTITUTIONS AND ENROLMENT IN RURAL AREAS -

27. The number of primary schools was 2750 in rural areas out of 2860 school in the state during 1981-82. There were only 1.7 % pucca primary schools in 1981-82 in rural areas.

228. Enrolment in these primary schools was 1,46,650 in 1981-82. But enrolment in primary classes (I $\frac{1}{2}$ V) was 1,77,530 (99,794 boys and 77,736 girls) in 1981-82. District-wise details are given in Statement 16.

(g) HABITATIONS WITH OR WITHOUT PRIMARY SCHOOLS -

229. The total number of habitations in the state in 1981-82 was 2,531. Out of these 2,531 habitations, 2,146 habitations had primary schools in them and 2,421 had primary schools within a distance of 2 Kms. during the period 1981-82. District-wise position is given in Statement No.17.

VII MIDDLE EDUCATION

(a) INSTITUTIONS

30. The number of middle schools increased from 337 in 1976-77 to 425 in 1981-82. There was over all increase in all the districts of the state. Highest number of middle schools are in Manipur Central (184) and the lowest in Tengnoupal (22). On an average a middle school was available for every 66.3 Sq. Kms. in the state in 1976-77. Which improved to 52.5 Sq. Kms. in 1981-82. On an average a middle school was available for every 3850 persons in 1976-77 however position improved during the period and a middle school could be made available for 3343 in 1981-82. District-wise position has been depicted in Statement 18.

(b) ENROLMENT -

31. Enrolment in classes VI-VIII increased from 48,674 (32,111 boys and 16,563 girls) in 1976-77 to 55,526 (33,395 boys and 22,131 girls) in 1981-82 showing an annual growth rate of 2.8 % during the period under consideration. Enrolment percentage in middle classes in the state was 56.9 in 1981-82. The highest percentage is reported 66.4 for Manipur Central and for other five district the percentage is reported below to that at state level. District-wise position is given in Statement No.19.

(c) TEACHERS -

32. The number of teachers increased from 1988 in 1976-77 to 3279 in 1981-82 in

Middle Schools, 56.9 % teachers were in Manipur Central district above. The percentage of trained teachers were 51.5 % (54.4 % male and 37.3 % female) during 1981-82. In Manipur South the percentage of trained teachers was only 14.3 where as in other five district it was above the State percentage. The teacher- pupil ratio in Middle schools was 16 in 1981-82 . District-wise position of teachers etc. is given in Statement 20.

(a) ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED CASTES -

33. Enrolment of Scheduled Caste children in Middle classes was only 877 forming 1.6 % of the total enrolment. There were 823 Scheduled Caste children in Manipur Central district alone out of 877 children in the state as a whole . In 1981-82 the percentage of Scheduled Caste population was 1.25 . The coefficient of equality or extent of coverage works out to 128.0. District-wise position is depicted in Statement 21.

(e) ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED TRIBES -

34. Enrolment of Scheduled Tribe children in Middle classes was 13,805 forming 24.9 % in 1981-82. It is seen that Manipur Central district has only 5.5 % children to the total enrolment in classes VI-VIII, where as other 5 districts have more than \angle In \angle 90 % Childre. 1981-82 the Percentage of Scheduled Tribes population was 27.3. The coefficient of equality works out to 91.2. District wise particulars are given in Statement 22. in Middle Classes.

(f) INSTITUTION AND ENROLMENT IN RURAL AREAS:-

35. The number of Middle schools were 390 in rural areas out of 425 schools in the state as a whole in 1981-82. There were only 2.3% pucca middle schools in 1981-82 in rural areas.

36. Enrolment in rural areas middle schools was 44,068 in 1981-82. But the enrolment in middle classes (VI-VIII) was 45,871 (27,929 boys and 17,942 girls) in 1981-82. The districtwise details are given in statement 23.

(a) HABITATION WITH OR WITHOUT MIDDLE SCHOOLS:

37. The total number of habitations in the state in 1981-82 were 2,531. Out of 2,531 habitations only 402 had middle schools in them, 982 habitations had middle schools upto 2 Kms. and 512 habitations had middle schools from 2 to 5 Kms. in the State. District-wise details are given in Statement 24.

VIII. HIGH/HIGHER SECONDARY EDUCATION:

(a) INSTITUTIONS

38. The number of high/higher secondary schools in the State increased from 235 in 1976-77 to 291 in 1981-82 showing an increase of 23.8% during the period under review. Increase in the number of institutions is noticed in all the districts of the state. Manipur Central district has the largest number of institutions i.e. 187 (64.3% of the total institutions) in the state.

39. Average area served by a high/higher secondary school was 95.1 Sq.Kms. in 1976-77. Now, the situation improved and a high/higher secondary school could be made available for every area of 76.7 Kms. in 1981-82.

40. Average population served by a high/higher secondary school in the state was 5522 in 1976-77, whereas in 1981-82 for every population of 4883 one such institutions was available. In the year 1981-82 average population served by a high/higher secondary school varied from 3,188 in Manipur East to 9,400 in Tengnoupal district. District-wise particulars can be seen From Statement 25.

(b) ENROLMENT -

41. The enrolment in high/higher secondary schools of the state increased from 61,451 in 1976-77 to 81,999 in 1981-82. The enrolment in classes IX-XI/XII was 23,451 (15,534 boys and 7,896 girls) in 1976-77, which increased to 27,360 (16,690 boys and 10,670 girls) in 1981-82 showing an increase of 16.7%. The enrolment increased in all the district of the State during the period under consideration. The enrolment ratio in classes IX-XI/XII was 27.1 (31.5 for boys and 21.0 for girls) in the State as a whole in 1981-82. Enrolment percentage was 27.1 for the state in 1981-82. Among the districts the highest (32.2%) was for Manipur Central and for other districts the percentage was below to that state percentage. District wise details of enrolment and enrolment ratio are indicated in statement 26.

(c) ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED CASTES -

42. Enrolment of Scheduled Castes in High/higher secondary classes was 357 during 1981-82 forming 1.3 % of the total enrolment. Out of these 357 students 343 were in Manipur Central district alone. In 1981 the percentage of the scheduled caste population was 1.25. Thus the coefficient of equality works out to be 104.0. District-wise details of enrolment and enrolment ratio of Scheduled Castes have been depicted in statement 28.

(d) ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED TRIBES -

43. Enrolment of Scheduled Tribes in high/higher Secondary classes was 7,122 forming 26.0 % to the total enrolment in 1981-82. It has been observed that Manipur Central district has only 5.3 % students to the total enrolment in high/higher Secondary classes whereas the other five districts of the State have more than 90 % scheduled tribes children in 1981-82. The percentage of Scheduled Tribe population was 27.3 % The coefficient of equality works out to 95.2. District-wise details of enrolment and enrolment ratio etc has been given in Statement 29.

(e) TEACHERS -

44. The number of teachers increased from 2,851 (2,506 males and 345 females) in 1976-77 to 3,787 (3,065 males and 722 females) during 1981-82 in high/higher secondary schools. The percentage of trained teachers were 37.2 % (40.6 % males and 22.7 % female) during 1981-82. The teacher-pupil ratio in high/higher secondary schools were 22 in 1981-82. District-wise details of teachers etc. is given in statement 27.

(f) INSTITUTIONS AND ENROLMENT IN RURAL AREAS -

45. The number of high/higher Secondary schools located in rural areas was 227 out of total number 291 schools in the State during 1981-82. There were 10.6 % pucca high/higher Secondary Schools in 1981-82 in rural areas.

46. The enrolment in rural areas' high/higher secondary schools was 55,958 during 1981-82. But the enrolment in high/higher secondary classes (IX-XI/XII) was 23,015 (14,287 boys and 8,728 girls) in 1981-82. The district-wise details are given in Statement 30.

IX. PROFESSIONAL, VOCATIONAL, SPECIAL AND OTHER (SCHOOL) EDUCATION -

47. There were 426 institutions providing professional, Vocational, Special and other education in the state which increased to 518 in 1981-82. The enrolment in these type of schools was 11,437 (7,231 boys and 4,206 girls) in 1976-77 which increased to 14,951 (6,512 boys and 8,439 girls) in 1981-82 showing an average annual growth rate of 6.1 %.

48. Of the total enrolment 384 belongs to Scheduled Castes and 2,668 belongs to Scheduled Tribes forming 2.6 % and 17.8 % of the total enrolment.

49. Teaching strength in these institutions was 751 in 1976-77 which decreased to 716 in 1981-82. There are over all increase in all the five district of the state except Manipur Central district where number of teachers decreased from 411 in 1976-77 to 336 in 1981-82.
