Chandigarh is a small territory spread over an area of 114 Sq.Kms. comprising Chandigarh, 22 villages and one town. It has recorded the population of 6,42,015 persons consisting of 3,58,614 males and 2,83,401 females according to 1991 population Census. Chandigarh has recorded a literacy rate of 77.81%.

The present publication titled "Statistical Handbook-1993" is sixth in the series. It contains comprehensive statistical data covering all important socio economic aspects of UT, Chandigarh such as Area, Population, Climate, Agriculture, Irrigation, Forest, Animal Husbandry, Power, Industries, Labour & Employment, Roads, Transport, Health, Education, Trade & Finance, Prices, Social Welfare, Crimes, Public Distribution System, Housing and Joint Stock Company.

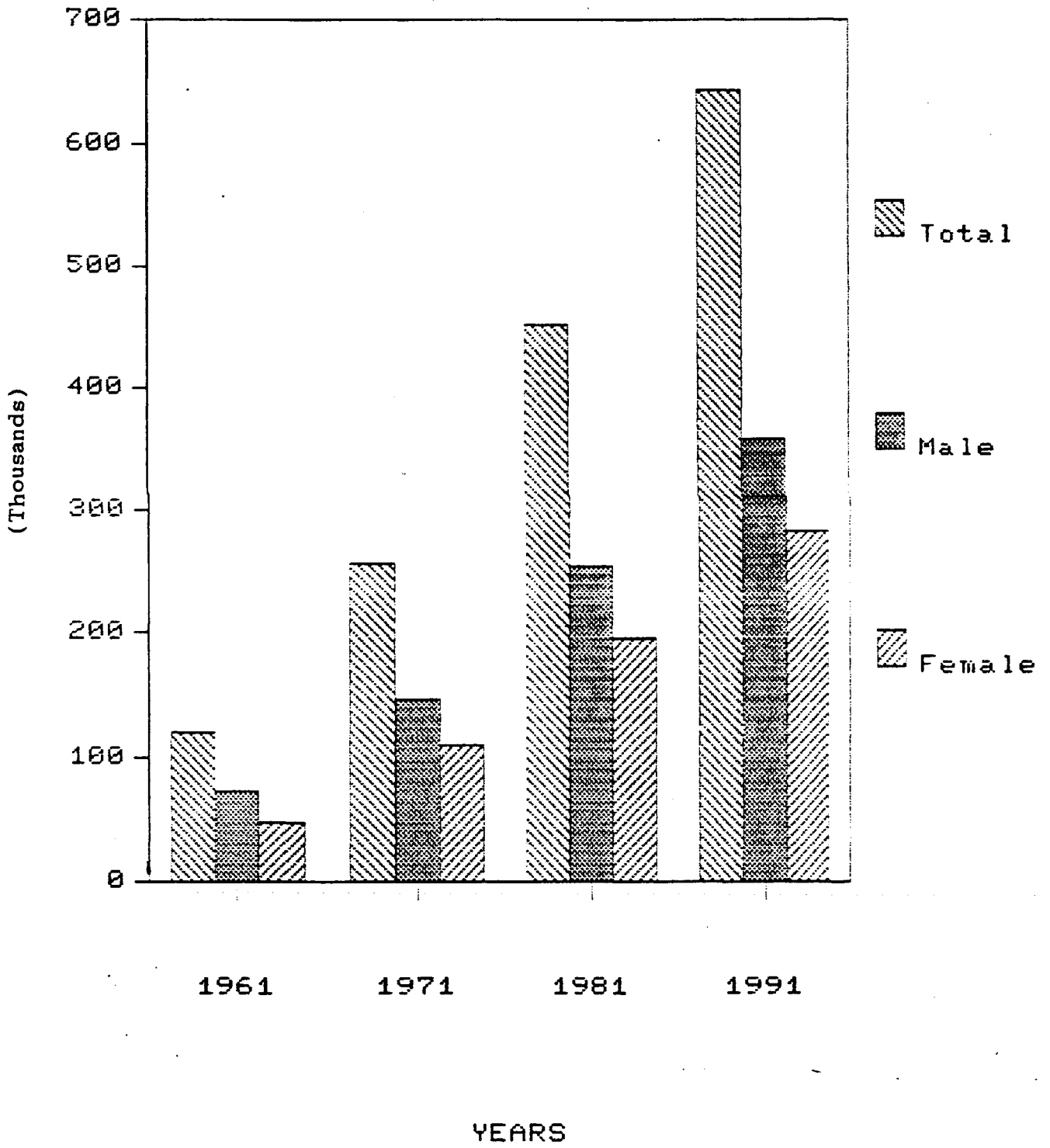

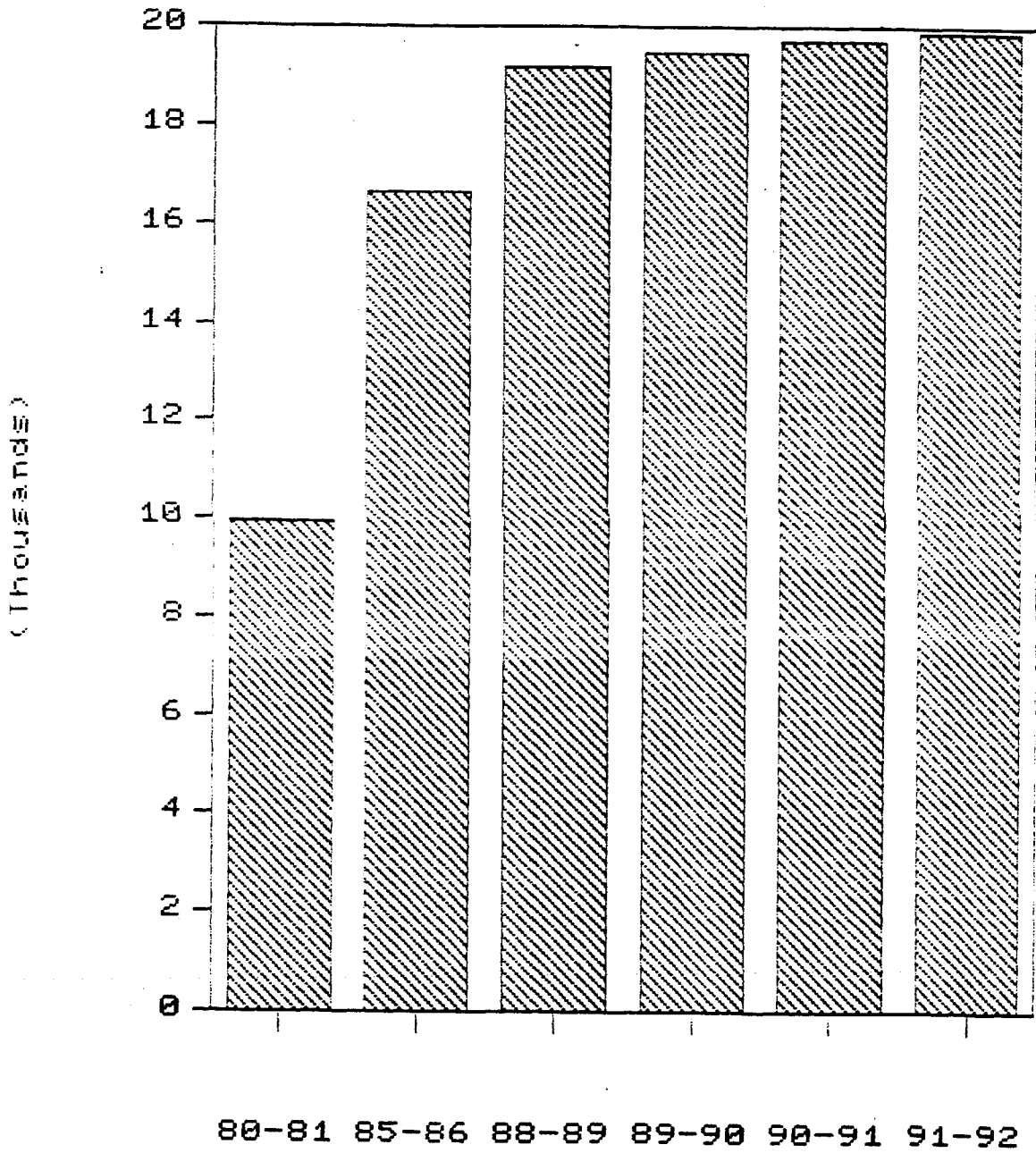

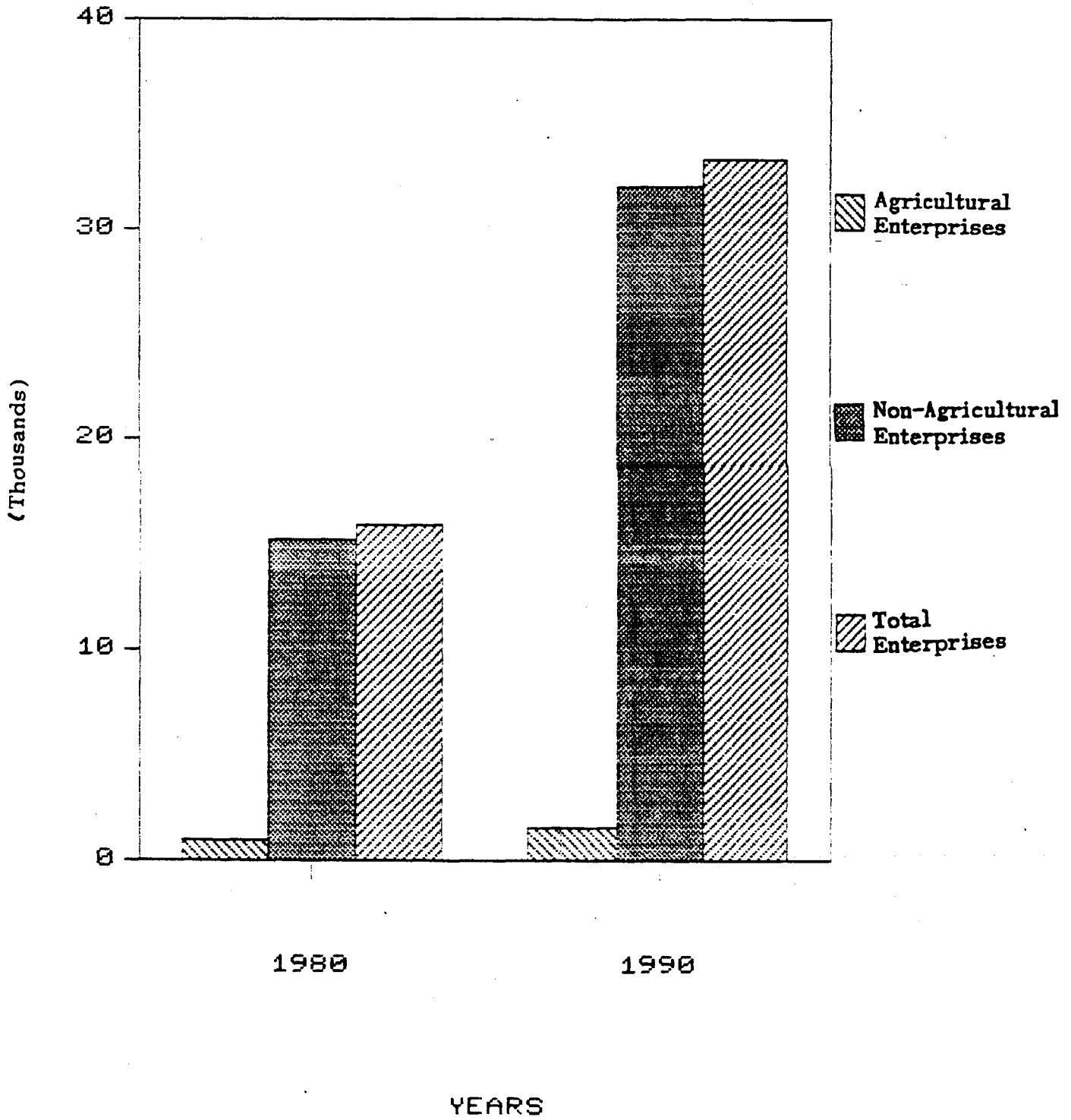
