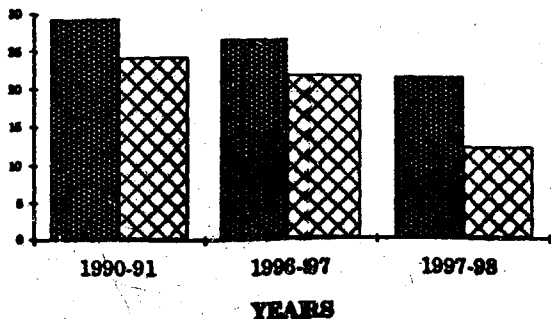

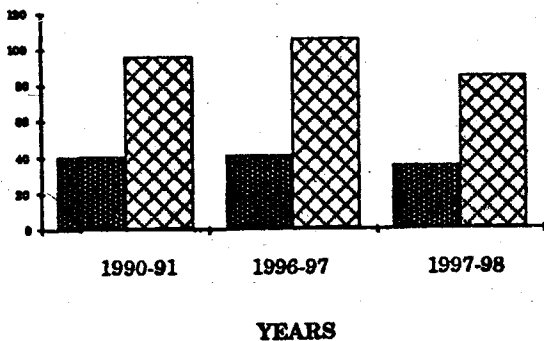
**AREA AND PRODUCTION OF TOTAL OIL SEEDS

■ AREA(Hectares) □ PRODUCTION(Tonnes)

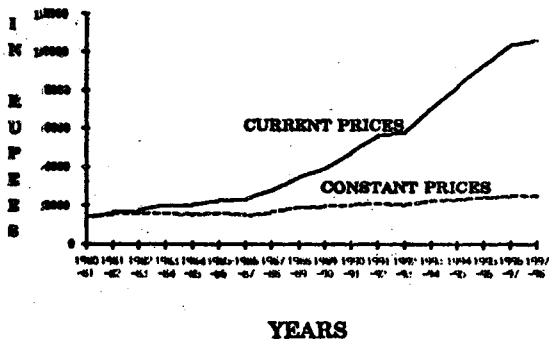


AREA AND PRODUCTION OF RICE IN ANDHRA PRADESH - 1997-98

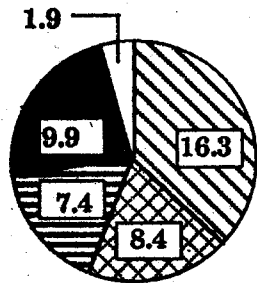

(BASE: 1980-81)**

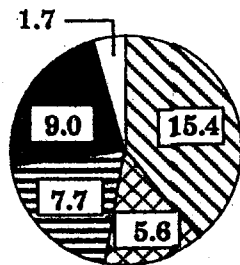
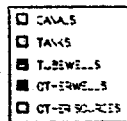
