INTRODUCTION

This report deals with the progress in the enrolment of Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes in India as on 31st March, 1965. It is based on the enrolment data collected, on Census basis, from all State Governments/Union Territories in Form A-I. Collection of data in this form was started from the year 1964-65. The data collected in Form A-I, as also in other forms, relates to recognised institutions only. This study covers all types of educational institutions. The data relating to 1960-61 which has been used in the report to bring out a comparative picture of the two years viz: 1964-65 and 1960-61, wherever possible, has been compiled from Form A of 1960-61.

2. Besides giving enrolment figures relating to different types of institutions, information has been given for different stages of education as well under the broad heads: General School Education, Vocational Education, Special and other stages of School Education, General Higher Education and Professional and other Higher Education. In the case of stage-wise enrolment, it has not been possible to give comparative figures as stage-wise figures of enrolment are not available for the earlier years. The statistics used in this report relating to the population of Scheduled Castes/Tribes are based on 1961 Census reports. It has not been possible to work out the percentage of Scheduled Castes/Tribes children attending school in 1964-65 to the total population of these children in different school going age-groups as separate population projections for these children are not available. However, a measure of the extent of coverage defined in the report has been introduced to indicate the progress in enrolment of Scheduled Castes in comparison to the other communities.

3. It may be mentioned that the enrolment figures, by type of institutions, are not strictly comparable over years as the institutions do not remain of the same type over years due to upgrading.

4. The enrolment figures of Professional, Technical and Vocational courses are not comparable between 1960-61 and 1964-65, due to change in the nomenclature which effect from 1964-65.

S U M M A R Y

The progress of educational development in India has been phenomenal since Independence. This is reflected by increase in the number of institutions of different types, enrolment, number of teachers employed and educational expenditure.

2. The progress in the enrolment ratio, at different stages of education, which is a significant index of the educational development, during the period, is given in Table I:

Even though overall expansion of education has been significant since Independence, the development in the different areas has not been uniform. There are still certain pockets which are under-developed in this respect. Apart from variation in the educational development in the different areas, there is also significant variation in the educational development amongst different groups of the population like women, Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, backward classes, hilly area people, etc., etc.

Enrolment ratio is enrolment in a particular stage divided by population in the corresponding age-group. In each stage, population of the following age-groups has been taken.

Stage	Corresponding age-group
Primary (Classes I-V)	6-11 years
Middle (Classes VI-VIII)	11-14 years

3. This report particularly deals with the educational development of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe communities who, according to 1961 census, formed 14.7 per cent and 6.8 per cent of the total population of the country respectively.

4. The percentage enrolment of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes to total enrolment increased from 10.4 and 4.0 in 1960-61 to 10.8 and 4.2 in 1964-65 respectively. In terms of extent of coverage, the overall position improved from 70.7 to 73.5 in case of Scheduled Caste during the period 1960-61 and 1964-65 and from 58.8 to 61.8 in the case of Scheduled Tribes. Table 2 indicates the position about the enrolment of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes in various types of institutions for the country as a whole during the period 1960-61 and 1964-65 and also gives the extent of coverage** State-wise details in respect of Scheduled Caste/Tribe enrolment in all educational institutions are given in the numerous statements given at the end of the Report.

** The extent of coverage is defined as :-

Percentage enrolment of Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes to total enrolment of all students x 100
percentage population of Scheduled Castes/
Scheduled Tribes to total population.

5. If a fair deal had been given to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes, the extent of coverage should have been 100, or in other words, the percentage enrolment of Scheduled Castes/Tribes to total enrolment should have been equal to the percentage population of Scheduled Caste/Tribes to total population. If this index is greater than 100, it implies that the educational advance of Scheduled Castes/Tribes is more than that of the total population and thereby it follows that there are some social groups whose condition is even worse than that of the general population. If this index is less than 100, it may be concluded that the Scheduled Castes/Tribes have still some leeway to make. In such cases, special efforts are needed to be made to improve their enrolment and smaller the extent of coverage, the greater the need for making such efforts.

6. For a fuller treatment of the subject, and because of the different position obtaining amongst Scheduled Castes and Scheduled tribes, as far as educational facilities are concerned, it has been felt desirable to divide this report into two parts: PART-I dealing with educational development of Scheduled Castes and PART-II dealing with educational development of Scheduled Tribes.

PROGRESS IN ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED CASTES

Population of Scheduled Castes

8. According to 1961 census, Scheduled Caste population of India was 64.4 million, of whom 31.5 million were women. Scheduled Caste population of each State/Union territory and its percentage to the total population of the State/Union territory is given in Table 3.

9. The population of Scheduled Castes for the year 1965 is not available. However, it has been assumed that the percentage of Scheduled Caste population of each State in 1965 was the same as that in 1961.

Enrolment of Scheduled Castes in various types of educational institutions

10. Total enrolment of Scheduled Castes in various types of recognised educational institutions increased from 49.7 lakhs in 1960-61 to 72.9 lakhs in 1964-65. The corresponding figures of girl students were 11.8 lakhs (23.8%) in 1960-61 and 20.2 lakhs (27.7%) in 1964-65. Details are given in Table 4:-

11. Additional enrolment during the four year period, has been of the order of 23.21 lakhs; the major increase being 14 lakhs in Primary schools and about 5.58 lakhs in Middle schools.

12. Enrolment of Scheduled Caste students, as percentage of total enrolment, and the extent of coverage is indicated in Table 5.

13. The overall extent of coverage of Scheduled Caste students increased from 70.7 in 1960-61 to 73.5 in 1964-65. The extent of coverage for colleges has, however, gone down because of the reversion in the categorisation of institutions as colleges in the year 1964-65. Some of the institutions covered under colleges were categorised as schools.

Statewise enrolment of Scheduled Castes in all educational institutions

14. Table 6 gives information about the Statewise enrolment over the period of four years 1960-61 to 1964-65:

16. The extent of coverage of Scheduled Castes in the year 1960-61 was more than 100 in 3 States (Assam, Kerala and Maharashtra) and 2 Union Territories (Pondicherry and Tripura). By 1964-65, the number of States and Union Territories, having the extent of coverage more than 100, increased to 7 (Assam, Gujarat, Kerala, Maharashtra, Dadra Nagar Haveli, Pondicherry and Tripura).

Enrolment of Scheduled Castes Statewise
by each type of institution

17. A review of the overall progress of the educational facilities available to Scheduled Caste students, during the period 1960-61 to 1964-65 has indicated an improvement though the position varied from State to State and also over various types of institutions. Statements AII to AIX indicate the progress of enrolment of Scheduled Castes in each State in respect of the following types of institutions:

18. A brief review of the enrolment development in the various types of institutions State-wise is given in the following paragraphs:-

GENERAL EDUCATION SCHOOLS

(i) Pre-Primary Schools:

19. Of the total enrolment of 1,21,184 in pre-primary schools in 1960-61 in the country, the number of Scheduled Caste students was 6,452 (5.3%). By 1964-65, the total enrolment in these schools increased to 1,98,022 of which 10,891 (5.6%) were Scheduled Caste students. This improvement is also indicated by the increased extent of coverage of Scheduled Caste students from 36.1 to 37.4 during the period. The State-wise figures are given in Table 8.

(ii) Primary Schools:

20. The total enrolment in Primary Schools in the country increased from 266 lakhs in 1960-61 to 358 lakhs in 1964-65, registering an increase of 35% during the period. The Scheduled Caste enrolment increased from 32 to 46 lakhs i.e. 44% during the same period.

21. Scheduled Caste students formed 12.0 per cent of the total enrolment in 1960-61 which increased to 12.9 per cent in 1964-65. The corresponding figures of the extent of coverage during 1960-61 and 1964-65 for the country as a whole were 81.6 and 87.8. State-wise position of these percentages is given in table 9. Detailed data is given in Statement A III.

(iii) Middle Schools

22. The total enrolment in middle schools was 106 lakhs in 1960-61 and it increased to 157 lakhs by 1964-65, showing an increase of 48% during the period. The corresponding increase in the enrolment of Scheduled Castes was 60%.

23. Scheduled Caste students formed 8.7% of the total enrolment in middle schools in 1960-61 and this increased to 9.4% by 1964-65. The extent of coverage in 1960-61, was only 59.2 which increased to 63.9 by 1964-65. The State-wise position is given in table 10.

(iv) High/Higer Secondary Schools

24. The total number of students enrolled in these institutions increased from 75 lakhs in 1960-61 to 113 lakhs by 1964-65, showing an increase of 50.8% during the period. The enrolment of Scheduled Caste students increased from 5.33 lakhs to 8.74 lakhs or 64 per cent during the same period.

25. The percentage enrolment of Scheduled Caste students to the total enrolment was 7.1% in 1960-61 and it increased to 7.7% by 1964-65. Correspondingly, the extent of coverage increased from 48.3 to 52.4. The position, as it existed in the different States during 1960-61 and 1964-65 is given in Table 11.

(v) VOCATIONAL AND TECHNICAL SCHOOLS:

27. As detailed statistics in respect of the enrolment of Scheduled Caste students ... studying in technical and vocational schools is not available for the year 1960-61, the position in respect of these students in 1964-65 only is discussed below:-

28. During this year, 2.69 lakh students in all were enrolled in technical and vocational schools, of whom 0.86 lakhs were girls. The number of Scheduled Caste students was 20,937 (15,966 boys and 4,971 girls). This formed 7.8 per cent of the total enrolment in vocational and technical schools and the corresponding extent of coverage worked out to 53.1. State-wise details are given in Table 13.

(vi) Schools for Special Education

29. Special education schools generally include schools meant for physically and mentally handicapped children and reformatories. Separate information in the enrolment of Scheduled Castes in these schools in respect of 1960-61 is not available. In the year 1964-65 for which information is available, the enrolment of Scheduled Caste students in these schools was 1,944 (1,688 boys and 256 girls). This formed 9.0 per cent of the total enrolment of 21,669 students in these institutions. The extent of coverage of Scheduled Caste Students was 61.2. Among the States, the extent of coverage of Scheduled Castes varied from 100 or more in Assam, Gujarat, Maharashtra and Orissa to 11.2 in West Bengal. State-wise details are given in table 14.

Schools for other Education

30. During 1964-65, the enrolment of Scheduled Caste students in other education schools was 2.20 lakhs (1.39 lakh boys and 0.81 lakhs girls) and it formed 9.4 per cent of the total enrolment of 23.25 lakh students (14.21 lakhs boys and 9.04 lakh girls). The extent of coverage of Scheduled Caste students in these schools for the country as a whole was 63.9. The state-wise position is shown in Table 15. Details of enrolment in Special and Other Education Schools are given in Statement A-VII.

Schools for Vocational, Special and Other education taken together

31. Enrolment of Scheduled Caste students in all the above category of schools taken together was 2.46 lakhs of whom 86,368 (35.3%) were girls. This formed 9.4 per cent of the total enrolment of students of all communities in these institutions. The extent of coverage of Scheduled Castes was 63.9. In certain States, the extent of coverage of scheduled castes was more than 100, e.g., Assam (191.9), Maharashtra (151.8), West Bengal (113.6), Pondicherry (303.9) and Tripura (163.1). In other States and Union Territories, it varied from 1.2 in Rajasthan and 28.4 in Bihar to 92.4 in Mysore.

(vii) Institutions for Higher education, Universities and Colleges of General education

32. The total number of students enrolled in these institutions increased from 7.63 lakhs in 1960-61 to 10.89 lakhs in 1964-65, i.e. an increase of 41.8 per cent during the period. The corresponding percentage increase in respect of boys and girls was 33.8 per cent and 77.4 per cent respectively. During the same period, the enrolment of Scheduled Caste students increased from 38,709 to 48,727 or by 25.9 per cent. Again, the enrolment of scheduled caste girls increased during the period from 3192 to 4314 or by 35.1 per cent.

33. The percentage enrolment of Scheduled Castes to total enrolment in universities and colleges was 5.0 per cent in 1960-61. This percentage decreased to 4.5 by 1964-65. The extent of coverage of scheduled castes also correspondingly decreased from 34.0 to 30.6 during this period. State-wise percentage enrolment and extent of coverage of Scheduled Castes is given in Table 16. Detailed data on enrolment is given in Statement A-VIII.

Higher, Professional and other Educational Institutions:

34. For the year 1960-61, data is not available separately for Professional schools and Colleges, although we have it for the year 1964-65. To make a comparative study at these two different points of time, the data in respect of schools and colleges for both the years have been combined. On the basis of this combined data, the analysis is as below.

35. While the total enrolment of Scheduled Castes in Professional, Special and other types of educational institutions remained almost the same i.e. about 2.72 lakhs in 1960-61 and 1964-65, the enrolment of girls increased from 38,305 to 89,388, registering an increase of 133% during this period.

36. The enrolment of Scheduled Caste students formed 11.8 per cent of the total enrolment in these institutions in 1960-61. In 1964-65, this percentage decreased to 8.3. The extent of coverage of Scheduled Castes also decreased from 80.3 in 1960-61 to 56.5 in 1964-65.

37. Table 17 gives the state-wise picture of the percentage enrolment of Scheduled Castes and their extent of coverage in professional, special and other institutions.

(viii) Colleges of Professional education

38. As stated earlier, data in respect of Scheduled Caste students in professional colleges and schools is not available separately for the year 1960-61. Therefore, the analysis under this heading relates to 1964-65 only.

39. While the total enrolment of students belonging to all communities in colleges for professional education was 5,66,225 (including 85,895 girls) in 1964-65, the enrolment of students belonging to Scheduled Castes was only 26,602 (including 3,458 girls). The percentage enrolment of Scheduled Caste students to total enrolment in these institutions came to 4.7 per cent for the country as

a whole. The extent of coverage was 32.0 per cent. The state-wise picture is shown in Table 18.

Since comparative stage-wise data for 1960-61 is not available, the enrolment for 1964-65 only has been discussed. GENERAL SCHOOL EDUCATION:

Primary Stage:

42. The number of classes constituting the primary stage of education varies from State to State. For the sake of uniformity, the first five classes have been treated to constitute the primary stage in all States/Union Territories.

43. The enrolment of Scheduled Castes in 1964-65 at this stage was 56.55 lakhs, of whom 16.77 were girls i.e. against every 100 boys, only 30 girls were on rolls in this stage of education for the country as a whole. The enrolment of Scheduled Caste students formed 11.7 per cent of the total enrolment in primary stage. The corresponding extent of coverage was only 79.6.

44. Table 21 indicates the level of enrolment of Scheduled Castes at the primary stage in various States and Union Territories.

Middle Stage:

45. Although the number of classes constituting the middle stage as well varies from State to State, for the sake of uniformity, classes VI to VIII (3 classes) have been taken to constitute the middle stage in all States and Union Territories.

46. The Scheduled Caste enrolment in middle classes was 9.16 lakhs in 1964-65, of whom 1.83 lakhs were girls. This enrolment formed 9.4 per cent of the total enrolment at this stage of education during this year. The corresponding extent of coverage of Scheduled Caste students was 64.0 at all-India level. Table 22 depicts the position of enrolment of Scheduled Castes in middle stage in various States and Union Territories.

High/Higher Secondary Stage

47. The number of classes in High/Higher Secondary stage of education varies from State to State. But for purposes of this report, High/Higher Secondary stage has been taken to consist of classes IX and above.

48. During 1964-65, the number of students belonging to Scheduled Castes in this stage of education was 3.65 lakhs, of whom nearly 58 thousand or 15.7 per cent were girls. The enrolment of Scheduled Castes in this stage for only 8.4 per cent of the total enrolment. The corresponding extent of coverage of scheduled castes was 57.1. The State-wise picture of Scheduled Caste enrolment in secondary classes is given in Table 23.

VOCATIONAL, SPECIAL AND OTHER STAGES OF SCHOOL EDUCATION

50. Vocational education includes *inter alia* Agriculture, Commerce, Teachers' Training, Technical/Industrial and Arts and Crafts schools etc. Special education includes institutions for handicapped children and reformatory schools. Other stages of education relate to Oriental Studies and Social (Adult) Education.

51. The enrolment of Scheduled Caste students receiving Vocational education during 1964-65 was 26,293 which formed 9.1 per cent of the total enrolment at this stage. The corresponding figures in respect of special and other stage of education were 1,982 and 2,18,613 forming 9.1 per cent and 9.2 per cent of the total enrolment respectively. Further details are given in table 25.

GENERAL HIGHER EDUCATION

52. The enrolment of Scheduled Castes in General Higher Education classes in 1964-65 was 64,055 of whom 4,983 were girls. This formed 3.8% of the total enrolment in General Higher education. PROFESSIONAL AND OTHER HIGHER EDUCATION COURSES:

54. The total enrolment of Scheduled Caste students in professional and other higher education courses in 1964-65 was 31,124 of whom 3,577 were girls. This formed 4.3 per cent of the total enrolment of 7,19,799 students belonging to all communities. The extent of coverage of Scheduled Caste students in this stage of education was 29.3 for the country as a whole. The stagewise distribution of scheduled caste students is given in table 28.

58. The population of Scheduled Tribes for the year 1965 is not available. However, it has been assumed that the percentage of Scheduled Tribes population to the total population of each State in 1965 was the same as that in 1961.

Enrolment of Scheduled Tribes in Various Types of Educational Institutions

59. Enrolment of Scheduled Tribes in various types of educational institutions increased from 19.29 lakhs in 1960-61 to 28.09 lakhs in 1964-65. The corresponding figures of girls students belonging to Scheduled Tribes were 4.68 lakhs (24.3%) in 1960-61 and 7.52 lakhs (26.8%) in 1964-65. Percentage enrolment of Scheduled Tribes to the total enrolment increased from 4.0 to 4.2 during the period. The extent of coverage of the enrolment of tribal population increased for the country as a whole from 58.8 in 1960-61 to 61.8 in 1964-65. The comparative position of the enrolment of Scheduled Tribes and their extent of coverage in different types of educational institutions for the country as a whole in 1960-61 and 1964-65 is shown in Table 31 and 31(a), respectively.

By 1964-65, the total enrolment in pre-primary schools increased to 1,98,022 of which 6,698 (3.4%) were scheduled tribe students. During this period, the extent of coverage of Scheduled Tribe students decreased from 51.5 to 50.0. The position in the different States and Union Territories is shown in Table 34.

64. While the total enrolment in primary schools in the country increased from 2.66 crores in 1960-61 to 3.58 crores in 1964-65, showing an increase of 35% during this period, the enrolment of Scheduled Tribes increased from 13.41 lakhs giving an increase of 46 per cent during the period. **To 19.65 lakhs**

65. The percentage enrolment of Scheduled Tribes in primary schools increased from 5.0% in 1960-61 to 5.5% in 1964-65 at all India level. The extent of coverage increased from 73.5 to 80.9. The statewise comparative picture of the percentage enrolment and extent of coverage is given in Table 35.

(iii) Middle Schools

66. The total enrolment in Middle Schools in the country increased from 1.06 crores in 1960-61 to 1.57 crores in 1964-65, showing an increase of 48% during the period. The corresponding enrolment of Scheduled Tribe students in these schools increased from 3.52 lakhs to 4.92 lakhs (or 40%) during the same period.

67. For the country as a whole, Scheduled Tribe students formed 3.3% of the total enrolment in Middle Schools in 1960-61, as against 3.1 per cent in 1964-65. As a percentage of total population, Scheduled Tribe population was 6.8%. Hence

(iii) High/Higher Secondary Schools:

68. The total number of students enrolled in these institutions in the country as a whole increased from 75.12 lakhs in 1960-61 to 113.24 lakhs in 1964-65, registering an increase of 50.8%. As against this, the enrolment of Scheduled Tribe students increased from 96,206 to 1,86,760 (94% increase) during the same period. State-wise details of enrolment giving comparative picture of these years is given in Statement B V.

69. The number of Scheduled Tribe students as a percentage of total enrolment in high/higher secondary schools increased from 1.3% to 1.6% and the extent of coverage varied from 19.1 to 23.5 during 1960-61 to 1964-65. The position in the different States is given in Table 37.

Vocational and Technical Schools:

71. Detailed data on the enrolment of the Scheduled Tribe students in technical and vocational schools for the year 1960-61 is not available. Therefore, the enrolment position of Scheduled Tribes relating to 1964-65 only has been discussed in the following paragraphs.

72. Of the total number of 2,69,096 students (1,33,373 boys and 85,723 girls) studying in technical and vocational schools in 1964-65 , 6244 students

(4,840 boys and 1,404 girls) belonged to Scheduled Tribes. It formed 2.3 percent of the total enrolment in vocational and technical schools. The extent of coverage of Scheduled Tribes for the country as a whole was 33.3. The position in regard to different States is given in table 39.

73. Major types of vocational schools are teacher training schools, agricultural schools, commercial schools and technical and industrial schools, etc. Detailed Statewise picture of enrolment of Scheduled Tribes in 1964-65 in these schools is given in Settlement B-VI.

74. For the country as a whole, there were 2,838 Scheduled Tribe students enrolled in teacher training schools, of whom 541 were girls. This formed

4.1 per cent of the total enrolment in these schools. The extent of coverage of Scheduled Tribes in 1964-65 came to 60.3

Total enrolment of Scheduled Tribes in Technical and Industrial Schools in 1964-65 was 1848 which formed 2.3 per cent of the total enrolment in this type of institutions. Of this total enrolment of Scheduled Tribes, 525 were girls. The extent of coverage of Scheduled Tribes in these institutions was 33.8 for the country as a whole.

SCHOOLS FOR SPECIAL EDUCATION

75. Special education schools are institutions of school level specifically meant for physically and mentally handicapped children. This also includes reformatories. Separate information on the enrolment of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes in these institutions for the year 1960-61 is not available.

76. In 1964-65, total enrolment in these schools was 21,669 consisting of 16,515 boys and 5,154 girls. Of this, 550 (536 boys and 14 girls) were Scheduled Tribes which formed 2.5 per cent of the total enrolment. The corresponding extent of coverage was 36.8 The State-wise position is given in Table 40.

SCHOOLS FOR OTHER EDUCATION

77. Data relating to the number of Scheduled Tribe students studying in this type of Schools for the year 1960-61 is not available. In 1964-65, total enrolment in these schools was 23,24,610 (14,20,568 boys and 9,04,042 girls). Of this, 1,36,014 (87,218 boys and 48,796 girls) or 5.9 per cent belonged to Scheduled Tribes. The majority of this enrolment was in social (Adult) education schools. The extent of coverage of these students in these schools for the country as a whole was 86.8. Statewise figures are given in Table 41.

INSTITUTIONS FOR HIGHER EDUCATION, UNIVERSITIES AND COLLEGES OF
GENERAL EDUCATION

73. While the total enrolment of students in this type of institutions increased from 7.63 lakhs in 1960-61 to 10.89 lakhs in 1964-65 or 41.8 per cent, the number of Scheduled Tribe students increased from 7,266 to 12,033 or 66 per cent.

79. For the country as a whole, the enrolment of Scheduled Tribes in these institutions constituted only 1.1 per cent of the total enrolment in 1964-65 as against 0.9 per cent in 1960-61. The corresponding figures of the extent of coverage were 16.2 and 13.2 respectively. Table 42 gives the comparative Statewise position of the percentage enrolment and extent of coverage.

HIGHER PROFESSIONAL AND OTHER EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS

80. For the year 1960-61, we do not have data available separately for professional schools and colleges, although we have it for the year 1964-65. To make a comparative study at these two different periods, the data in respect of schools and colleges for both the years has been combined. On the basis of this combined data, the analysis is as below.

81. The total enrolment of scheduled tribes in these institutions increased from 1,28,166 in 1960-61 to 1,47,747 in 1964-65, registering an increase of 15 per cent. As against this, the enrolment of students belonging to all communities in these institutions increased from 23.1 lakhs in 1960-61 to 32.7 lakhs in 1964-65 showing an increase of 41.6 per cent.

82. For the country as a whole, the enrolment of Scheduled Tribe students in 1960-61 formed 5.5 per cent of the total enrolment in these institutions. This percentage decreased to 4.5 in 1964-65. The extent of coverage of Scheduled Tribes decreased from 80.9 in 1960-61 to 66.2 in 1964-65. Table 43 gives the Statewise picture of the percentage enrolment of Scheduled Tribes and their extent of coverage in these institutions.

COLLEGES OF PROFESSIONAL EDUCATION

83. Since data of Scheduled Tribe students receiving professional higher education is not available separately for the year 1960-61, their enrolment position is analysed below for the year 1964-65

84. There were 4,214 Scheduled Tribe students (including 486 girls) on rolls in colleges for professional education in 1964-65. This formed only 0.7 per cent of the total enrolment of 5,66,225 (including 85,895 girls). The extent of coverage of Scheduled Tribe students in these institutions for the country as a whole was 10.3.

85. Table 44 gives the enrolment of Scheduled Tribe students in some of the main types of professional colleges, together with percentage enrolment and extent of coverage during 1964-65.

86. So far, the progress in enrolment of Scheduled Tribes in various educational institutions has been discussed. But since some institutions provide facilities of education for more than one stage of instruction e.g. a high school may have middle and primary classes attached to it, it is desirable to analyse

the progress of enrolment at various stages of education, in order to get the correct picture. In subsequent paragraphs, therefore, the enrolment of Scheduled Tribes by stages and classes has been discussed for the year 1964-65, the corresponding data for 1960-61 having not been available. Table 45 indicates the enrolment of Scheduled Tribes for 1964-65 at different stages of education.

CENTRAL SCHOOL EDUCATION

(i) Primary Stage:

87. The number of classes constituting the primary stage of education varied from State to State. However, for the sake of uniformity, 5 classes have been taken here to constitute the primary stage of education in all States. For the country as a whole, enrolment of Scheduled Tribe students in primary stage was 22.82 lakhs (16.54 boys and 6.28 girls) in 1964-65. This formed 4.7 per cent of the total enrolment. The corresponding extent of coverage was 69. The States' position of enrolment together with percentage enrolment and extent of coverage is shown in Table 46.

(ii) MIDDLE STAGE

88. The number of classes forming middle stage also varied from State to State. For the sake of uniformity, VI to VIII (3 Classes) have been taken to constitute middle stage in all States and Union Territories.

89. For the country as a whole in the year 1964-65, the enrolment of Scheduled Tribe students in the middle stage was 2.59 lakhs of which only 0.53 lakhs were girls. The enrolment formed 2.6 per cent of the total enrolment at this stage of education. The corresponding extent of coverage was 38.2. The Statewise position is given in table 47.

(III) HIGH / HIGHER SECONDARY STAGE

90. The number of classes in high/higher secondary stage of general school education also varied from State to State. For purposes of this report, the high/higher secondary stage is taken to consist of classes IX and above.

91. During 1964-65, the enrolment of Scheduled Tribes at high/higher secondary stage was 0.93 lakh, of which nearly 0.17 lakh were girls. This enrolment formed 2.0 per cent of the total enrolment in these classes. The corresponding extent of coverage was 29.4. The Statewise position of the enrolment of Scheduled Tribes at high/higher secondary stage is shown in table 48.
