NOTIFICATION

The 21st May 2009

No.8161/SME.— In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Orissa hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Orissa Elementary Education (Method of Recruitment and Conditions of Service of teachers and officers) Rules, 1997, namely : —

1. (1) These rules may be called the Orissa Elementary Education (Method of Recruitment and Conditions of Service of teachers and officers) Amendment Rules, 2009.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the *Orissa Gazette*.

2. In the Orissa Elementary Education (Method of Recruitment and Conditions of Service of teachers and officers) Rules, 1997 (hereinafter referred to as the said rules) in rule 6

I. for clause (a) of sub-rule(1) the following clause shall be substituted, namely : —

“(1) (a) Vacancies in the posts belonging to Level-V of the service shall be filled up by way of direct recruitment in the following manner, namely :—

(i) As nearly as may be but not more than 60% of the vacancies shall be filled up by the candidates having passed High School Certificate Examination and / or Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination with Certified Teacher Training Course from recognised Board or University and / or equivalent thereof.

- (ii) the remaining 40% of the vacancies shall be filled up by the candidates having Bachelor Degree in Arts or Science or Commerce or Examination equivalent thereto with Bachelor Degree in Education”.

II. clause (c) shall be renumbered as sub-rule (2).

3. In the said rules, in rule 7, in sub-rule(1), for clause(e), the following clause shall be substituted, namely :—

“(e) (i) He/She must have passed High School Certificate / Higher Secondary(10+2) Examination with Certified Teachers Training course or equivalent examination from a recognised Board or University in order to be eligible for the vacancies under sub-clause(i) of clause(1)(a) of rule-6; and

(ii) He / She must have passed Bachelor Degree in Arts, Science or Commerce Examination or equivalent thereto with Bachelor Degree in Education or equivalent thereto from a recognised University, in order to be eligible for the vacancies under sub-clause(ii) of clause(1)(a) of sub-rule(I) of rule-6”.

4. In the said rules, in rule 11 after sub-rule(1), the following sub-rules, shall be inserted, namely :—

(i) “(a) 60% of the vacancies shall be filled up by the candidates having passed High School Certificate / Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination with Secondary Teachers Training/Certified Teachers Course from recognised Board or University and/or equivalent thereof.

(b) 40% of the vacancies shall be filled up by the candidates having passed Bachelor Degree in Arts or Science or Commerce or equivalent with Bachelor degree in Education”,

(ii) After sub-rule(2), the following clauses and the proviso shall be inserted namely :—

“(a) As nearly as may be but not more than 50% of the vacancies shall be filled up by the candidates having passed High School Certificate / Higher Secondary (10+2) with Secondary Teachers Training / Certified Teachers Course from recognised Board or University and/or equivalent thereof.

(b) The remaining 50% of the vacancies shall be filled up by the candidates having Bachelor degree in Arts, Science, Commerce or examination equivalent thereto with Bachelor degree in Education.

Provided that in case of non availability of adequate number of persons for promotion to Level-III of the service, candidates having rendered 13 years of service in Level-IV & V taken together shall also be considered for promotion against the remaining vacancies.

Provided further that the persons must have rendered minimum one year of service in Level-IV ”.

(iii) After sub-rule(3) the following clause shall be inserted, namely :—

“(a) He / She must have possessed a Bachelor Degree in Arts, Science, Commerce or an examination equivalent thereto with Bachelor Degree in Education from a recognised Board or University.”

5. In the said rules, in rule 15, in sub-rule(1) after clause (c), the following clause shall be inserted, namely :—

“(d) Separate gradation list for teachers having passed

(i) High School Certificate and / or Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination with Certified Teacher Training Course; and

(ii) Bachelors degree Examination in Arts, Science, Commerce or an examination equivalent thereto with Bachelor Degree in Education. shall be maintained in Level-V, IV & III of the Service”.
