1. Fifth Plan Outlay

The approved outlay for Educational Development in the Fifth Five Year Plan is Rs.1130.00 lacs :-

This includes an outlay of Rs.167.50 lacs for buildings.

2. Annual Plan for 1974-75

An outlay of Rs.150.00 lacs was originally approved for the year 1974-75 including Rs.57.00 lacs for buildings. This was subsequently revised to Rs.150.00 lacs. The expenditure is estimated around Rs. 122.96 lacs.

The main achievements during the year 1974-75 are given below :-

Elementary Education

- (i) Opening of 400 Primary Schools.
- (ii) Upgrading of 102 Primary Schools to Middle Standard as against a target of 100 schools.
- (iii) Provision of incentives to children particularly girls and in tribal areas.
- (iv) Improvement of Libraries in Elementary Schools.
- (v) Work on 100 class rooms in co-operation with community.

Secondary Education

- (i) Upgrading of 41 Middle Schools to High Schools as against the target of 30 schools.
- (ii) 37 additional hands were provided to District Offices besides appointment of eight Deputy DEOs. A separate District Education Officer was appointed for Lahaul & Spiti District.

University Education

- (i) Development grant of Rs.10,00 lacs to H.P. University.
- (ii) Provision of additional staff and equipment to the existing Colleges.

General

- (i) In order to strengthen educational administration at the Directorate and Zonal level, 31 additional hands were sanctioned.

Art & Culture

- (i) Two new District Libraries were opened at Una and Hamirpur.
- (ii) Improvement of Central State Library, 9 District Libraries, 5 Block and 25 Village Libraries.
- (iii) Improvement of State Museum, Simla.
- (iv) Continuation of work on District Gazetteers

3. Annual Plan for 1975-76

1- Primary & Middle (Rs. 1 lacs)
Facilities (Rs. 66.69 lacs).

- (1) It is proposed to continue 400 Primary and 102 Middle Schools opened in 1974-75 and to open another 90 Primary and 50 Middle Schools in 1975-76 by way of step towards Universal Education.

- (ii) Provision has been made for the following centres for part-time classes proposed to be started in 1975-76 :-

Teachers Training (Rs. 1.29 lacs)

Provision is to be utilised mainly for in-service training of about 500 elementary teachers.

Incentives (Rs. 4.54 lacs)

The amount is to be utilised for providing incentives like free text books, free writing material, free clothing in order to increase enrolment in schools, to reduce wastage and stagnation and to improve the rate of retention. In all, approximately 64,000 children will be benefited.

Qualitative Improvement (Rs. 4.01 lacs)

The amount is proposed to be utilised for the following programmes :-

- (a) Introduction of work experience in 16 schools
- (b) Improvement of libraries in 150 schools.
- (c) Supply of science kits in 400 Primary Schools
- (d) Continuation of 49 merit scholarships and award of 60 New Scholarships in Middle Classes.
- (e) Completion of works and construction of 50 class rooms in co-operation with community.

II. SECONDARY EDUCATION (Rs. 29.46 lacs)1. Inspection (Rs. 3.15 lacs)

The provision is meant for continuation of 46 heads provided to District Education Offices.

2. Facilities (Rs. 19.15 lacs)

The provision is to be utilised for continuation of 41 High Schools opened in 1974-75 and for opening of 35 New High Schools in 1975-76. 35 additional Teachers sanctioned in 1974-75 will be continued.

3. Teachers Training (Rs. 0.05 lac)

The provision will be utilised for the improvement of College of Education for the Science Education Programme.

4. Qualitative Improvement (Rs. 6.58 lacs)

The provision is to be utilised mainly for the supply of library books (Rs. 0.03 lac), improvement of laboratories (Rs. 0.30 lac) and completion of works (Rs. 5.98 lacs).

5. Scholarships (Rs. 0.33 lac)

100 scholarships are proposed to be continued.

III- SPECIAL EDUCATION (Rs. 2.05 lacs)

1. Adult Education (Rs. 0.40 lacs)

The amount is for providing functional literacy to 1000 adults.

2. Modern Indian Languages (Rs. 1.32 lacs)

The provision is for the development of State Institute of Languages.

3. Sanskrit Education (Rs. 0.35 lacs)

The provision is meant for improvement of 5 Sanskrit Pathshalas being run by the Department and completion of building of Sanskrit Pathshala, Sundernagar.

IV- PRE-UNIVERSITY EDUCATION (Rs. 0.11 lac)

In order to work out details for introduction of the new educational structure of 10+2+3 and Vocational Courses at the Pre-University Stage, it is proposed to appoint a Senior Class-I Officer at the Headquarters and a provision of Rs. 0.11 lac has been made for the purpose.

V- UNIVERSITY EDUCATION (Rs. 18.32 lacs)

1. H.P. University (Rs. 12.00 lacs)

The provision is meant for development of the H.P. University.

2. Facilities (Rs. 3.42 lacs)

The provision is to be utilised for continuation of staff (Rs. 2.00) sanctioned for existing Govt. Colleges, the improvement of Colleges (0.42) and lifting assistance from U.G.C. (Rs. 1.00) lac)

3. Scholarships (Rs. 2.70 lac)

The provision is to be utilised for 50 Scholarships for T.D.C. and 20 for M.A./M.Sc.

4. Other Programmes (Rs. 5.20 lacs)

The provision is meant for completion of works in Colleges (Rs. 5.05 lacs); development of text books libraries in Colleges (Rs. 0.10 lac) and faculty improvement (Rs. 0.05 lac)

4. MINIMUM NEEDS PROGRAMME (Rs. 42.00 lacs)

The approved Fifth Plan Outlay for Minimum Needs Programme is Rs. 335.00 lacs. An expenditure of Rs. 20.51 lacs is expected in 1974-75 against an outlay of Rs. 30.00 lacs. An outlay of ~~Rs. 42.00~~ ^{Rs. 42.00} ~~Rs. 84.30~~ lacs which is included in the total outlay of _____ lacs for Primary & Middle Education has been proposed under Minimum Needs Programme for 1975-76.

The main items of achievement under this programme may be mentioned as follows :-

- (1) Continuation of 160 Primary and 26 Middle Schools opened in 1974-75.
- (2) Opening of 90 New Primary and 50 Middle Schools in 1975-76.
- (3) Opening of 300 P/T Classes and 40 continuation classes for age-group 11-14 years.
- (4) Incentives to about 64,000 children.
- (5) Construction of 73 Glass rooms through P.W.D. and 50 in co-operation with the community besides completion of 100 class rooms taken up in 1974-75.

5. SUB PLAN FOR TRIBAL AREAS (Rs. 7.65 lacs)

The approved outlay for Sub-Plan for tribal areas for the 5th Plan is Rs. 36.63 lacs.

A brief description of the Sub-Plan for Tribal Areas for the year 1974-75 and 1975-76 is given below :-

Sub-Plan 1974-75 (Tribal Areas)

An outlay of Rs. 5.20 lacs was sanctioned in the budget for 1974-75 in the Sub-Plan. This was subsequently revised to Rs. 6.25 lacs. The expenditure is estimated around Rs. 6.87 lacs. Main achievements during 1974-75 are given below :-

- (1) Opening of 25 Primary Schools as against the target of 23, 6 Middle Schools according to target and 4 High Schools against a target of 2 High Schools. Area-wise break-up is given below :-

- (i) Continuation of 25 Primary Schools and opening of 3 new Primary Schools.
- (ii) Continuation of 6 Middle Schools and opening of 3 New Middle Schools.
- (iii) Continuation of 4 High Schools.
- (iv) Incentives to about 7000 children at a cost of Rs.0.80 lac.
- (v) Opening of 23 Centres for Part-time Classes for Functional Literacy.
- (vi) Completion of work on 7 School buildings.

- (vii) Construction of 6 class rooms through PND and 6 in co-operation with the Village Panchayat.
- (viii) Additional enrolment of 400 children in Primary Classes and 159 in Middle and 48 in Secondary Classes.

Minimum Needs Programme (Tribal areas)

Out of the total outlay of Rs. 7.65 lacs proposed for 1975-76, an outlay of Rs. 5.18 lacs will be covered under the Minimum Needs Programme.
