GENERAL SURVEY

Population .—

The estimated population of Haryana in 1978 was 116.83 lakhs. Of this, 16.45 lakhs (14.08%) belonged to age-group 6—11, 9.50 lakhs (8.10%) to age-group 11-14 and 8.81 lakhs (7.54%) to age-group 14-17 years. Thus the total estimated number of school going children in age-group 6—17 years were 34.76 lakhs (29.75%) in 1978, and out of this, 16.57 lakhs (47.67%) were actually attending the schools.

Institutions :—

During this period, the number of institutions of different types remained almost the same. The table I given below gives the comparative picture of the selected type of institutions in 1976-77 and 1977-78.

Enrolment :—

The enrolment in Classes I—V has come down from 11.68 lakhs in 1976-77 to 11.46 lakhs in 1977-78. This decrease was due to unprecedented floods in Haryana during this academic year.

The enrolment in Classes VI—VIII increased from 3.85 lakhs to 4.07 lakhs. The enrolment in Classes IX-XI was 1.04 lakhs only. Enrolment in Classes of Higher Education has also shown an upward trend. The enrolment at different stages of

education in the year 1976-77 and 1977-78 is given below :—

Teachers :—

The number of teachers in schools for General Education increased from 50290 in 1976-77 to 51349 in 1977-78 showing an increase of 1149. Of this number, 79, 28741, 13237 and 9382 teachers were teaching Pre-Primary, Primary, Middle and High & Higher Secondary Classes respectively. The percentage of trained teachers in Primary, Middle and High & Higher Secondary Schools was 99.21, 99.75 and 98.94 respectively. The number of teachers in institutions of Higher Education and teachers training colleges (excluding other professional colleges) was 3411 during the year 1977-78.

Education among Scheduled Castes :—

The total Enrolment of Scheduled Castes in Schools for General Education i.e. in classes I—XI was 2.06 lakhs. The Enrolment of Scheduled Castes has also come down from 2.08 lakhs in 1976-77 to 2.06 lakhs in 1977-78. The decrease in the enrolment of Scheduled Castes is due to the general fall in the enrolment at Primary and Secondary stages.

Budget Provision :—

The total budgeted expenditure of the State Government on general education increased from Rs. 3748.10 lakhs (actual expenditure) in 1976-77 to Rs. 4108.59 lakhs in 1977-78 (Revised estimated). The budgeted expenditure as well as the percentage of expenditure on Primary & Secondary education to total expenditure has also gone up from 2899.92 lakhs (77.48 %) in 1976-77 to 3446.81 lakhs (83.89 %) in 1977-78 respectively. Again though the total expenditure on Direction and Inspection has increased from Rs. 122.42 lakhs in 1976-77 to Rs. 129.92 lakhs in 1977-78, but the percentage of expenditure on this item to total has come down from 3.27 to 3.16.
