GENERAL FEATURES OF ARUNACHAL PRADESH

- 1. ARUNACHAL PRADESH:** Arunachal Pradesh is situated in the North-Eastern part of India with 83743 sq. Kms in area. Arunachal is the largest state areawise in the North-East region.
- 2. Location** : Between latitude 26° 28' N to 29° 30' N and Longitude 91° 30' E to 97° 30' E.
- 3 Forest area** : 68,847 Sq.Km. (82.21 %) of forest area in Arunachal Pradesh (as per Satellite Survey of Dec 88 to Feb. 99)
- 4. Arunachal Pradesh Capital** : Itanagar (located at an altitude of 530 metre above SL). It is named after Itafort meaning fort of bricks built in 14th century A.D.

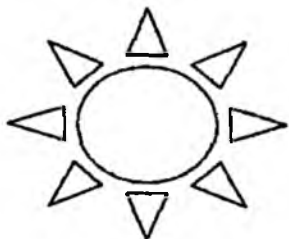
