FOREWORD

BASIC INFORMATION on the Directorate of Higher & Technical Education representation of the status of institution of Higher And Technical Education in the State of Arunachal Pradesh. It is due to the pioneering effort and team work of the Directorate of Higher and Technical Education, Itanagar. This brochure is in Publication since 2001, this outline presents at a glance the achievements and progress made in the field of Higher Education in Arunachal Pradesh. The Directorate collects and compiles relevant data from all the institutions of Higher, Technical and Professional Education in the State. This outline study is an effective tool to analyse and review the status and qualitative performance of these institutions. This kind of innovative Endeavour enables the Directorate to evaluate and take further needful measures for the overall improvement of the standard and quality of Higher Education. Since its inception in 1996, the Directorate has been committed to inculcate good practices and promote congenial Academic ambience in the Higher Educational institutions of the State.

The Saga of achievement is not a one day affair, statistical information and Graphical representation show that the Directorate as a monitoring and controlling Apex body, has left no stone unturned in bringing physical expansion and qualitative improvement of Higher and Technical Education in the previous years. Arunachal Pradesh has made a quantum jump in the realm of Higher as well as Technical Education. This is evident from the fact that there are 32 (thirty two) Institutions as on today, 13 (Thirteen) Government Institutions, 5 (Five) Central Government Institutions and 14 (Fourteen) Private Institutions, J. N. College, Pasighat was the only one institution of Higher Education in 1964. Nine Institutions including Arunachal University and NERIST were set up to impart Higher and Technological Education between 1964 and 1997. During this long span of thirty-three years the pace of expansion and development of Higher Education was rather slow and tardy. But in the last thirteen years (2001-2013) there has been a proliferation of Higher and Professional Education in the State. During this short period the State has been credited with the establishment of 21 (twenty one) Institutions of Higher and

Technical Education including Institution of non-formal Education. One significant development has taken place during this period. And that is the phenomenal growth private Educational Institutions with a leading role. Though the Private Colleges and Universities came into existence very late, some of them have achieved tremendous success with far-reaching consequences. This has provided a competitive edge to the State Government Institutions which have improved over the years.

Utmost sincerity has been maintained in the accuracy and authenticity of the data to further upgrade their compilation. The corpus of the data is based upon the inputs received from the affiliating University and other concerned competent authority/Heads of offices and Institutions.

The objective of this venture is to bring academic excellence in our Educational Institutions so as to enable them to compete with one another within the State and outside. Keeping this in view the results of Colleges and postgraduate Departments of the University in the previous University examinations have been compiled with a view to keep track record of their performance. A comparative statement has been prepared so that the concerned Colleges and University Departments may be aware of where they do stand and what they are required to improve in the next academic session.

The thrust is upon the learners and their teachers through this compilation an attempt has been made to indicate the enrolment of students, strength of the faculty members of all Institutions of Central Government, State Government and Private management. Tabular and graphical representation of figures makes it comprehensible and lucid for the readers.

The present edition is the updated version of all relevant and useful information. It has incorporated some more information on literacy rate in the State, access rate of Higher Education among the masses, results of APCSTE, AP-JEE etc.

Experiences of the recent past have shown that this handbook has proved a compendium guide for the researchers, planners, policy makers

and administrators. Hence, it caters the needs of various Departments/Organisations/Ministries like MHRD, Govt. of India for publication of Education Survey series, Economics and statistics Department of the Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh and above all to the individual research Scholars.

For this Herculean task of compiling this booklet and bringing into print, my heartfelt thanks go to all heads of the institutions for furnishing the necessary information, enabling us to bring out this statistical achievement this year too. I am also thankful to all my colleagues and staff, Dr. V. N. Sharma, SLO (NSS), Mr. N.K. Tripathi, ODS (T), Mr. Mithun Sarkar, UDC, Ms. Kirken Jini, UDC, whose collective and painstaking effort have made this compilation see the light of the day on time.

INTRODUCTION

Arunachal Pradesh, erstwhile NEFA, is situated at the North Eastern most corner of India sharing International boundaries with three countries namely Bhutan, China and Myanmar. It is area wise the largest state amongst the eight states of the North-Eastern region having an area of 83,743 sq. km and low density of population-17 per sq. The territory was known as “hidden land” during the British period. Slow and gradual administration penetrated only after the Independence of the country in 1947. Rapid development was made after 1972 when the territory attained the status of Union Territory and statehood in 1987.

At the time of independence of the country, there were officially 3 primary schools with enrolment of 35 students. When the first Census was conducted in 1961, the literacy rate was recorded at 7.23%. Now the state has 3172 number of different categories of schools including 118 numbers of Higher Secondary Schools with enrollment of 4, 19,811 (up to academic session 2011-12). The literacy rate as per census, 2011 has increased to 66.95.

The history of higher education in the state started with the establishment of the J.N. College, Pasighat on 4th July 1964 with enrolment of 42 students. Now, we have 30 number of higher education institutions including a Central University, a Deemed University and an NIT. The enrollment of higher education is recorded at 19548 (up to academic session 2011-2012). However, the Gross Enrolment Ratio (GER) within the age group of 18-24 years is quite low figure of 8.3 against the national figure of 12.4. The student-teacher ratio of Govt. Colleges in the state is 1:48 against the UGC laid norms of 1:20 for science, 1:25 for Honors Course (Humanities) and 1:30 for Pass course respectively. As such, there is acute shortage of teachers in Colleges.

The Directorate of Higher & Technical Education was established in 1996 by bifurcating from the erstwhile Directorate of Public Instruction. The mandate of the directorate is to consolidate and expand higher education in the state. As per “The Business of the Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh (Allocation) Rules 1998 under section 7.B, the Directorate of Higher & Technical Education has to deal with the following subjects:

1. College Education
2. Expansion, development and propagation of Technical and Professional Education(other than Medical Education)

3. Stipend/Scholarships and loans for Higher Education including Technical Education.
4. Administration of Educational institutions under the sector
5. Matters relating to Rajiv Gandhi University(Arunachal University)
6. Matters relating to conduct of Joint Entrance Examination and allotment of seats to Technical and Professional courses including Medical, Engineering, Agriculture, Horticulture, Pisciculture etc. against Arunachal Pradesh quota.
7. National Service Scheme
8. Matters relating to nomination of students to Engineering Institutions.

As a nodal Govt. Department the Directorate has not only the primary responsibility to co-ordinate for the planned development of Higher & Technical Education but also to oversee maintenance of standard of Higher Education in the state. Keeping this in view, this Basic Information is brought regularly as an annual exercise by this Directorate.

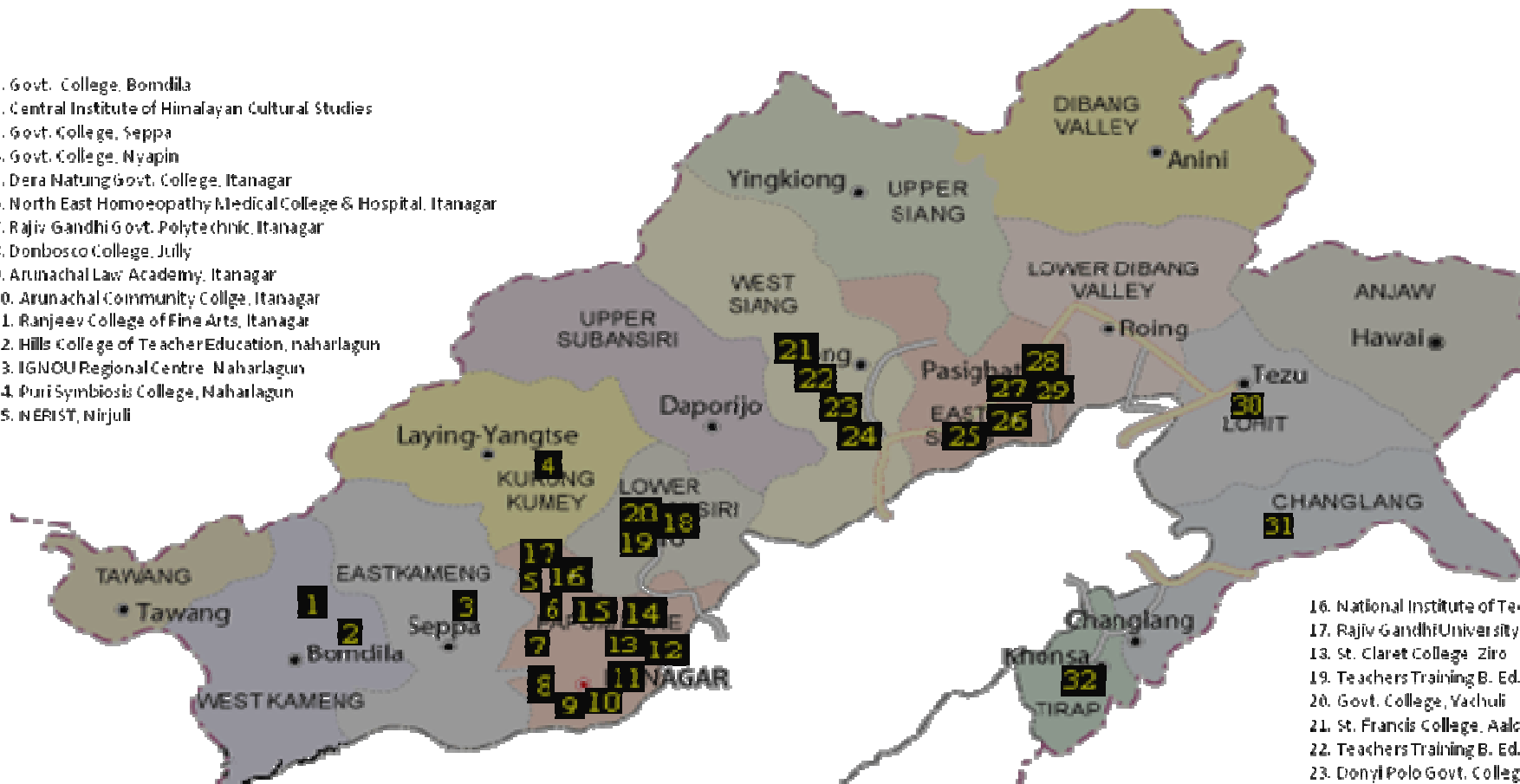

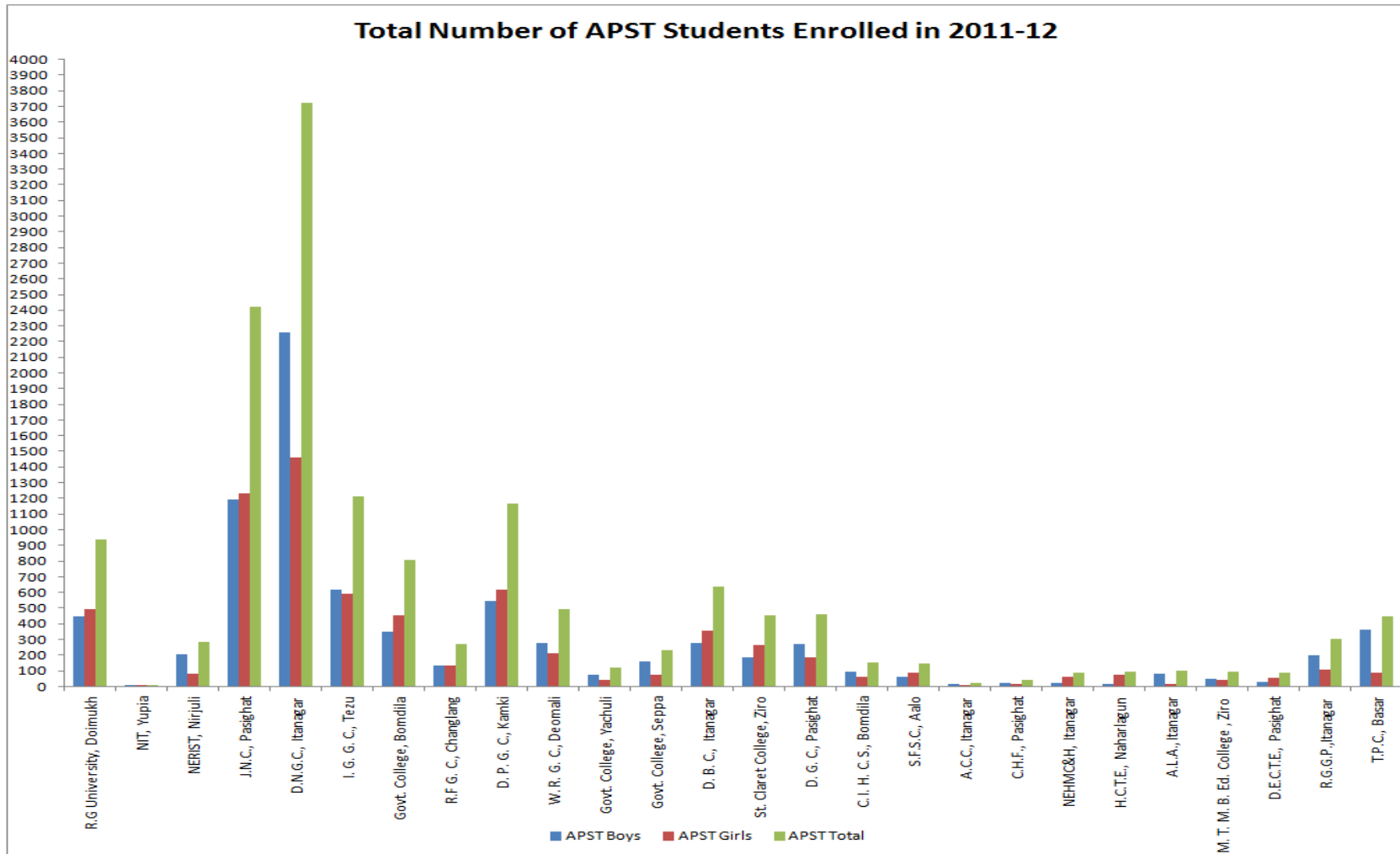

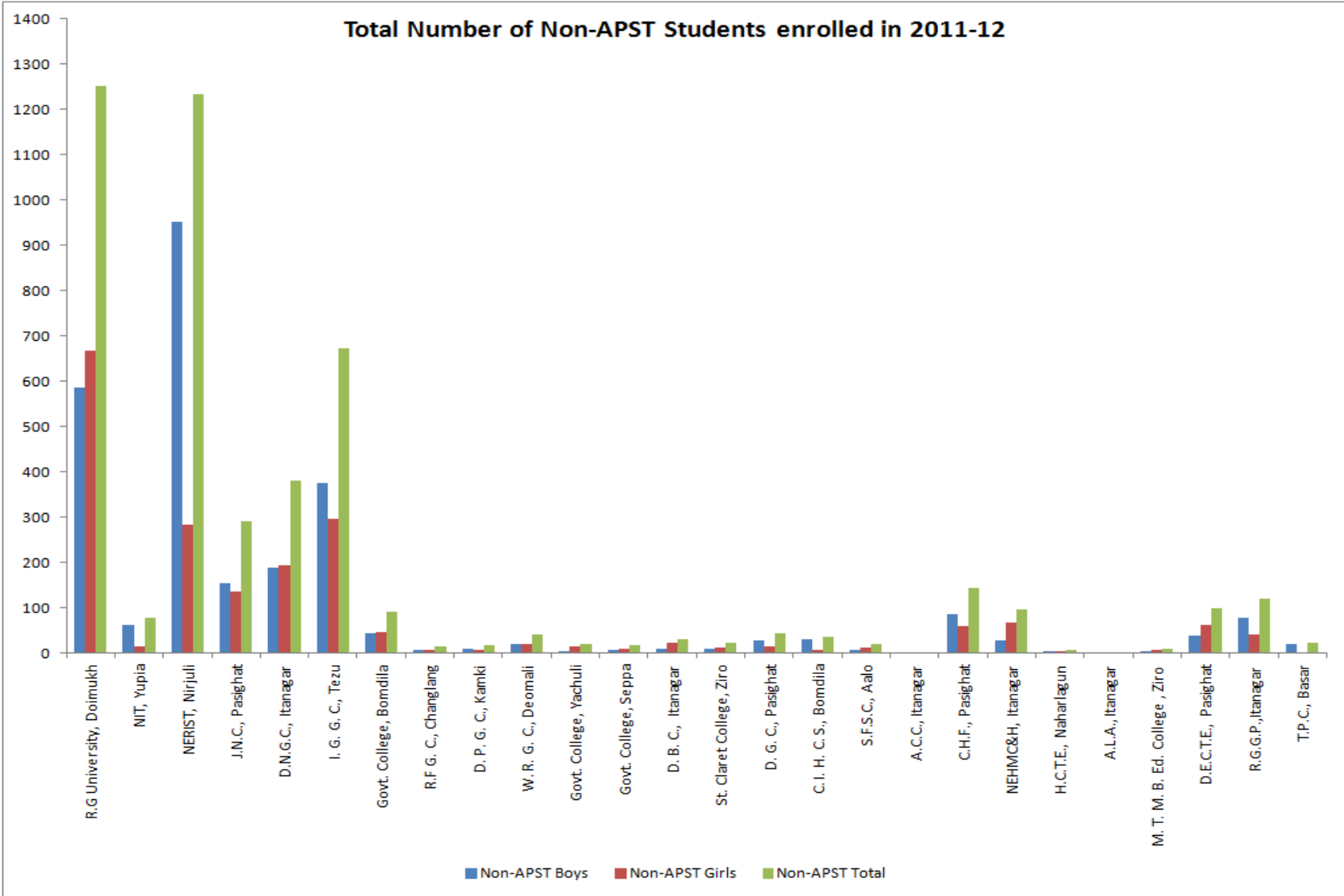

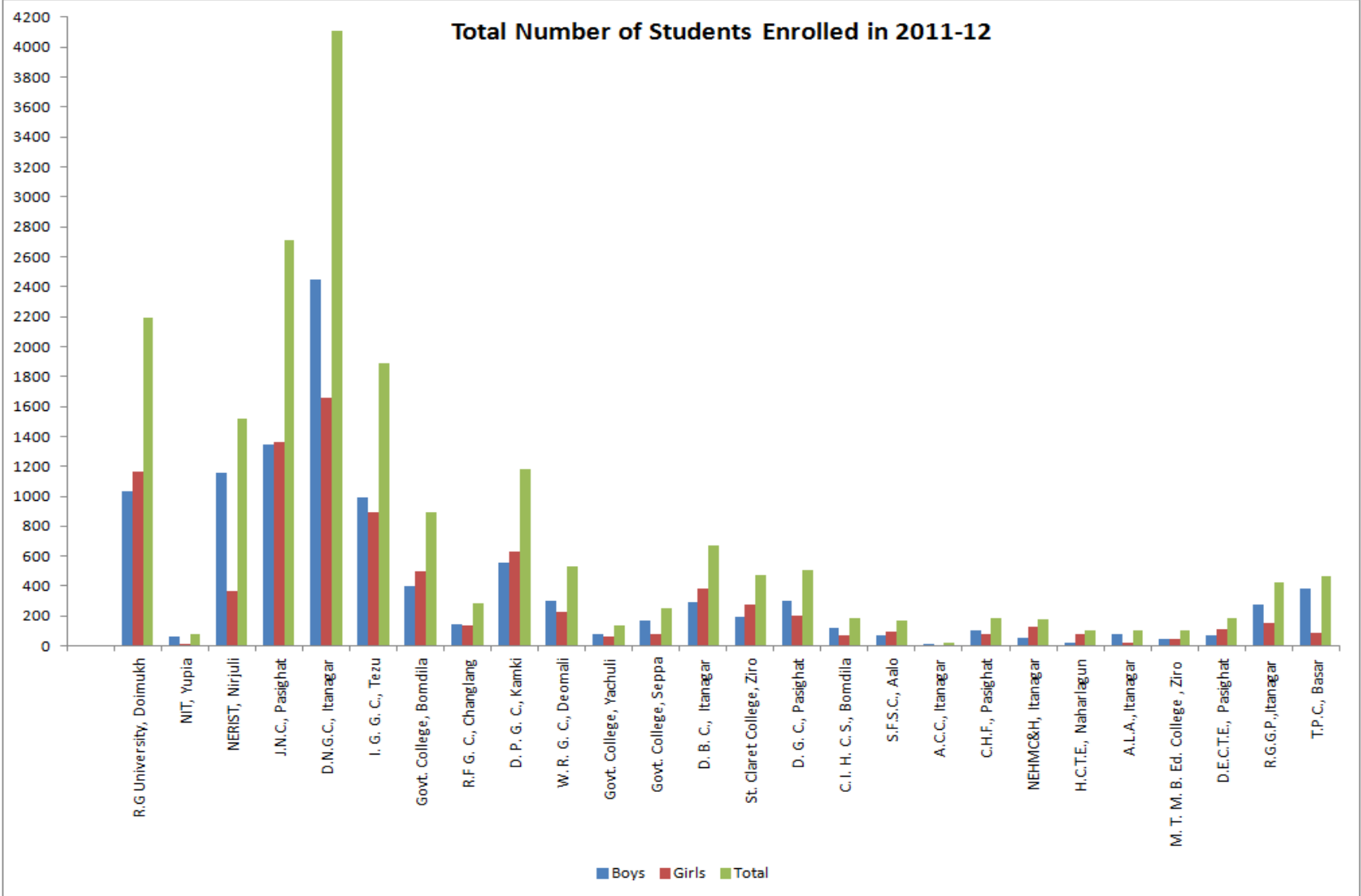
GRAPH SHOWING STUDENT ENROLLMENT DURING 2012-13



Total Number of Non-APST Students enrolled in 2011-12



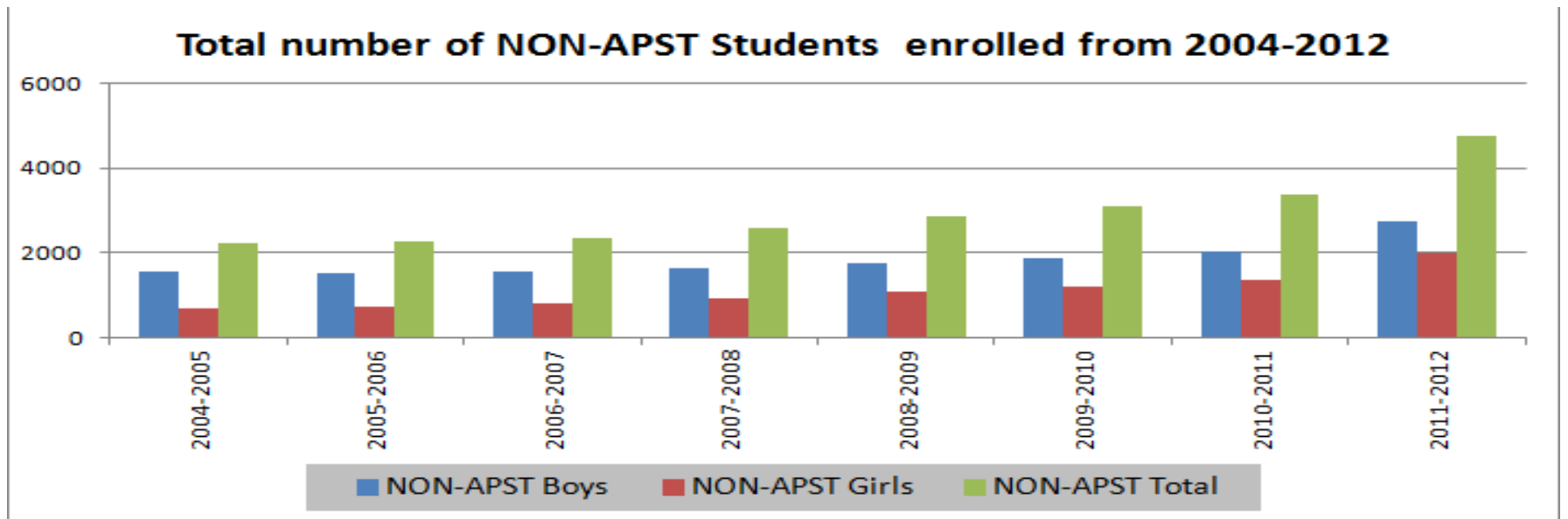
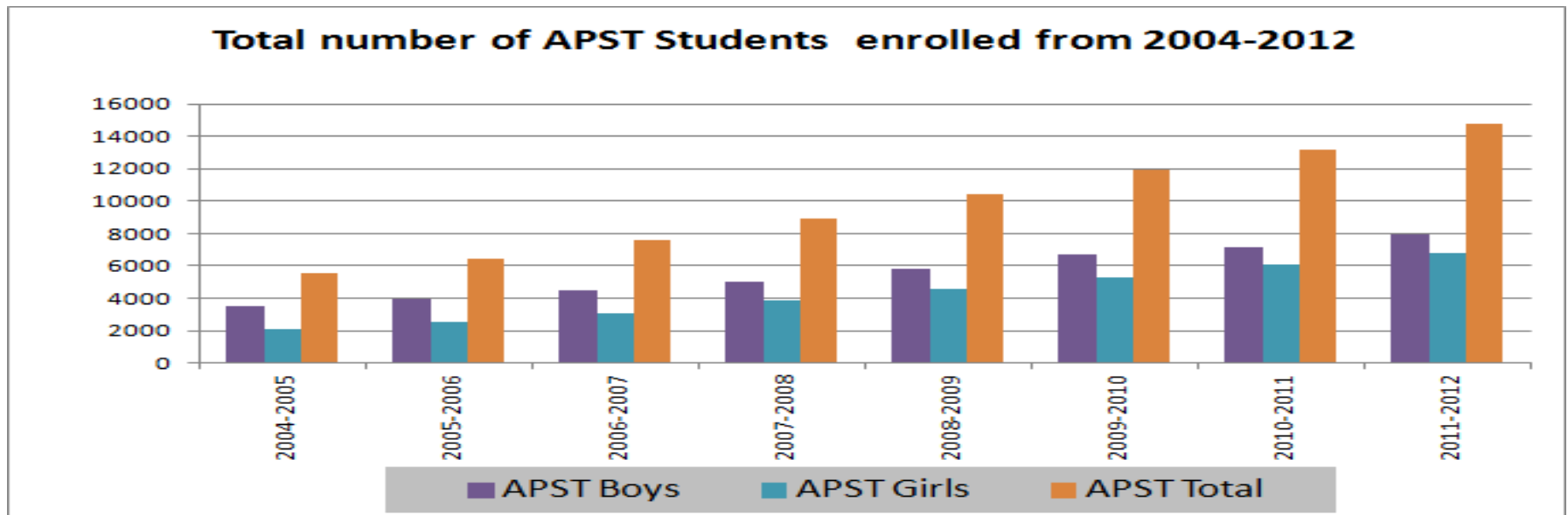

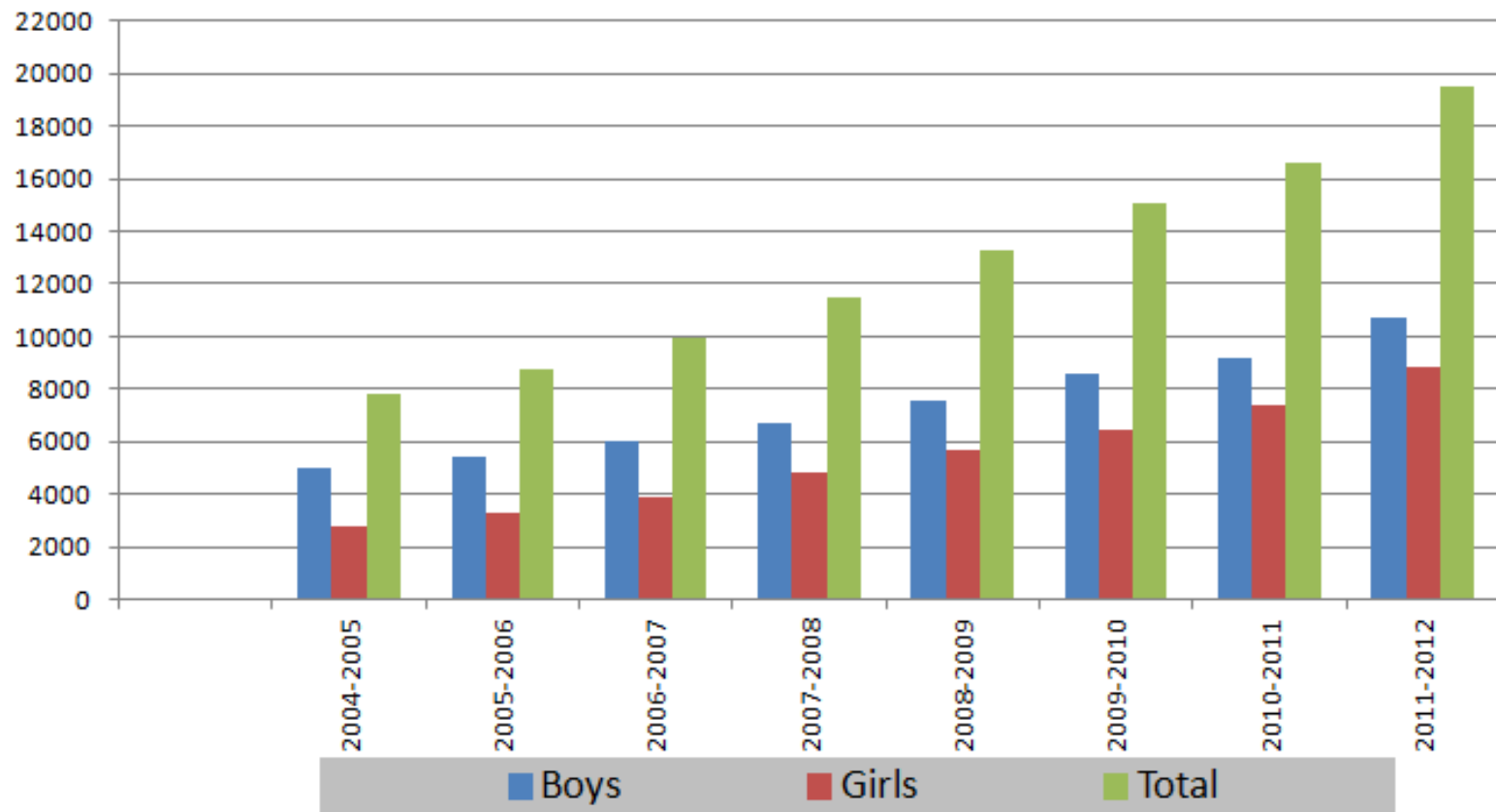

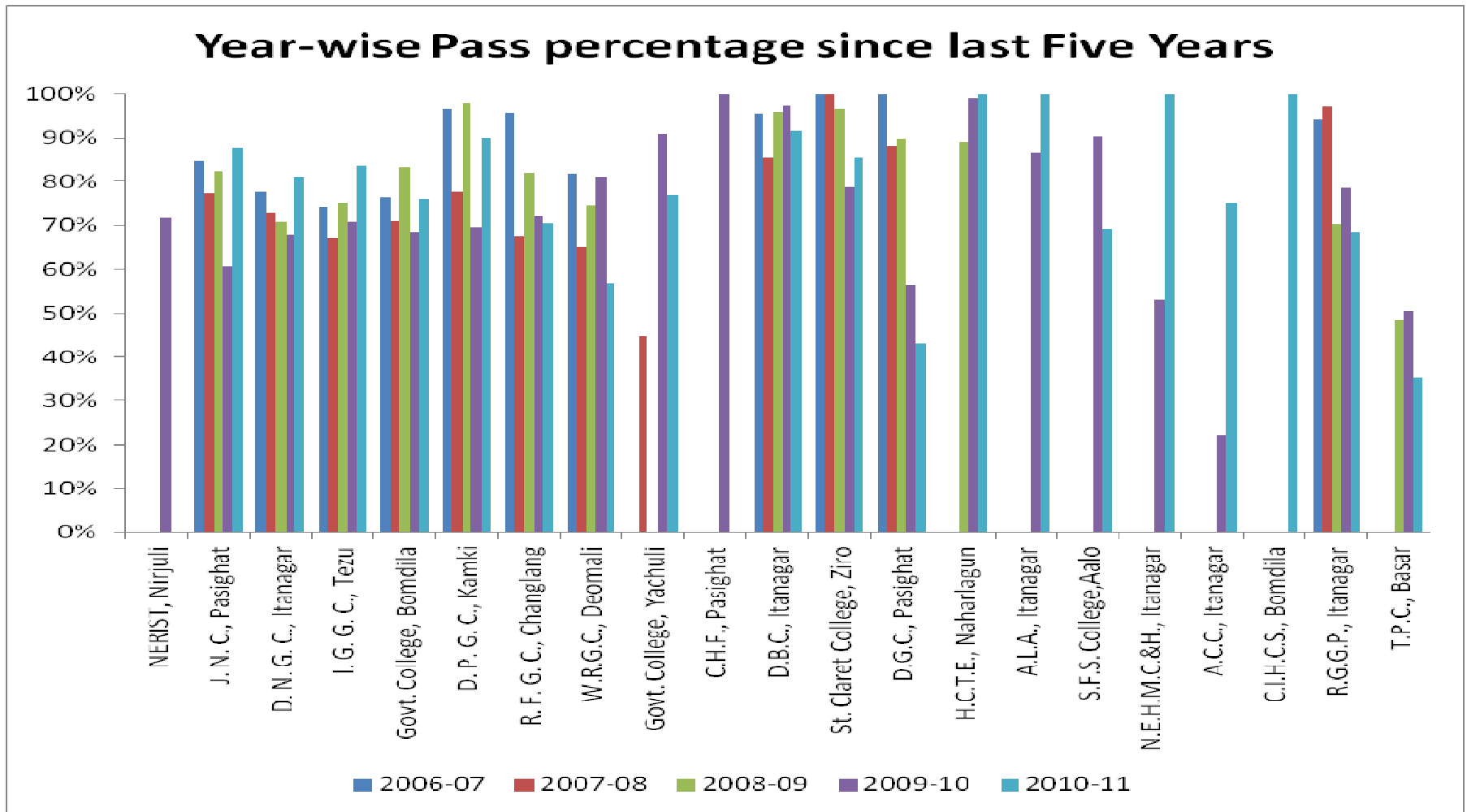
